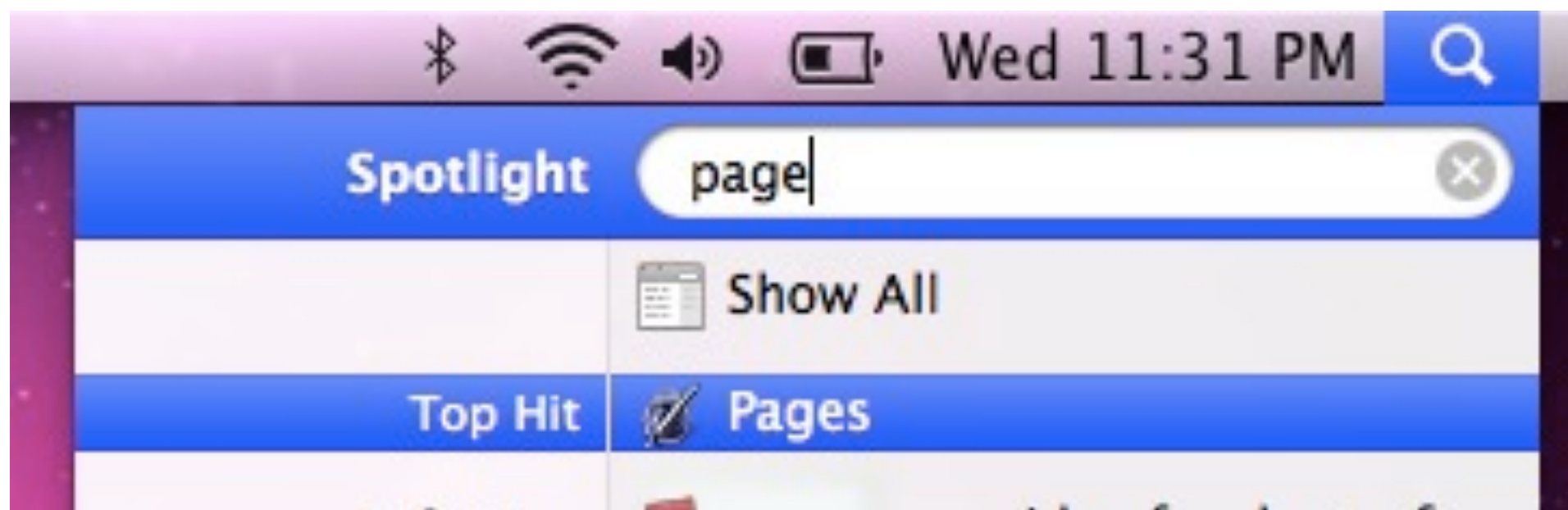

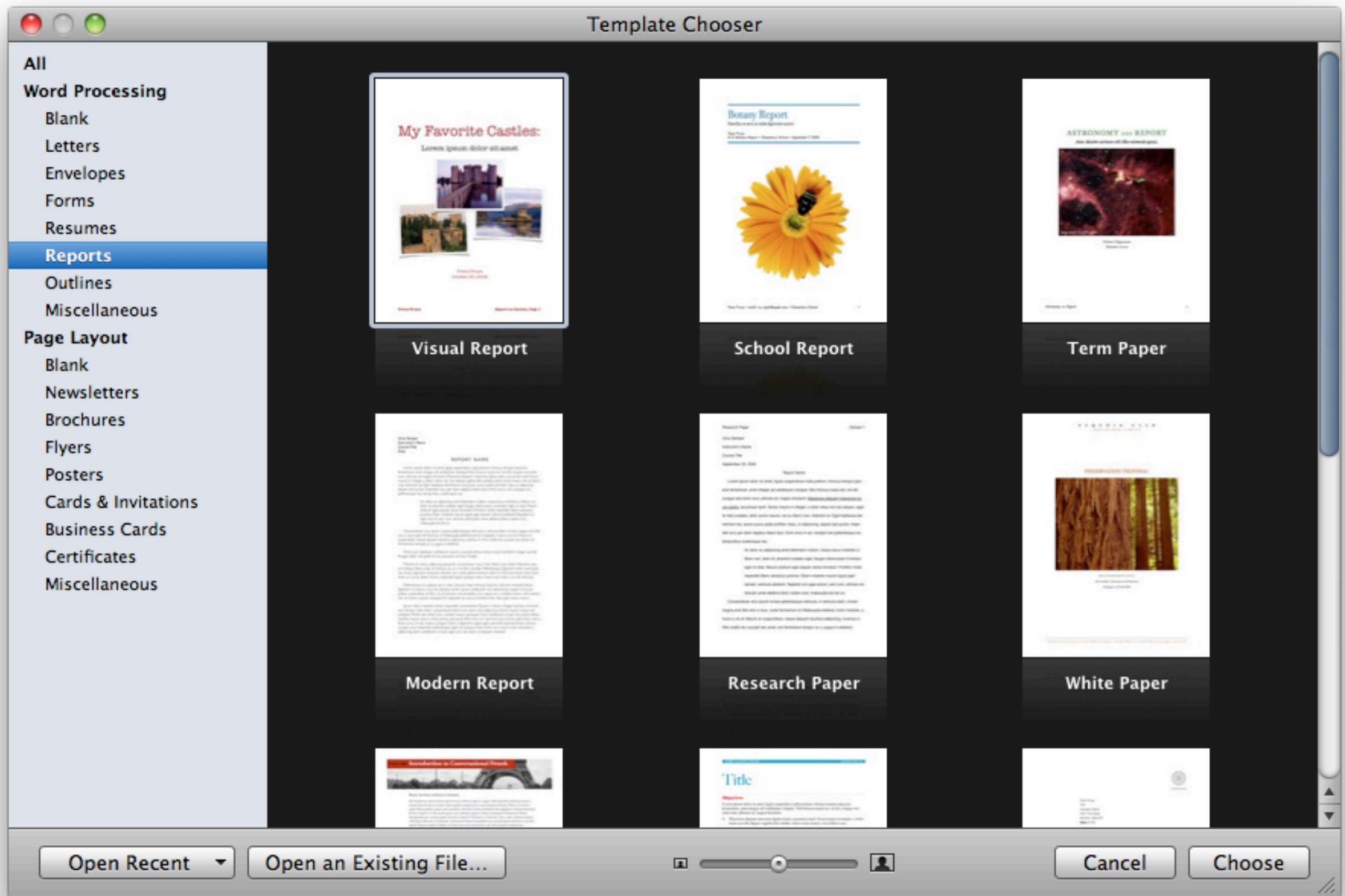

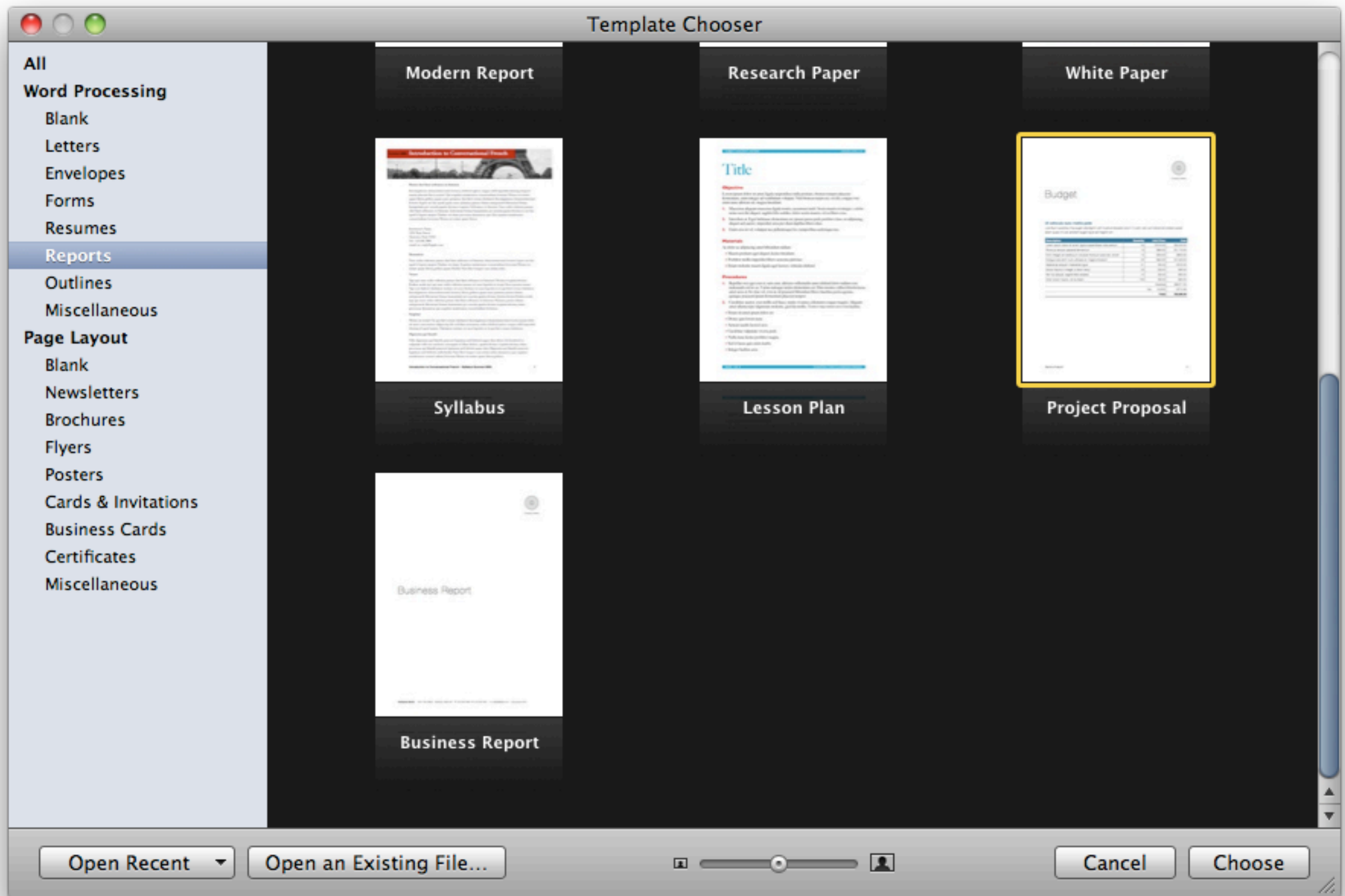
Here's how to make eBooks from Pages or Microsoft Word files.



