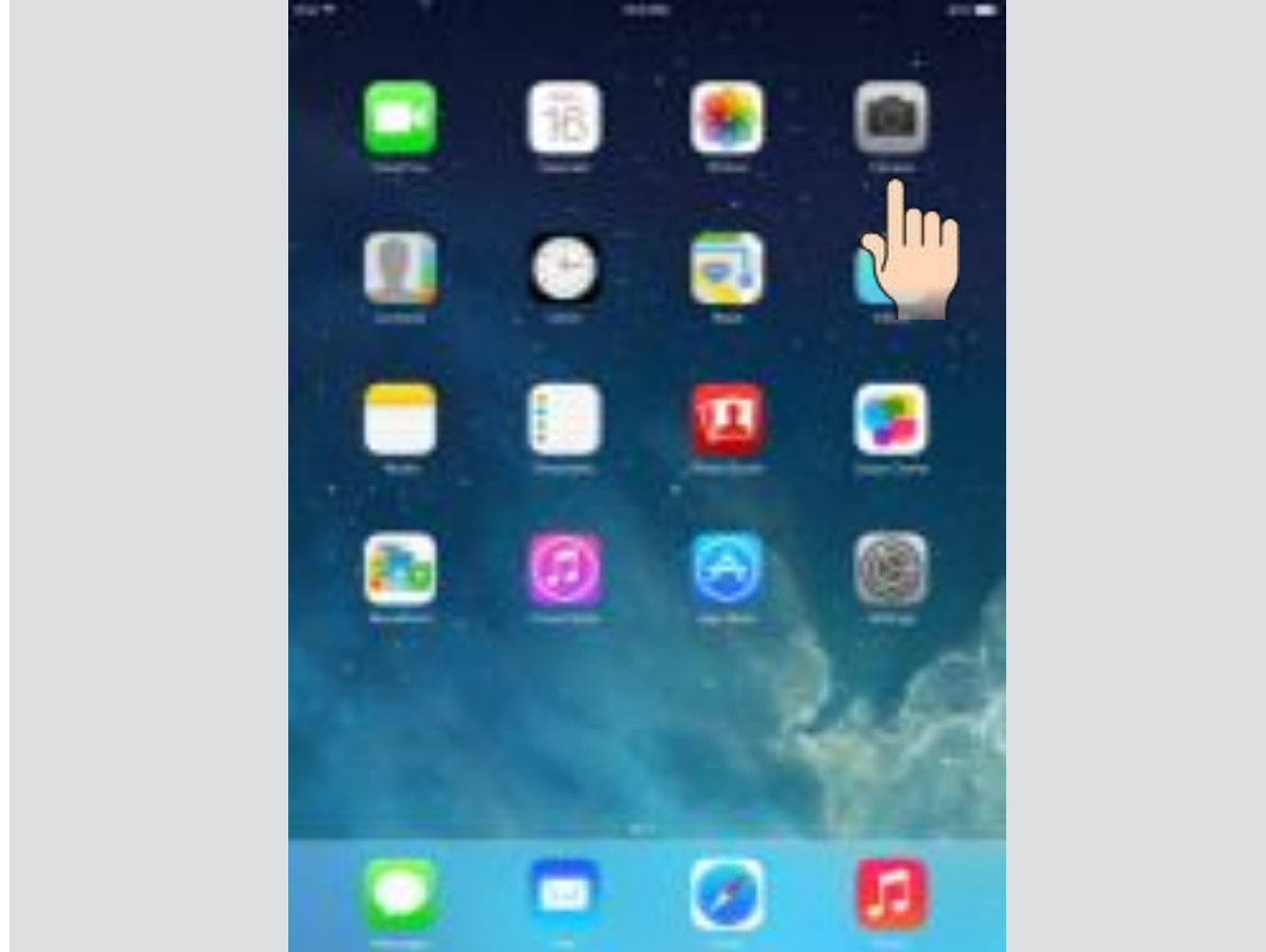
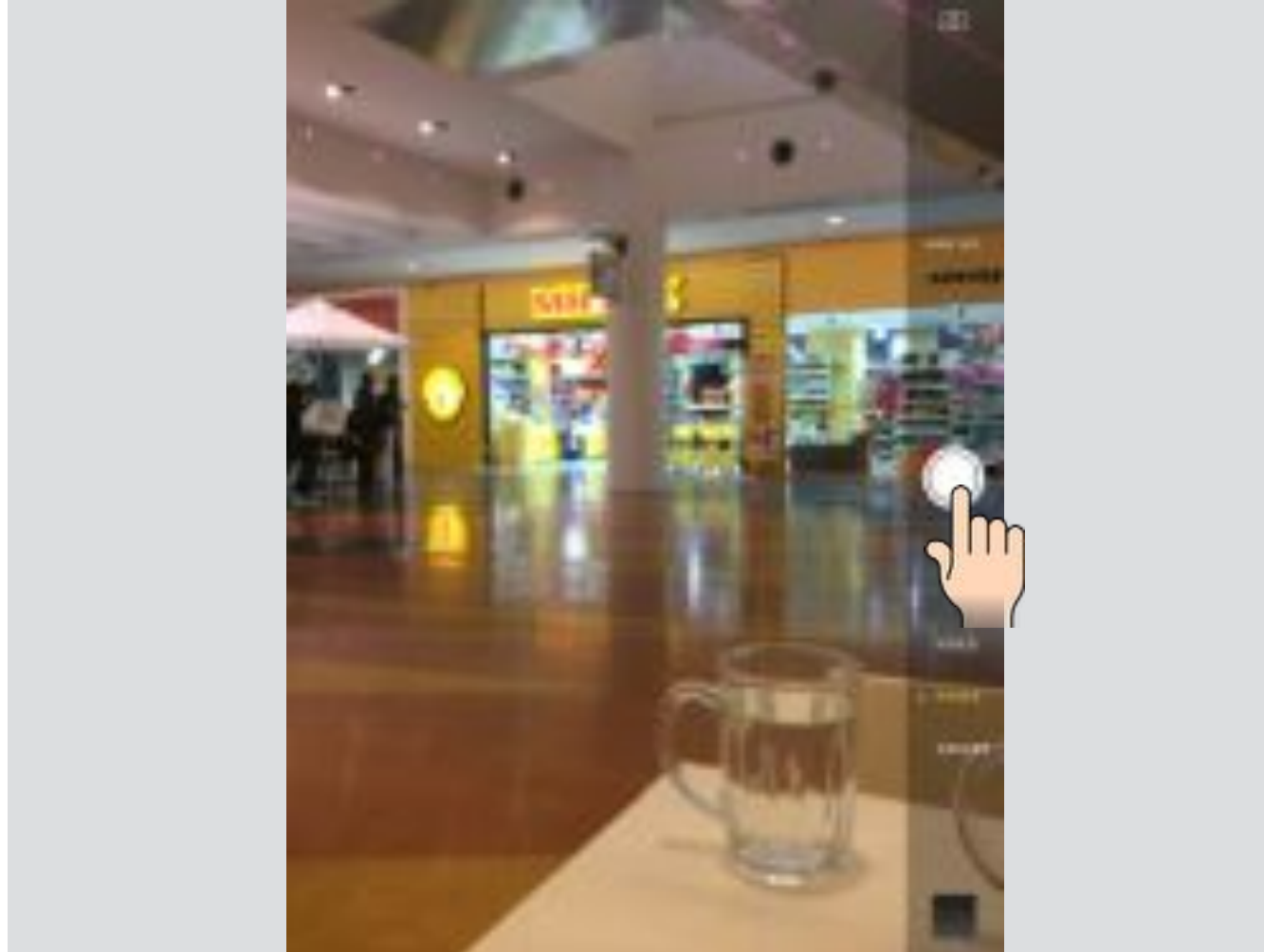


iPhoto for iOS

Double tap the cell directly below the car price and type 3. This will represent the interest rate.



Double tap the next cell and enter 7. This will be the number of years.



Double tap the cell directly below and tap the = sign to enter a formula.



