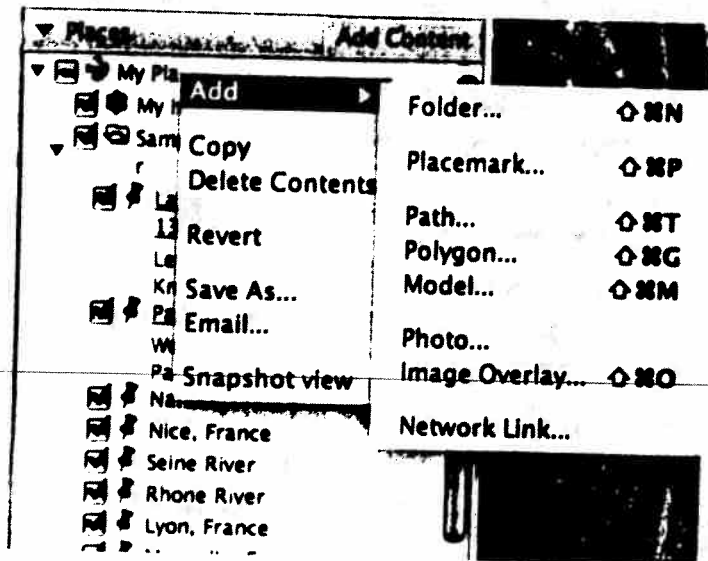
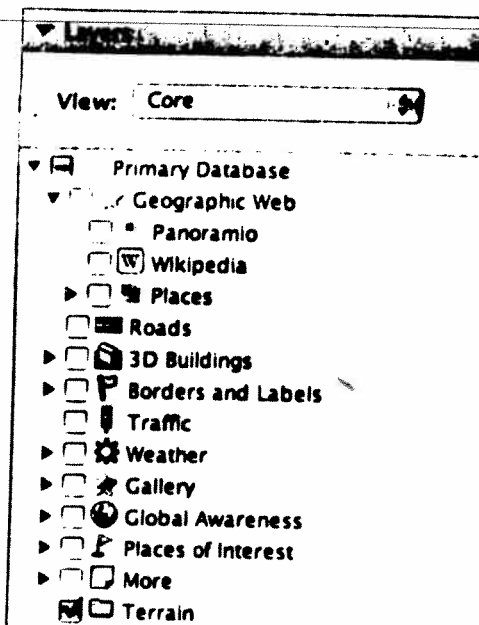


Creating a Google Earth Tour

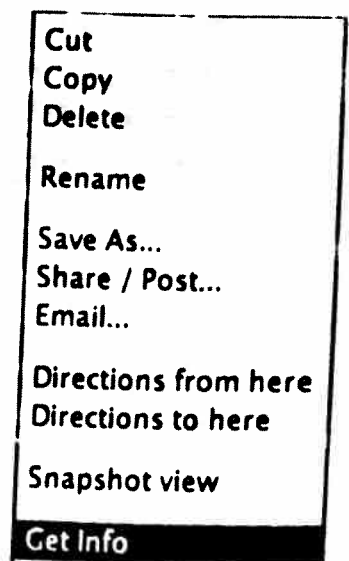
1. Create your tour folder
 - a. Open Google Earth
 - b. Control-click on My Places --> select Add --> Folder
 - c. Name your folderpd_firstnames



2. Create landmarks for each of your locations.

- All projects should begin at LMS rm 138!
- Use Search to "fly" to the location you want to placemark.
- Use the controls within the program to set the elevation and altitude before you create the placemark.
- Control-click on your folder --> select Add --> Placemark. Name your placemark.
- For geographic features turn on the terrain layer which is one of the layers found in the Geographic Web layers. This makes it easier to see the geographic features.

3. After you have created all your placemarks make sure that they are in the correct order for your tour. To re-order your placemarks just click on the one you want to move and drag and drop it to the correct location in the tour.
4. To add the content to your placemarks control-click on the placemark and select Get Info.



5. Paste the content for the placemark into the description box.
6. You can change the placemark symbol by clicking on the placemark symbol.
7. To insert a link to an image or website type in the following text EXACTLY!!

8. To insert an image itself requires more steps.

Inserting an Image using a URL

Right click on the image in a web browser and select Properties. Select and copy the entire URL for the image.

Type the following into the description box for your placemark EXACTLY!!

Inserting an Image Overlay using a downloaded Image

Download the images you want to use to a folder on your desktop.
 Control-click on your placemark --> select Add --> Image Overlay

Name the image overlay.

Click on Browse to navigate to the image.
 Type text about the image including the URL of where you got the image into the description box.

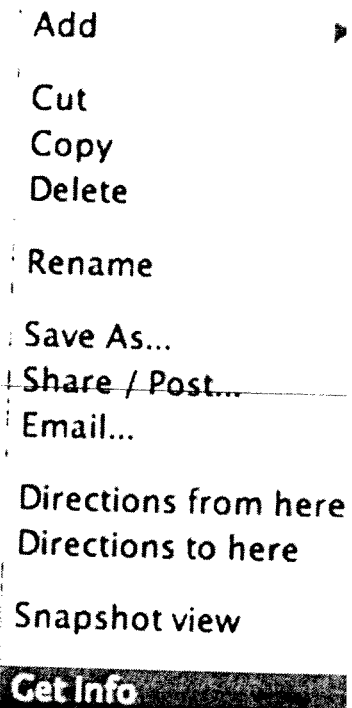

1. Control-click on the placemark and select Get Info
2. Copy and paste the paragraph that you write from the Moodle wiki into your description box.



To add your images into Google Earth – use an image overlay

1. Download your images from the websites to the desktop of the computer
2. Go to the placemark where you want to place the image and zoom all the way in.
3. Control-click on the placemark and select add image overlay
4. Name the image overlay first!
5. Use the browse button to find the image on your desktop
6. Paste in the description box the URL of the image.
7. To adjust the image...

Resize the box using the green handles on the image.

Use the crosshair in the center of the image to move its location.

Use the diamond on the left side of the picture to rotate it.
