THE ENEMIES OF ROME - HANNIBAL



Task:

Imagine that you are part of Hannibal's army that is marching towards Rome. Write 4 postcards home to Carthage telling your family or friends what life is like on the journey. You must include as many historical facts as possible: e.g. the route taken, places visited, major battles, attacks by barbarian tribes, the food you ate, the climate, the problems that you have experienced etc.

Aims of this task - to show understanding and factual knowledge of Hannibal the man and his attack on Rome.

<u>Grade</u>	<u>What is required</u>
A	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You have shown a detailed and accurate understanding of 4 of the main events on Hannibal's journey to attack Rome. This understanding will be presented in 4 postcards written as if you were one of Hannibal's men. Your postcards show solid factual knowledge of the main problems and experiences of Hannibal's army on their way to Rome: e.g. how he crossed the Alps with elephants. Wide-ranging examples have been included in your work: e.g. food eaten and attacks by Albrogians. Your work contains accurate dates and includes references to events that actually happened on the journey to Rome.
B	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You have shown sound knowledge and understanding of 4 of the main events on Hannibal's journey to Rome. You mention some of the problems which Hannibal's men encountered on their journey, but these will not be described and explained in detail: e.g. the reasons why Hannibal succeeded in crossing the Alps will not be explained. You will also have included some, but not many, dates and historical events in your work.
C	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You have shown some good factual knowledge about Hannibal's journey, but you need to develop your understanding and add more historical details and examples. You have some understanding of the problems encountered on the journey but have not explained these in enough detail.
D	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You have shown a basic knowledge and simple understanding of the main events in Hannibal's journey. Your work lacked detailed information about Hannibal's journey and makes some reference to the conditions on the journey: e.g. "It rained again today..." You have only included 2 postcards.
E	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You have shown vague factual knowledge and an outline understanding of Hannibal's journey: e.g. that he used elephants. You have covered only one event.