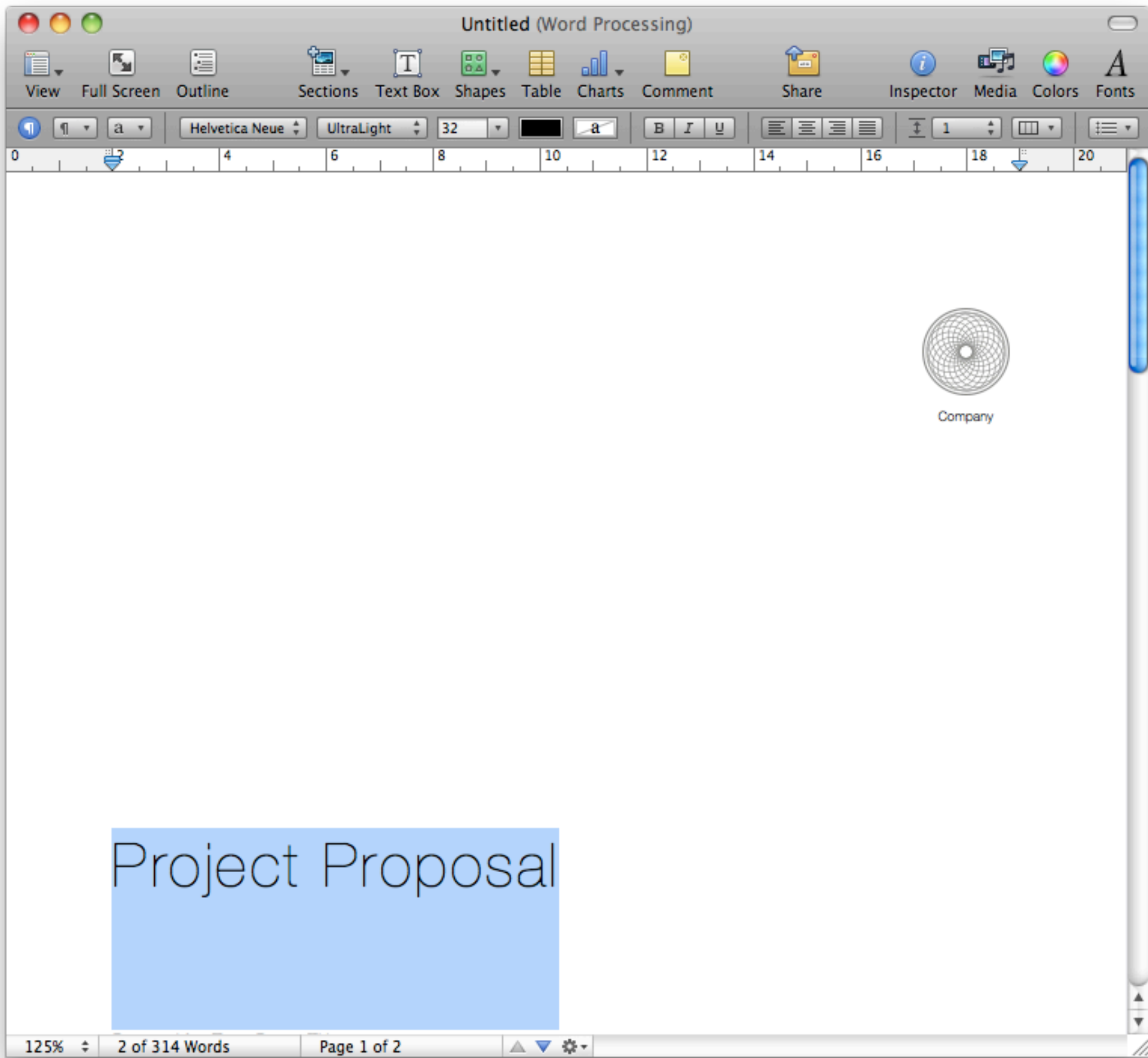
Press Command and Spacebar, type page, Pages will be displayed as the Top Hit. Press return to launch it.



