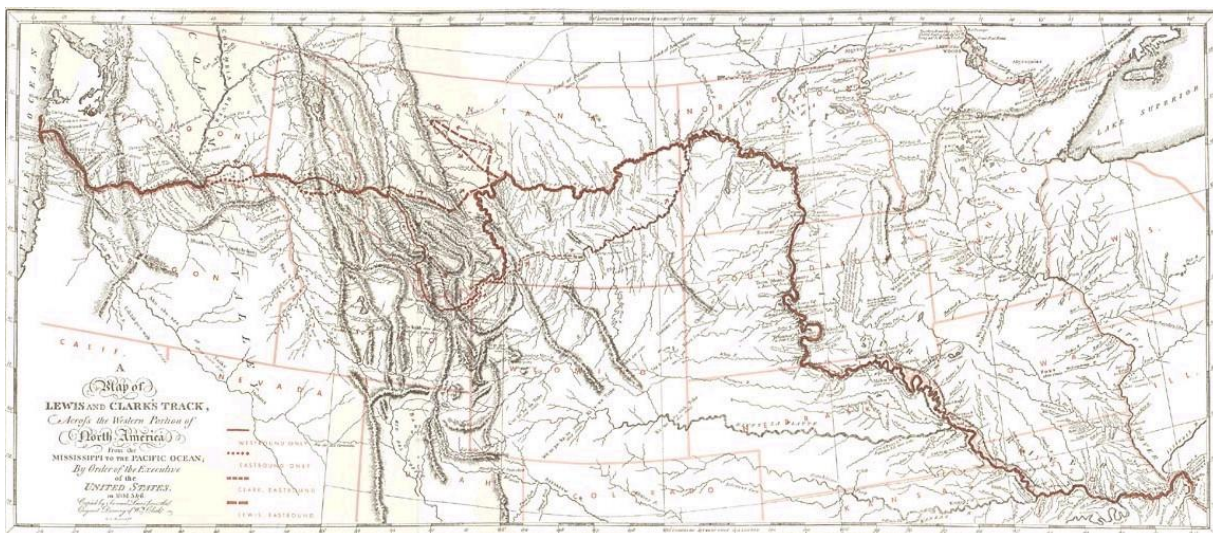
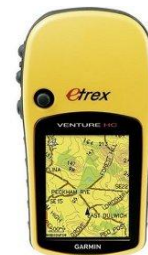


## Finding Your Way with Lewis and Clark and GPS



The expedition of Meriwether Lewis and William Clark as they searched for "the courses and sources of the Missouri, and the most convenient water communication thence to the Pacific ocean,"<sup>2</sup> continues to spark the imagination of Americans.

Today we are going to use "cooperative competition" & GPS (Global Positioning System) to explore some little-known fact and fiction about the Lewis and Clark Expedition. You will use GPS devices to locate geocaches that each contain quiz questions about the Lewis and Clark expedition.



- Each group will search for two geocaches. Each geocache contains six copies of a quiz question about the expedition. You are to give a copy of the question to each of the other groups.
- Once you have returned to base camp with your questions, you will be given three additional questions by the boss (that's me!).
- Answer all the questions on your "Turn-In Copy" and give it to the boss.
- Finish the activity by following the directions on the "Working Copy."