Tap the cell containing the number 30000 to add it to the formula.



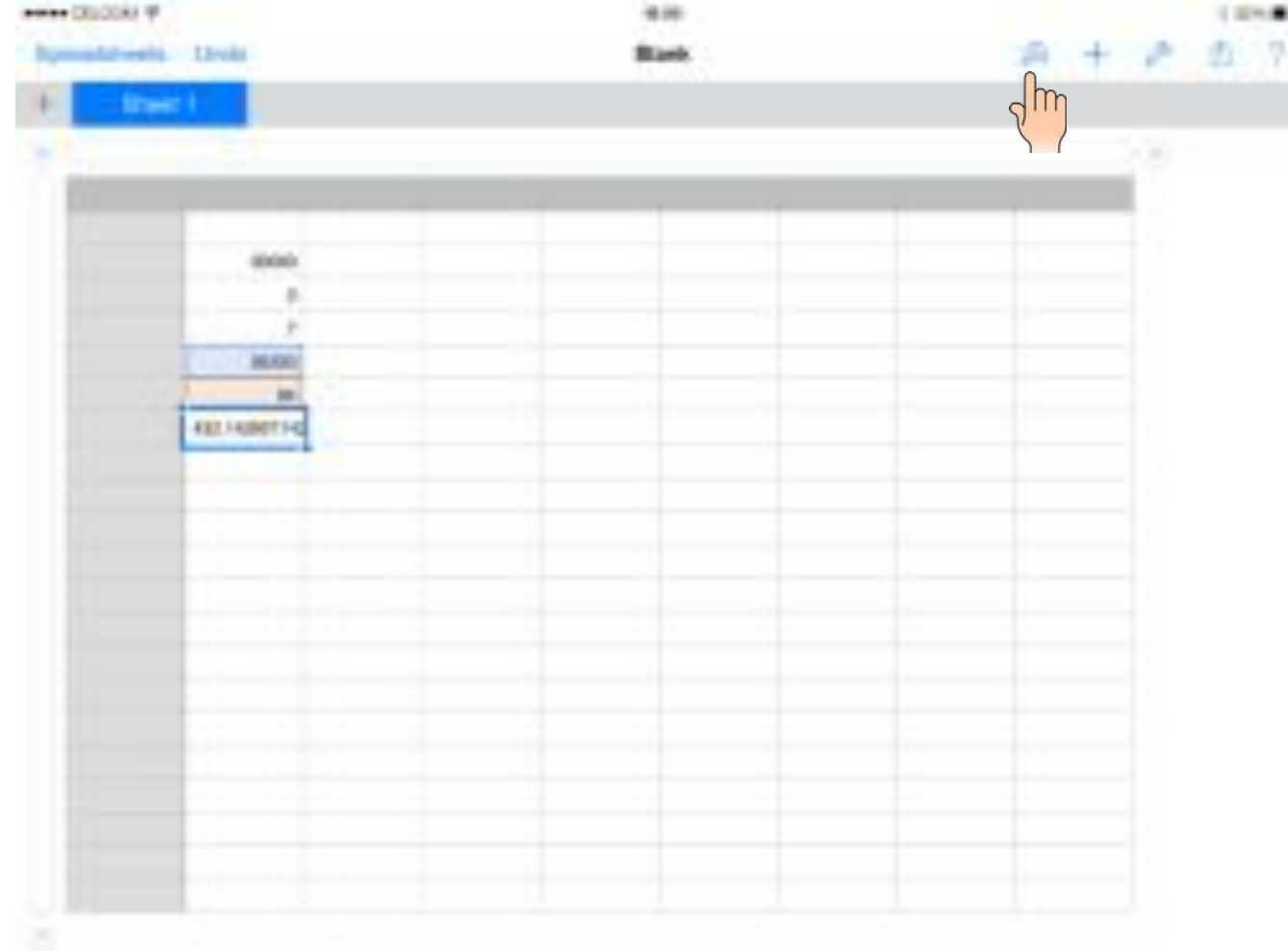
Complete the formula as shown. Tap the green circle to accept the equation.



