Weekly Objectives

First Grade Families,

This week, we are introducing the Writing station to our Daily 5 routine. This station is differentiated based on student needs. Different activities include sight word writing, handwriting practice, how-to writing and bucket filler slips.

Last week, we introduced our final station, the Word Work station. This station will also be differentiated by ability levels. Students will be assigned a color level and will choose from activities including short vowel identification, comparing short and long vowels, using blends and digraphs and sorting words based on parts of speech.

At this point in the year, students are expected to

correctly identify short vowel sounds in words, correctly use upper and lower case letters in words and sentences and end sentences with punctuation. As students complete homework, please reinforce these prior objectives.

Weekly Objectives are:

- Reading/Language Arts — Review all short vowel sounds

Naming Part (subject) — Students will identify the naming part of a sentence.

Genre—Fables

- Math — Everyday Uses of Numbers—Conclude Unit 2— Addition and Subtraction Facts and Number stories

- Science — Measuring Properties of Matter (Length, Mass and Capacity) Light—Students will distinguish between man-made and natural sources of light.

- Social Studies — Needs and Wants— Students will distinguish needs (food, water, shelter, air) from wants.

Goods and Services— Students will sort jobs that produce a good from those that provide a service.
