

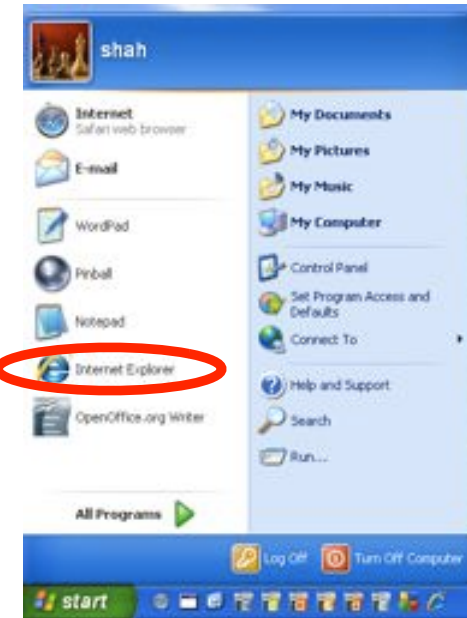

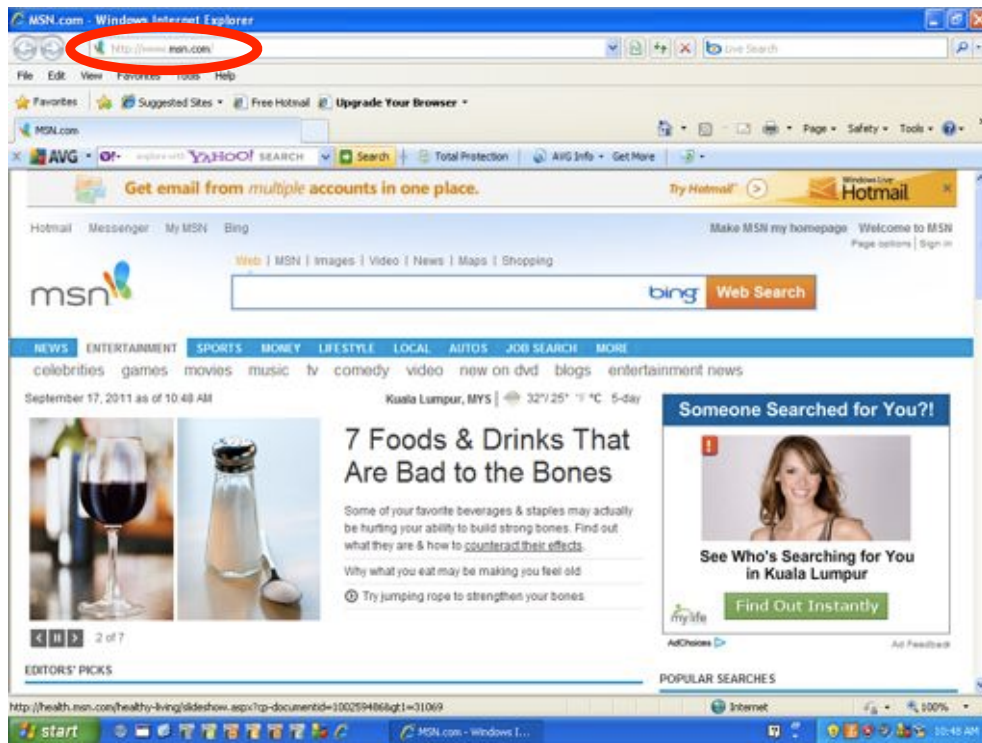
# Downloading iTunes



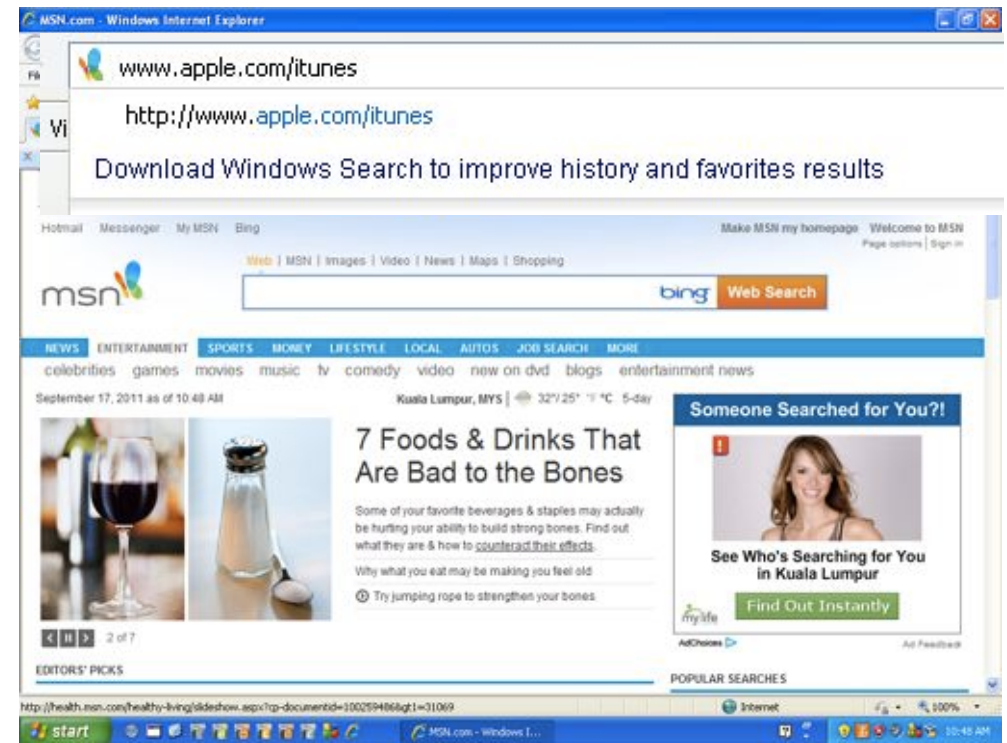
Click the Start menu.



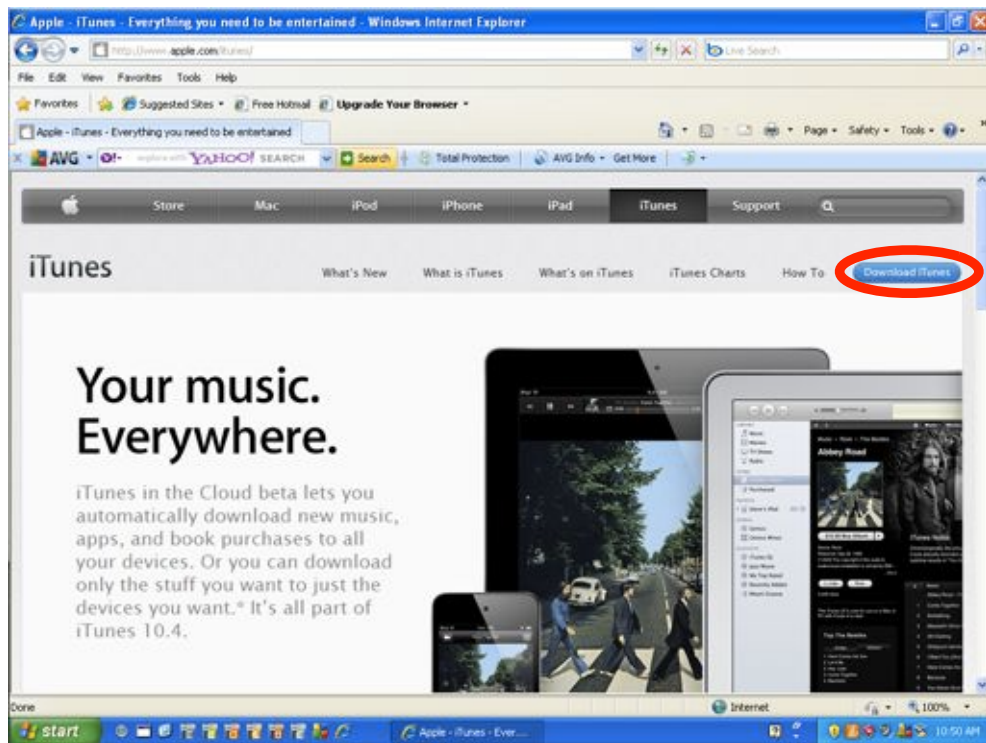
Choose Internet Explorer.



