7.1 Messages



Tap Messages.



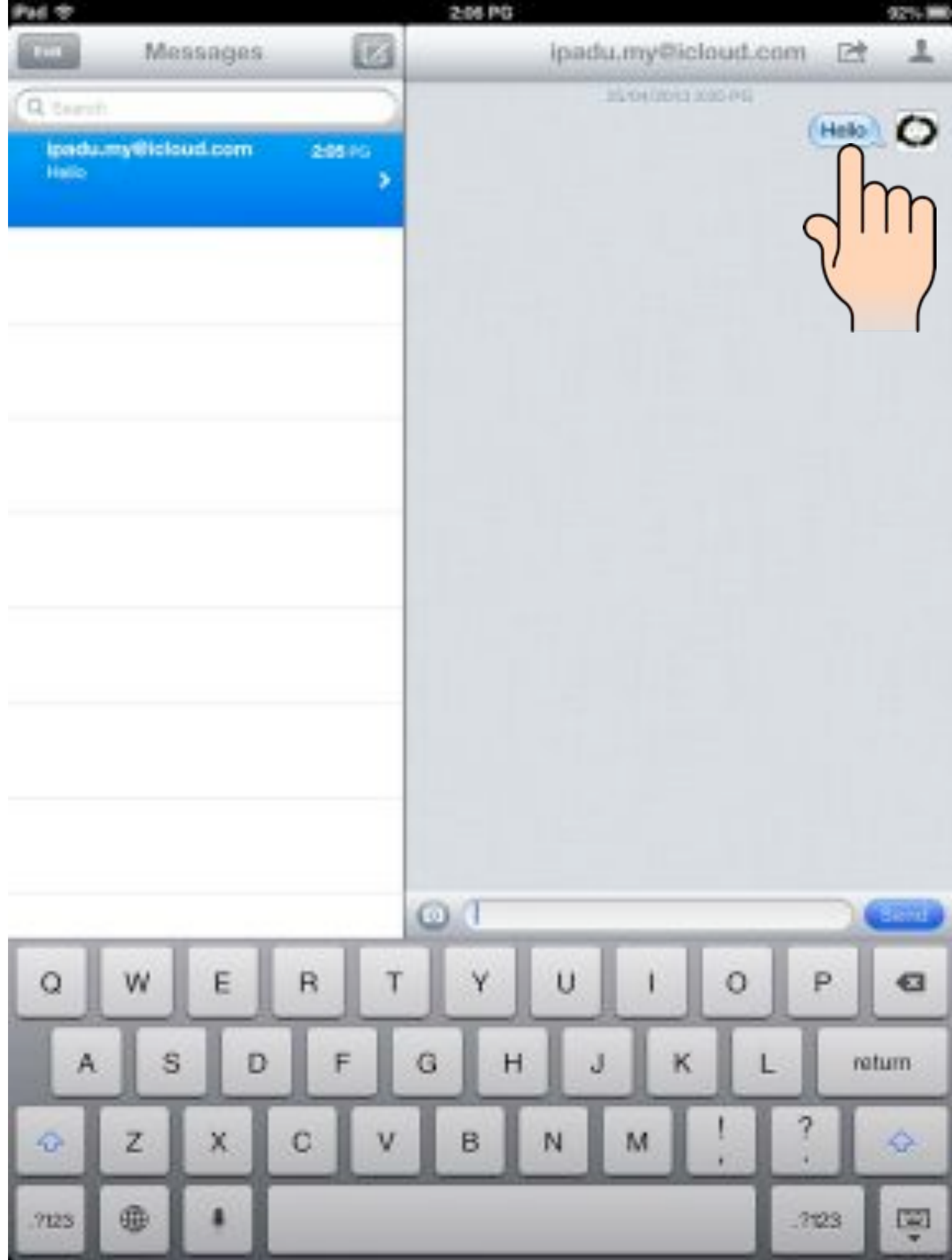
Type the AppleID of another iPad user in the space provided.



Type a message that you want to send to that user.



Tap Send.



The message will be sent to that user.



Here you can see that the other user has replied.



Press the Home button to return to the starting screen.

7.2 FaceTime



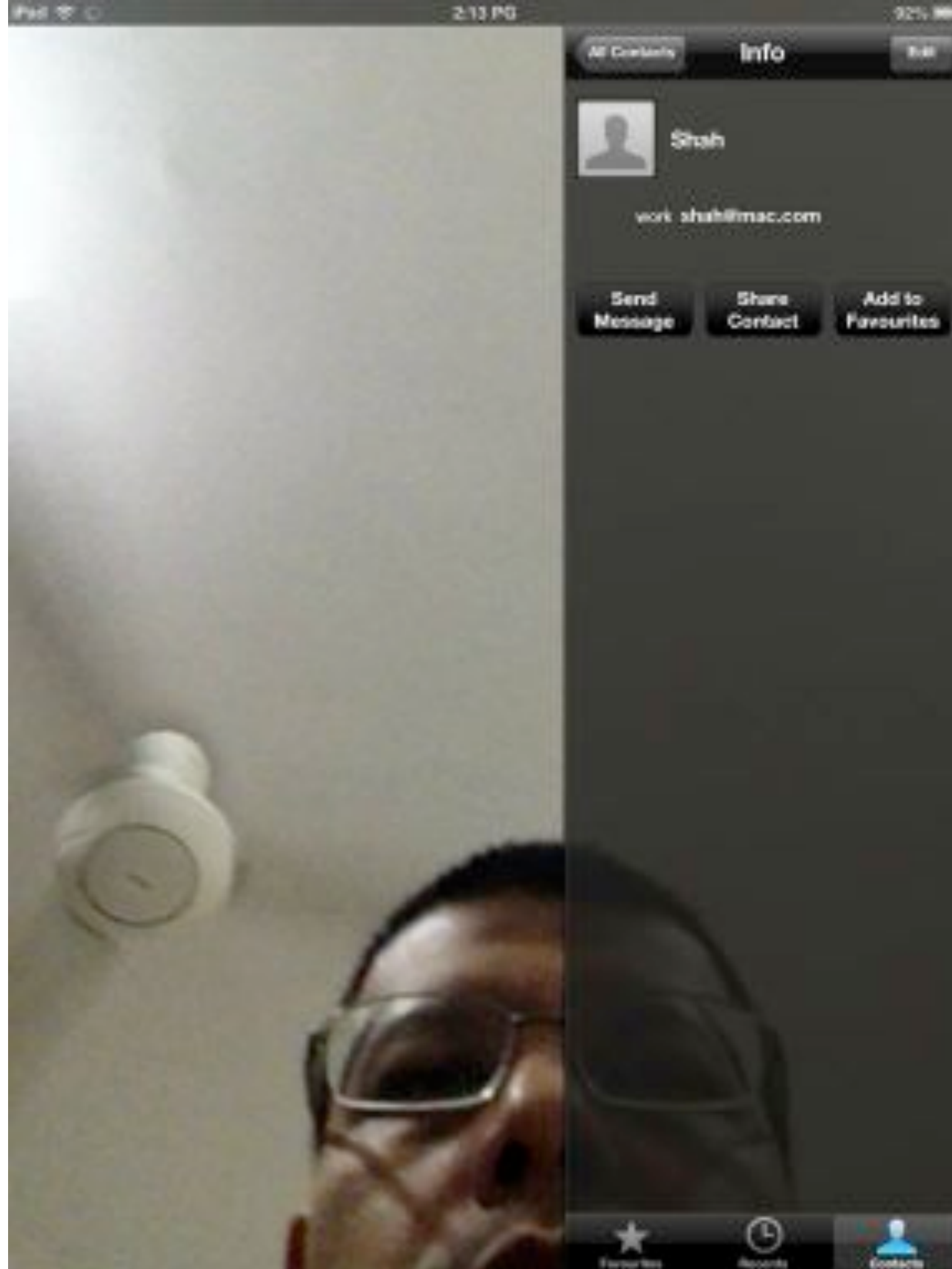
Tap FaceTime.



