

# How to Make a Circle Book



Cut out a circle.



Then with a pencil lightly mark a radius (from the center out to the edge).



Cut on this line, being careful not to cut past the center.

Fold the circle completely in half along the line where you cut.





Open the circle and fold over the quarter formed by the cut. Now your book looks like  $\frac{3}{4}$  of a circle.



Continue folding.: Fold the already folded 2 quarters over onto the quarter above them so that now your book looks like a semi-circle. Finally fold the thick part over onto the remaining quarter of a circle. Now your book is  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the original circle's size.

One outside page becomes the back. The other outside page becomes the front. You are left with six "pages" (actually quarters), for your text and pictures.

If six pages is not enough, you can add another circle. After cutting two circles to the center mark, tape them together on that cut. Below is a red circle taped on top of a pink one.



### EXAMPLE

Below is a single circle book my daughter made — the Lipizzaner Sires. She is opening it up page by page (L-R; top to bottom).