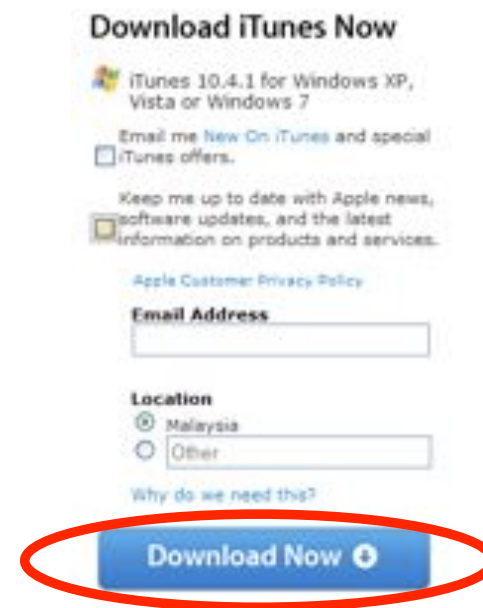
Type '<http://www.apple.com/itunes>' in the URL field.



Press Enter.



Click the 'Download iTunes' button.



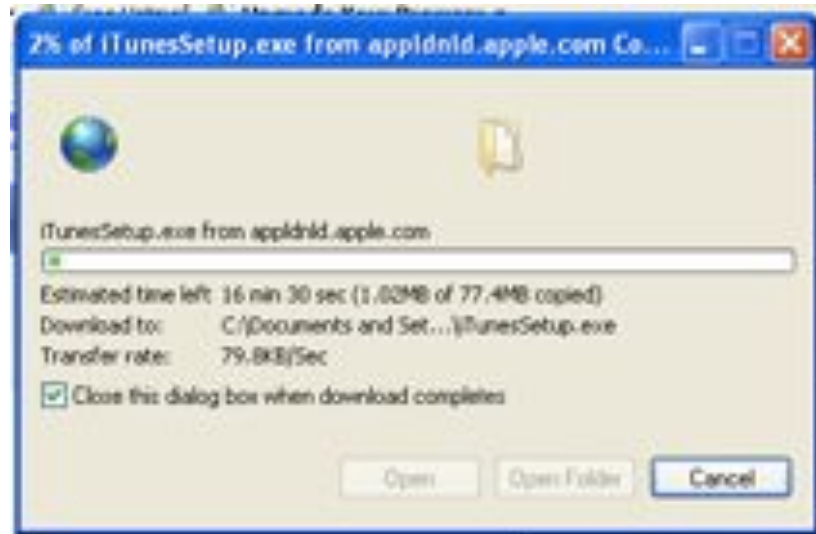
Untick the two buttons, and click Download Now.



Click Save

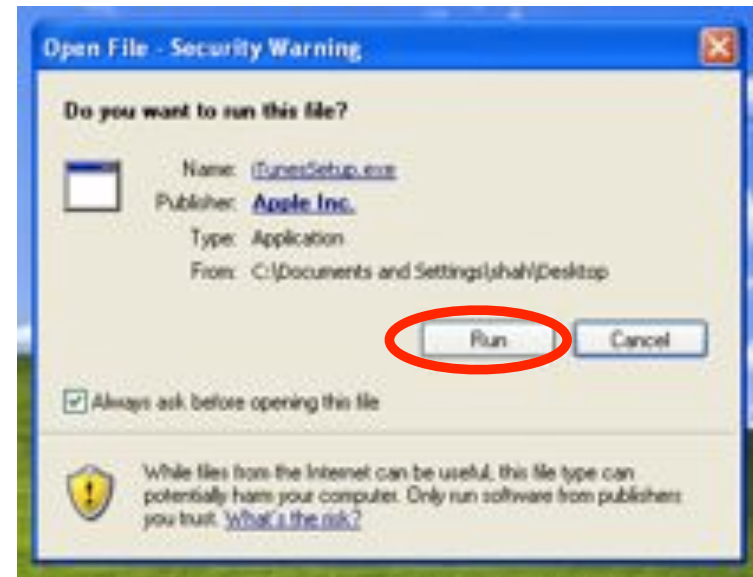


Choose Desktop so you can find the file easily later.  
Click Save.



## Installing iTunes

Wait until the download is complete.

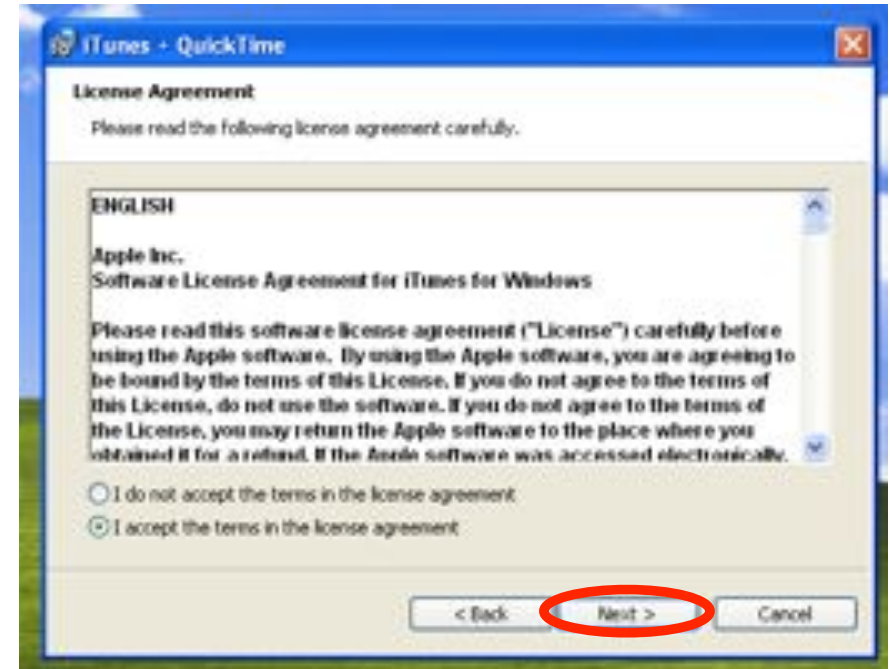


Find the iTunes Setup file on the Desktop. Double click it. Choose Run.



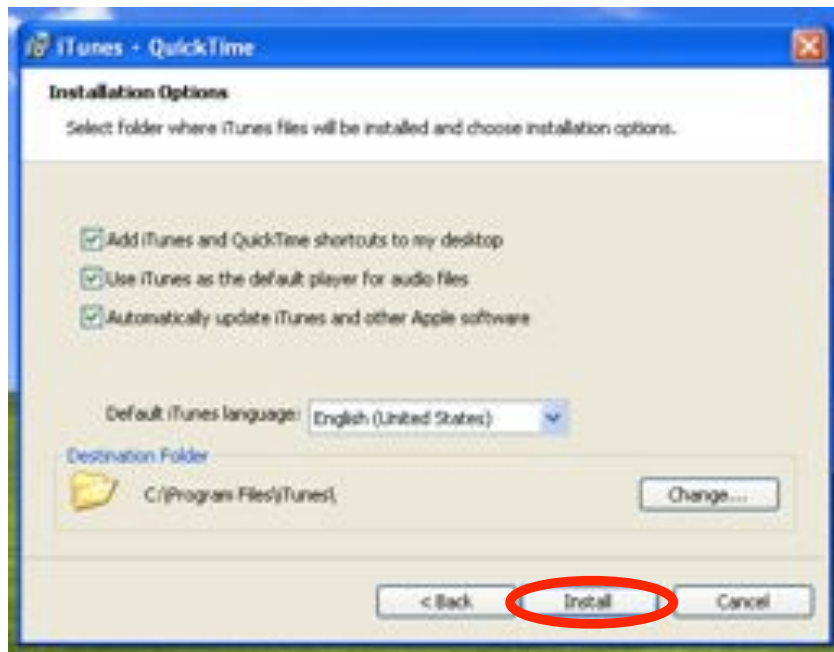


The Install iTunes program starts. Click Next.



Click 'I accept the terms of the license agreement'.  
Click Next.

