3.1 Configuring iTunes



Click on the iTunes icon in the Dock.



Click Agree.



The main iTunes window appears. Click Agree.



Click Go to the iTunes Store.



The main iTunes Store window appears.



Choose Sign In... from the Store menu.



Enter your AppleID and password and click Sign In.



Choose Authorize This Computer... from the Store menu.



Enter your AppleID and password as shown and click Authorize.



Your computer has been authorized. Click OK.

3.2 Configuring and using iBooks



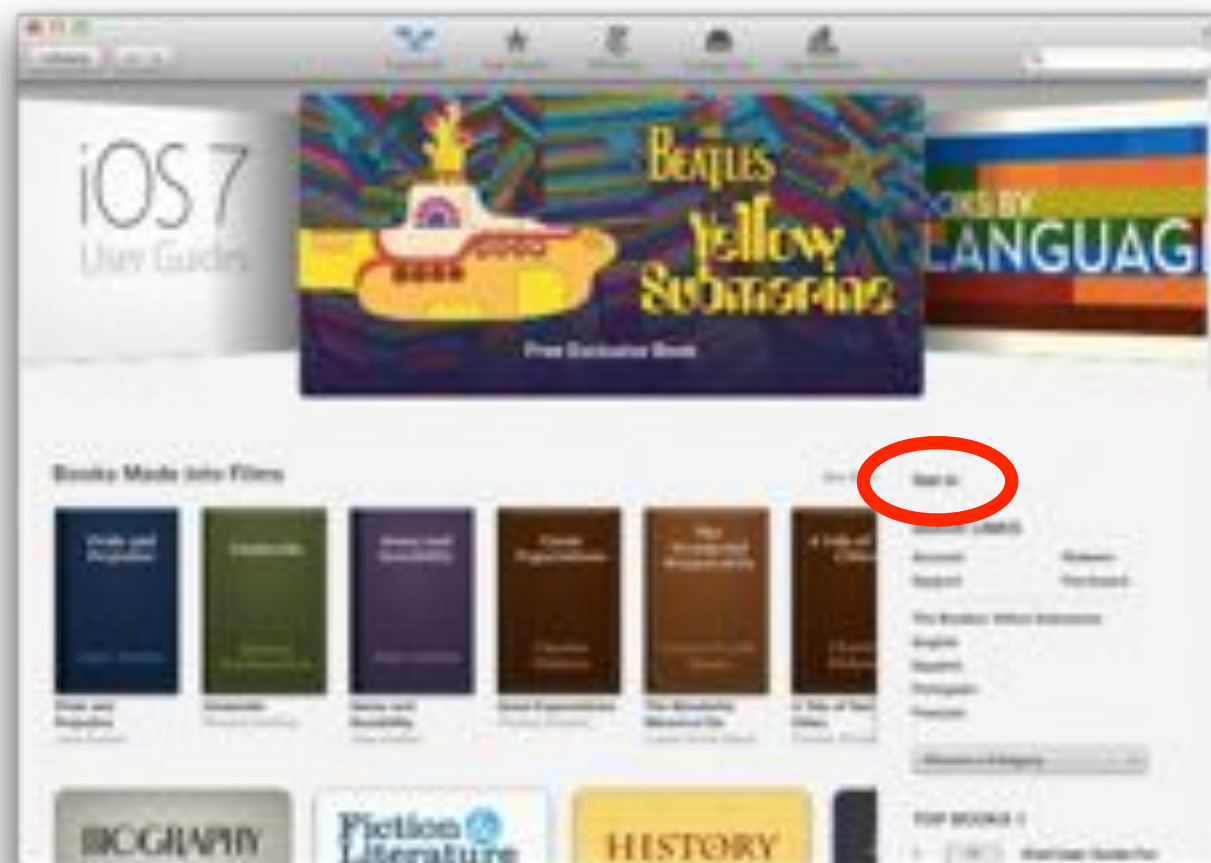
Click the iBooks icon in the Dock.



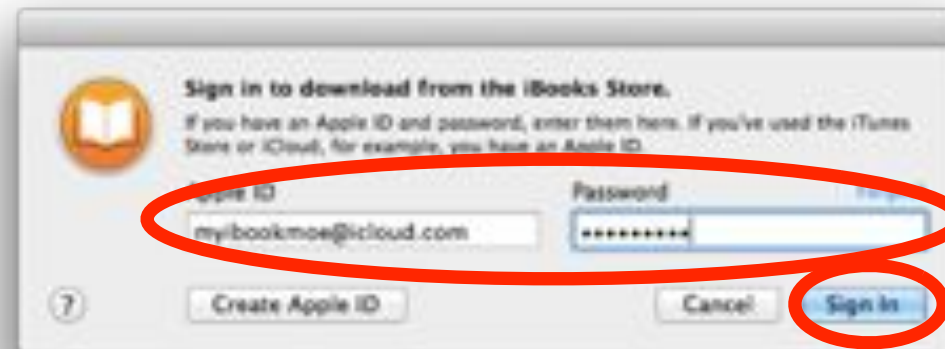
The main iBooks screen appears. Click Get Started.



