

# Enhanced Podcasts

- Open Garageband
- Choose New Podcast Episode
- Save
- Select the Male or Female Track
- Record by clicking the red button



## Select the Jingles Track



- Click on the eye to view selections
- Drag and drop your selection into the track
- Drag and drop sound effects to automatically add a new track
- Slide voice, jingles and sound effects to create your audio.

## Add Artwork

### Capture pictures from the Internet to your desktop

- Control click – choose Save Image as
- Command, Shift + “4” – click and drag to save selection to desktop
- Drag and Drop to desktop


### Adding Pictures to Podcast

- Click on the Podcast Track
- Drag and Drop Pictures into the Podcast Track
- Use double arrow – click and drag to adjust pictures as needed to fit poem

# Enhanced Podcasts


## Add Episode Artwork

- Drag Artwork into Episode Artwork
- Adjust the size of your Artwork
- Double click the picture to open the Artwork Editor – use the slider and adjust the box to fit your art.



## Adjust the track volume

- Click on the right triangle under the track title
- This opens the Track volume area
- Click on the line – a break (dot) is created
- Adjust the volume by adding more breaks (dots) and adjusting the volume level as desired.



## Ducking



- Click on the top triangle as shown to adjust volume levels so that the Voice track is the focal track.

- Share to iTunes
- iTunes will create a folder for you

## Publishing your Podcast

- Under Share in the Menu Bar – Send Podcast to iTunes
- iTunes will create a folder for you
- Click Save

## Open your Class Wiki –

- Click on the word “Blog” at top of page
- Click the “+” to add a new blog page
- Title it – “your name”
- Delete text instructions and enter your poem, include the poem type and title on the first line
- Click on Insert Media – images, audio or Quicktime
- Browse to your Podcast
  - Username – Music – iTunes Music – locate your folder and your poem
- Click Open
- Click Insert

## Your poem should upload to the page

- Click Save
- Click the word “WIKI” at the top of the page to return to the main WIKI page
- Click on Poetry page
- Click on Pencil to edit
- Place curser at bottom of list of names
- Click on Add Link to Create or Edit a Link
- Search
- Enter your name
- Click on your name in the pull down menu to link
- Save the page