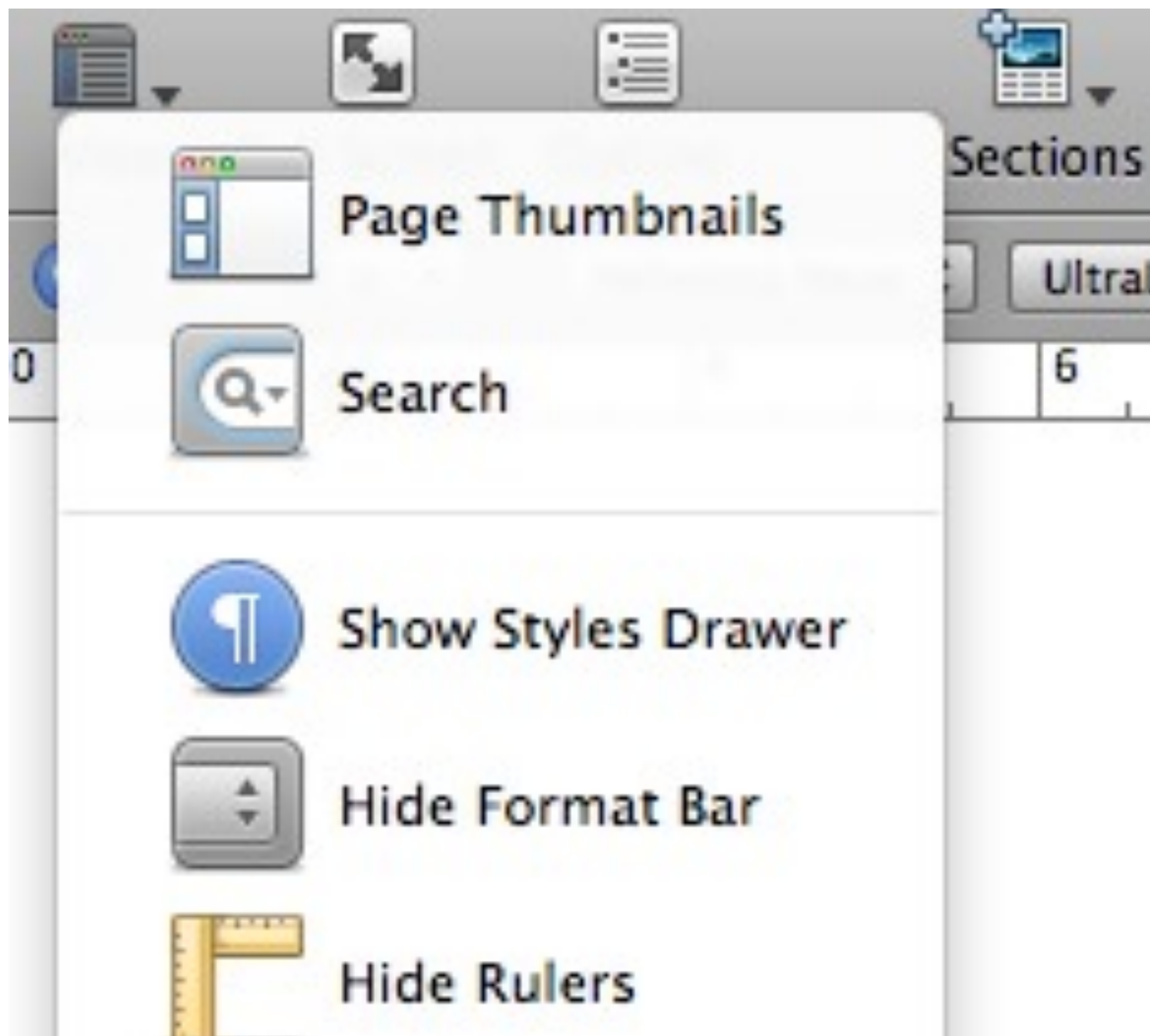
You can open an Existing Microsoft Office Word file or choose an existing template to open a new file.



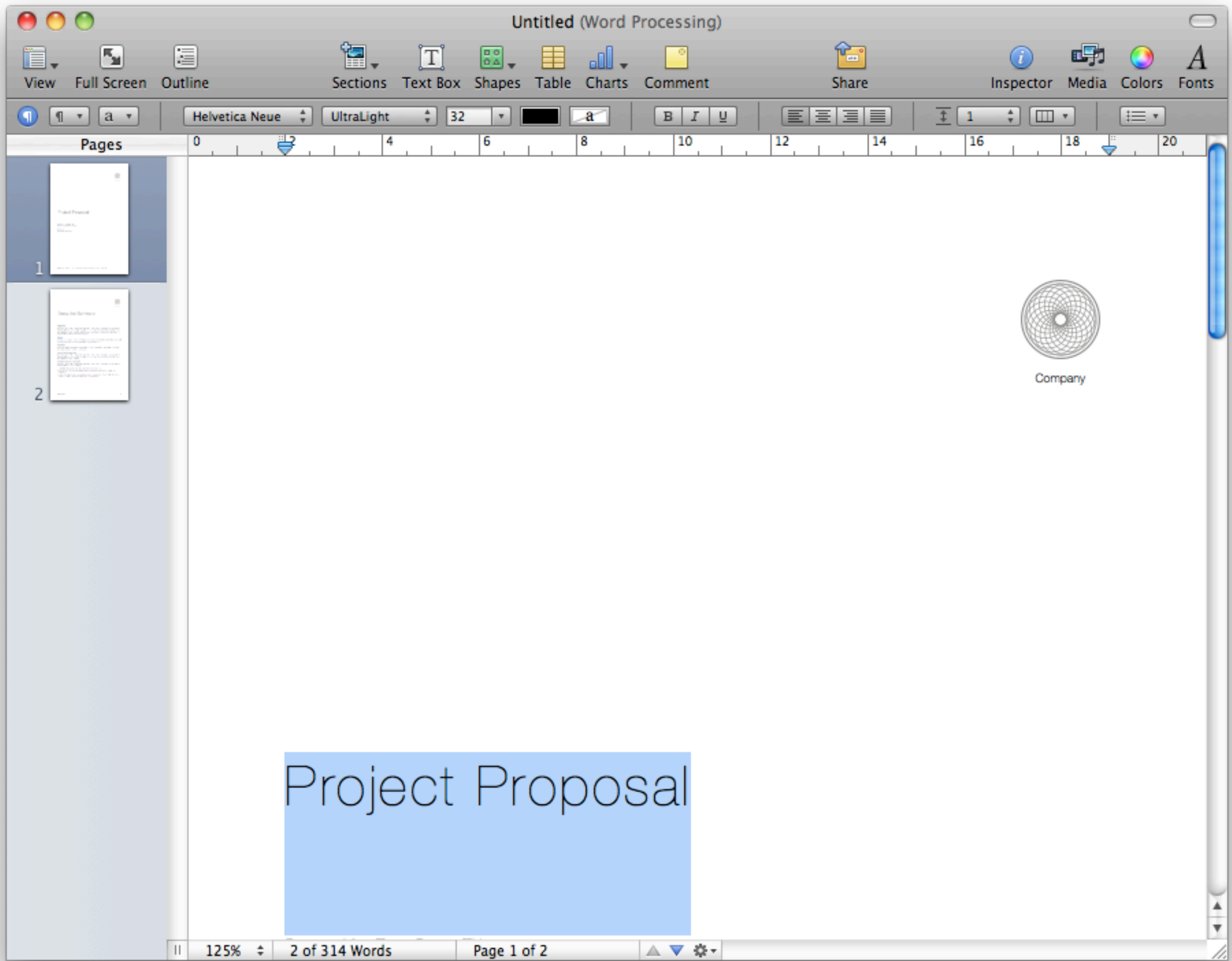
Here, we're using the Project Proposal Template. Click Choose.