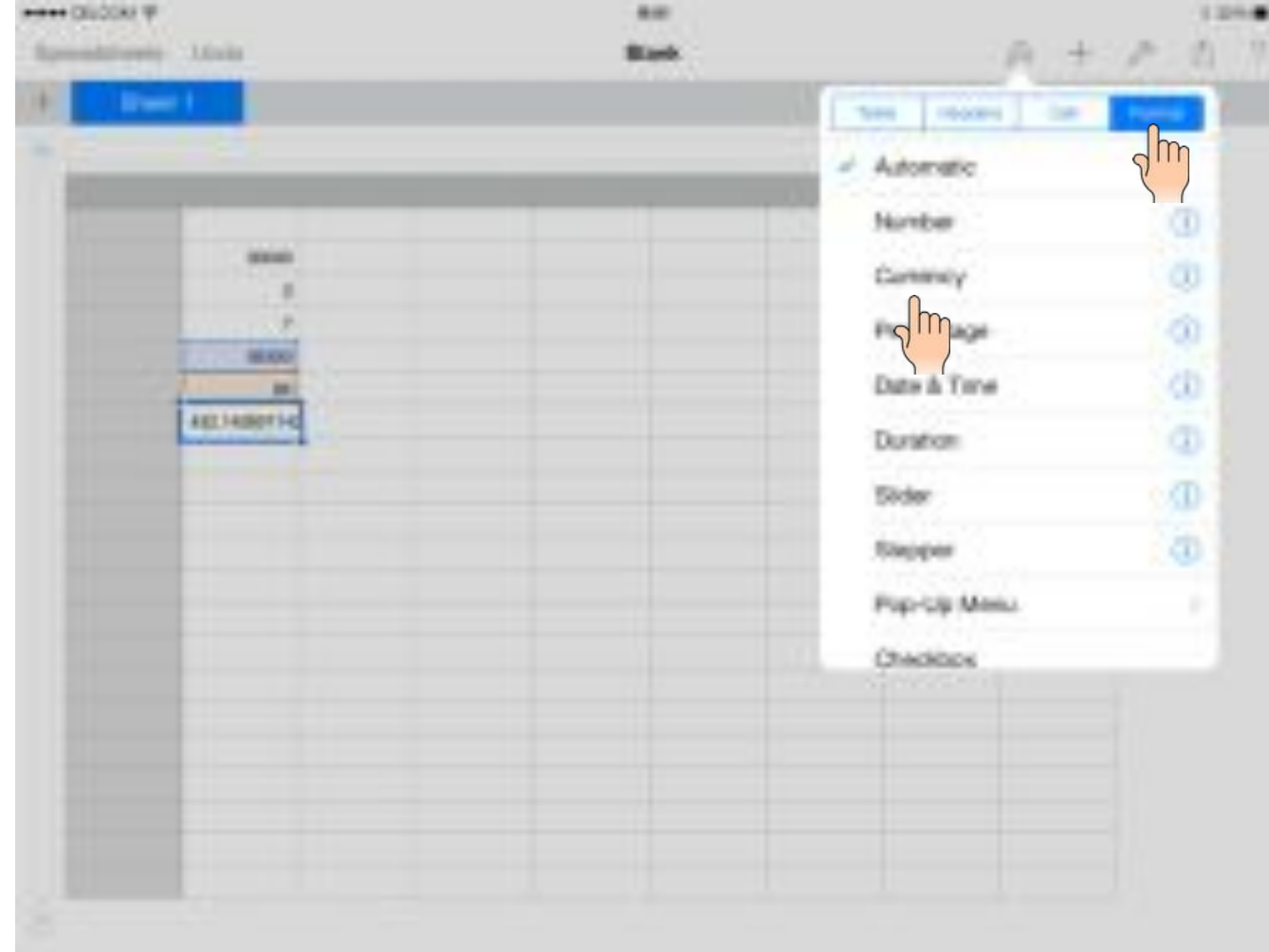
The total amount that you have to pay (car price + interest for 7 years) is calculated. Now we'll calculate the number of months. Double tap the cell below the calculation and enter a new formula as shown.



