I will follow up on this. <p>MATHS</p> <p>Over the next few weeks we will looking at division. Please discuss division as 'sharing' as home with your child and encourage them to practise division with objects around house.</p> <p><u>Maths Home Learning Books - AWS</u></p> <p>Just 1 page due next Wednesday so that students have more time for Mathathon.</p> <p>Feel free to mark this at home with students, or they will self-mark before school.</p> <p>Circles – Book 2 - Page 27, worksheet 33 Triangles and Squares – Book 3 - Page 45, worksheet 12</p> <p><u>Mathathon</u></p> <p>Keep learning the answers at home and getting sponsors for the Mathathon grand quiz which will be held on the 14th of June.</p> <p><u>Study Ladder</u></p> <p>I have set some new tasks on Study Ladder for students to complete.