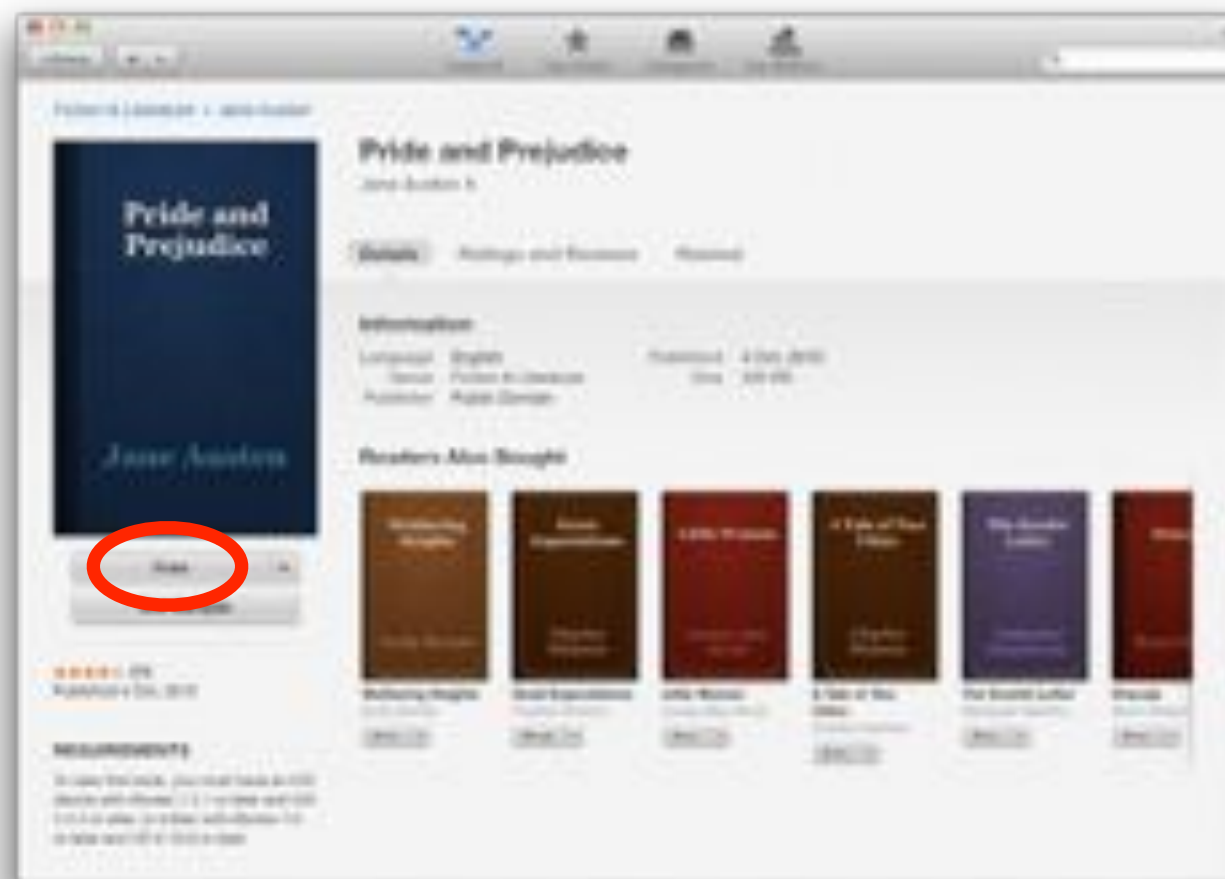
Your Library appears. Click iBooks Store.



Click Sign In.



Enter your Apple ID and password. Click Sign In.



Click Free.



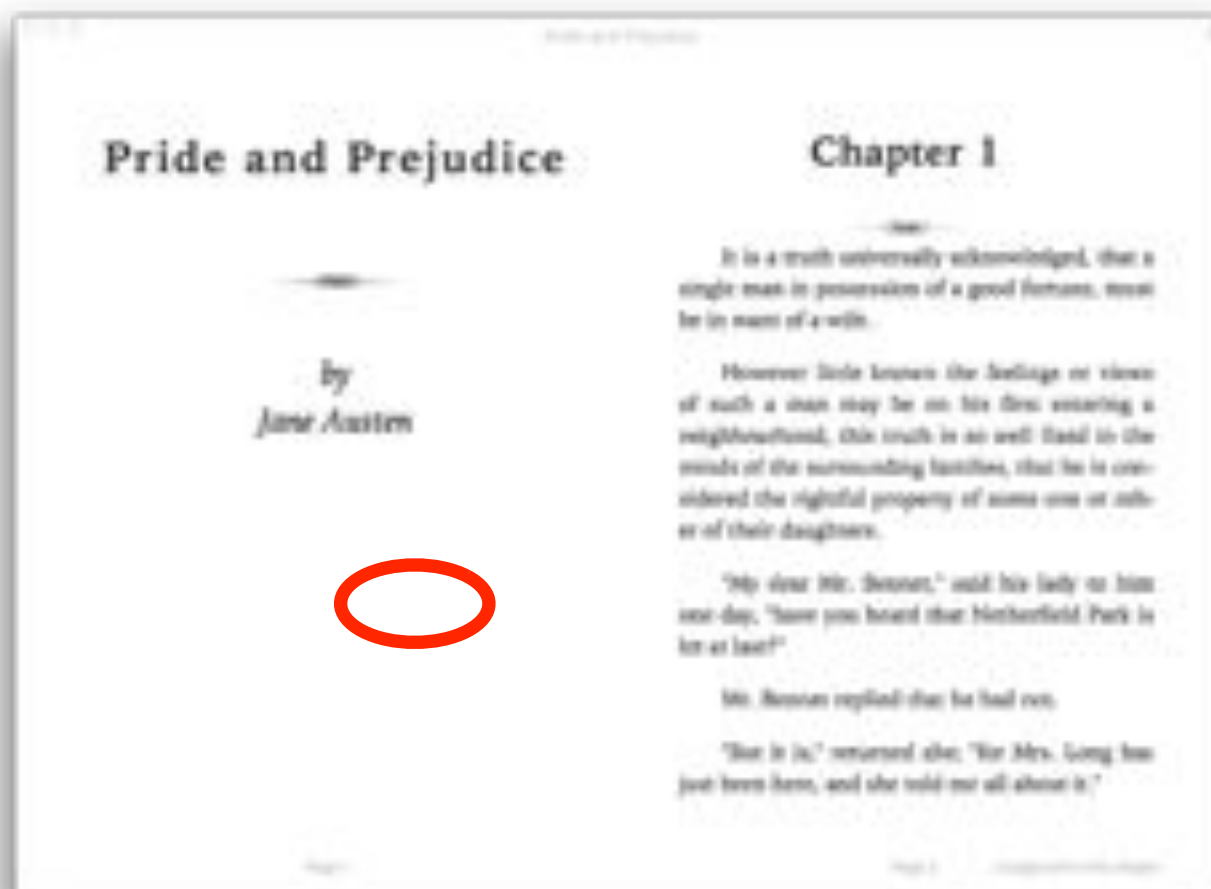
Enter your AppleID password and click Buy.



