On Bioterrorism

Like all other forms of terrorism, Russia takes a very hard line against bioterrorism. However, Russia is considered to be the number one exporter of bioweaponry after the collapse of the USSR. Despite this, there have been no recorded cases of bioterrorism within Russia itself, with the exception of German bioterrorism during WW I, which is not really relevant. Almost all recent cases of bioterrorism have occurred in the USA, the UK, and Japan all of which have relatively frosty relationships with Russia.

On Peacetime Military Incidents Over International Waters

Russia will stall all attempts to have meaningful dialogue about peacetime military incidents over international waters due to its numerous border disputes and disagreements with other countries about Russia's territorial waters.
