1. Create a Venn diagram to compare and contrast the two experiments of Milgram and Asch about conformity. (include key terms, make sure diagram is clear and organized)
2. Create five multiple choice questions about one of the experiments we discussed in class to test a classmate (don't forget to provide an answer sheet). If you chose this you CANNOT do number 8.
3. Write a letter as one of the people that were apart of any experiment we have discussed. - Describe the way you felt during the experiment, and how the experiment has changed you.
4. Create a wanted ad for one of the experiments (except Zimbardo). You need to include an outline of what the subject will experience during the experiment. (Make sure you are inline with what the actual experiment made the subjects do)

5. Research a social psychology experiment we did not discuss in class and give a summary of the experiment. At least one credible source is required.
6. Create a comic strip or instruction sheet to explain an experiment we have learned (use pictures and key words to explain process clearly)

9. Write a newspaper article that is reporting on the experiment (of your choice). The article must include what went on during the experiment and how this will change society. (include specific, accurate facts with good English. You could include quotes and images. Have a look at newspapers for an idea of how they present articles. Need at least 2 credible sources)
10. Create an infographic about one of the experiments (either discussed in class or not). (be creative and have a balance of text and graphics. Include factual information and links to other useful websites that may help with revision. At least two credible sources are required.)
11. Create storyboard based on one of the experiments we have studied. This could feature a person or place of the experiment. (be creative but keep it true to the original experiment)