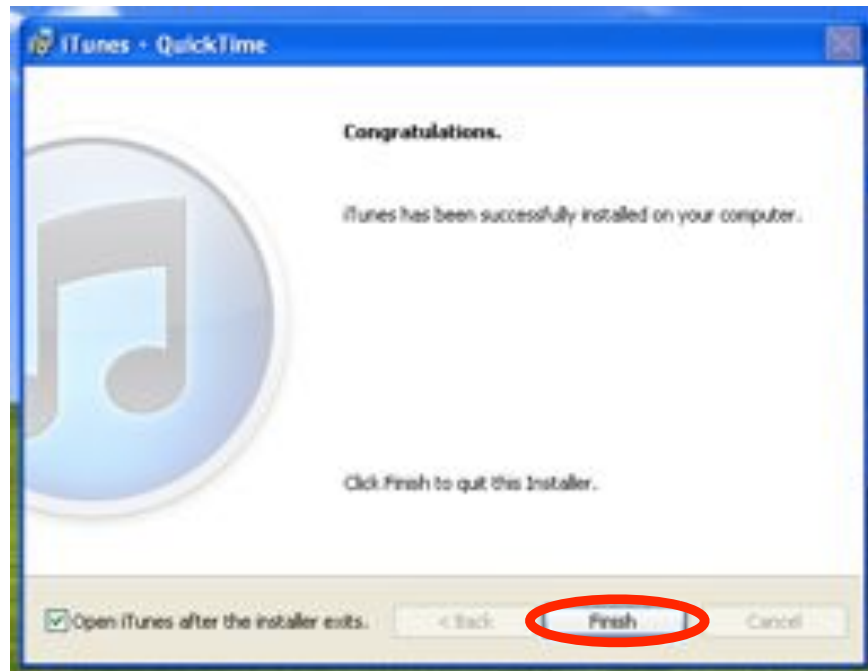




Click Install.



Wait for the installation to finish.



Click Finish.

# Creating an iTunes Store Account



In the Search Store field, search for iBooks.



You will see the iBooks application under the iPad Apps section. Click the Free button.



Since you do not have an iTunes account yet, you will be prompted to create a new iTunes Store account. Click Create New Account.

Click Continue.



Tick 'I have read and agree to these terms and conditions', and click Continue.

## Provide Apple ID Details

Email:  This will be your new Apple ID.

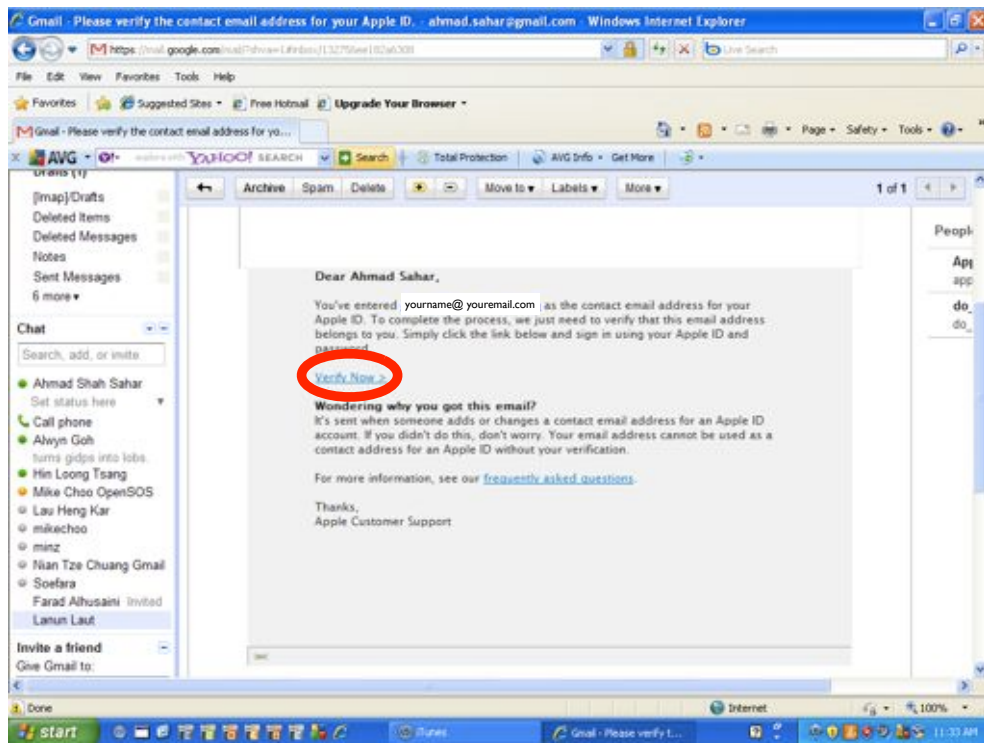

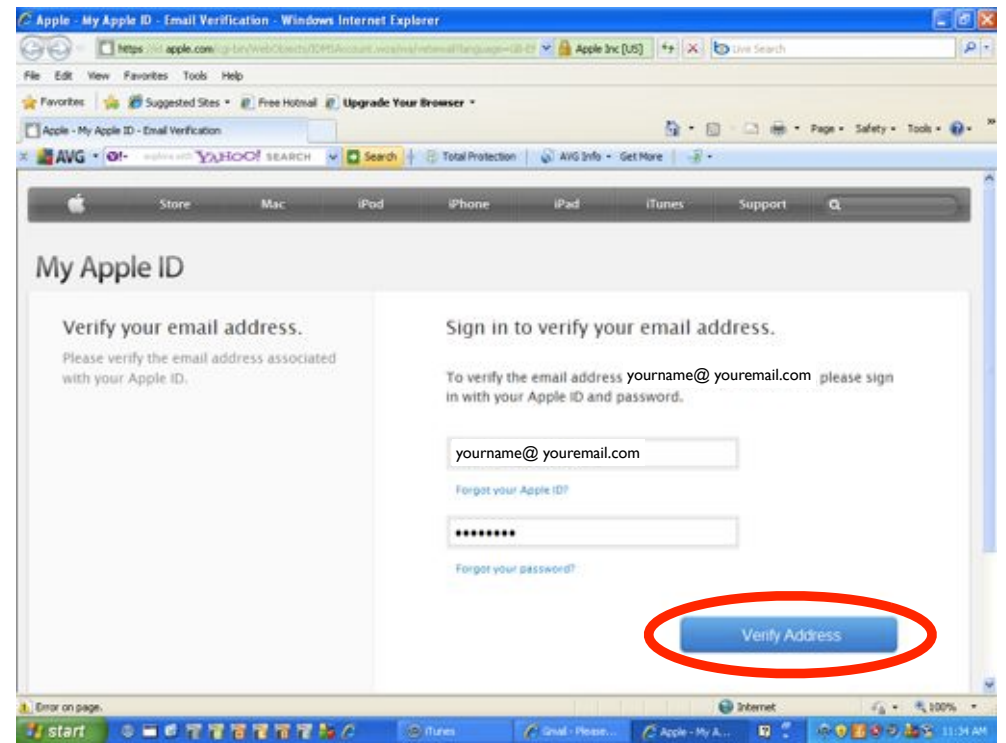

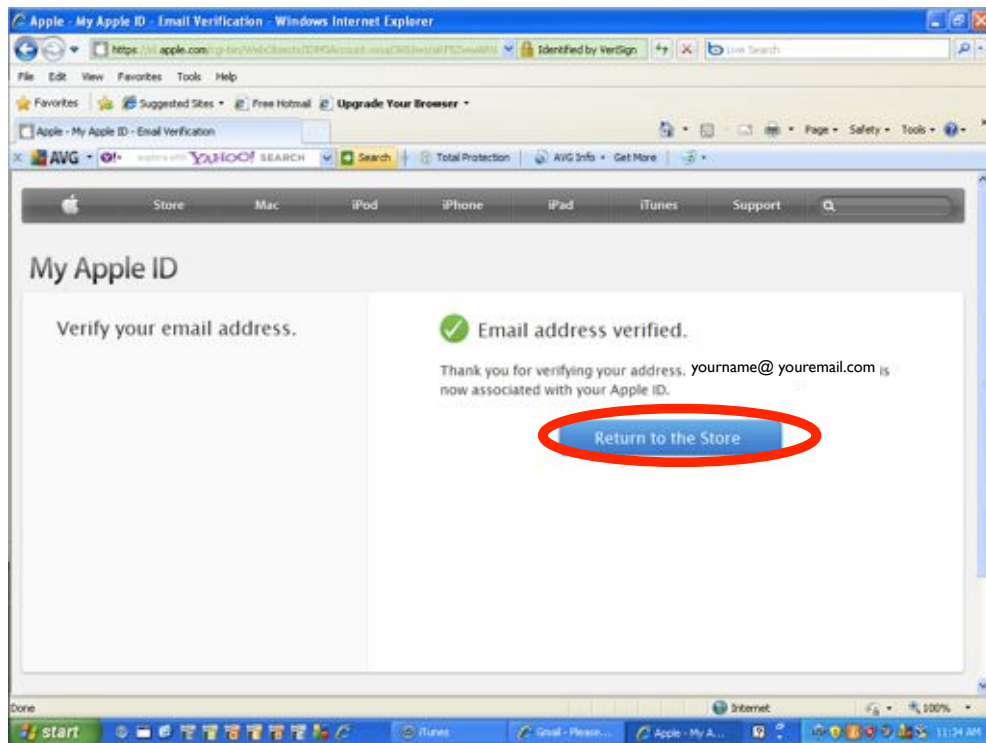
An email will be sent to your email address for verification. Click Done.



