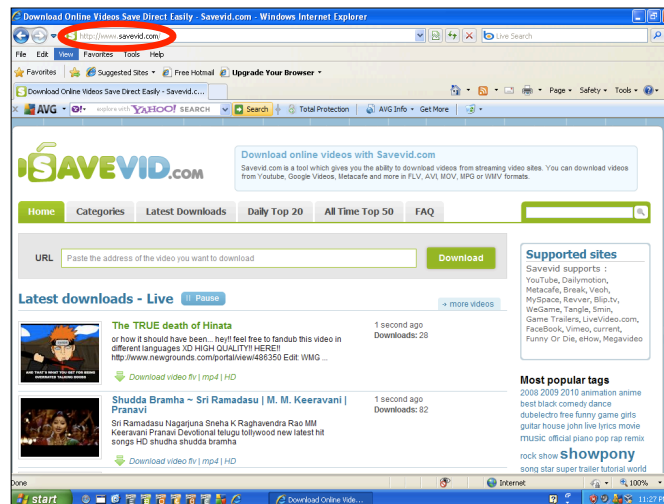
Go to www.youtube.com and type a search term in the Search field, such as physics.



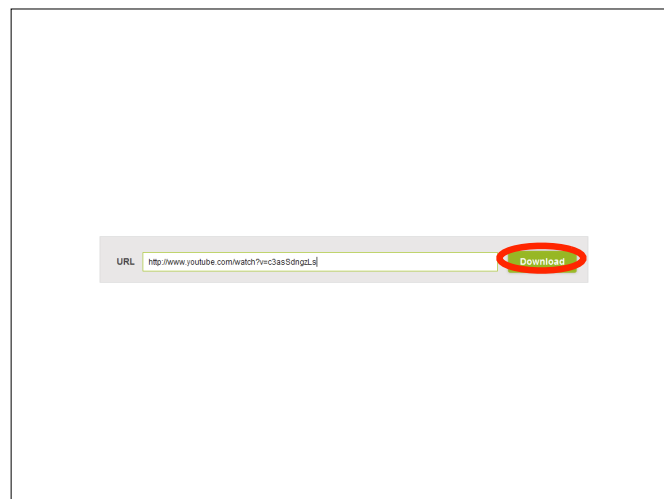
Click a video.