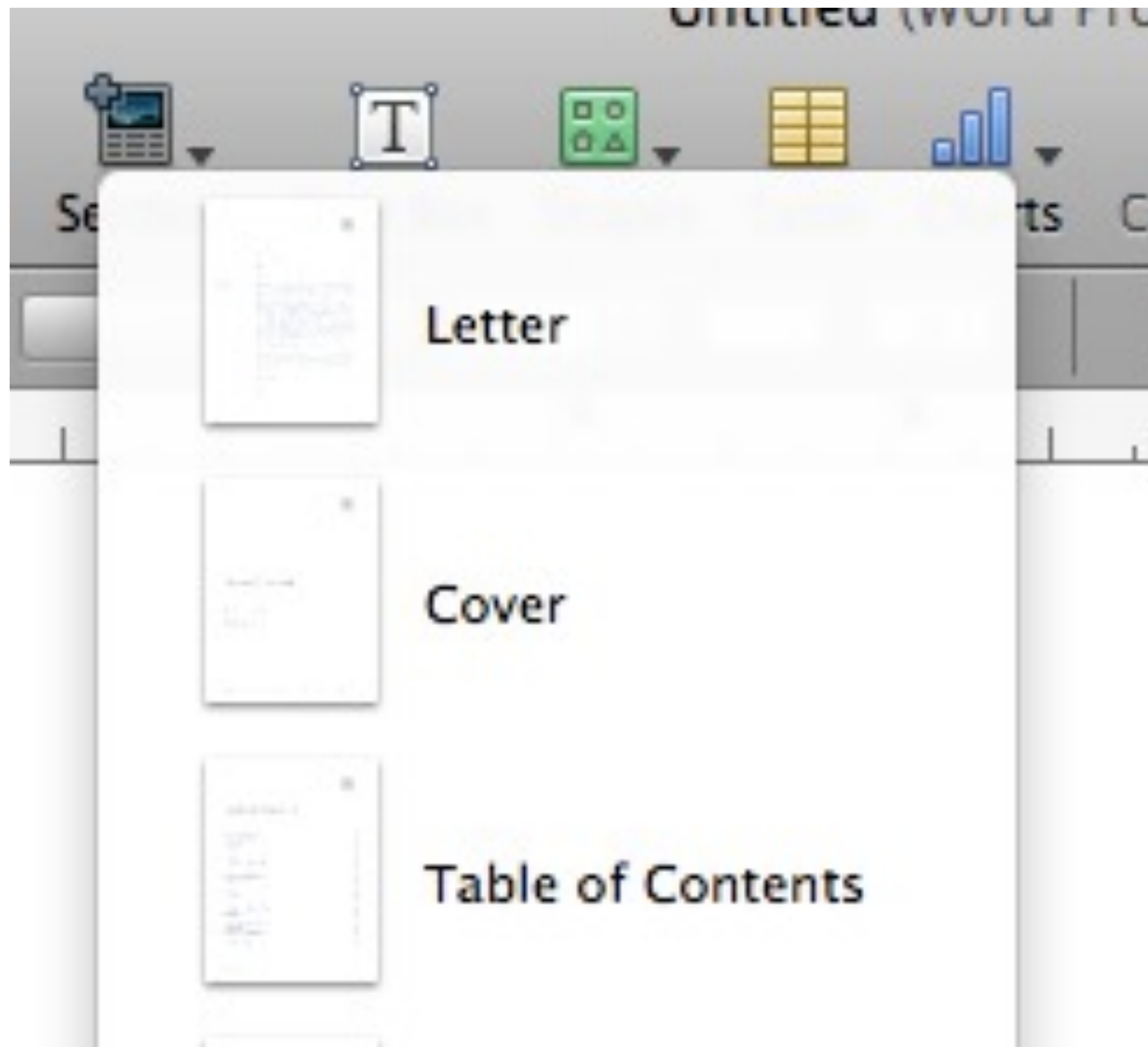
The first page is displayed.



