* Use numbers: 1 2 3 4

* you can use each number once per expression

* you can add, multiply or subtract the numbers

* you can use parenthesis and exponents if you want

ex.) $(1 \times 2) + 4 - 3 \rightarrow$ I would use this as my expression for 3 =

\downarrow
 $2 + 4 - 3$
 \downarrow
 $6 - 3 = 3$

* my advice *

randomly create expressions following the above "rules" and then solve them - just play with the numbers and different math tasks (add, subtract or multiply)
