Other ways to give the time (optional language)

2:00 It's two (o'clock).

2:30 It's half past (two).

2:05 It's five after (two).

2:35 It's twenty-five to (three).

2:10 It's ten after (two).

2:40 It's twenty to (three).

2:15 It's quarter after (two).

2:45 It's quarter to (three).

2:20 It's twenty after (two).

2:50 It's ten to (three).

2:25 It's twenty-five after (two).

2:55 It's five to (three).

Now give everybody in the class a time. Students should walk around and practice this conversation, recording the times that they hear.

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
