___ ___	archipelago	1) an area of land completely surrounded by water
___ ___	bay	2) a large body of water surrounded by land
___ ___	cape	3) a large stream of water that flows into a lake or ocean or other body of water
___ ___	delta	4) a triangular deposit of sand and soil that collects at the mouth of some rivers
___ ___	gulf	5) the part of a river where its waters flow into another body of water
___ ___	harbor	6) a narrow deep waterway connecting two bodies of water OR the deepest part of a river or waterway
___ ___	isthmus	7) low land between hills or mountains
___ ___	oasis	8) a point of land extending into a body of water
___ ___	strait	9) a row of connected mountains
___ ___	tributary	10) land surrounded by water on all sides but one
___ ___	canal	11) part of an ocean extending into land and usually larger than a bay
___ ___	channel	12) a land form with high elevation and a pointed or rounded top higher than a hill
___ ___	desert	13) an opening in the earth's surface through which steam and ashes and lava are forced out

Landforms

___ ___	glacier	14) a narrow waterway connecting two large bodies of water
___ ___	island	15) a stream or river that flows into a larger stream or river
___ ___	lake	16) a dry barren region that may be sandy and without trees
___ ___	mountain	17) a narrow strip of land with water on both sides connecting two larger areas of land
___ ___	mountain range	18) part of an ocean or lake extending into land and usually smaller than a gulf
___ ___	mouth	19) a broad and flat or gently rolling area usually low in elevation
___ ___	peninsula	20) a group of many islands
___ ___	plain	21) a fertile place in the desert where there is water and some vegetation
___ ___	river	22) a waterway dug across land through which ships can pass
___ ___	swamp	23) low wet land that supports grass and trees
___ ___	valley	24) a huge mass of ice that moves slowly down a mountain
___ ___	volcano	25) a sheltered area of water where ships can anchor safely