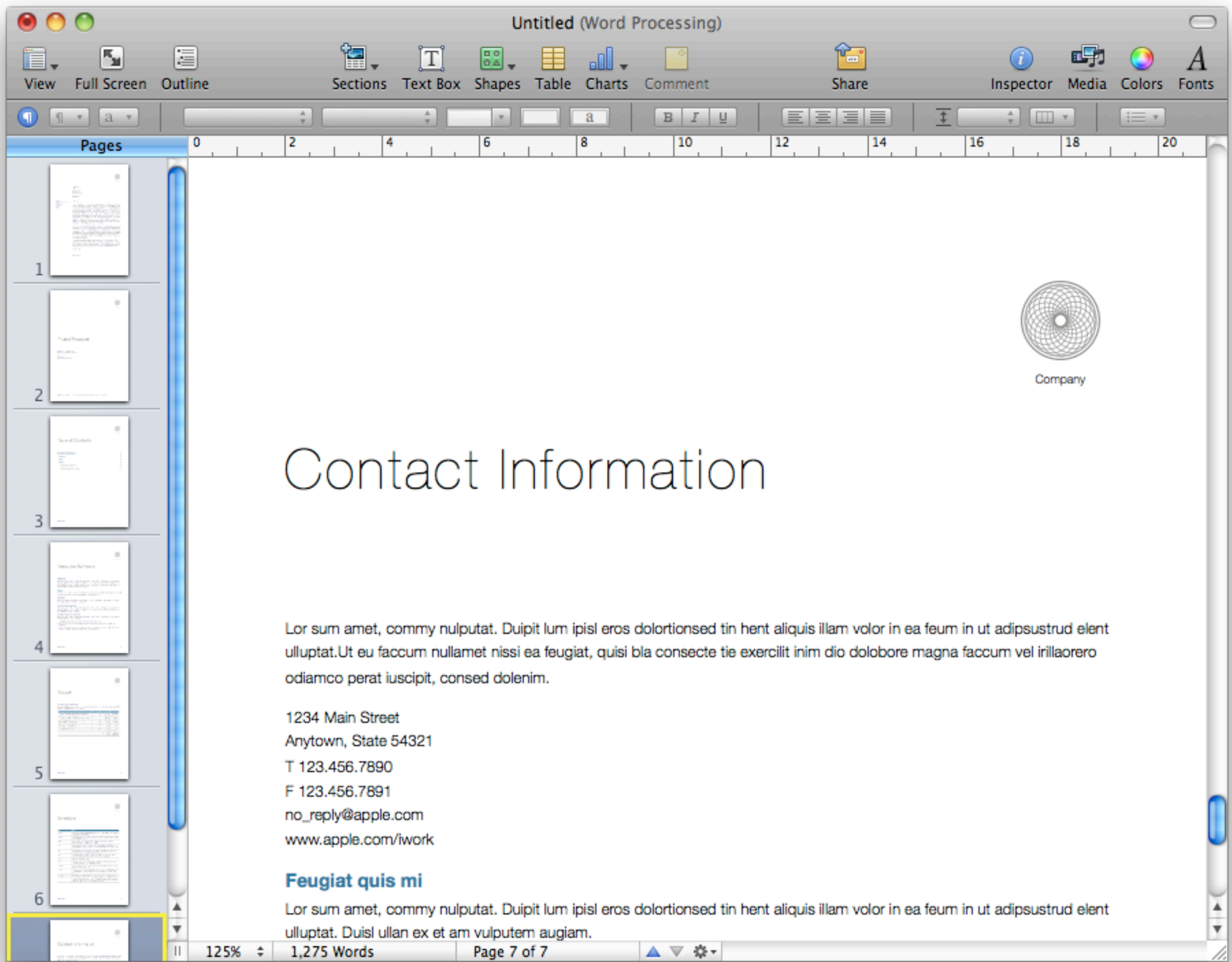
Enable Page Thumbnails.



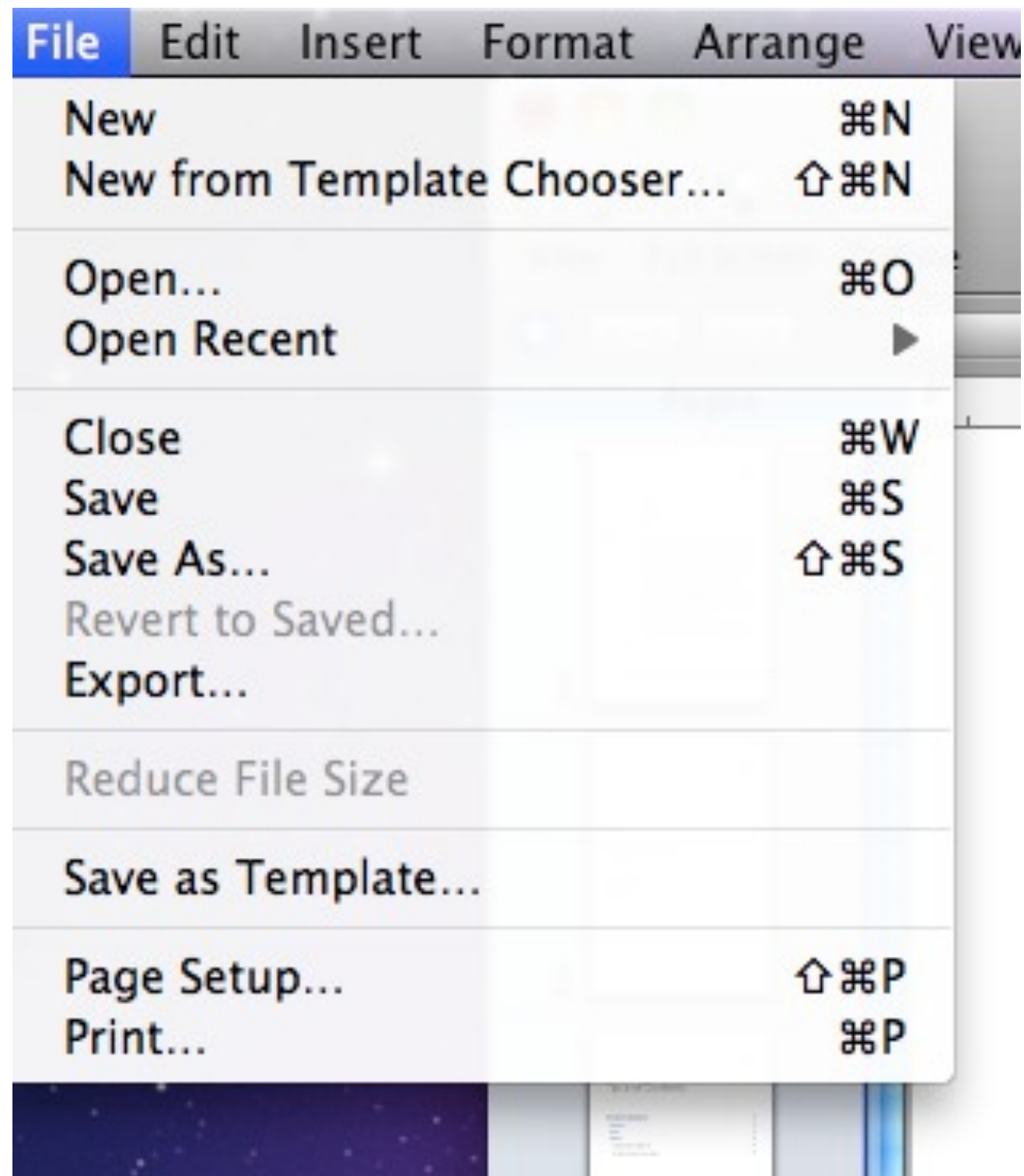
Click Sections

Address the email to the person you want to receive the ePub.



