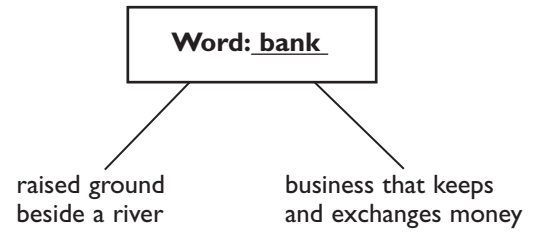


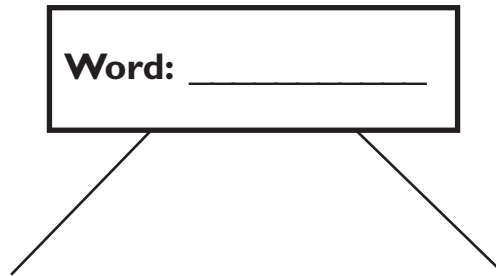
# Multiple Meaning Map

A Multiple Meaning Map is used to show more than one definition of the same word. The vocabulary word to be defined goes in the box. Each meaning goes at the end of a line under the box. Below, a single sentence uses both meanings of the word. Look at the example.

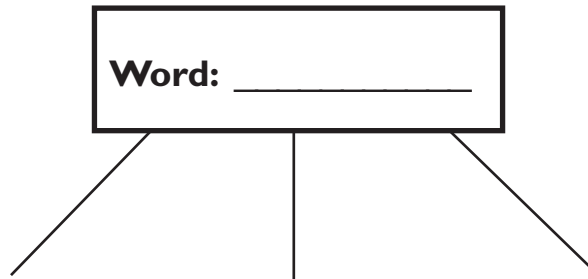
