

Question of MUN Club Officers Elections

The HIS MUN Club,

Recalling the Club resolution passed on May 15, 2012, which calls for the election of club officers,

Further recalling the Club resolution March 22, 2011, which states that the MUN Coordinator is responsible for ensuring that club resolutions are carried out,

Believing that students can organize themselves in carrying out the work of the United Nations through club activities,

1. Defines a member of the MUN club as any HIS student who has attended at least one conference as a delegate from HIS in the last calendar year with exceptions granted by the MUN Coordinator or immediate past MUN Club leaders;
2. Declares that any member can add themselves for any one and only one of the available positions by
 - a. Going to the wiki page for the election
 - b. Listing their name for the office they choose
 - c. Completing this action 1 week before the announced date of the election;
3. Proclaims that the candidates give short speeches on the day of the election;
4. Defines the election commission as the MUN coordinator and two other teachers that have been chosen by the MUN coordinator and which will,
 - a. Create a wiki page that will list all offices up for election
 - b. Create ballots from the list on the wiki page for the election
 - c. Distribute the ballots at the time of the election
 - d. Observe members place their ballots place in the election box
 - e. Announce the close of the election
 - f. Tabulate the results;
5. Declares that any defined member of the HIS MUN Club can place one vote for each of the three offices on the decided election date;
6. Declares that the winner will be chosen by a simple majority with no run offs;
7. Strongly suggests that the club pass a resolution at the beginning of each school year choosing the date of the election;

8. Urges members to work together to publicize the date of the election by,
 - a. Word of mouth
 - b. Small announcement on the wiki
 - c. A sign on the bulletin board outside the MUN room.