Tap the + button.



Type in the name and AppleID of another iPad user. Tap Done.



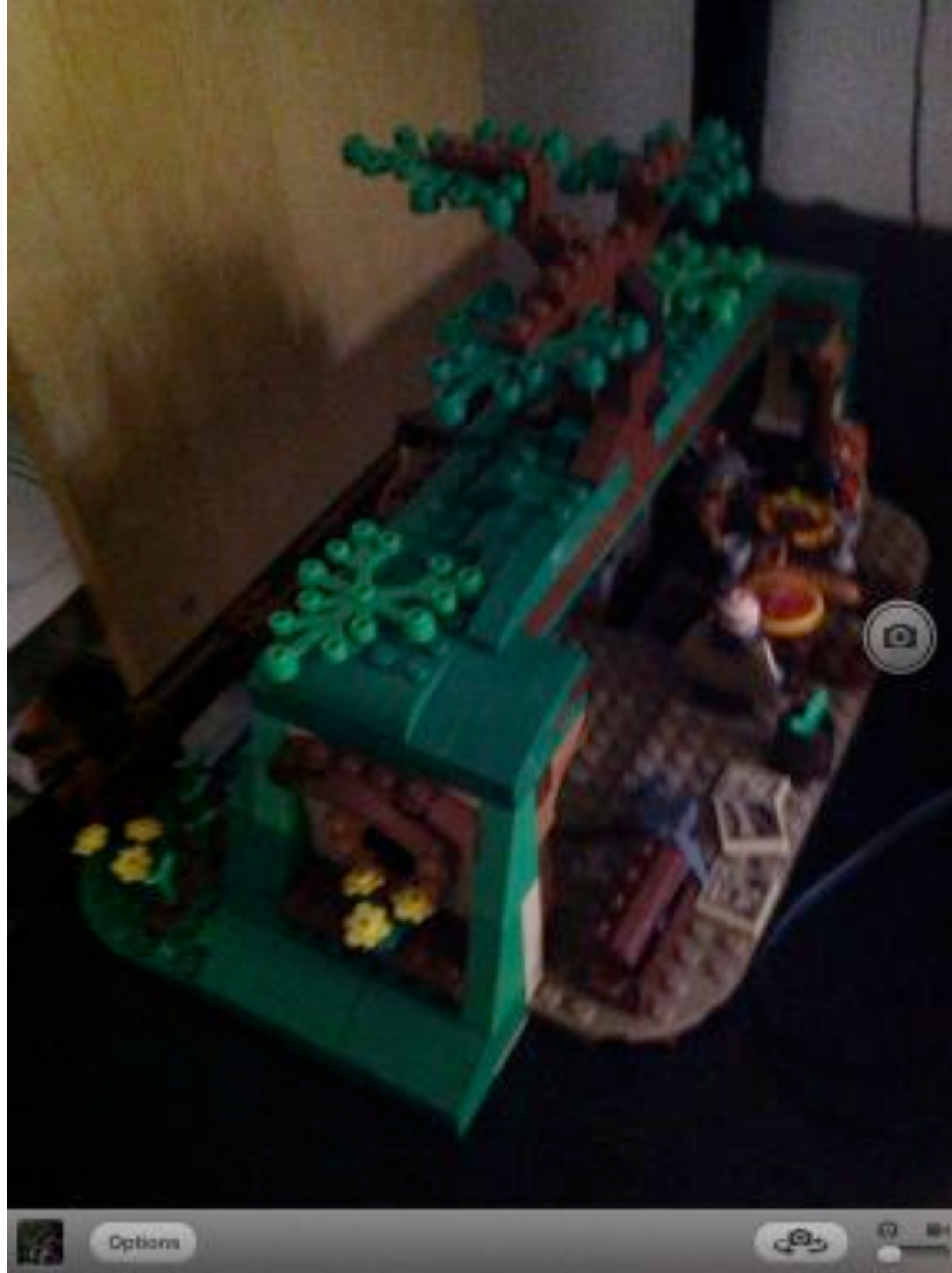
Tap the AppleID of the other user to initiate a video conference call.



Wait until the user picks up the call.



Tap End when you're done.