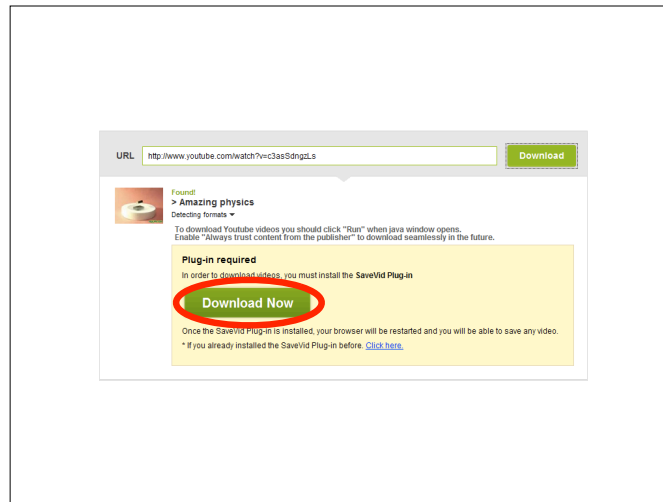
Copy the URL



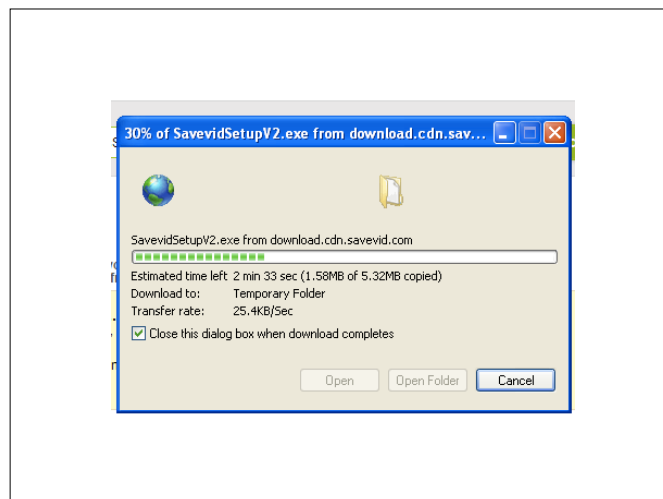
Go to www.savevid.com



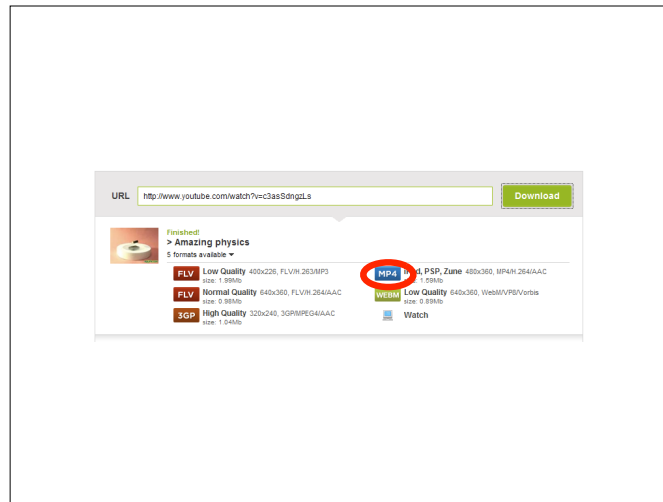
Paste the URL and click Download.



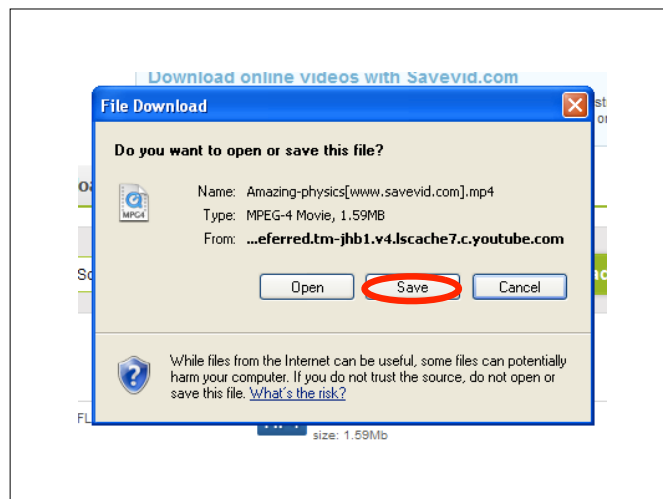
If you don't have the plugin, you need to click Download Now.



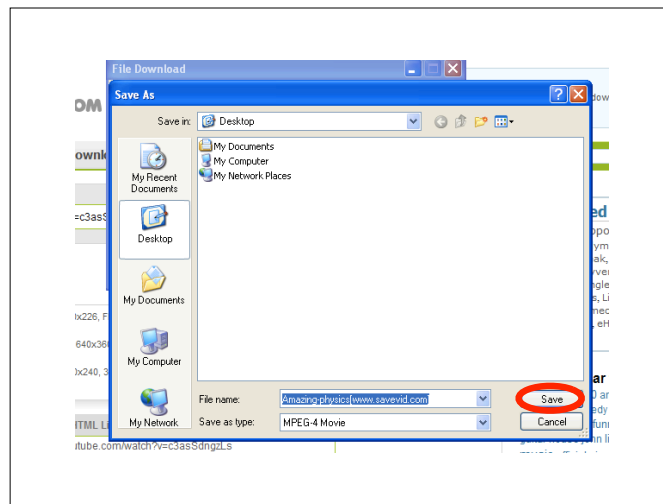
Wait until the plugin downloads and installs.



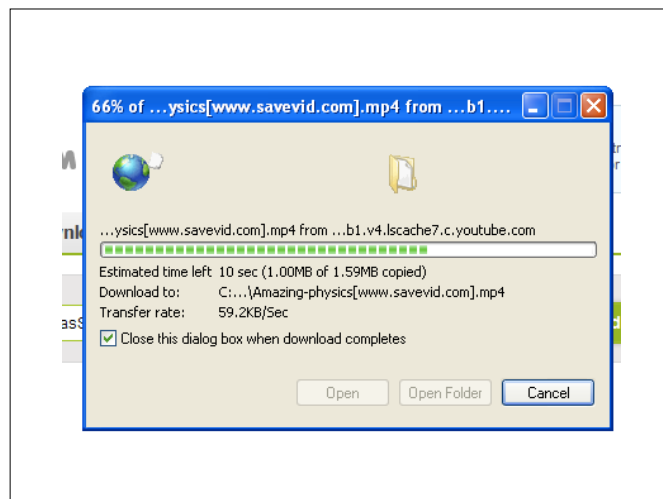
Now when you click download, it will show you the various formats available. Click MP4.



