

Anthem Essay Assessment Checklist:

- ✓ Demonstrate understanding of the novelette
- ✓ Use a formal writing style (Voice of authority/3rd person)
- ✓ Write clearly and coherently
- ✓ Use consistent verb tense
- ✓ Organize ideas: Introduction (thesis), Body, Conclusion
- ✓ Use a minimum of three (3) quotes from *Anthem* to support the main idea
- ✓ Use at least one (1) quote from one (1) of the articles of the week (1-4)
- ✓ Include a Works Cited page at the end of your paper (Get it from common/_students/_High School/Knuth/___hour
- ✓ Use 12 point font and double space everywhere
- ✓ Submit it by the end of class on Tuesday, October 2, 2012

Parenthetical reference format:

- Quotes must be exact.
- The author's last name should be in parentheses following the quote.
- Include the page number for Anthem. No page number is necessary for the articles.
- The author's last name refers the reader to the Works Cited page.

Examples:

No individual may work for himself in Anthem's society because the leaders endorse the Great Truth. "The Great Truth which is this: that all men are one and that there is no will save the will of all men together" (Rand 20).

People in leadership positions, as stated by Russel, "should remember we are called to these positions to serve others and the greater good," but service for the sake of service could potentially lead to a collectivist society as demonstrated in *Athem*.