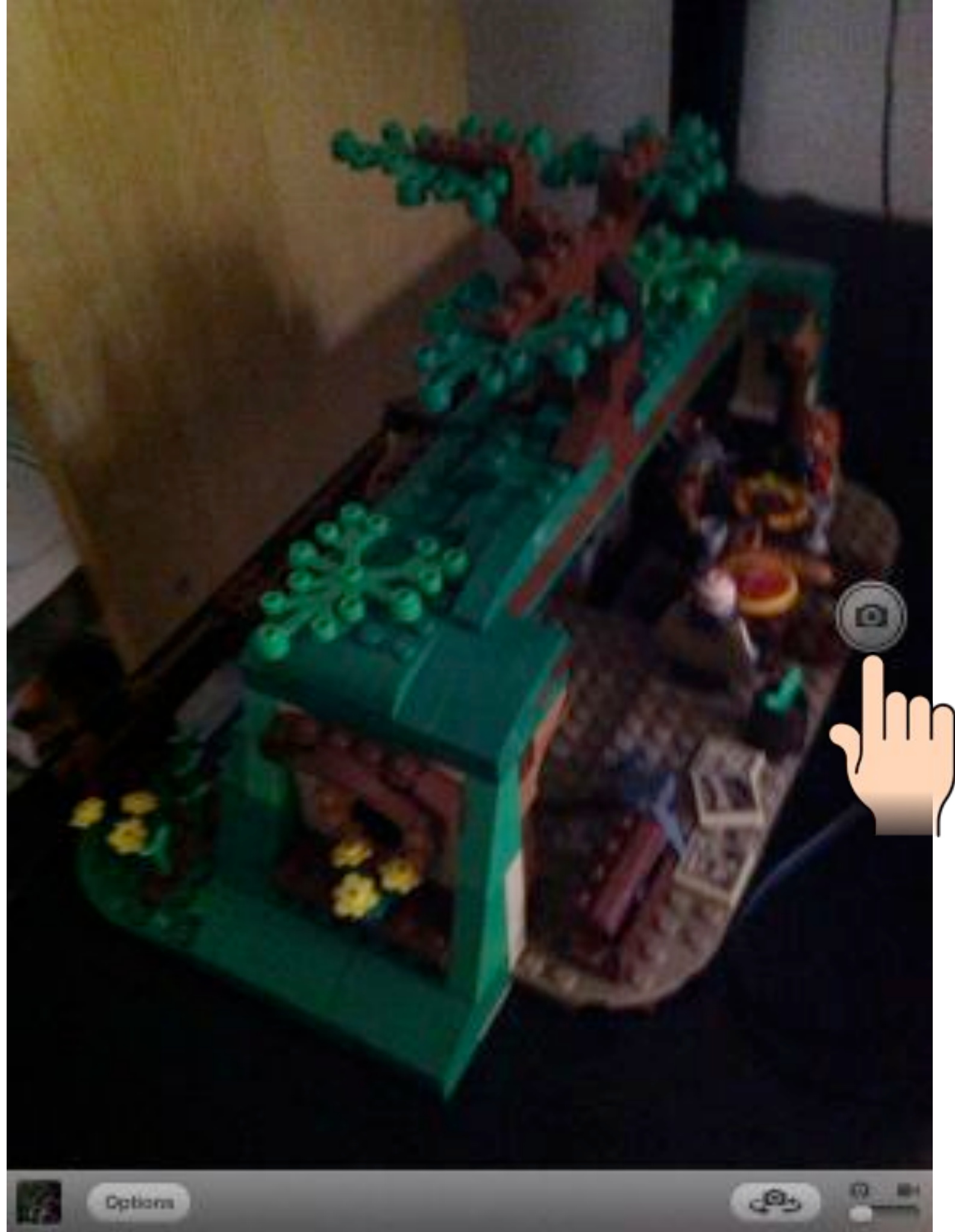


Press the Home button to return to the starting screen.

7.3 Camera



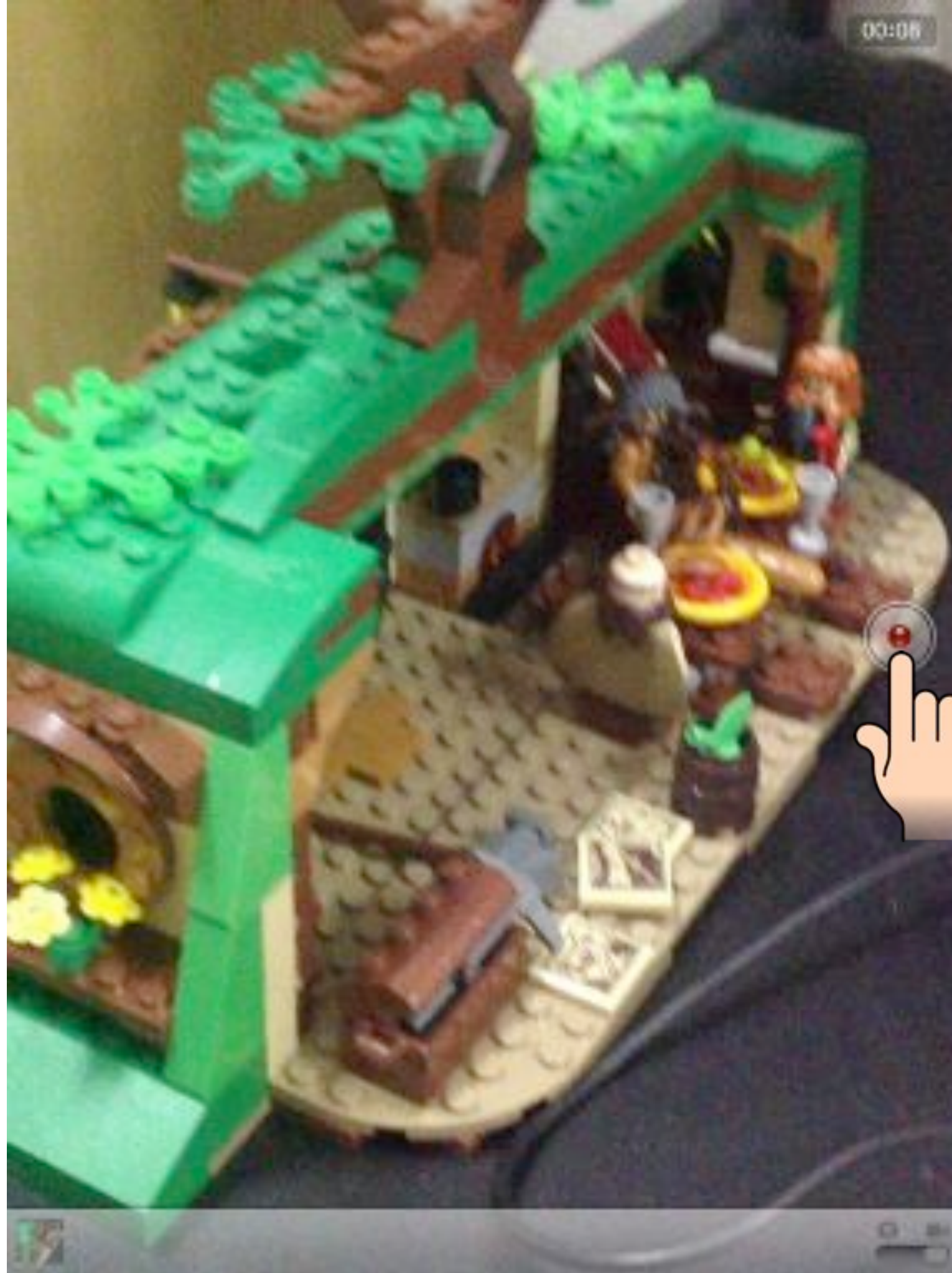
Tap Camera.

Tap here to record a video.



