

EVERYTHING YOU WANT TO KNOW ABOUT THE 7TH GRADE FIELD TRIP ON DECEMBER 11TH

1. What time are we leaving?
About 9:30am or whenever the buses arrive.
2. How are we getting on the buses? *You will be assigned a group and a teacher who will lead you.*
3. Will we have “regular” classes that day? *Not really. You will attend your Intervention class as usual and then go to your 1st period class for attendance. After attendance, you may be moved to either Mr. Merhar’s room or Mrs. B’s room.*
4. What are we doing about eating? *You will be able to buy some additional breakfast food before we leave for the field trip (between 9:00-9:20)The choices are prices are listed at the bottom of this sheet.*
5. What about lunch? *There will be no lunch because the performance is from 11:00 until 12:30, and then we have to travel back to school. Unless you have a medical emergency and have been given permission prior, you may not pack or bring any food with you on the field trip (however, see #6). When we arrive back to school, you will be given a snack (PBJ sandwich round; fruit punch; and either potato chips or applesauce.) You already paid for this along with the transportation & ticket price.*
6. Can we pack a lunch to eat for when we return to school?
Yes, but you will not be able to refrigerate it or buy something additional to drink from the cafeteria.
7. Where are we eating when we get back? *Each team will grab their snack from the cafeteria and then will come up to a teacher’s room to eat it.*
8. Do we have to do any work when we get back? *With time, you will have to do a short follow-up assignment after you eat.*
9. Are we allowed to take our iPods, iPads, cameras or cell phones with us?
NO! All electronics will stay back in your locker (or at home). The theater does not want any distractions (noises, lights, etc.) for the performers.
10. What if there is an emergency? *Your teachers will have phone, and your emergency information to contact whomever is necessary in that situation.*
11. Will we be allowed to buy souvenirs or food at the play? *No, you will have an intermission to use the restroom or the drinking fountain but concessions will NOT be open.*
12. What if I need to use the restroom or get thirsty during the performance? *Students will NOT be permitted to walk around the theater or to leave their seats during the performance. You will need to be sure to use the restrooms and water fountain before we get on the bus (at school) and during intermission, when permitted.*
13. Do we have to dress up? *Not necessarily; it is customary to dress a little “nicer” when you go to a theater. Keep your sweats, shorts, and athletic wear at home on this day. Wear something “nice”. This does NOT mean ladies should wear homecoming dresses and gentleman should wear suits! This means a tie is fine (but not necessary!); khakis are great; dress pants; etc. Ladies—do not wear uncomfortable or high heels, as we cannot ensure how snowy or icy it will be and how far we’ll have to walk when we get off the bus. Jeans are permitted. Be sure that your attire meets the dress code and remember that we will be representing our school and community.*
14. Will we be the only school there? *No. There will likely be other schools there, too.*
15. Is it ok if I sit with my friend? *If your friend is assigned to the same teacher/group as you, then yes. But if you are caught talking during the performance, standing on the bus, or behaving inappropriately, you will be separated and will remain by your teacher’s side.*