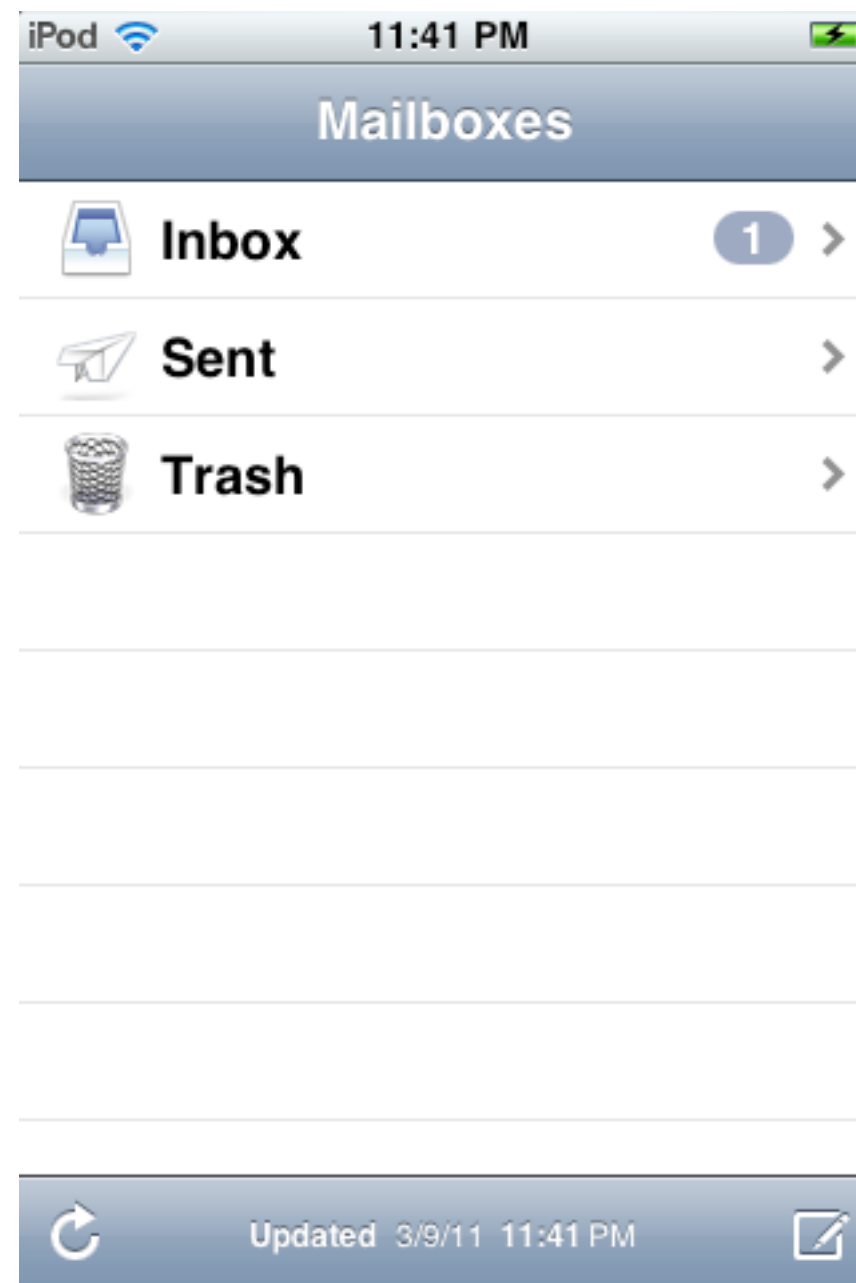
Attach the ePub.



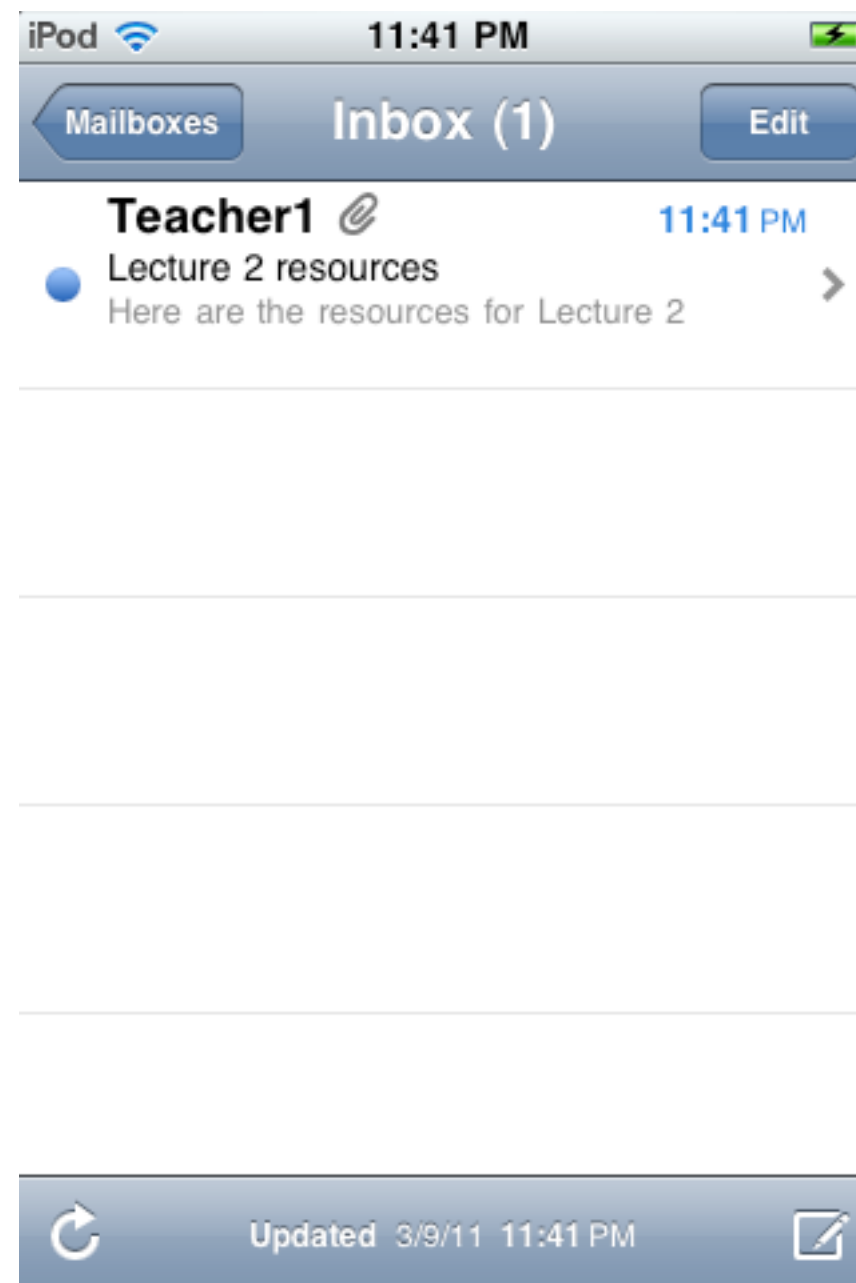
Click Send.