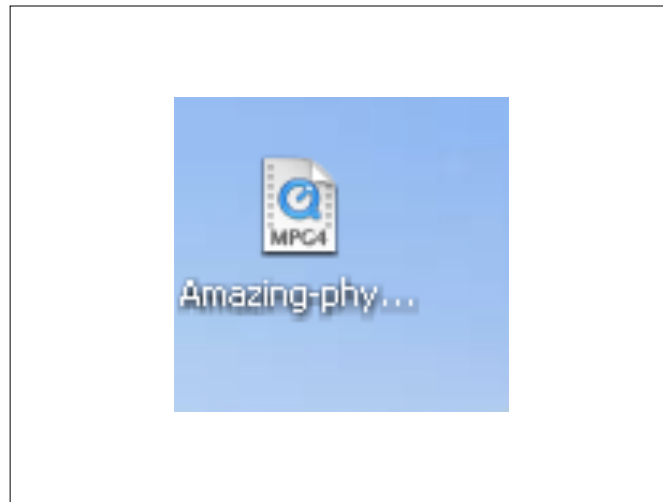
Click Save.



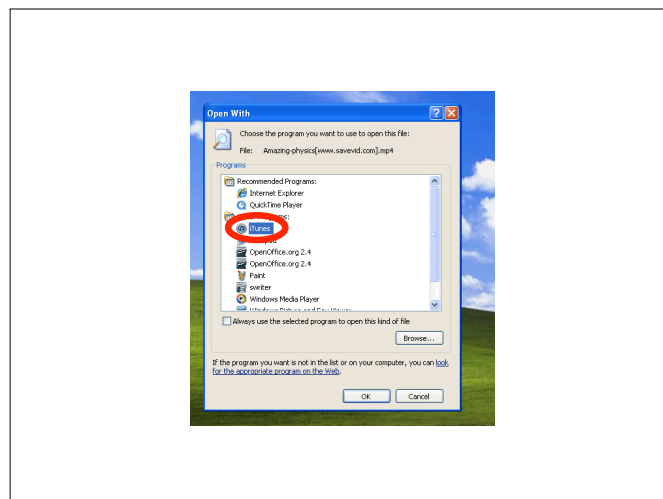
Save it to the Desktop.



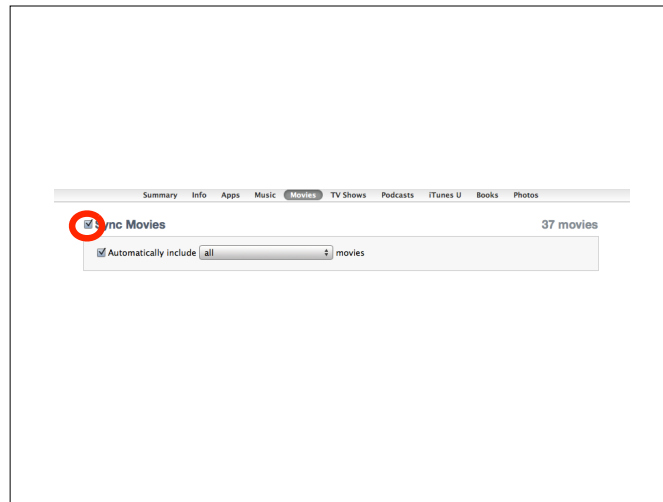
Wait for it to finish.



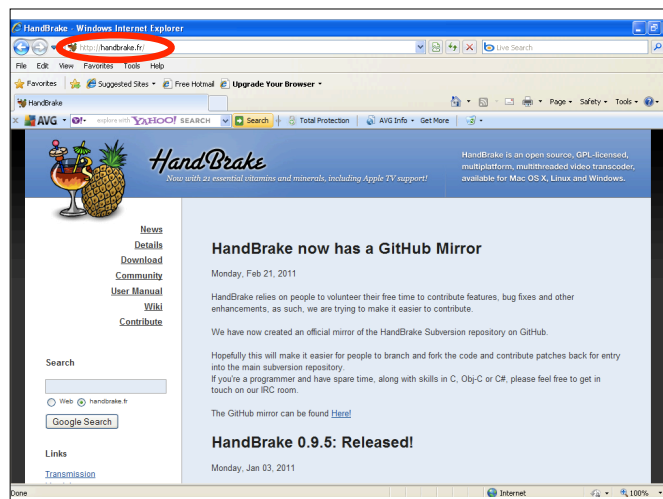
File is on the Desktop.



Right click the file. Choose Open With. Choose iTunes.



File will be copied to iTunes. To sync to the iPad, connect the iPad to the computer, launch iTunes and make sure that Sync Movies is ticked.
