

Role Play Dialogue #2: Fall



Registering for Guitar Lessons

This activity is most useful for English learners: Intermediate (CLB Speaking Level 5)

Setting: Ming (B) is registering for '*Cover Tunes Guitar Class*', being offered at the Royal Conservatory of Music

A: The Office Administrator B: Guitar Student

A: Hello, would you like to register for a class?

B: Yes. I want to take a guitar class.

A: Well, we offer several part-time guitar classes.

B: When are they held?

A: The guitar classes are held on Wednesday nights or Saturday afternoons.

B: Okay, Wednesday nights or Saturday afternoons. I'll register for the Wednesday night class. I work Saturdays.

A: Okay. The Wednesday night class has lots of space. What level are you?

B: I'm a beginner. I can play some basic chords. I also want to learn some songs.

A: The Wednesday class is called 'Cover Tunes Guitar class'. The description says: Students learn popular Canadian songs on guitar including 'Four Strong Winds', 'The Wreck of the Edmund Fitzgerald' and 'If I had a Million Dollars'. It's suitable for beginners.

B: I'm a beginner, so I should fit right in. How many students are in the class?

A: The maximum is 8 students per class.

B: Sounds good. I'd like to register now. Do you take VISA?

A: Yes, we do. You can also pay in 4 installments of \$69.85 if you like.

B: Four installments, that sounds good. I'll pay \$69.85 now, and the rest when?

A: The next 3 payments will be charged monthly to your VISA.

B: Okay, so the next payment is in October, then November, then the last one in December?

A: Yes, that's right. Here's your receipt and class admission paper. The class runs for 14 weeks.

B: Okay. I'm looking forward to it.

A: I hope you enjoy your class.

B: Thank you, I'm sure I will.