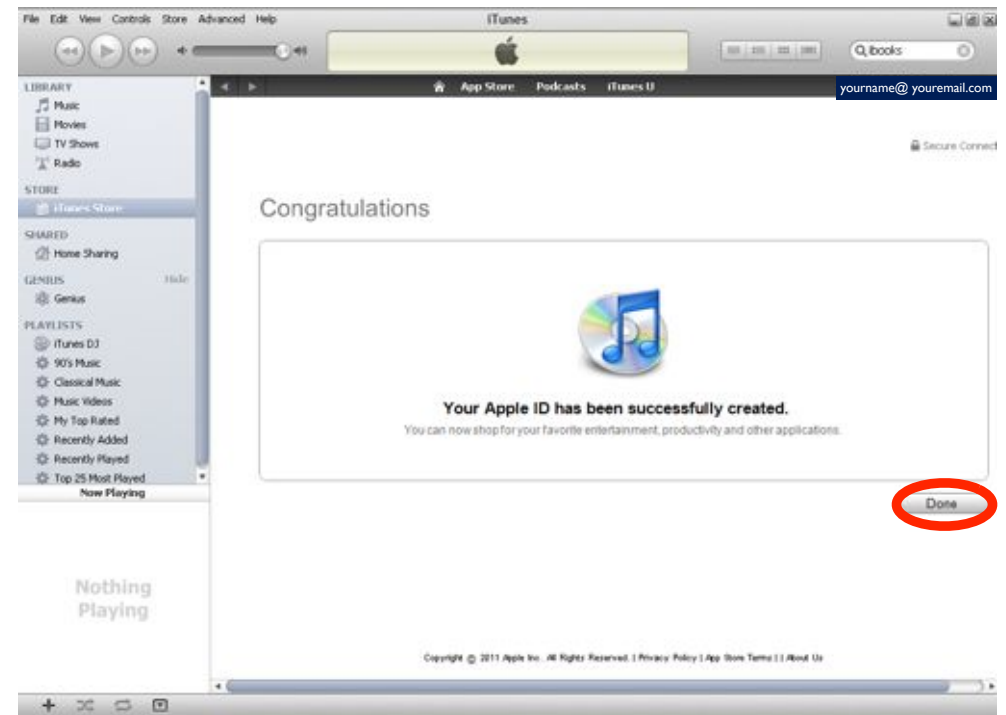
Open your email. You should see an email from Apple. Click the Verify Now > link.



To verify, enter the email address and password you entered in iTunes and click Verify Address.



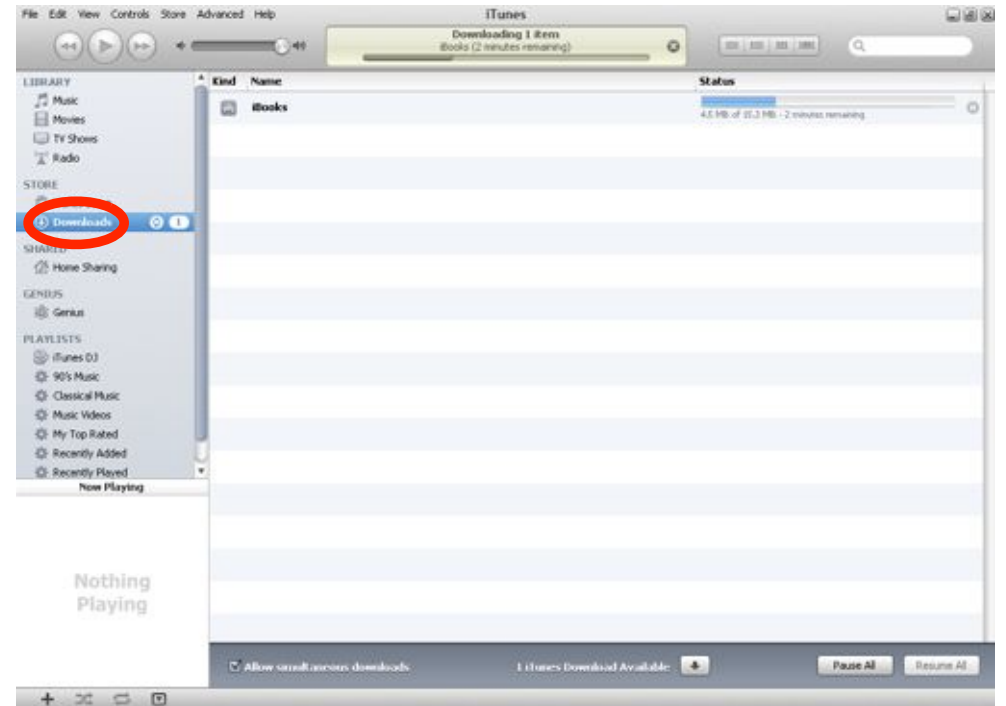
If you have entered the information correctly you will see this screen. Click Return to the Store.



The computer will return to the iTunes program and you will see this screen. Notice that you will be logged in using your newly created AppleID. Click Done.

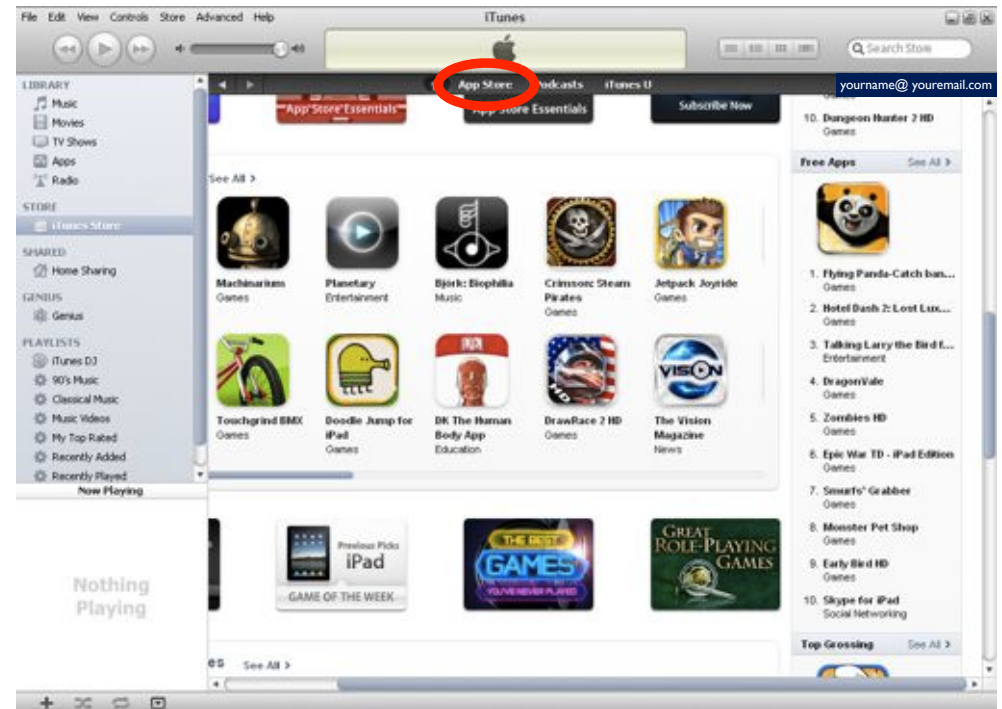


If iTunes has not yet started downloading iBooks, click Download.



If you click the Downloads button in iTunes, it shows all the programs that iTunes is currently downloading. Wait for the iBooks download to finish.

# Downloading from the iTunes Store



When you click on iTunes Store on the left side of the screen, you will see the iTunes Store. You are able to download three types of content; iTunes U, Podcasts and Apps. Normally you will see Apps when you click on the iTunes Store button.



Click the Podcasts button to see Podcasts.

