Monthly Objectives

English Language Arts: We will be reading books about fall, thanksgiving and fairy tales. Through these read alouds we will practice identifying point of view, compare and contrast story elements, and make predictions. Letters: Ee, Vv, Zz, Xx, Jj, Qu, Yy, Kk. Sight words: had, have, help, helps, here, away, do, was, ill, her, his + says.

Science: Students will explore ways that objects change and interact with other objects due to movement. Students will also observe, identify and explore patterns of change in nature.

Math: Students will count and represent quantities and collections fluently to 20. Students will identify patterns in numbers while counting to 50. Students will also use multiple models to develop number sense and represent numbers to 10 in flexible ways. Students will compare quantities and collections fluently to 20

Social Studies: Students will be introduced to good citizens in the community. Students will also use voting to make some decisions in the classroom. Students will also explore family customs and traditions.