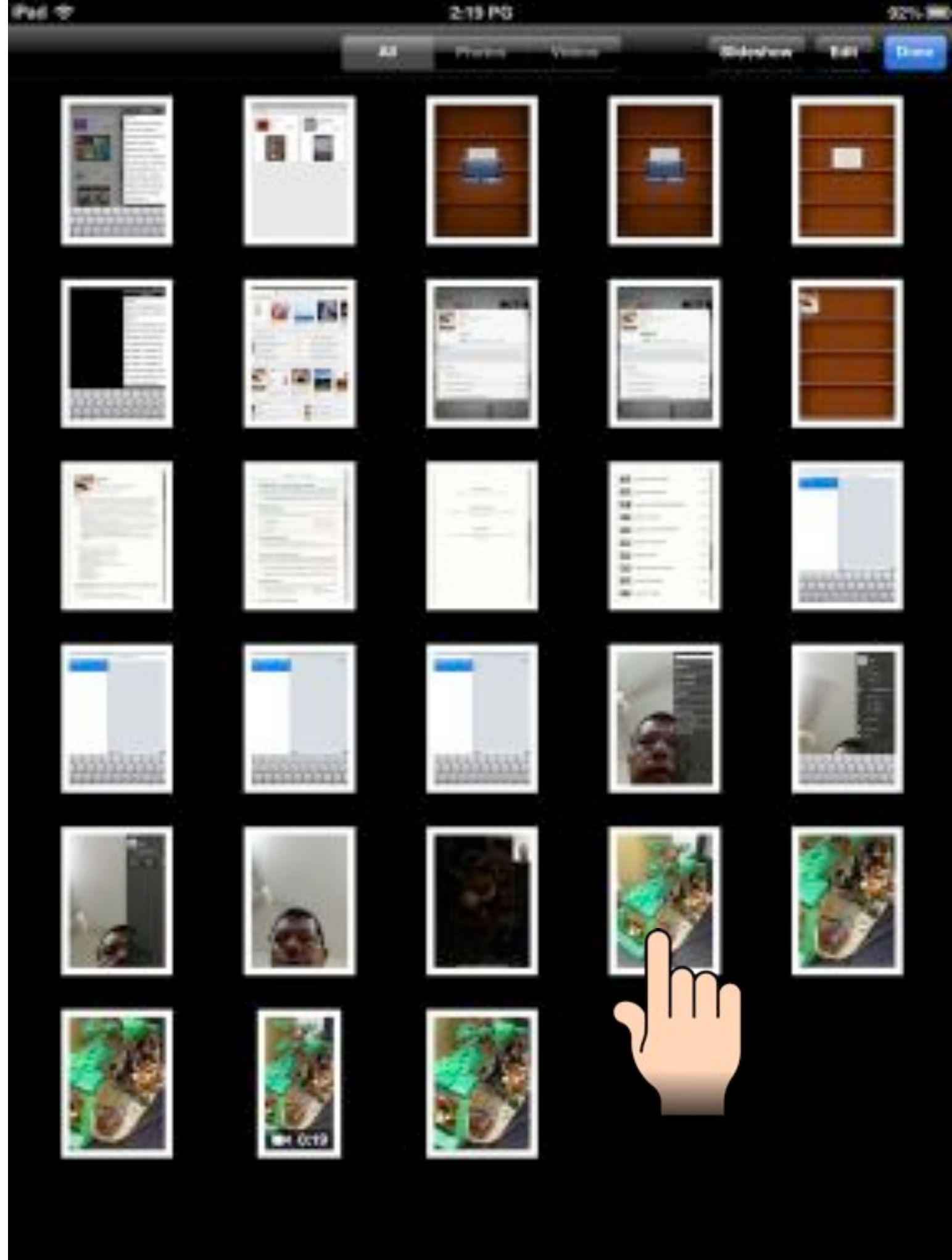
Note that a timer will appear to show the duration.

Tap here to see all the photos and videos that you have taken.



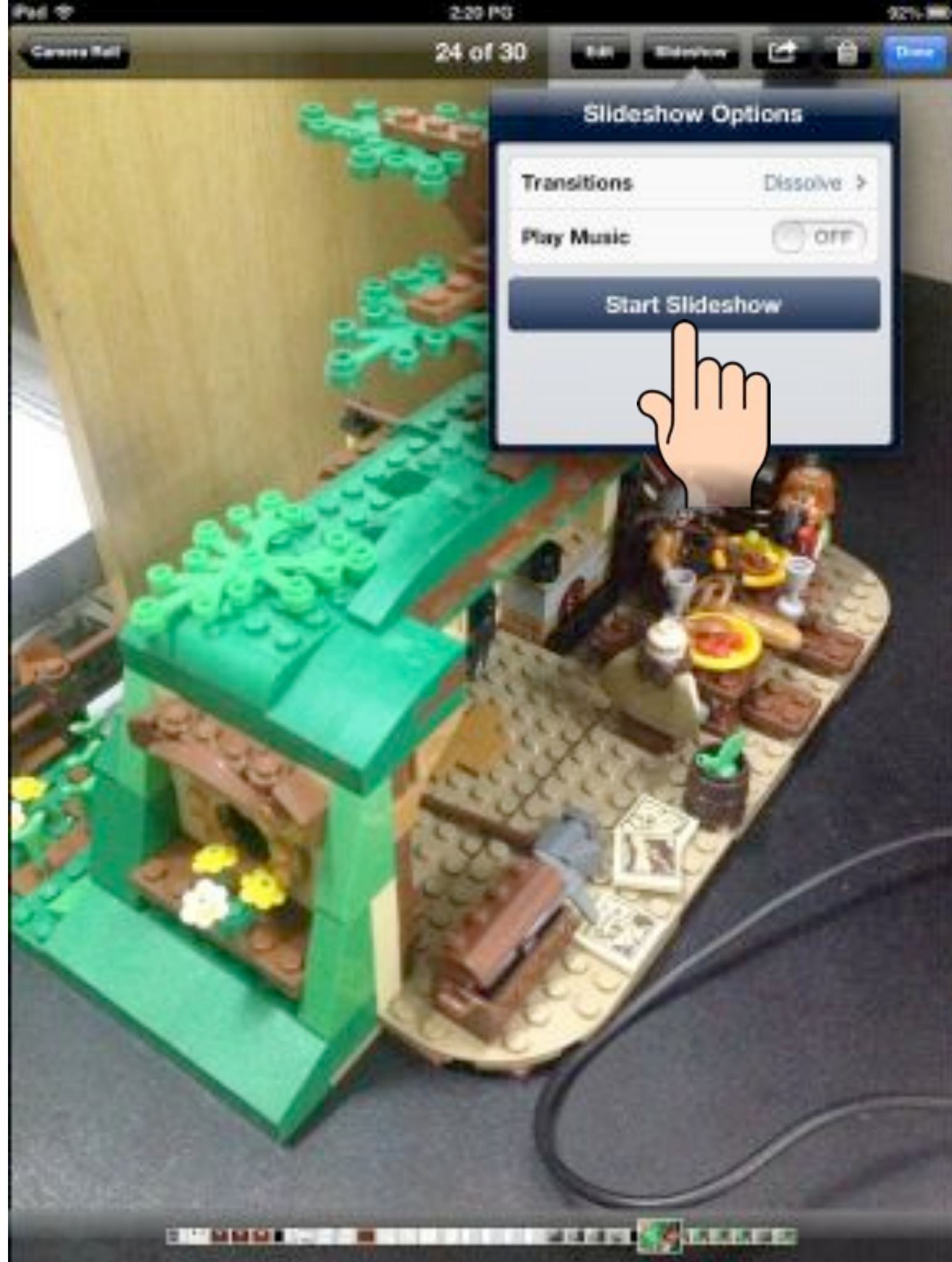
Tap any picture to see it.