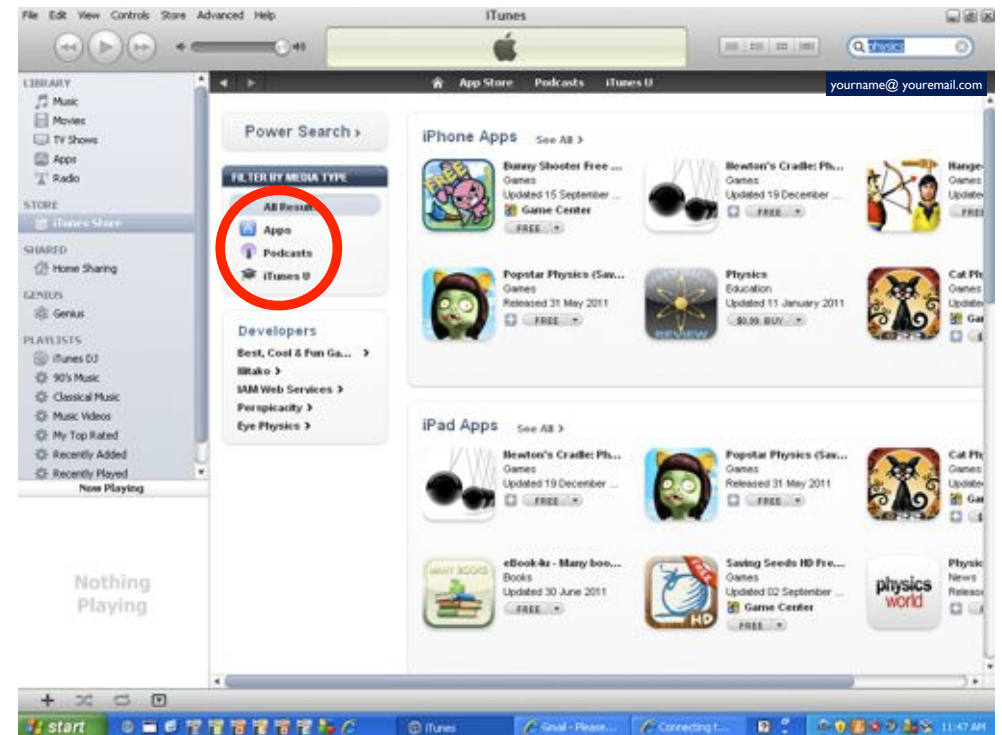


Click the iTunes U button to see iTunes U content. These are lectures on academic subjects that are produced by Universities worldwide and hosted by Apple.





To search for content, type a search term in the search field.



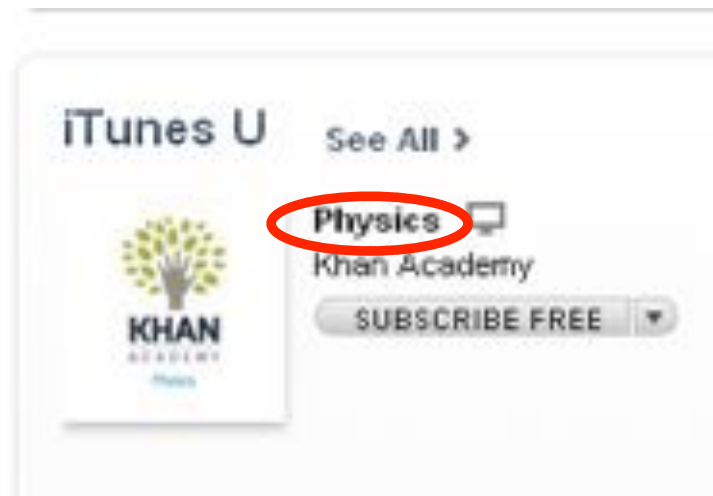
You will see search results returned, and you can filter by Apps, Podcasts and iTunes U on the left side of the screen.



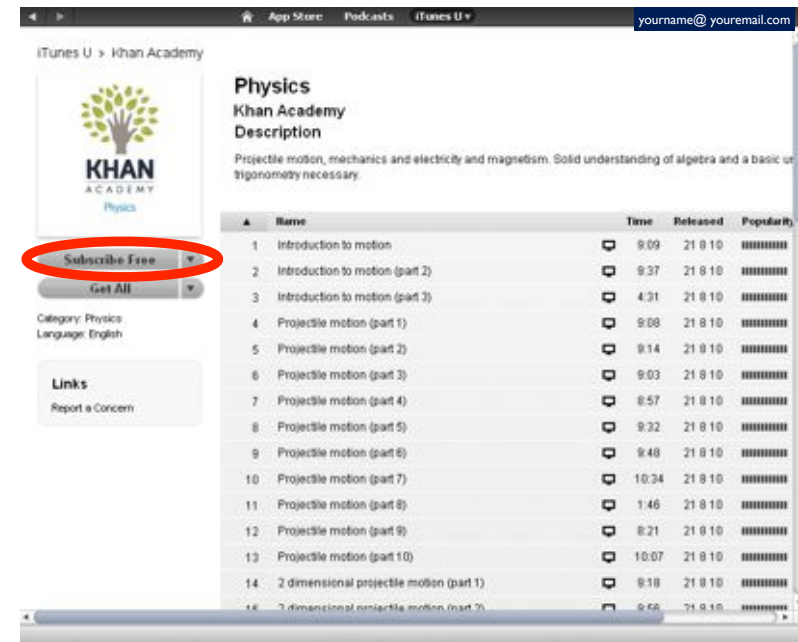
# iTunes U



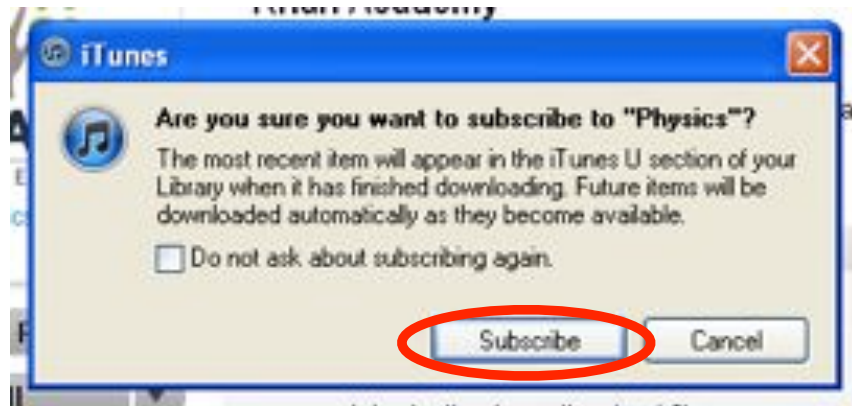
Click on the iTunes U filter. You will see all iTunes U content related to Physics.



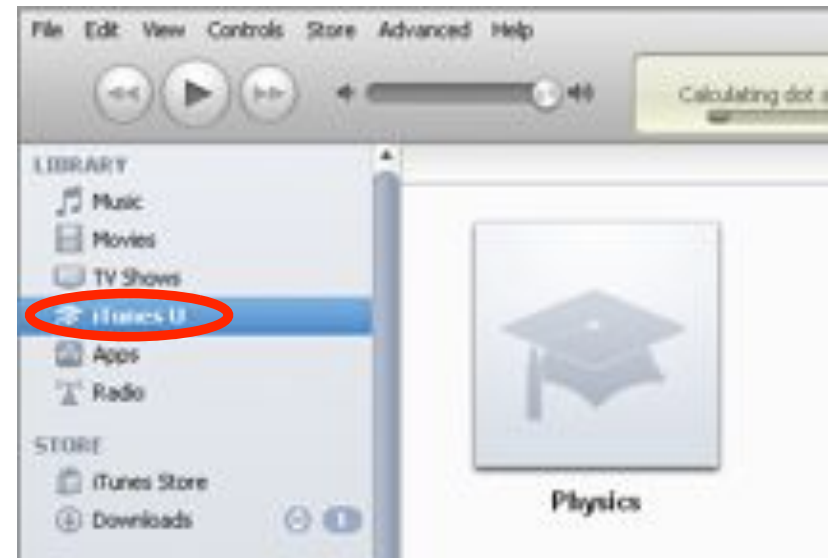
Here we'll choose Physics produced by Khan Academy. Click on the Physics link.



All the lectures will be displayed. Click the Subscribe Free button. This will download the latest lecture, and will automatically download any new lectures produced by Khan Academy in the future.



