

Dear parents / guardians;

As you might be aware of by now, your child will have the opportunity to learn using an iPod Touch at school this year. As a reminder to all parents/guardians and students, the Soaring Eagles teachers have created a list of expectations that all students are expected to respect.

- ✦ Respect the iPod and accessories that have been given to you (take care of it);
- ✦ Respect other students' iPod (you are not to play with someone else's iPod);
- ✦ Respect the teacher's expectations of iPod usage (when you are able to use it, how you are able to use it, where you are able to use it);
- ✦ Students must dock their iPod properly and carefully at all assigned time;
- ✦ No cyberbullying;
- ✦ Students can only have school appropriate content on their iPod. This includes content that a student might save on his/her iPod (i.e. pictures, text, videos, etc.);
- ✦ Students must be careful to ensure that all contributions made on school websites (i.e. Wikis, blogs, email, etc.) are appropriate and respectful;
- ✦ Each student is responsible for having his/her iPod with them at all times when they are in school (unless otherwise told by a teacher).
