

Arson Suspect is Held in Massachusetts Fire

On Saturday afternoon, a number of tragedies took place downtown. Fire was set to a warehouse and was undetected until a 911 call was made saying the fire had "spread to a number of other buildings." Firefighters rushed to the scene and began putting out the largely spread fire. No fatalities or injuries were reported. Meanwhile, a suspect was caught by police and held inside the police station. Soon after, fire was set to the police station where the mistaken suspect was trapped in a holding cell. The flames spread too quickly for police to save the man from the cell. The arsonist has not been caught, and police are refusing to be questioned about this tragedy involving the death of a young man. The public is shocked by the apparent carelessness of the police.