Wait until the book downloads. Click Library to see all your books.



Your book appears on the screen. Click the page corners to turn the pages.



If the menu bar is invisible, click on the page to show the menu.



Click the Table of Contents button.



The Table of Contents is displayed.



Click on the Notes button. Any notes you make will appear here.



Click on the Appearance button. You can configure your reading experience here.



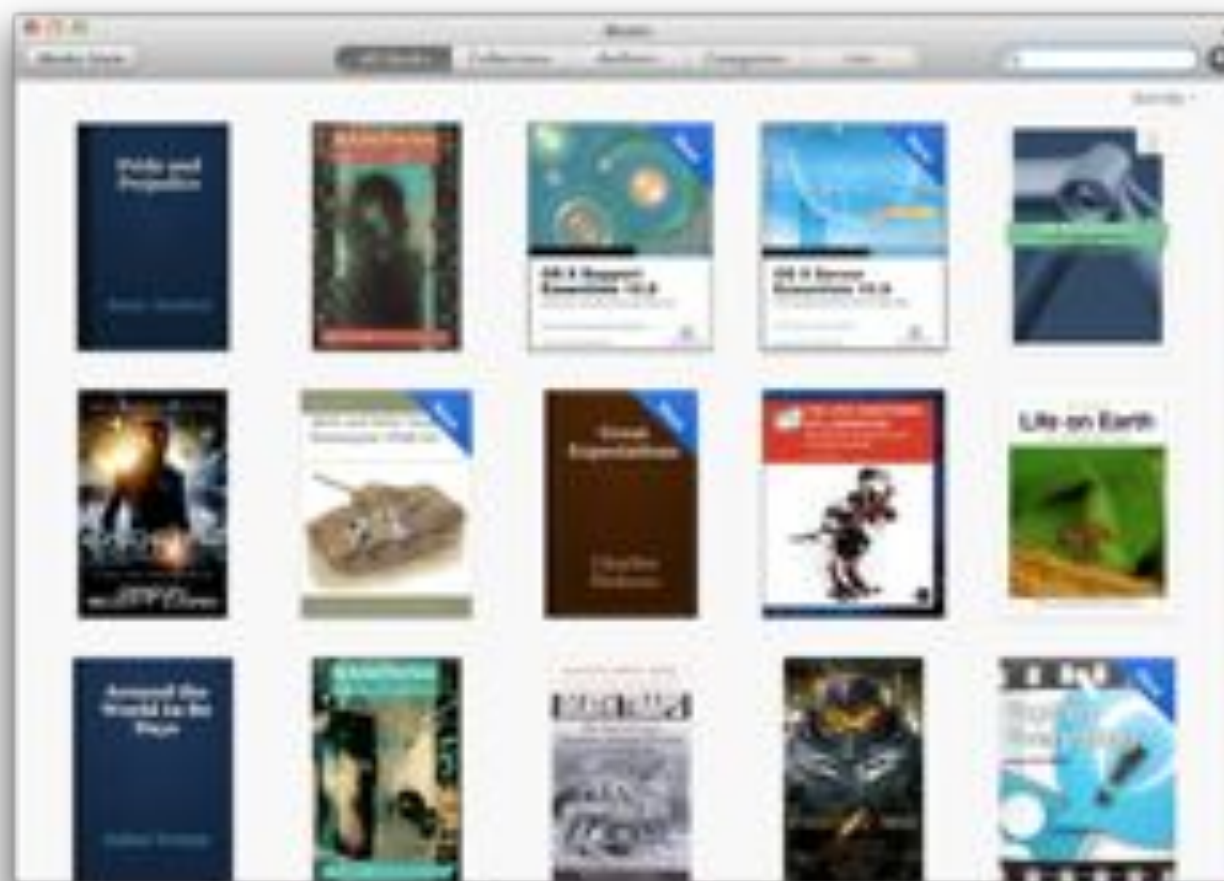
Click on the Search button to search for a specific term in your book.