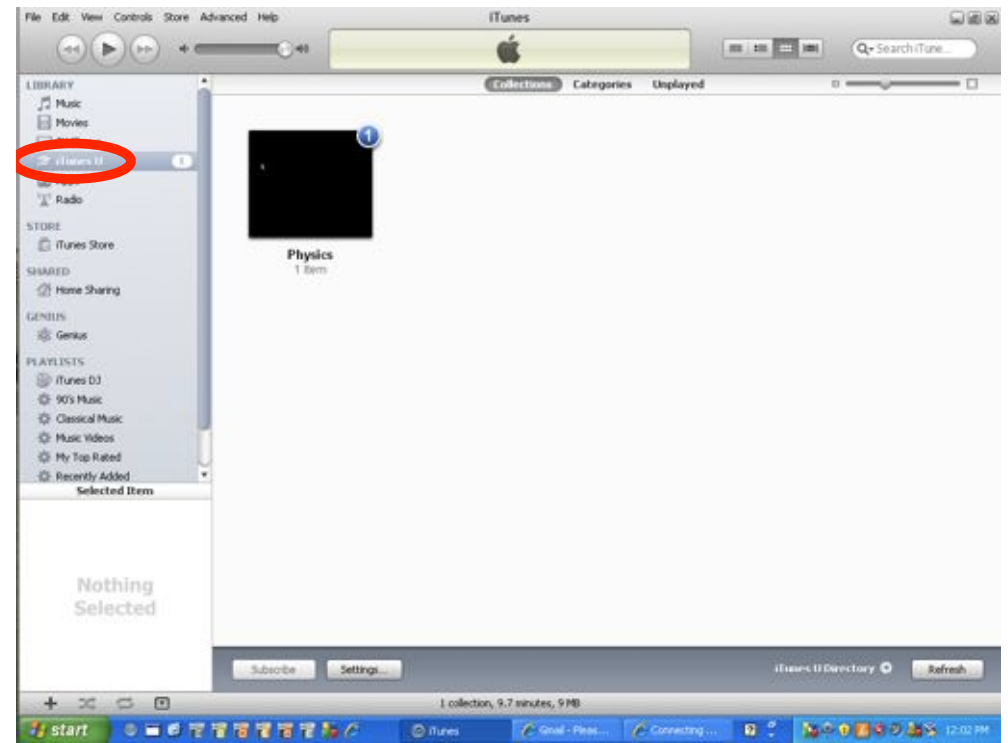
Click Subscribe to confirm your subscription.



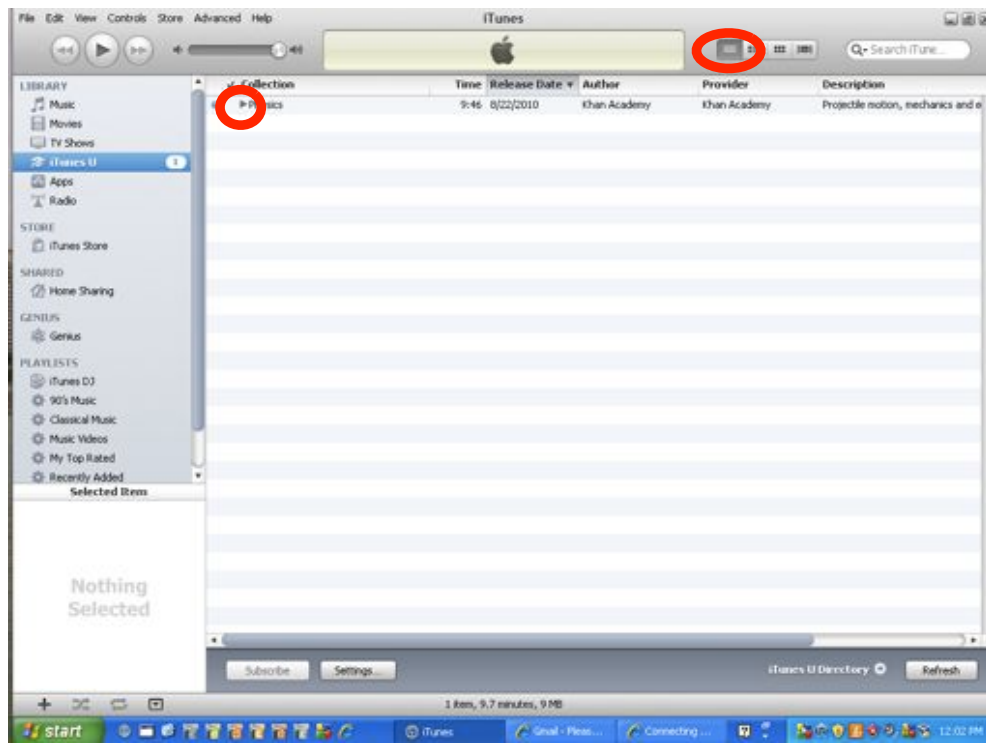
If you click on the iTunes U button on the left column of iTunes, you'll see that the subscription has been added.



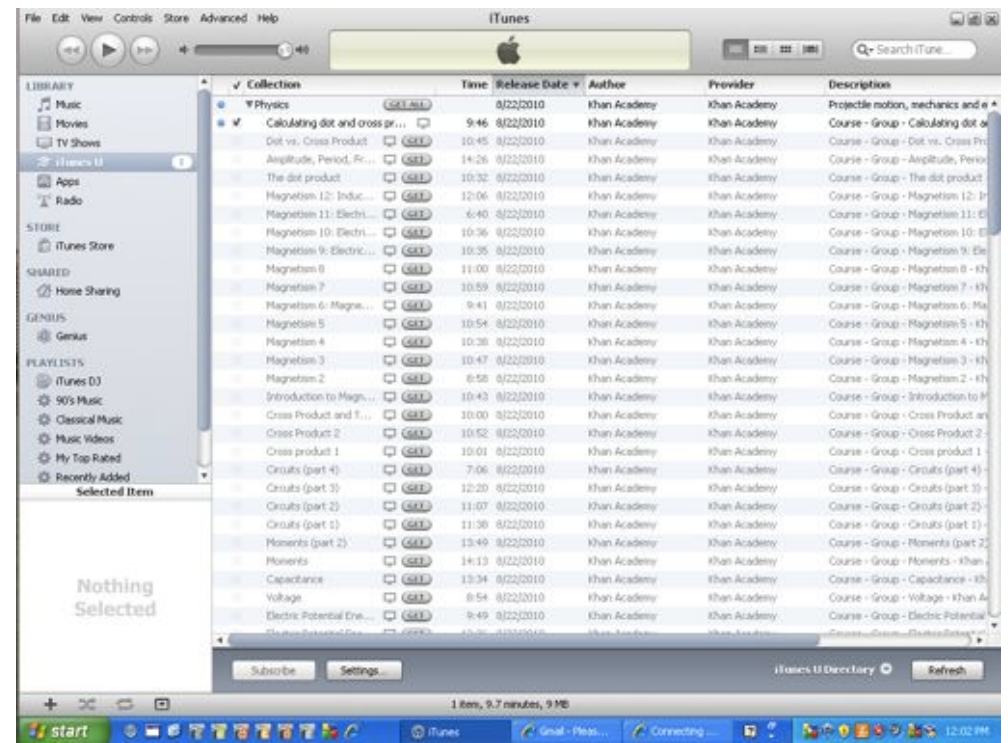
Click the Downloads section to see the progress of the download.



Click iTunes U again after the download is complete. You'll see there is one new item for Physics.

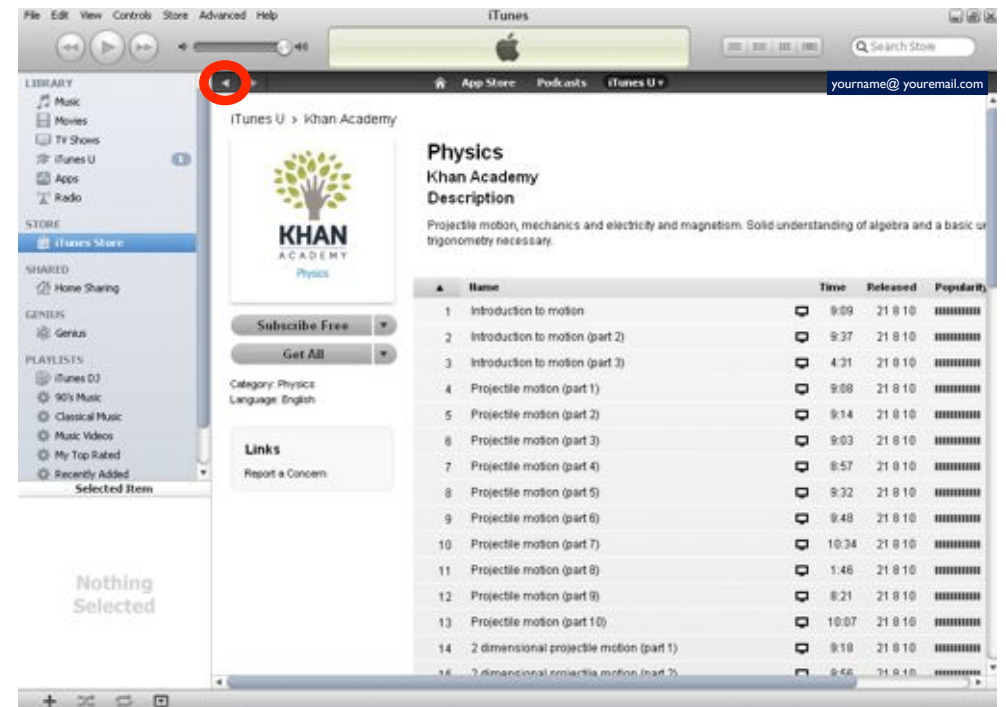


Choose list view and click the triangle to the left of the Physics collection.



