

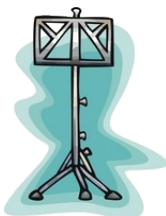
**Here you have more vocabulary related to music and musical instruments.

KEYBOARD INSTRUMENTS

These are the musical instruments which have a **row of keys**.

You play these instruments by **pressing** the keys with your fingers.

They are also called **the keyboards**.



WIND INSTRUMENTS

The musical instruments that you play by **blowing** through them.

These instruments have

buttons or **keys** that you **press**

or

holes that you **cover**

with your



PERCUSSION INSTRUMENTS



The musical instruments that you play by **hitting** them with

your hands or special **sticks**



, or by **shaking** them.

The people in an orchestra or band that play percussion instruments are called **the**

STRINGED INSTRUMENTS



The musical instruments that produce sound from **a set of strings**.

You play some of these instruments by **pulling** a **bow**



across the strings, and some others by **pulling** the strings with your fingers or

with a **plectrum**



The people in an orchestra or band who play stringed instruments are called **the strings** or **the string section**.