Tap anywhere on the screen to show the menu.



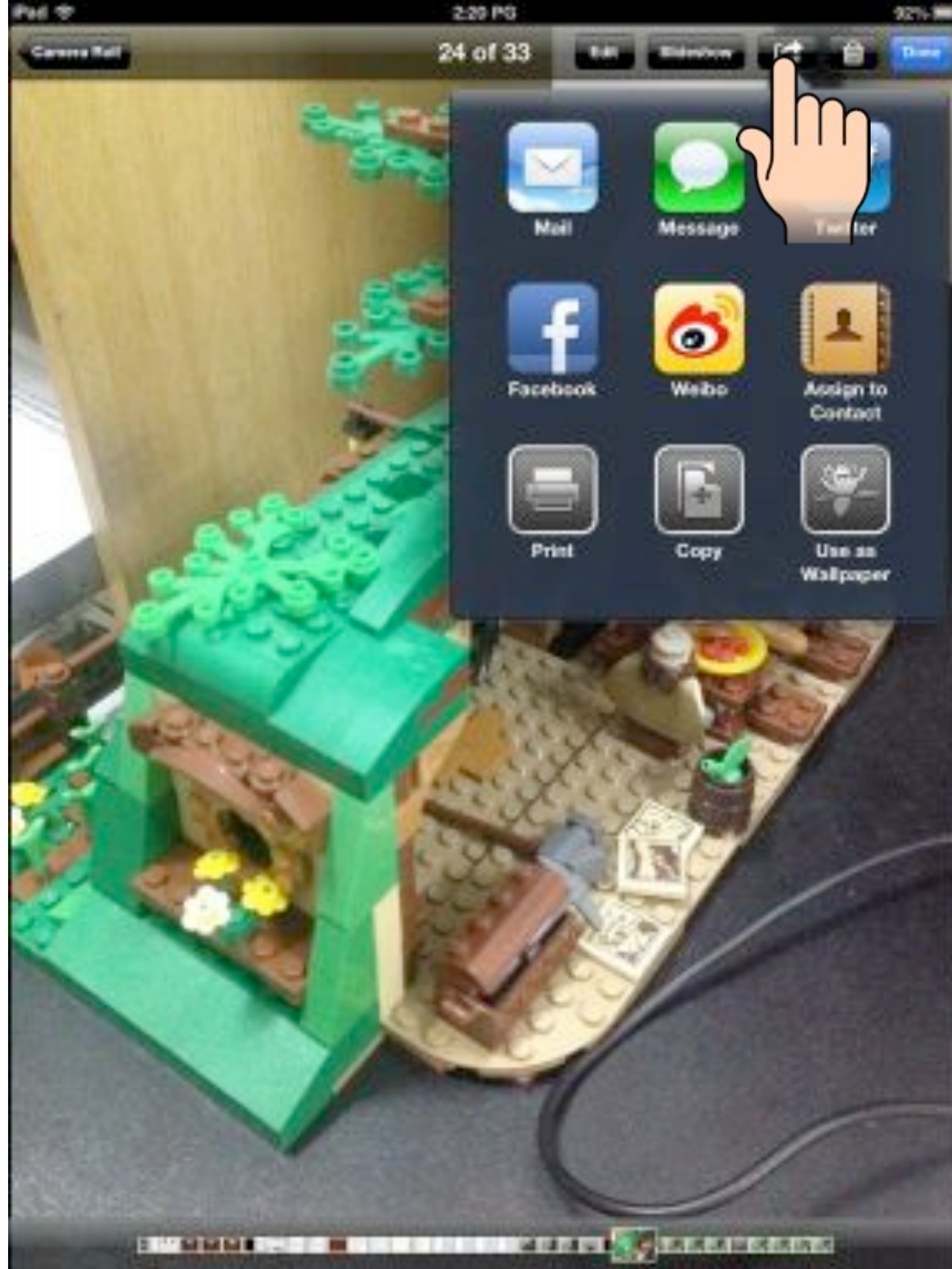
Tap Slideshow to display the slideshow settings.



Tap 'Start Slideshow' to begin.



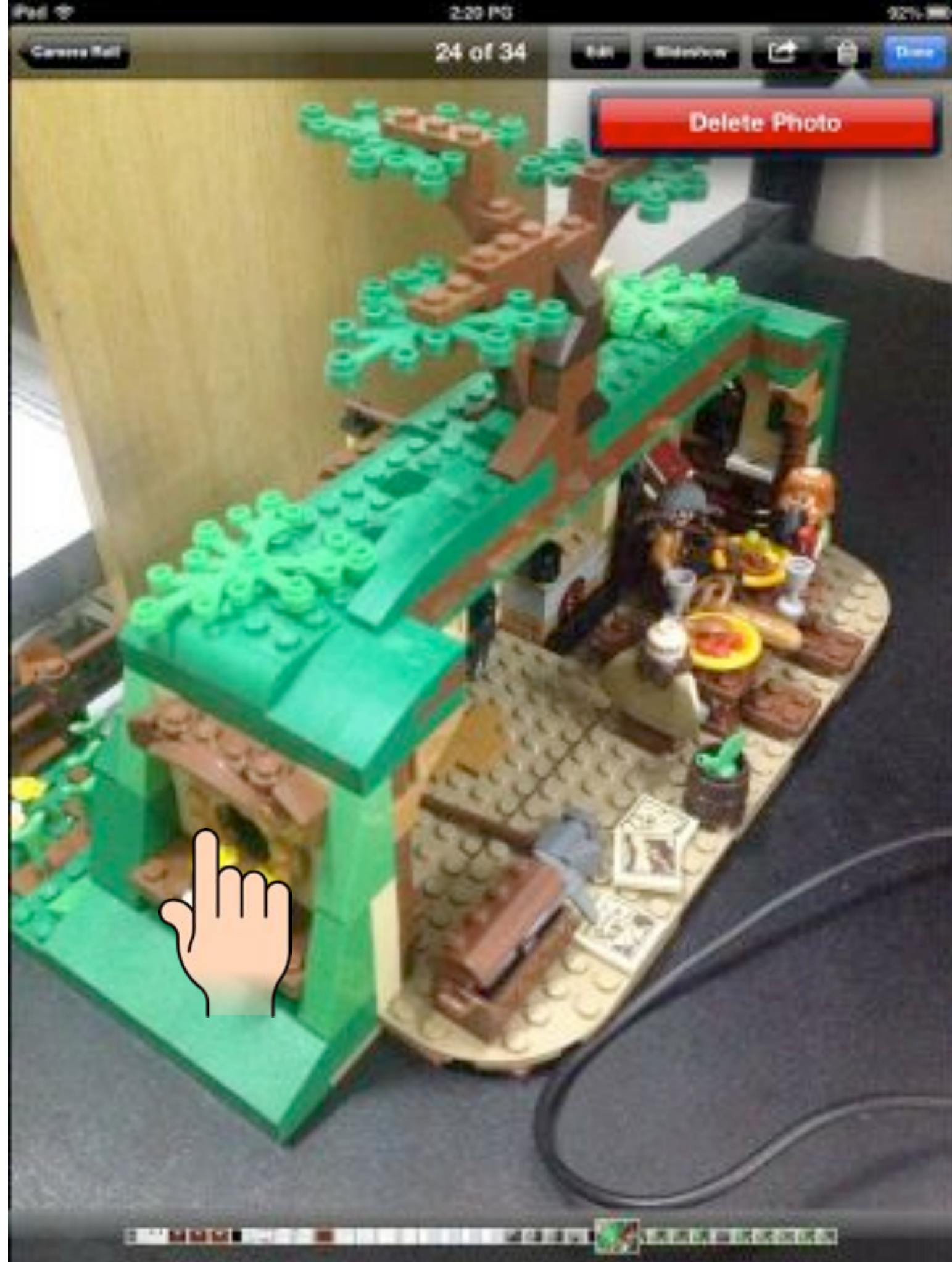
Tap the screen again to display the menu bar.