Click the bookmark to bookmark the page. Click on the arrow head next to the bookmark to show all your bookmarks.



Click the Book button to return to the Library.



The Library is displayed.



Quit the iBooks application.

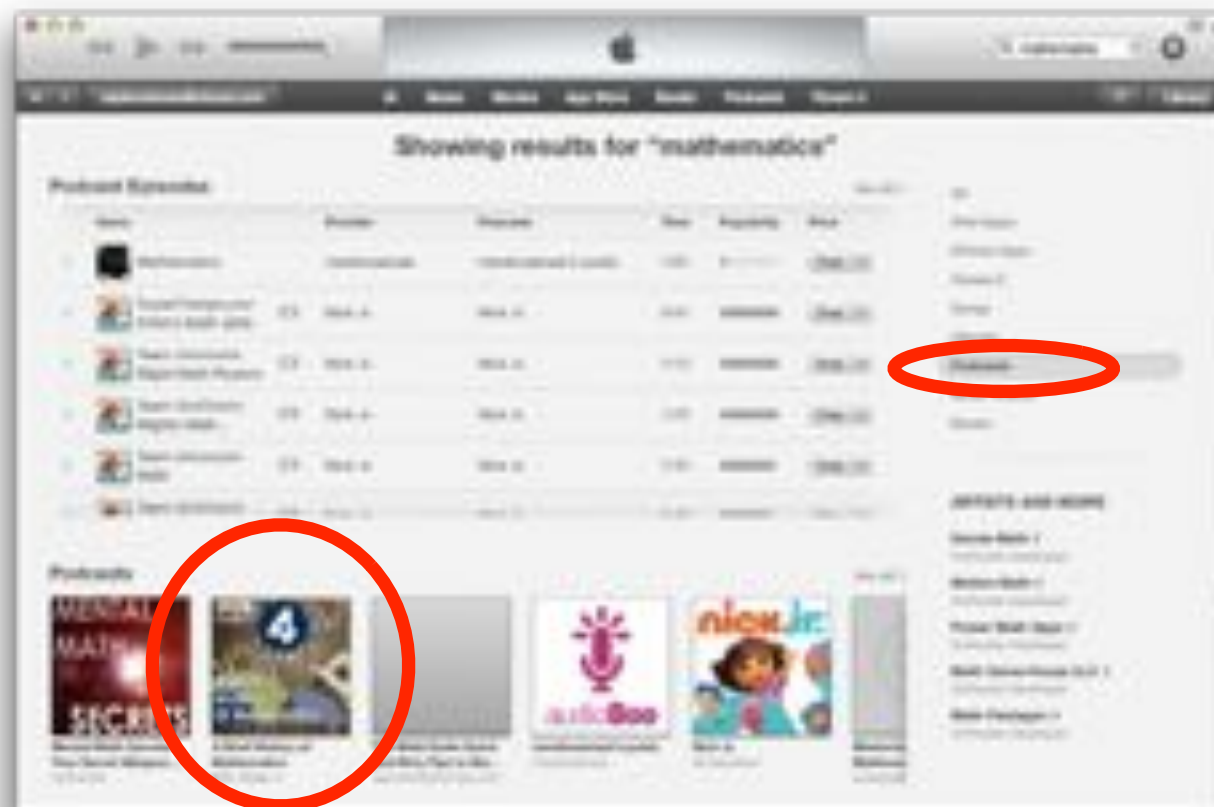
3.3 Downloading Podcasts



Type Mathematics in the iTunes search field and press Return.



All content related to Mathematics is displayed. You can narrow it down by clicking Music, Movies, Apps, Books, Podcasts or iTunes U.



Click Podcasts. These are normally audio or video files dealing with a particular subject matter. Click the BBC 4 podcast.



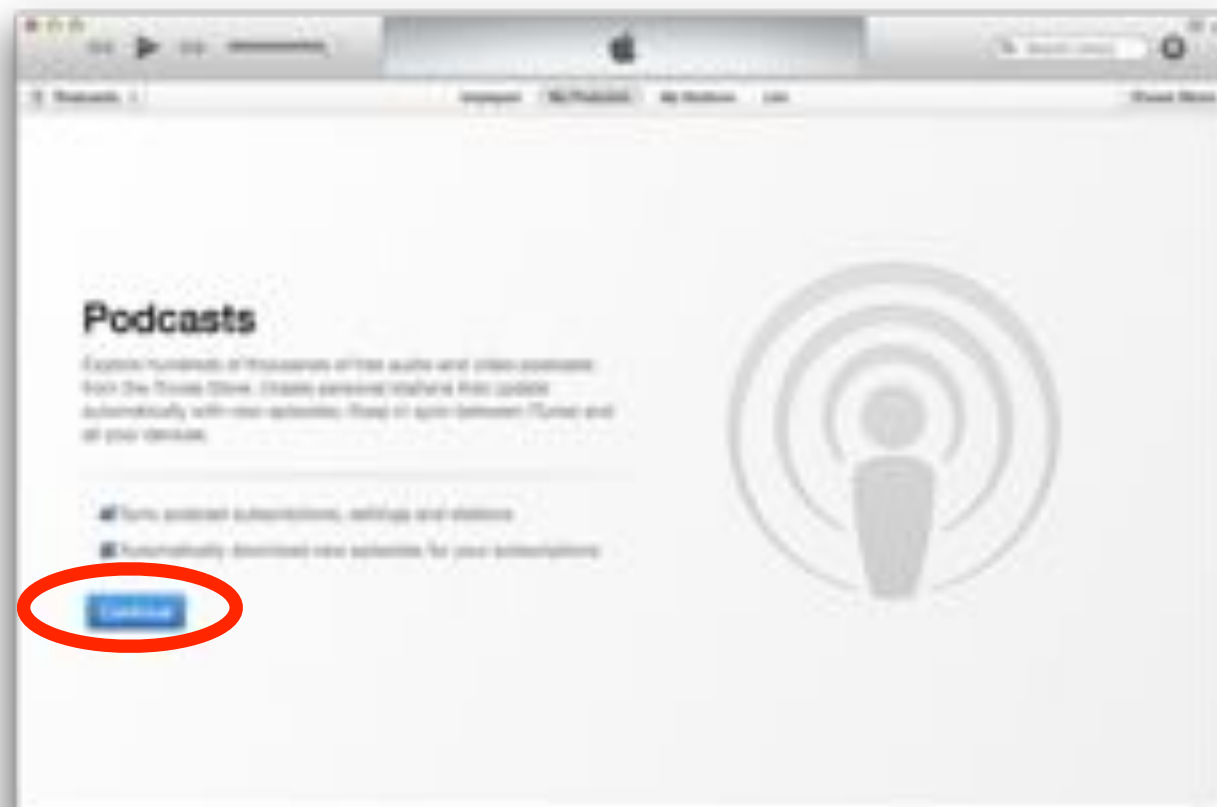
You can see all episodes of this podcast. Choose an episode and click Free to download it.