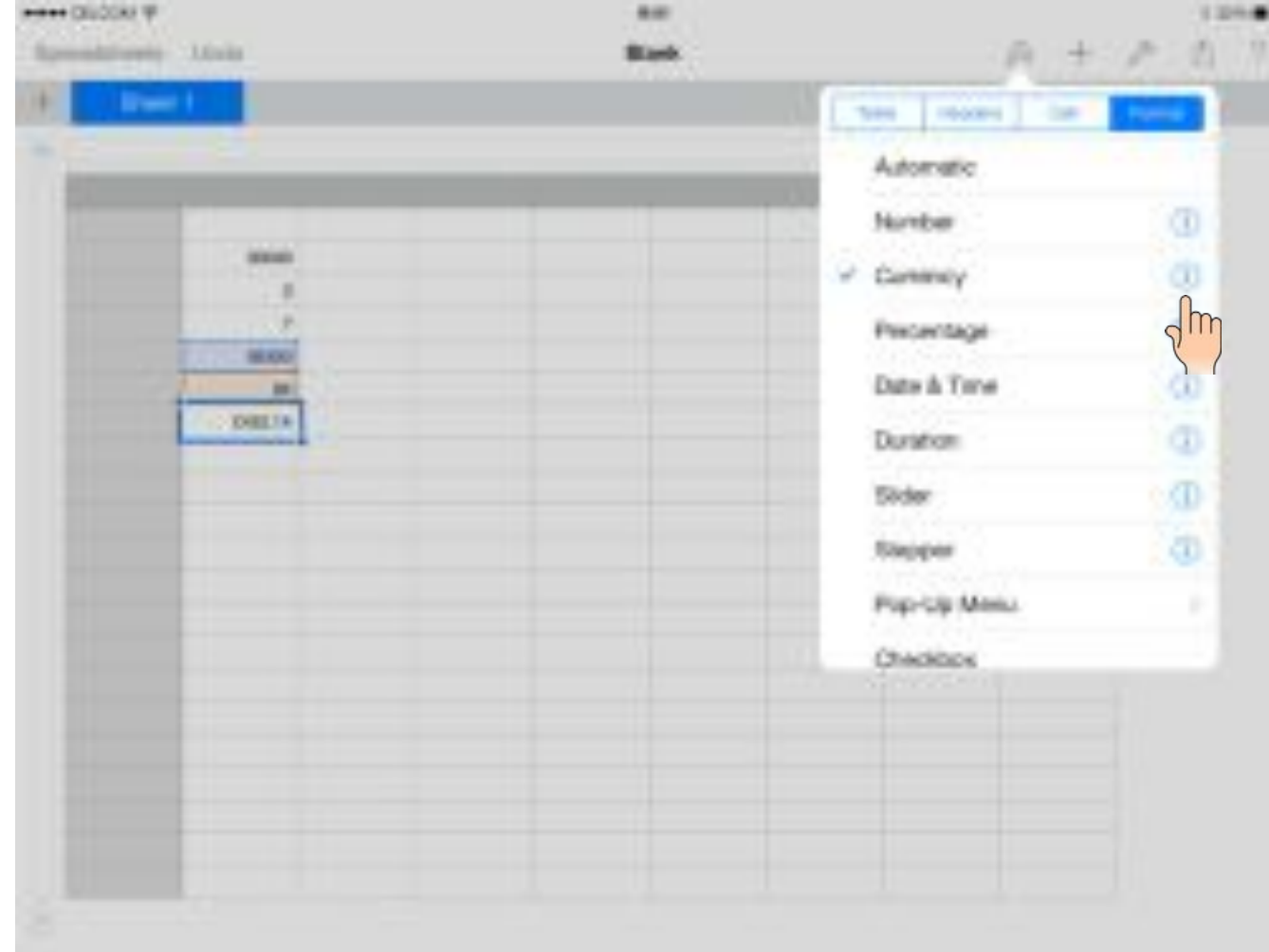
Finally we will divide the total amount with the number of months to calculate the monthly instalment. Double tap the cell below the earlier calculation and enter the formula as shown.



