### Creating a Photo Album in iPhoto

#### Accessing iPhoto Libraries

I. You have already used your teacher's Public Folder to access this sheet. You will also access tomorrow's tutorial here tomorrow as well.

II. After accessing this sheet you are to begin to fill your iPhoto Library with potential images for your Comic Life project.

- Launch iPhoto
- Go to "File" / New Album
- Title your album "MPM Comic Life"

III. Launch Safari (THIS WILL NOT WORK WITH FIREFOX!!!!!!)

- Go to one of the websites listed below to begin your search for possible images. These sites are hyperlinks, so you can click on the URL and this will take you to the website.

- When you find a possible image, put your cursor over the picture that you are interested in. Right click your mouse and select "Add image to iPhoto library". The image will automatically be downloaded into your iPhoto documents.

- Continue to view images and add more images than needed to your iPhoto library.

- Go back to iPhoto and be sure that all images are in your "Comic Life" album. You may need to drag and drop your images to your album if they are under "Last Import".