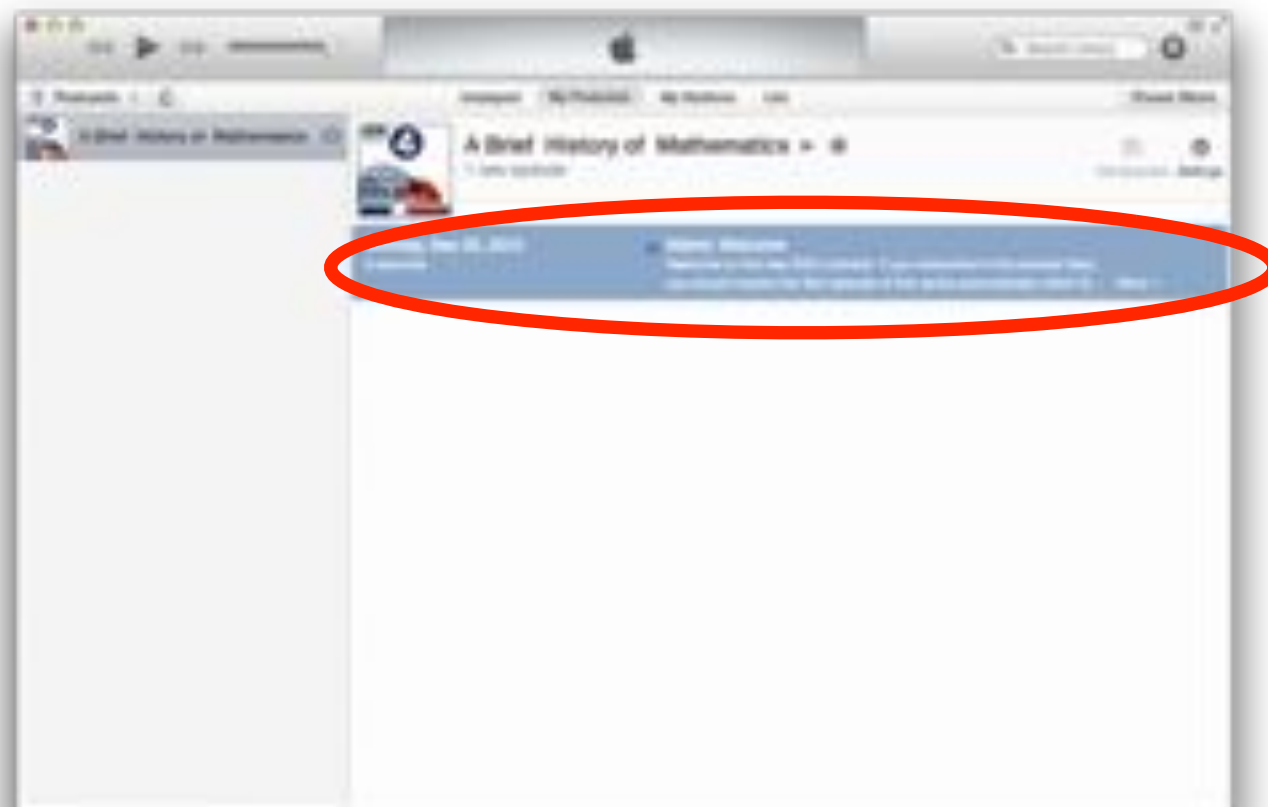
Click Library to go to your iTunes Library.



Choose Podcast from the Library pop-up menu.



Click Continue.



Click a podcast to play it.