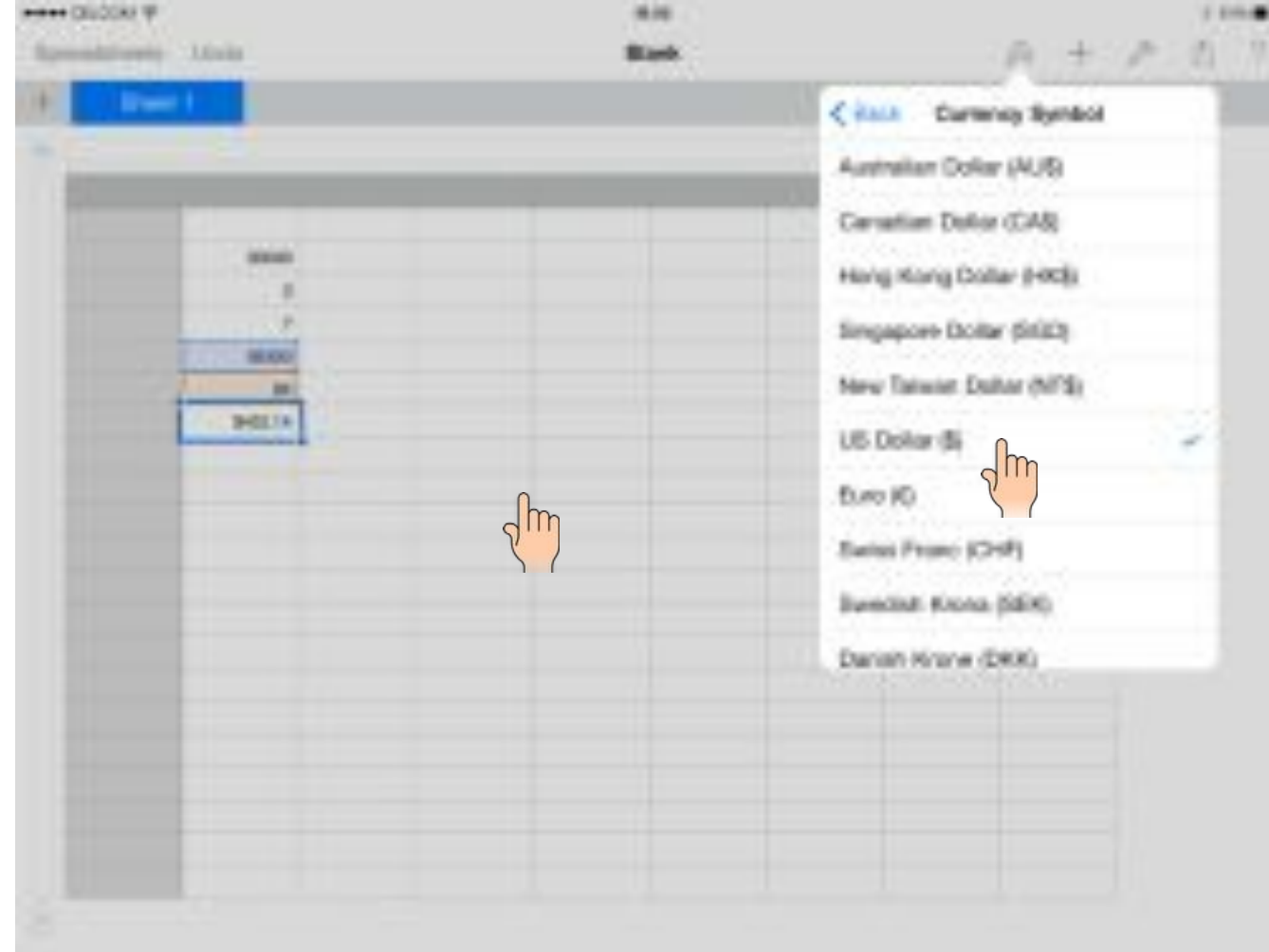
The monthly instalment has been calculated. We will now change the formatting. Tap the Format icon.



