

Role Play Dialogue #1: Fall



Taking the TTC to the National Film Board

This activity is most useful for English learners: High Beginner (CLB Speaking Level 3)

A: ESL Student B: Classmate

A: Hi Wei, are you going on the class field trip tomorrow? The teacher said we're going to see a film about Canada.

B: Yes, I am. I love films! I'm looking forward to visiting the John Spotton Theatre and the NFB Mediatheque.

A: I'm taking the TTC from my place and meeting the class there.

B: I live in Chinatown, so I'm just going to walk over at 9:00 am.

A: Can you help me with the TTC?

B: Yes, I can. Let me see your map. Where do you live?

A: I live near Lansdowne and Queen Street.

B: Take the 501 Queen Streetcar eastbound and get off at John Street.

A: Then what?

B: Walk south on John Street for one block. The NFB is on the northwest corner of John Street and Richmond Street. The address is 150 John Street.

A: Thanks for your help. Do you want to meet for coffee beforehand?

B: Sure. There's a Second Cup right on the corner, where the streetcar stops. I'll meet you there at 8:30 am.

A: Great! I'm new to Toronto so I'm still learning my way around.

B: I came here 2 years ago, so now I'm quite familiar with downtown Toronto.

A: Are you bringing your notebook?

B: Yes, I am. I may want to write some information down while we're there. How about you?

A: I have to work right after class so I may leave my notebook at home.

B: Well, see you tomorrow.

A: Yes, see you tomorrow at 8:30 at the Second Cup.