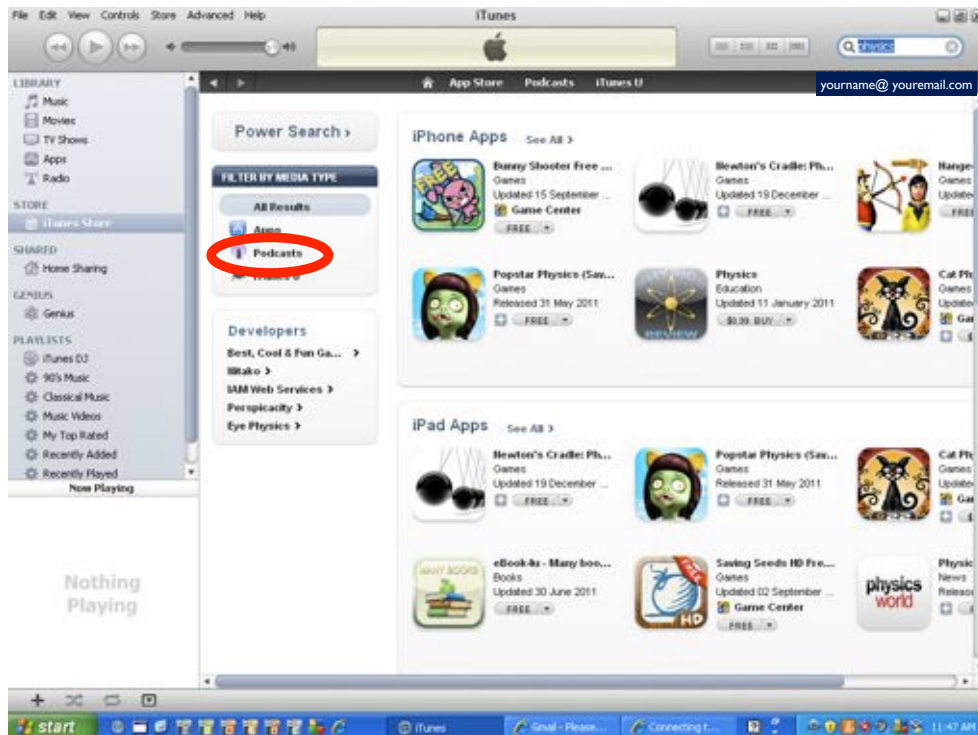
You will see that the latest lecture has been downloaded, and you can download all previous lectures by clicking Get All.

Click the iTunes Store button in the left column of iTunes. Click the back button in the store.



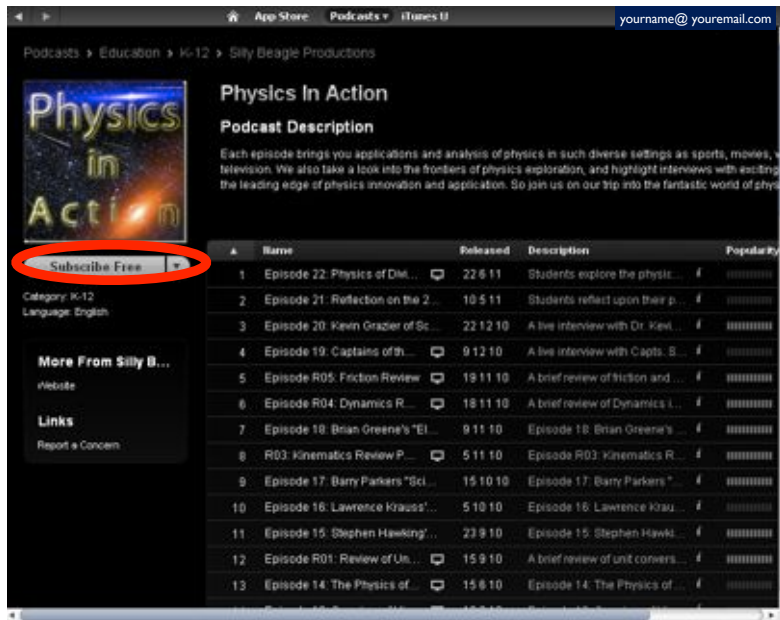


Click on the Podcasts filter in the search results. You will see all Podcasts related to Physics.



Click on the Physics in Action podcast. Podcasts are independently produced and anyone can make a Podcast.

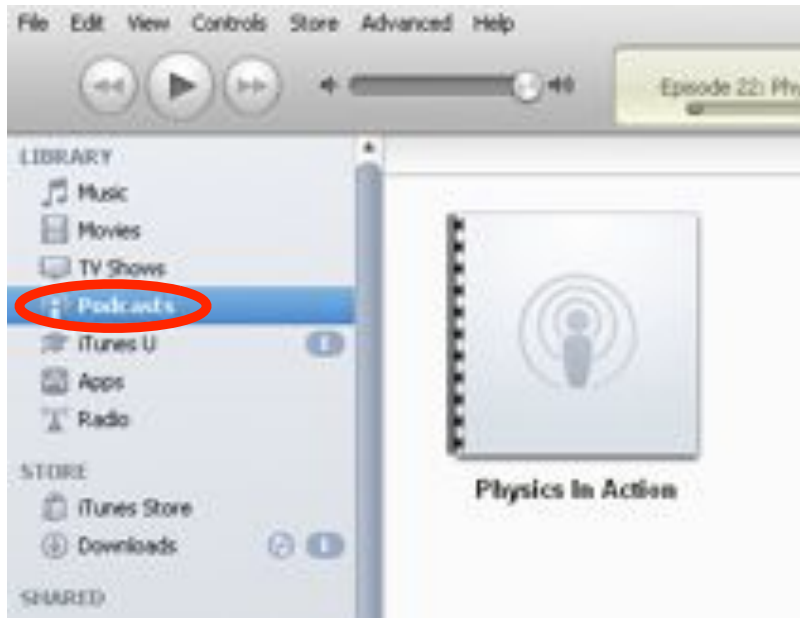




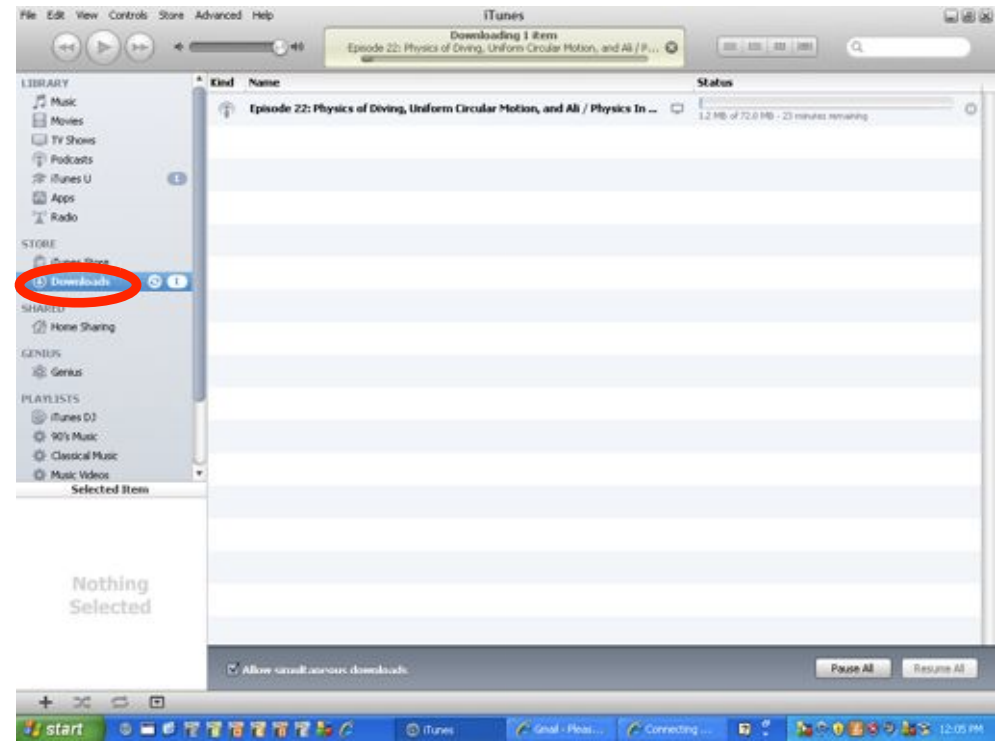
Click on the Subscribe Free button.



