

## Comic Life - Milwaukee Public Museum Project

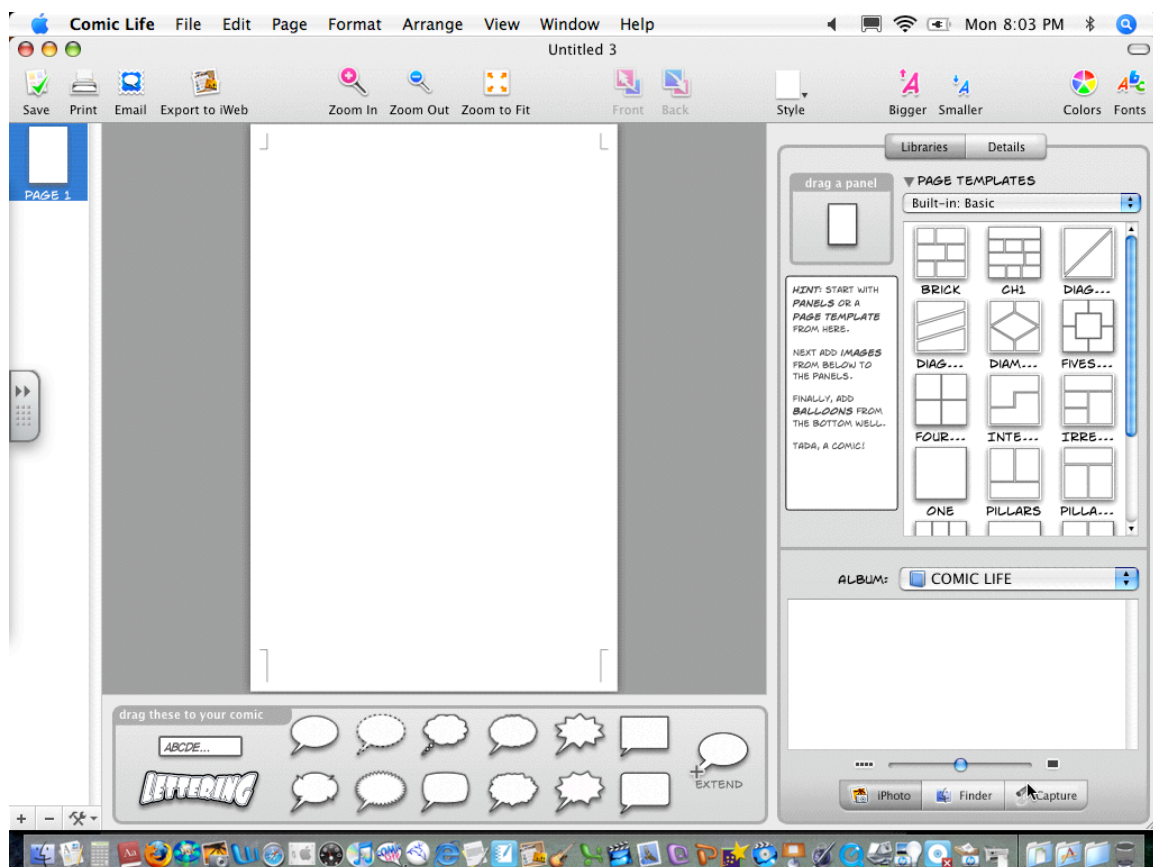
### Day 2 - Creating Your Project

I. You now have finished gathering all of your images, AND if your teacher required you to complete a storyboard, your teacher has approved it.

II. Now it is time to take a quick "Comic Life" tutorial.

- Working with Comic Life.....

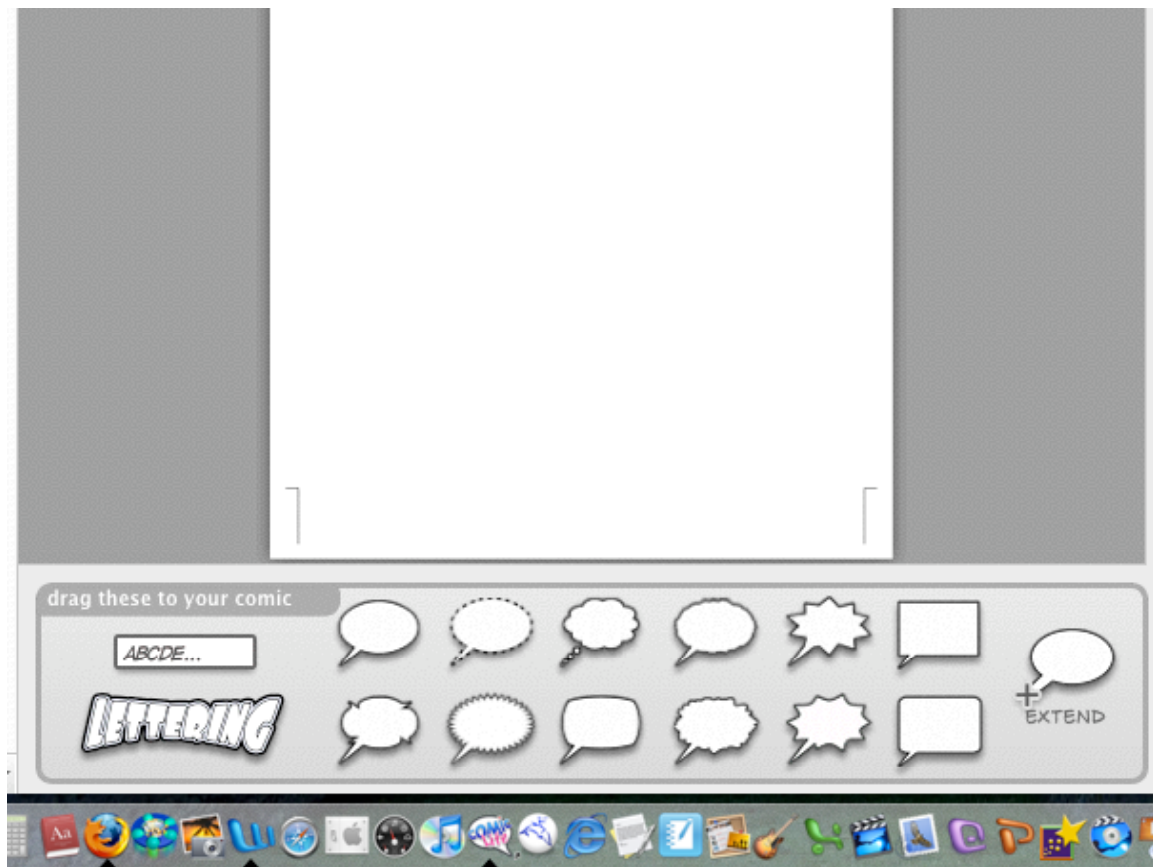
- Once you have opened Comic Life, a blank sheet will appear. You will need to select the template you would like to use. These are located under the "Libraries" and "Details" buttons on the right side. See example below.



- To select a template simply click on the template you like and drag it to the blank page.
- After selecting a template the next step is to add pictures. Images will come from iPhoto and the album you titled, "MPM Comic Life".



- Once you have found the picture or image you want, you simply drag and drop it into the frame in which it should appear.
  - At this time you can manipulate the photo by rotating, shrinking and stretching.
  - Continue to drag photos/images into the template until the storyboard is complete.



- To add titles simply drag and drop either a word or thought bubble. To add commentary about a scene add the "ABCDE..." box.
- After adding narration and conversation bubbles, be sure to spell check, have a peer editor, and check your rubric to be sure all requirements are met.
