In a reflective essay, respond to the following questions as thoroughly as possible:

- Which book did you enjoy most? Why?
- Which book made you think the most? Why?
- What connections did you make within text, to other books, or to the world around you when you were reading? Explain.
- How did your reading connect to your own life? Explain.
- Which genre did you tend to read? Why?
- How have your reading habits been impacted by the assigned independent reading? Please explain and be honest.
- What book(s) do you plan to read next? Why?
- How do you feel about reading independently?

Your writing should be organized and well written using MLA Style format. Grading will be based on the Basic Writing Rubric.
