

## Model United Nations Club

Dear parents of MUN Club members,

The members of the Model United Nations Club will be traveling to a final conference this year. The conference takes place on May 12 at Suzhou Singapore International School. Details about travel are listed below. Since it is a smaller conference, SUZMUN presents a good opportunity for students who have less experience in MUN. Also, because it is the last conference in our calendar, the trip is also somewhat bittersweet; several of the students on this trip will be attending their last HIS MUN club trip. With that in mind, the trip has been extended one day longer to include a day of sightseeing in Suzhou the day after the conference.

A snapshot of the trip. Please note that the trip does take place in the middle of AP exams. Those students signed up for AP exams must consider this commitment very carefully.

Leave HIS immediately after school.	Spend the day at Suzhou Singapore International School. Team dinner after the conference.	Visit the older part of Suzhou to enjoy a boat ride and visit a garden. Return to HIS in the early evening.

The estimated cost of the trip is 700 RMB. It includes two nights at a hotel, the fee for renting a bus for the trip, the conference registration fee, and the usual supervision fee. The trip cost includes lunch and dinner on Saturday, but does not include any other meals. The hotel has breakfast available for 15 RMB; it is a standard Chinese breakfast, so some students might be bringing their own breakfast cereal. The group will have at least one Western meal a day. The first payment of 300 RMB will be due in two weeks, on March 27. The funds can be turned in to Ms. Peggy Pan. It is important that students confirm their commitment to the conference before the end of March.
