Third Grade Homework Calendar

Each week, your child will get a new homework calendar. There will be different homework choices in math or writing for each day. Please select one with your child to complete. **Reading Reflections should be completed every day.** Homework and Daily Reading Reflections should be completed in each student's homework notebook unless a separate sheet is attached. Reading Reflections are expected to be one complete paragraph with at least 4-5 sentences. Homework notebooks and Reading Logs in the Daily Folder should be turned in each day. Color in or draw an X in the box of the Math or Writing homework choice you made.

Reading Reflection: Read for at least 20 minutes. After reading, reflect on whether or not this was a good fit book for you. Did it match your purpose and interest? Did you understand what you read? Did you know all or most of the words? Please do not answer the above questions with a yes or no. Each question should be explained in at least one complete sentence.	Reading Reflection: Before reading , explain why you chose what you will read and what you hope to find out. Read for at least 20 minutes.	Reading Reflection: Enjoy a fiction book today. Before reading , preview your book. This may include looking at the cover, title page, illustrations and summary. Then, write down 2-3 predictions of what you think will happen. After reading, review each prediction. If that event actually happened, put a check mark next to it. If your prediction changed, write another sentence to tell how it changed.	Reading Reflection: Read for at least 20 minutes. Make sure you record what you read in your reading log.