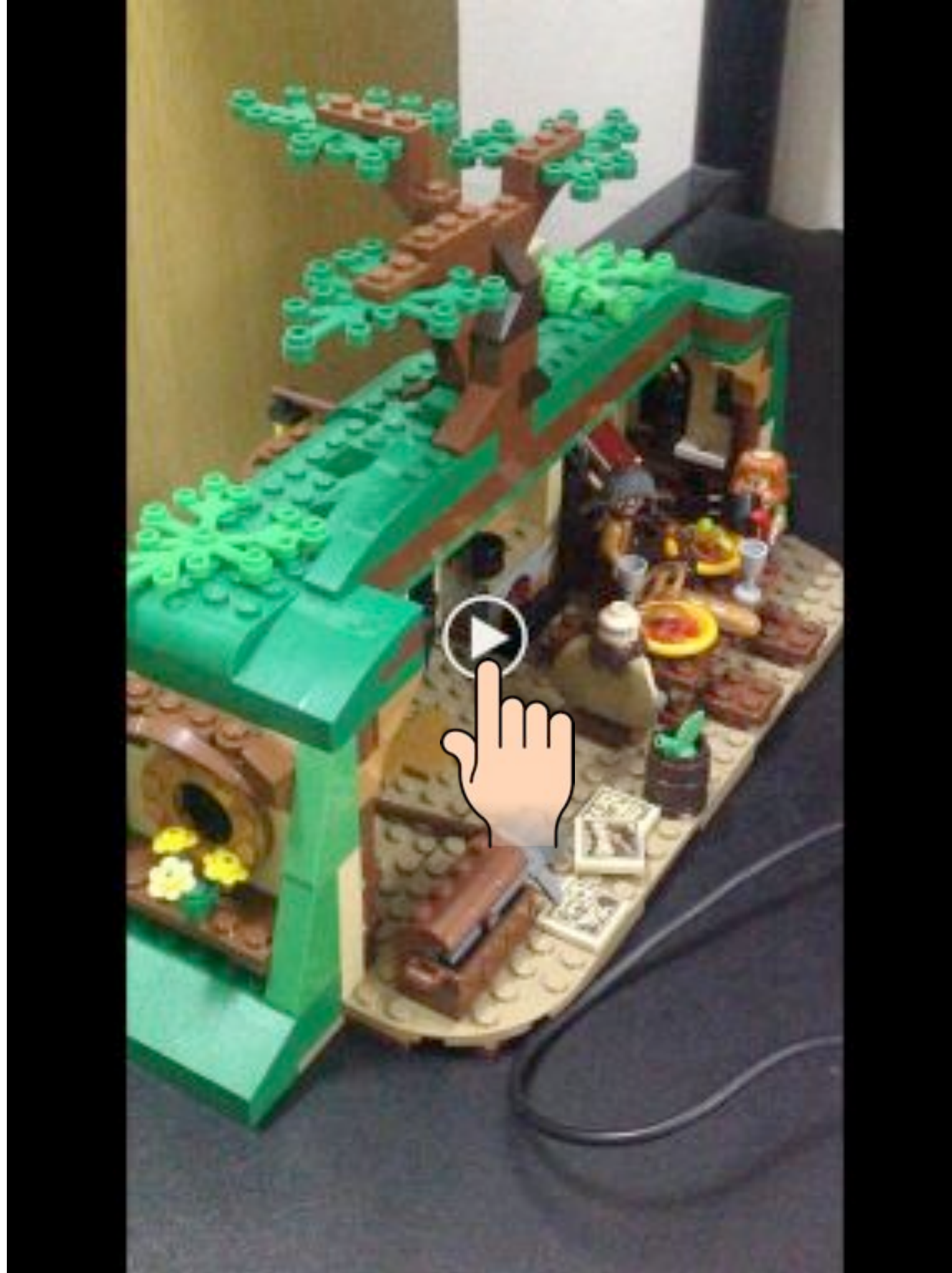
Tap this button to show the sharing options. You can share in many different ways.

The video plays.