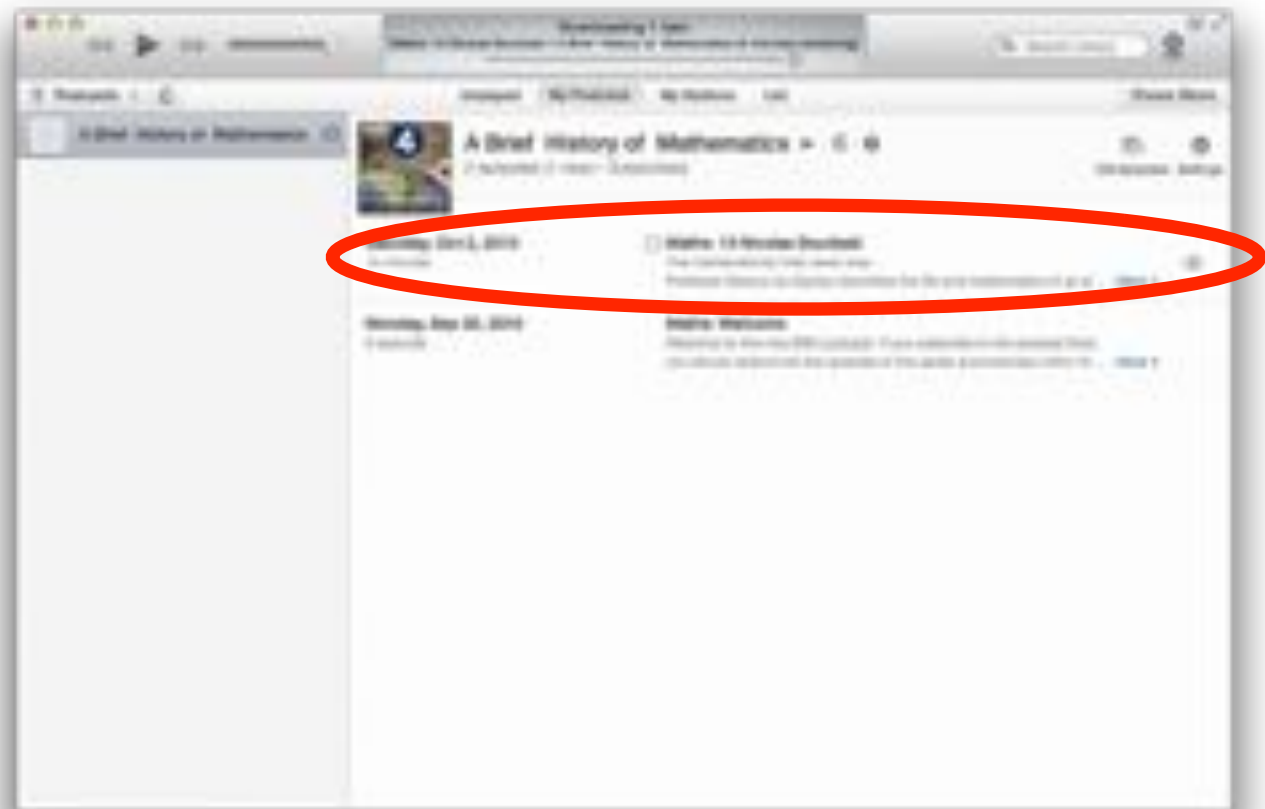
You can control the podcast with these controls.



Click Settings.



Tick the Subscribed check box. This will make new podcast episodes download automatically.



Here you can see a new episode appears automatically.



Click the iTunes Store button to return to the iTunes Store.

3.4 Downloading iTunes U



Click the light grey back arrow in the black bar to return to the list of found results for Mathematics.



Click Free to download an episode.



If you see this dialog box, click OK.



Click Library.



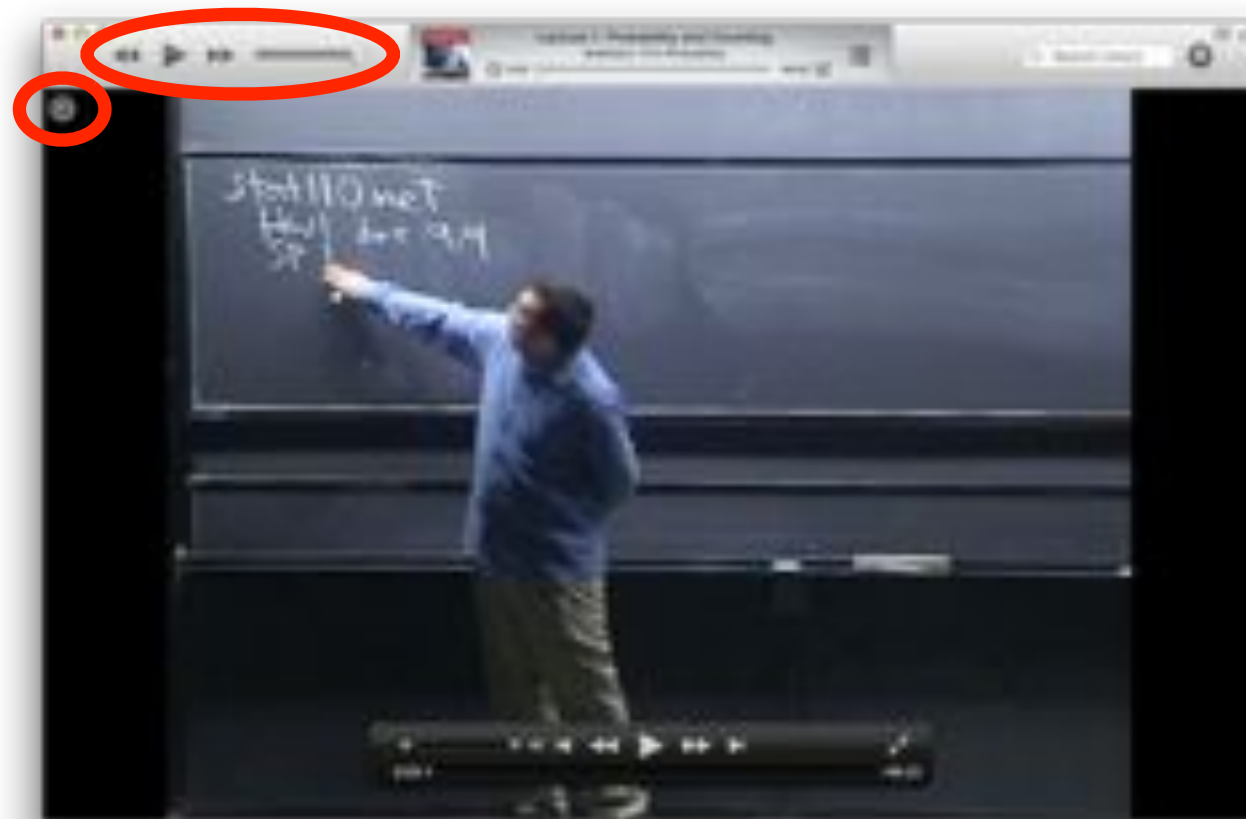
Choose iTunes U from the pop-up menu.



