Grammar:

Compound sentences

- Independent Clause
- Coordinating conjunctions (a.k.a. FAN BOYS)

Complex sentences

- Independent and Dependent clauses
- 2 sentence formulas
- subordinating conjunctions (cheat sheet with list of words)

Semicolons

- 2 related independent clauses
- using a connector word
- list of items that contains commas

Compound-Complex sentences

- 2+ IC & 1 DC
- 1 thought (complex sentence) + 1 thought connected with a FAN BOYS
- EXAMPLE:
 1. (complex = 1 thought) Although I don't normally eat fish, I usually do during Lent.
 2. (1 thought) I don't think it's that bad.
 3. (FAN BOYS) and
 4. Combining all parts: **Although I don't normally eat fish, I usually do during Lent, and I don't think it's that bad.**

Appositives

- extra information about a noun – usually the subject of sentence

Subject – Verb Agreement

- singular subject → singular verb
- plural subject → plural verb

Indefinite Pronouns (Subject – Verb Agreement)

- use cheat sheet of words to determine if subject is singular and plural
- this determines the verb agreement
