MONTHLY Objectives

English Language arts (ELA): The students will identify the main idea, and practice sequencing. The students will also identify the point of view of a book. Other skills we will be practicing include letter knowledge, sounds and blending. Our High Frequency Words are: had, have, here, help, helps, away, do, was, will, says, her + his.

Math: Students will count and represent quantities and collections fluently to 20. Students will also compare quantities and collections fluently to 20. Students will use multiple models to develop number sense and represent numbers to 10 in flexible ways

Science: Students will explore ways that objects change and interact with other objects due to movement. Students will also observe, identify, and explore patterns of change in nature.

Social Studies: This unit introduces students to good citizens in the community. Students also use voting to make some decisions in the classroom. In this unit, students explore national holidays and customs, as well as family customs and traditions, as commemorations of important group values.
