Teacher's notes

Language focus: Future tense / seaside vocabulary
Time (approx.): 12 minutes
Preparation: Photocopy one worksheet for every student.

- Using the worksheet:**
- In Exercise 1 students need to re-order the letters to make words associated with the seaside. Then, give them 5 minutes to think of as many words as possible of things they might see at the seaside.
 - In Exercise 2 the students join the two parts of the verb together. They can look at page 101 of *Way Ahead* Student's Book 4 for extra help. This will prepare them for the final part of the activity and revise vocabulary at the same time.
 - Finally in Exercise 3, the students use the verbs and say whether they *will* or *won't* do these things when they are at the seaside.