Click the download button to download an episode.



Double click the episode to play it once it has been downloaded.



Use the controls to manage the playback. Click the X button to exit.



Click on the iTunes Store when you're done.

3.5 Downloading Apps



Click the light grey back arrow in the black bar to return to the list of search results.



Click Apps. A list of all Mathematics related apps are displayed. Click Mathematics for Kids.



Click the Free button.



Enter your Apple ID and password and click Download.



The app will start downloading.

3.6 Importing music



Launch Safari.



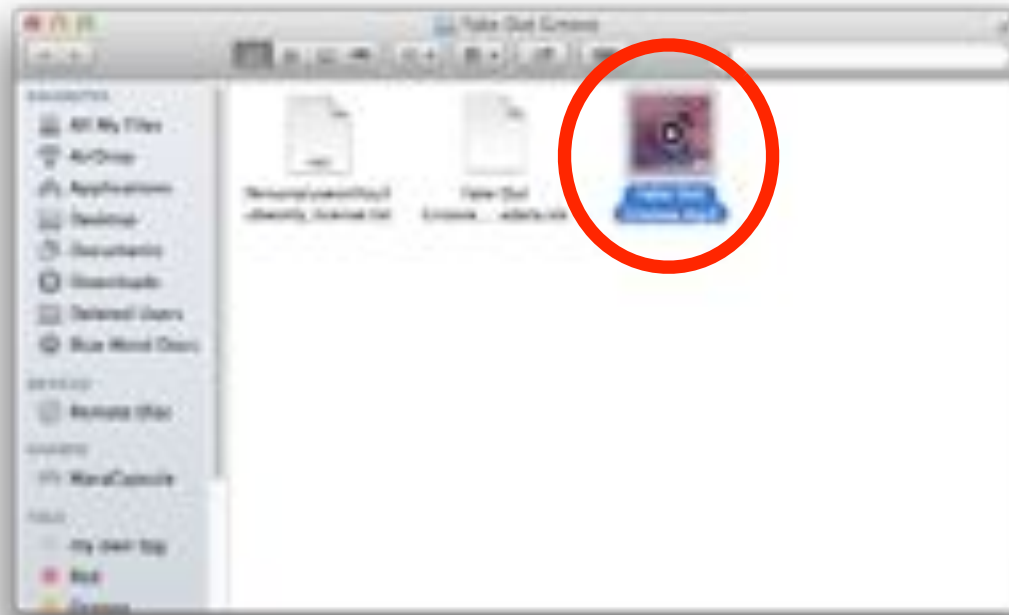
Type <http://www.freeplaymusic.com> in the URL field. Here you can download all kinds of music for free.



Click the Download button in Safari to see your download progress.



The downloaded file is automatically imported into iTunes. Click Music in the Library pop-up menu. Double click the track to play.