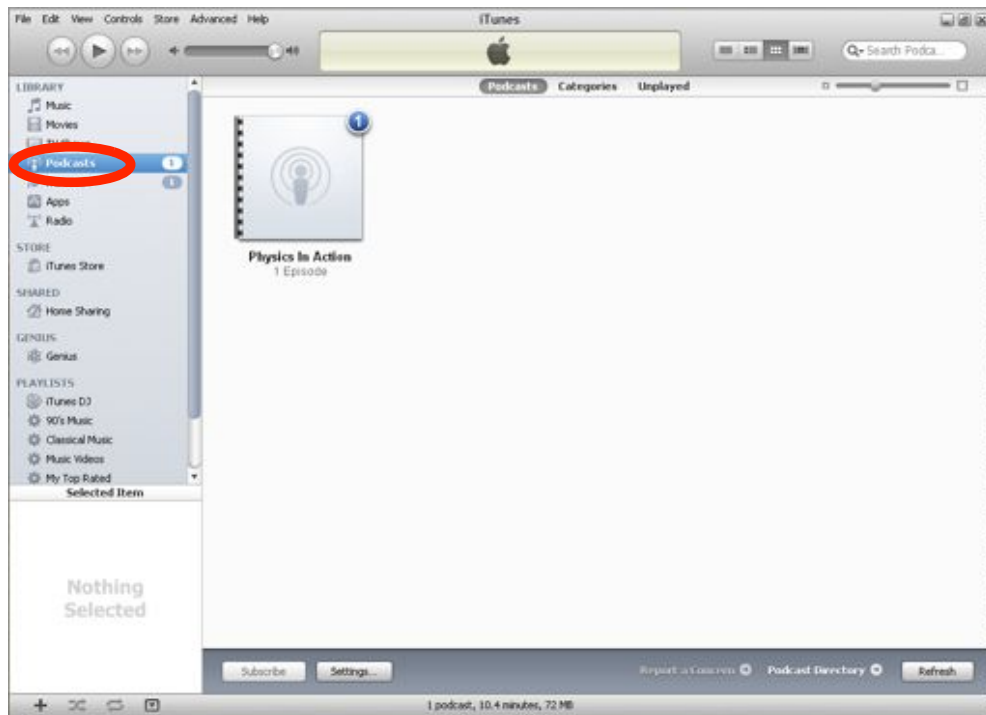
Click Subscribe.



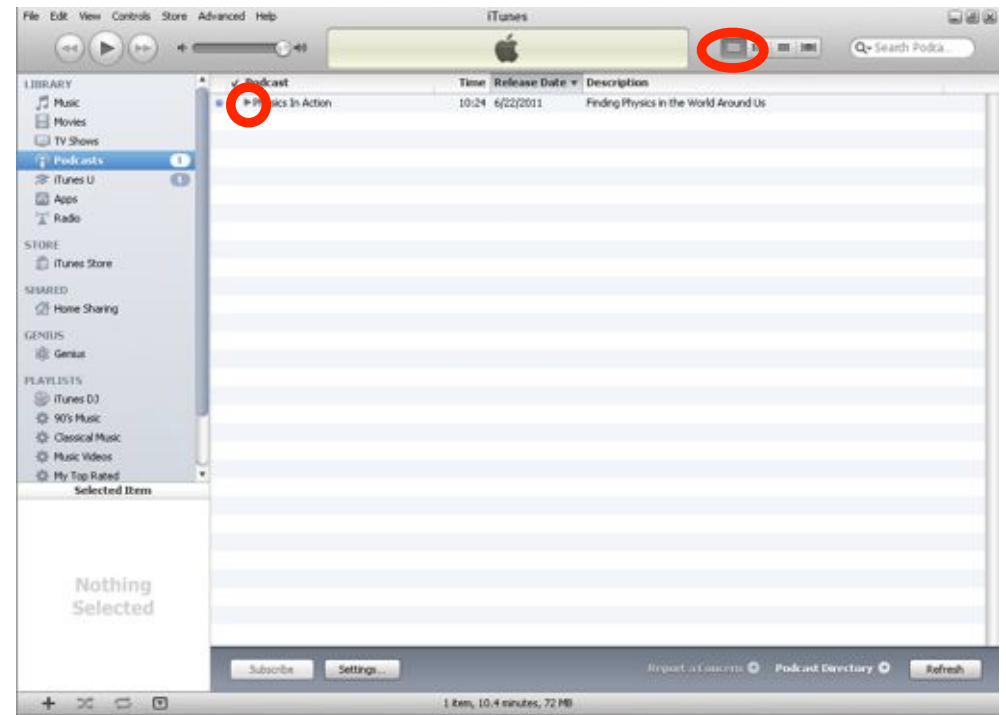
Click the Podcasts button in the left column of iTunes. You will see the Podcast has been added.



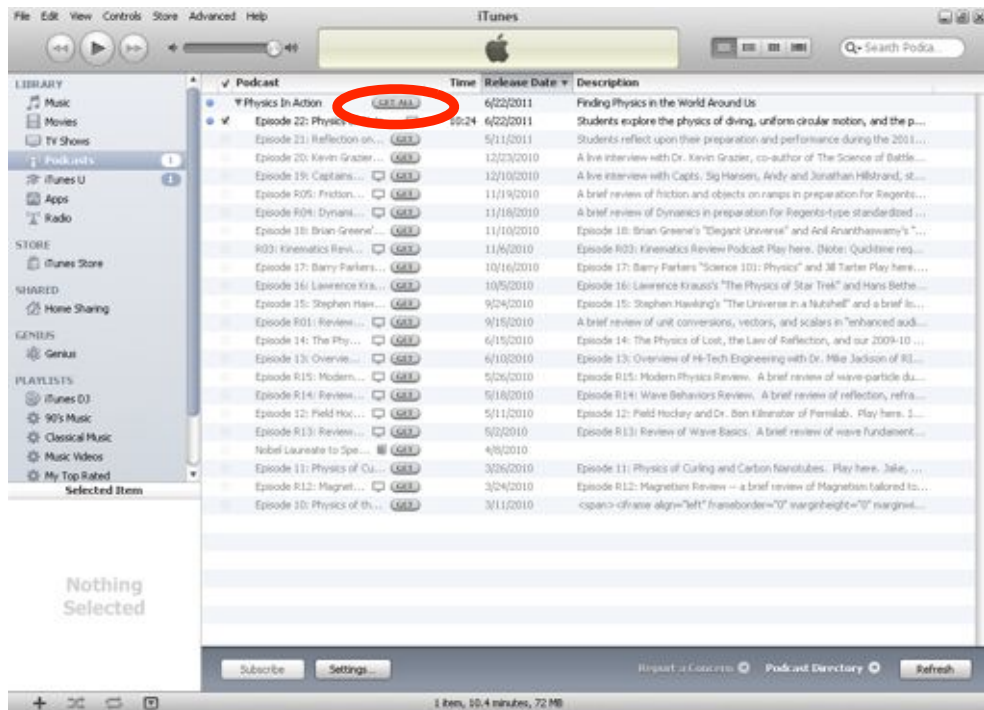
When you click the Downloads button, you will notice the Podcast being downloaded.

Click the back button.



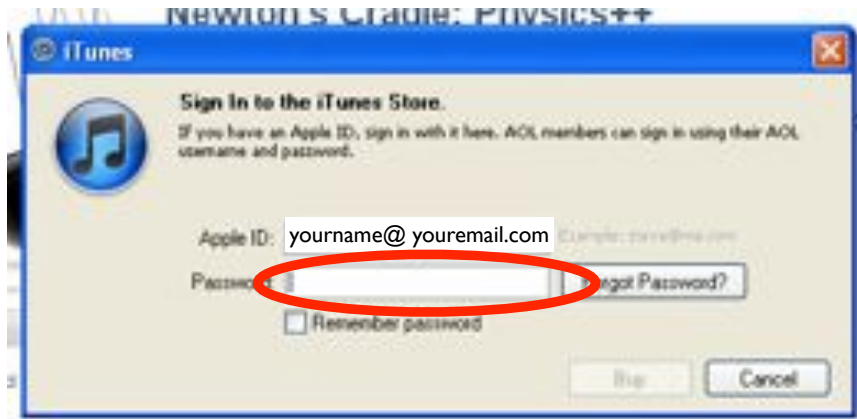
Click the Apps filter in the search results. You will see all Apps related to Physics.
