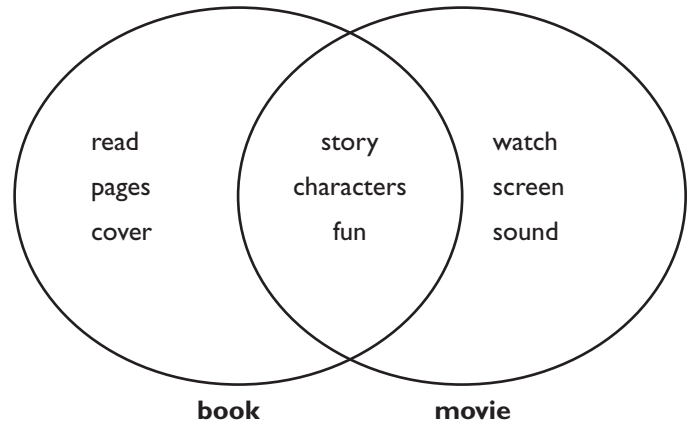


Venn Diagram

A Venn Diagram is used to compare and contrast two people, things, places, or ideas. Words that describe only the first thing go in one circle. Words that describe only the second thing go in the other circle. Words that can be used to describe both things belong in the overlapping, center section. Look at the example.

Make your own Venn Diagram by choosing two things to compare and contrast. Write their names on the blank lines under the circles. Then write vocabulary words on the lines inside the circles.