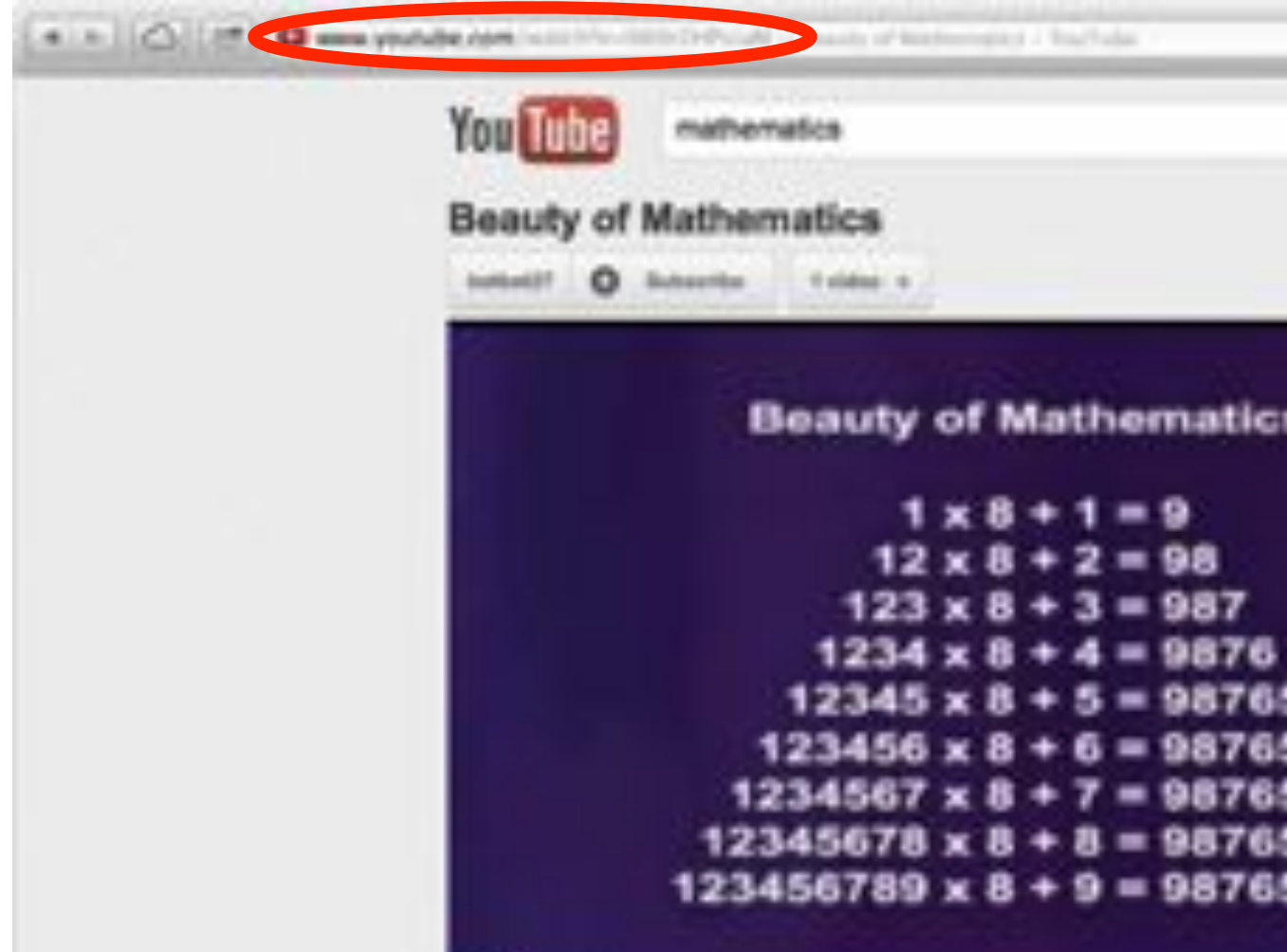


You will find the original file in your Downloads folder. Safari uses this folder by default.

3.7 Importing videos



Go to <http://www.youtube.com> and type mathematics in the search box. Press Return to search for mathematics videos.



The selected Youtube file is displayed. Copy the URL.



Go to <http://www.keepvid.com> and paste the URL in the space provided. Click Download.



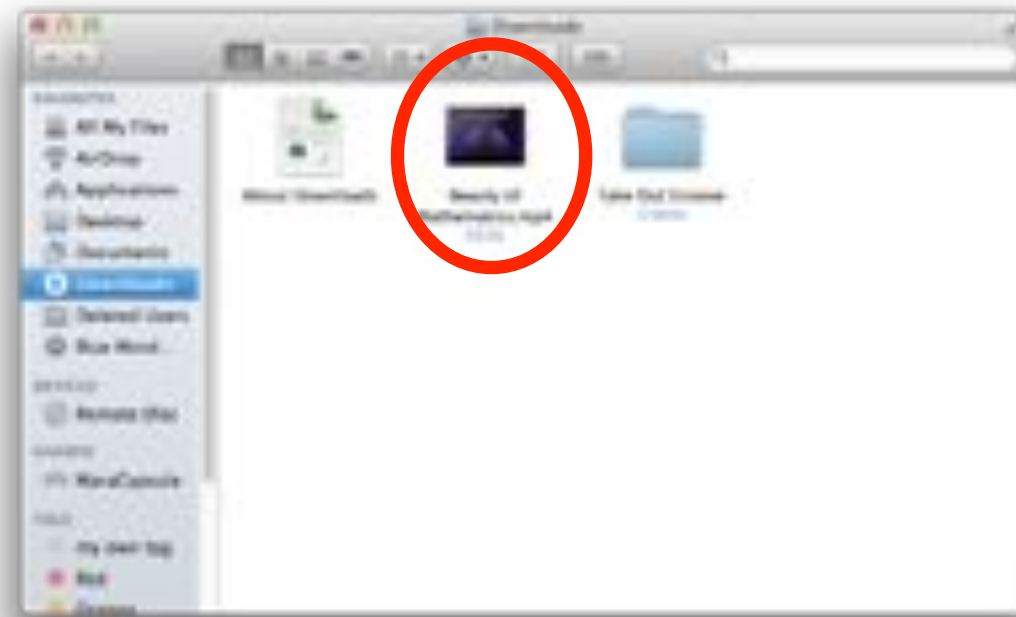
When you see this dialog box, click Run.



Keepvid will generate a list of download links. Click the .mp4 file.



The downloaded file will open in QuickTime Player. Mouse over it to see the playback controls.



Go to your Downloads folder in the dock and open it. The original .mp4 file will be there. You can drag it to iTunes to import it. Quit iTunes when done.