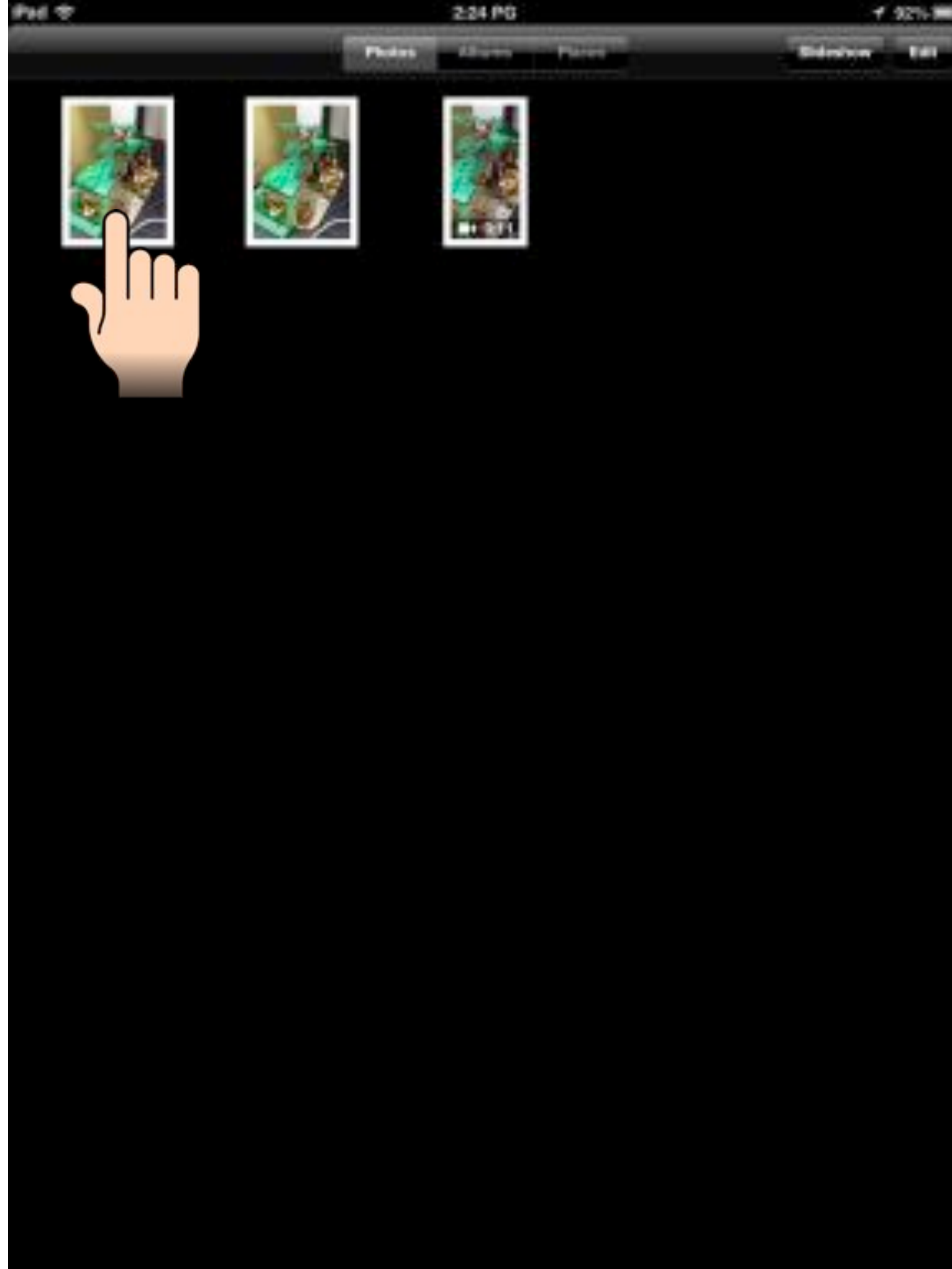


Press the Home button to return to the starting screen.

7.4 Photos



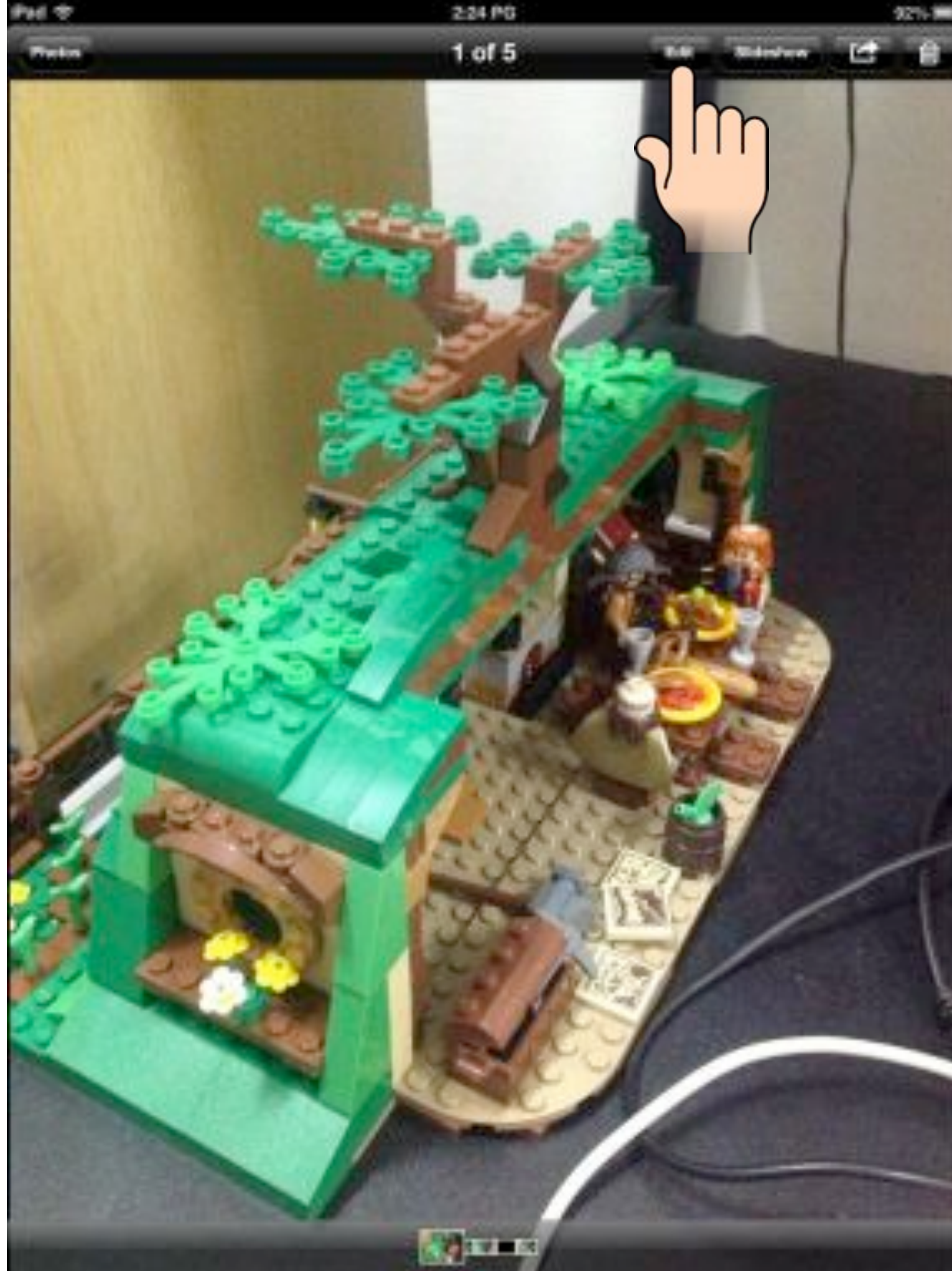
Tap Photos.



Photos has all the pics that were taken by Camera. Tap any picture.