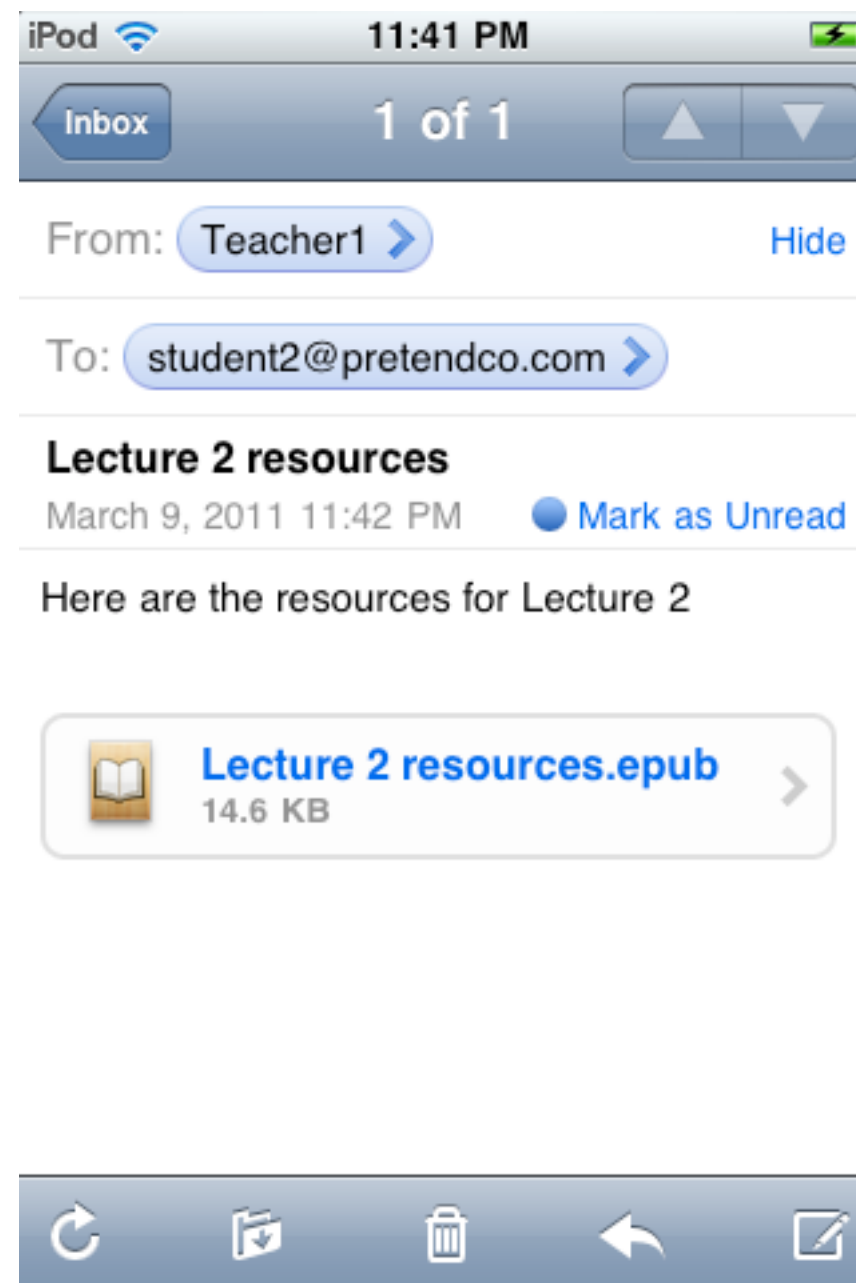
On the Mobile Device, Launch Mail.



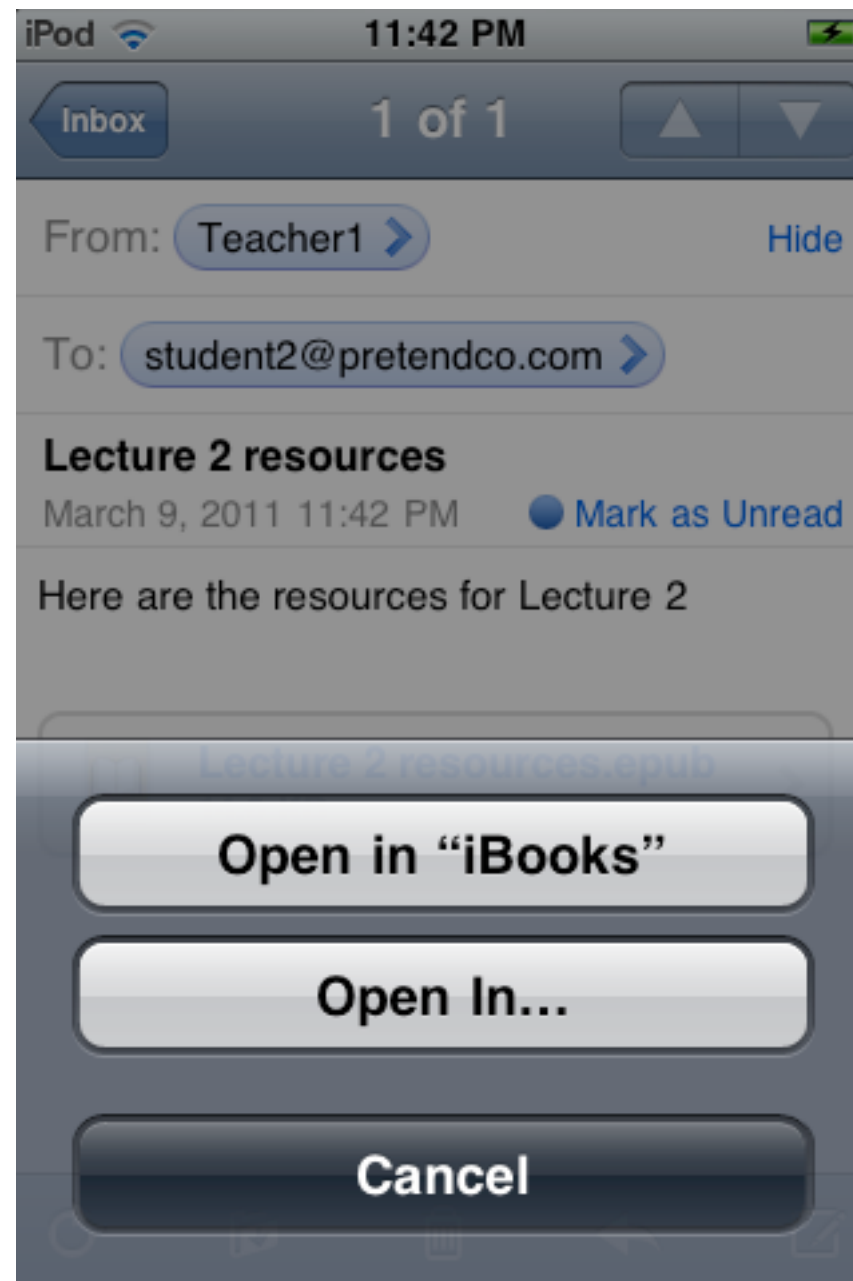
You will see a new email in the Inbox.



