The Code of Conduct and Statement of Disciplinary Action are agreed to by signing the attached Permission Slip.

1. Code of Conduct

All school rules outlined in the Hangzhou International School Parent-Student Handbook will be enforced on school trips.

All members of the school community will be respectful to each other in an environment that is safe. Disrespectful behavior includes the use of profane language, stealing, fighting, threatening, or other types of rude behavior. In some circumstances, inappropriate behavior off school grounds can affect the functioning of school and will not be tolerated. Making inappropriate comments in a language other than English is also and equally prohibited. The Electronic Use Policy is also in effect at all times during the trip, and students are further reminded that they are personally responsible for any electronic equipment they bring.

2. Statement of Disciplinary Action

The following disciplinary actions will be taken in the event the Code of Conduct or school policies are not followed:

- Placing the student in the care of a chaperone (which could include night-time hours)
- Requiring parents to retrieve their child from the trip
- Referral to school administration, which could result in disciplinary action.
