Monthly Objectives

English Language arts (ELA): HFWs: and are like likes but down not on up us big go in it little come said with to as has want. Letters and sounds: R L U N I G D F H W. Students will continue identifying the parts of a book: front/back cover, spine, title, author and title page; as well as the story elements: characters, setting, problem, solution. Students will begin to discover cause and effect relationships in read alouds. Students will deepen their comprehension by learning the CAFÉ strategies: Text to text and text to self connections & backing up and rereading/monitoring and fixing up what we read.

Math: Students will compare the length of given objects. Students will identify coins. Students will identify ways to earn income and distinguish between income and gifts. Students will collect and organize data to create graphs and interpret information. Students will count forward to 50 by 1's and to 100 by 10's. Students will count and represent quantities and collections fluently to 20. Students will identify patterns in numbers while counting to 50.

Science: Students will gather information about properties of matter by measuring objects and determining how they behave in water. Students will conduct simple investigations and use their senses to explore light, heat and sound energy. Students will also explore ways that objects change and interact with other objects due to movement.

Social Studies: Introduce students to the reasons for certain national patriotic holidays and contributions of important people in history. Introduce students to ways in which families satisfy their basic human needs for food, clothing, and shelter and to why people work.