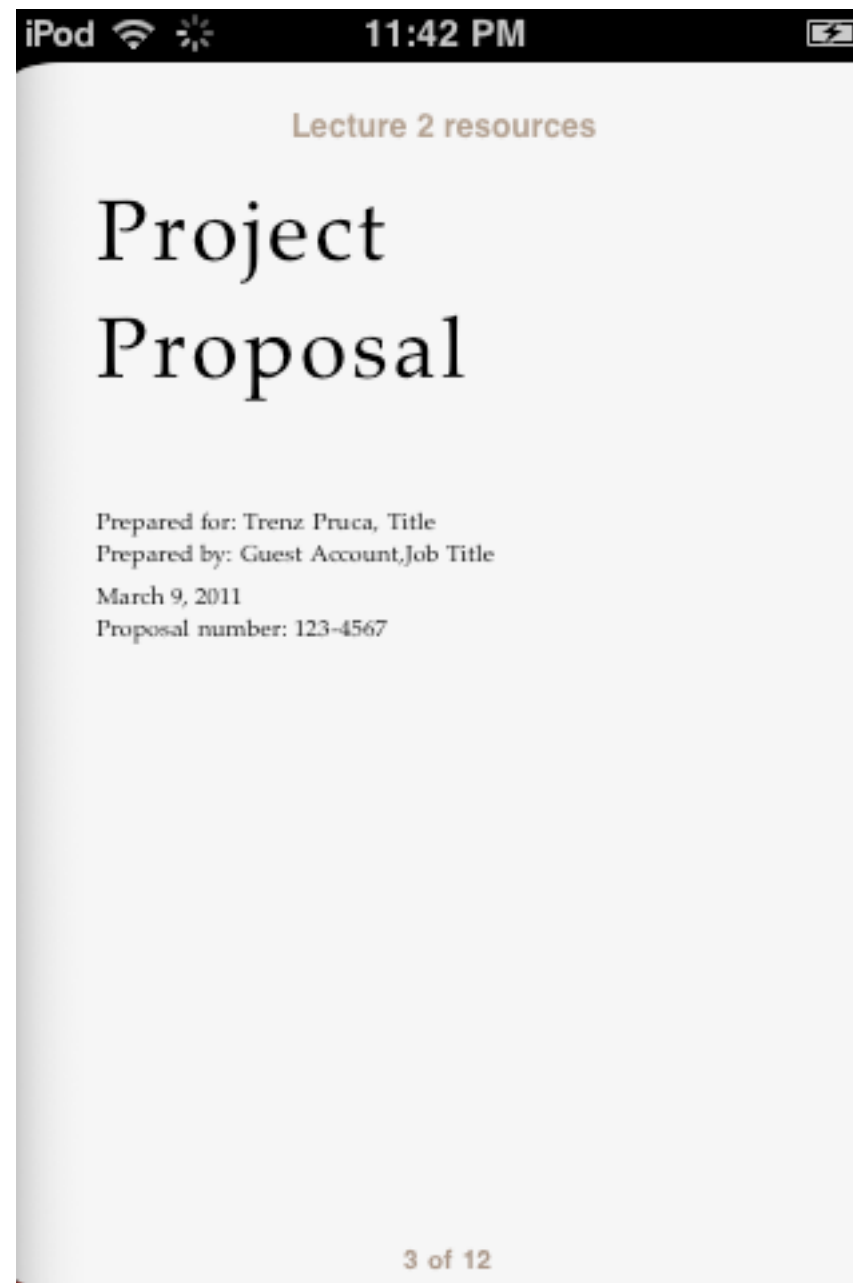
Tap the new email.



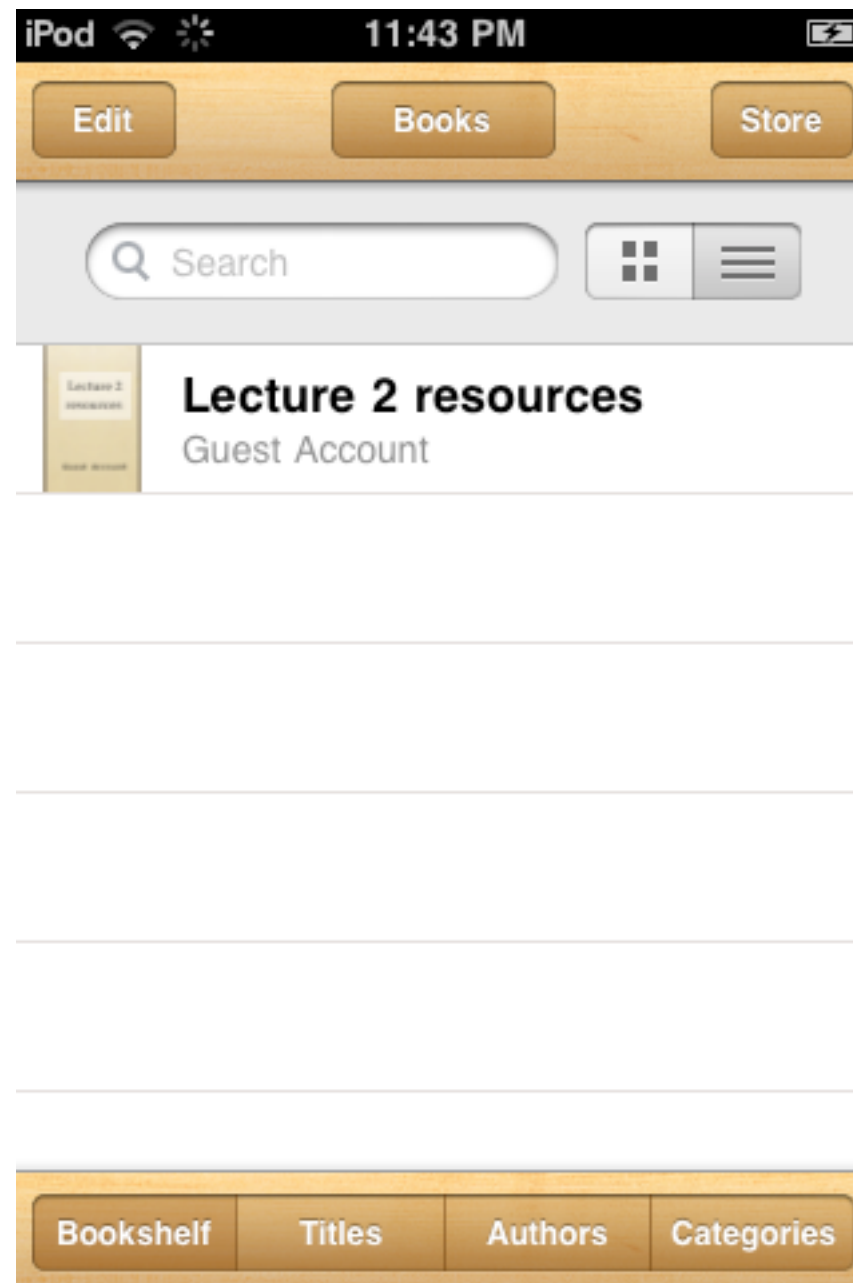
Tap the attachment.
