The first quarter of the school year is already in the books. This year is truly flying by!!!

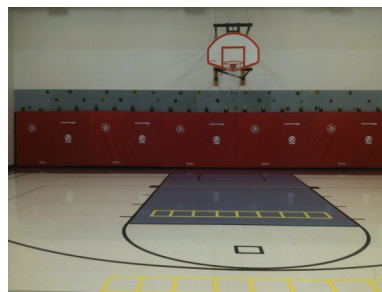
During the first quarter we completed these various activities:
