<b>Choice 1</b>  LABOR DAY HOLIDAY  Possible Writing Genres: How To's, Lists, Informational books, letters, comic strips, adventure stories, fantasies, etc.	<b>Choice 1</b> In your homework notebook sketch a picture of something fun you did over the long weekend. Have a parent or sibling look at your sketch and discuss what details you can add to your sketch.	<b>Choice 1</b> Write what the word <b>expanded form</b> means to you. Then write the following numbers in <b>expanded form</b> . Ex) $543 = 500 + 40 + 3$  a) 234      b) 6,372 c) 893      d) 471 e) 506      f) 2011	<b>Choice 1</b> Take a scavenger hunt around your house. What kinds of writing genres did you find? Be sure to list the name of the item and what writing genre it could be.
<b>Choice 2</b>  LABOR DAY HOLIDAY	<b>Choice 2</b> Find a comic strip on the internet or in the newspaper. Write down in complete sentences what details in the sketches helped you understand what was happening. Could you add any other details?	<b>Choice 2</b> Write 782 in as many ways as you can think of. You must show 782 in at least <b>eight</b> different ways.	<b>Choice 2</b> In your homework notebook write down three topic ideas that you could write about. What genre of writing you could write those topics in? Then choose one of the topics and draw a pencil sketch of it.
<b>Choice 3</b>  LABOR DAY HOLIDAY	<b>Choice 3</b> Design your own comic strip giving an example of following the Wiley Way. Make sure your sketches have lots of details added. Write down why using lots of details was important in creating your comic strip.	<b>Choice 3</b> For the following problem explain which answers are correct and why they are correct. Explain why the other choices are incorrect.  Which way shows the number 5,362 written in expanded form? a) $300 + 5,000 + 2 + 60$ b) $5,000 + 300 + 60 + 2$ c) $5,000 + 360 + 2$	<b>Choice 3</b> Write your own "what if story." The examples are only to get your thinking. Be creative. Examples: -What if the principal had pink hair? -What if we had school in outer space?
<b>Reading Reflection:</b>  LABOR DAY HOLIDAY	<b>Reading Reflection:</b> After reading for at least 20 minutes, explain the reason why you chose your <b>just fit</b> <b>book</b> . What was your purpose for reading the book? Why did it interest you? Was it a <b>just fit</b> <b>book</b> ? How did you know?	<b>Reading Reflection:</b> After reading for at least 20 minutes, tell me about the genre of the book you read. Explain what parts in the book helped you figure out which genre it was.	<b>Reading Reflection:</b> After reading for at least 20 minutes, write about your favorite part in the story. Be sure to tell what your favorite part was with details from the story and why it was your favorite part?