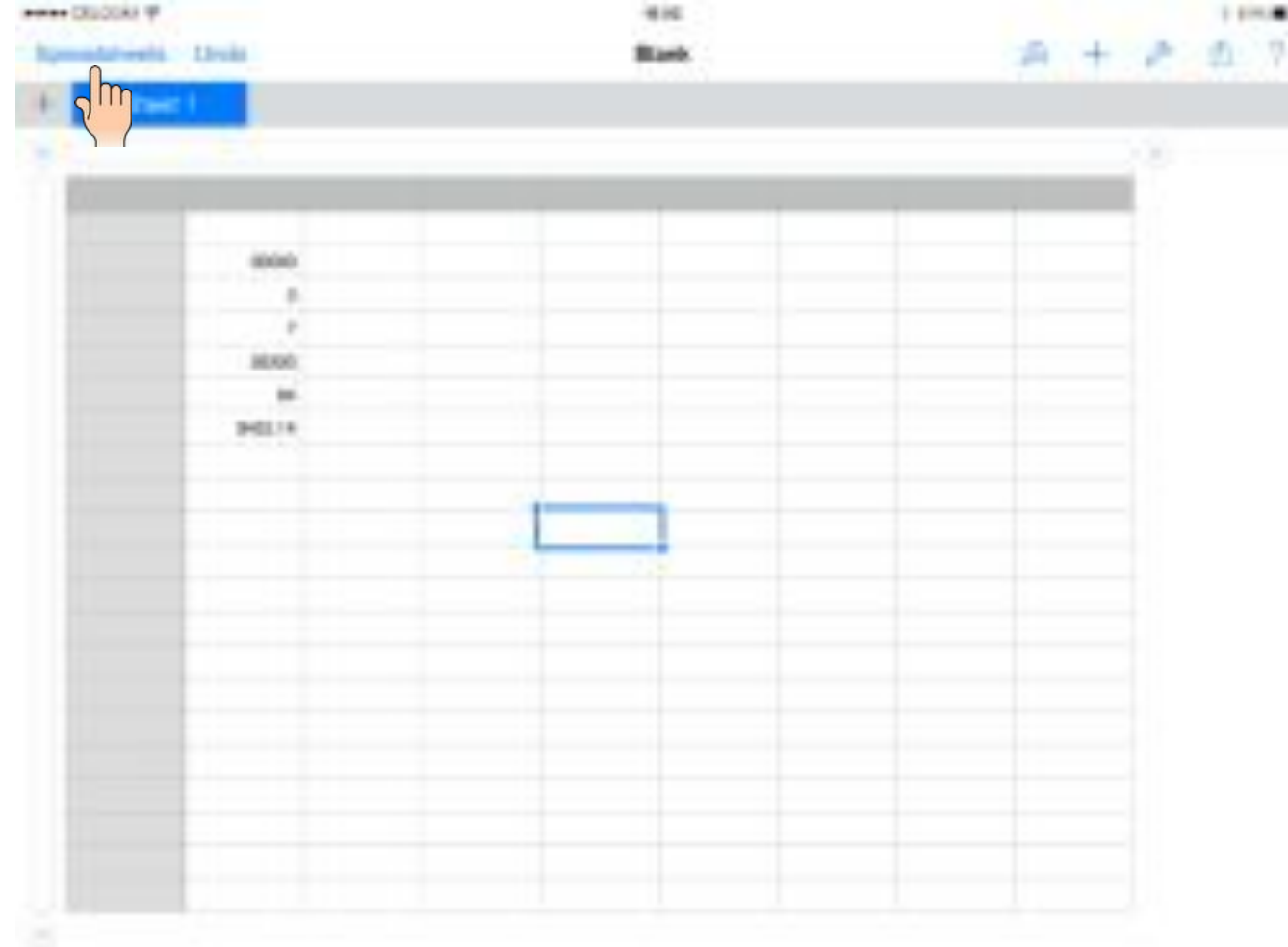
Tap Format and tap Currency.