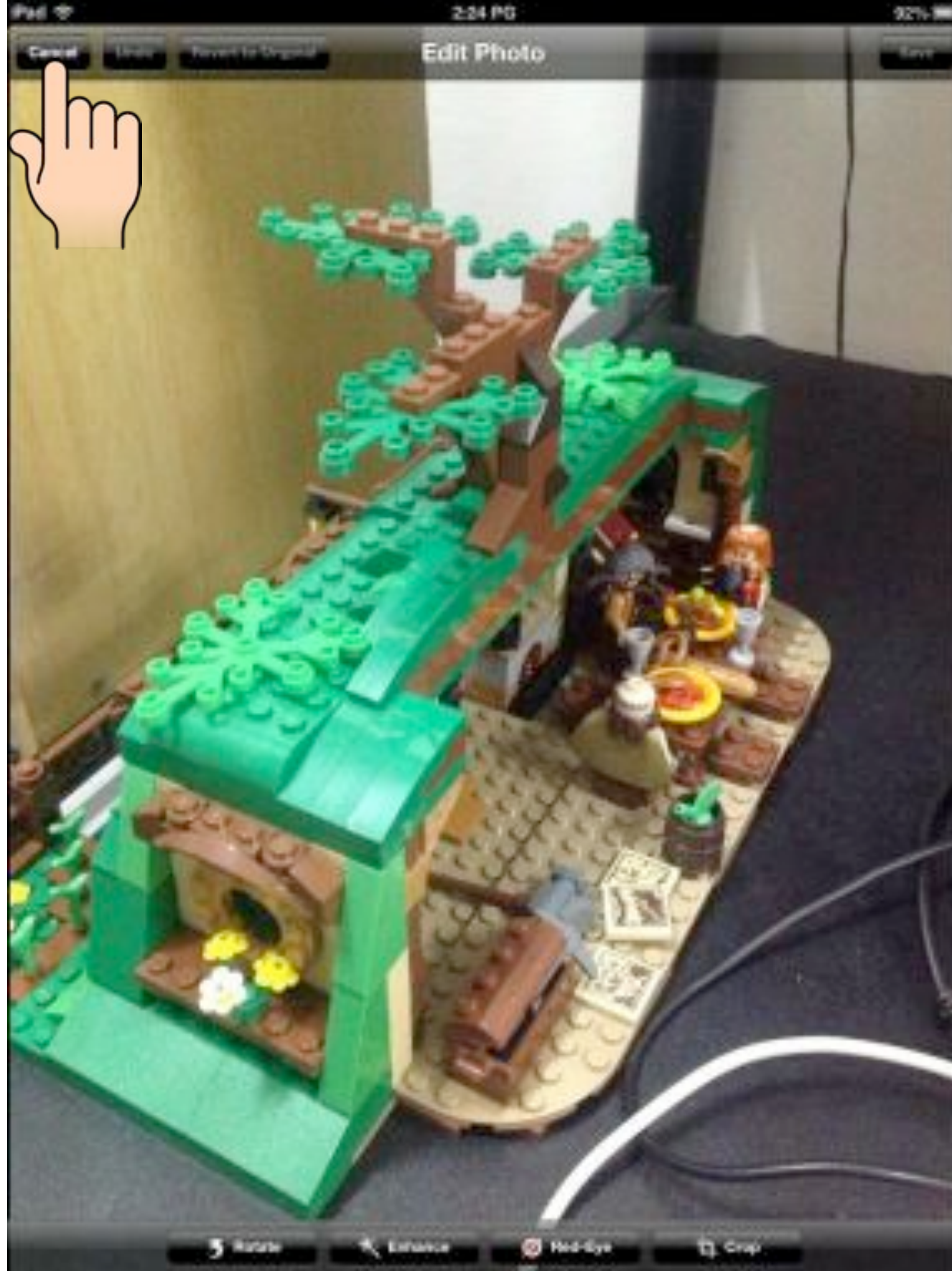
Tap a picture to display the menu.



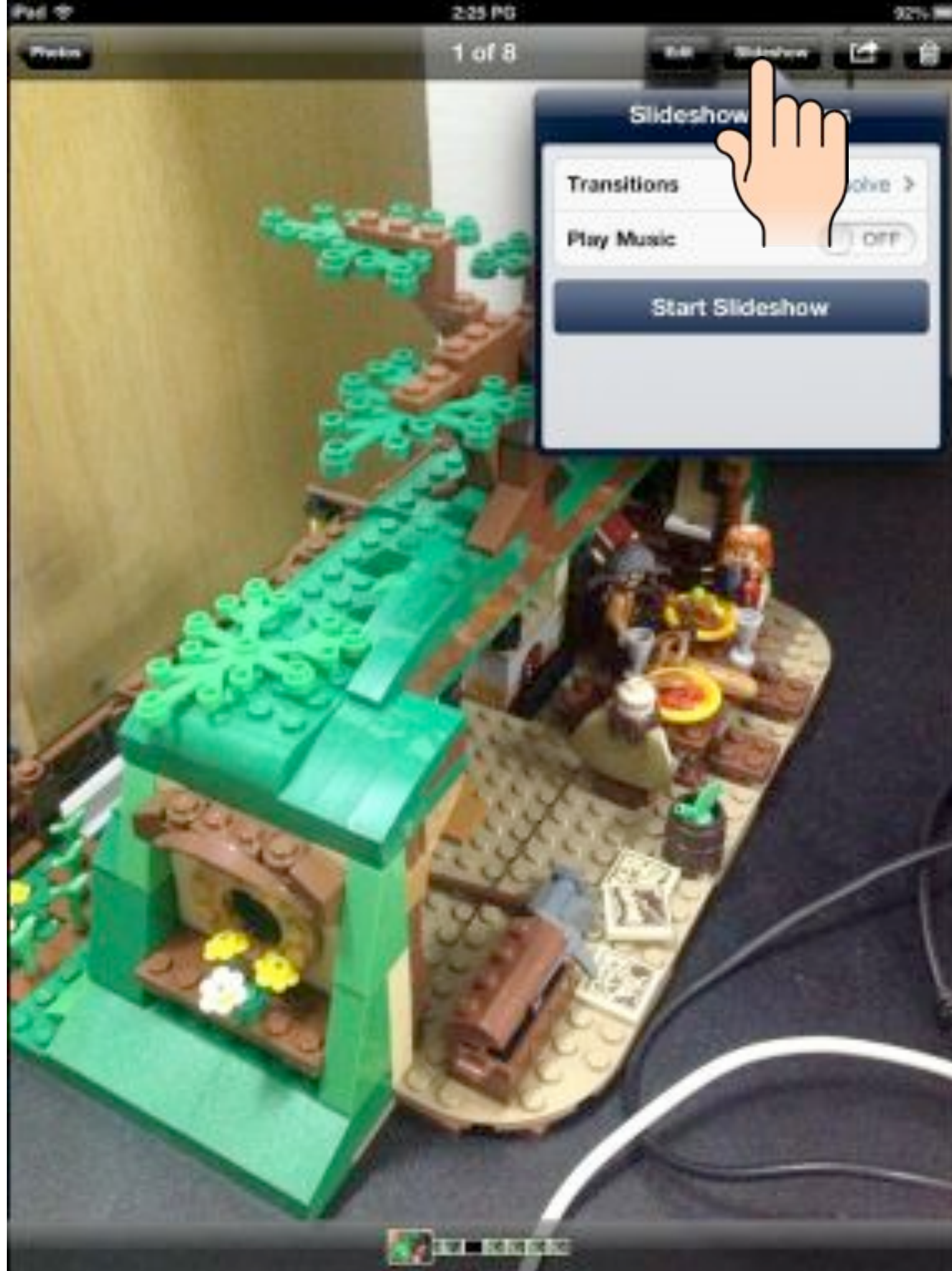
Tap Edit.



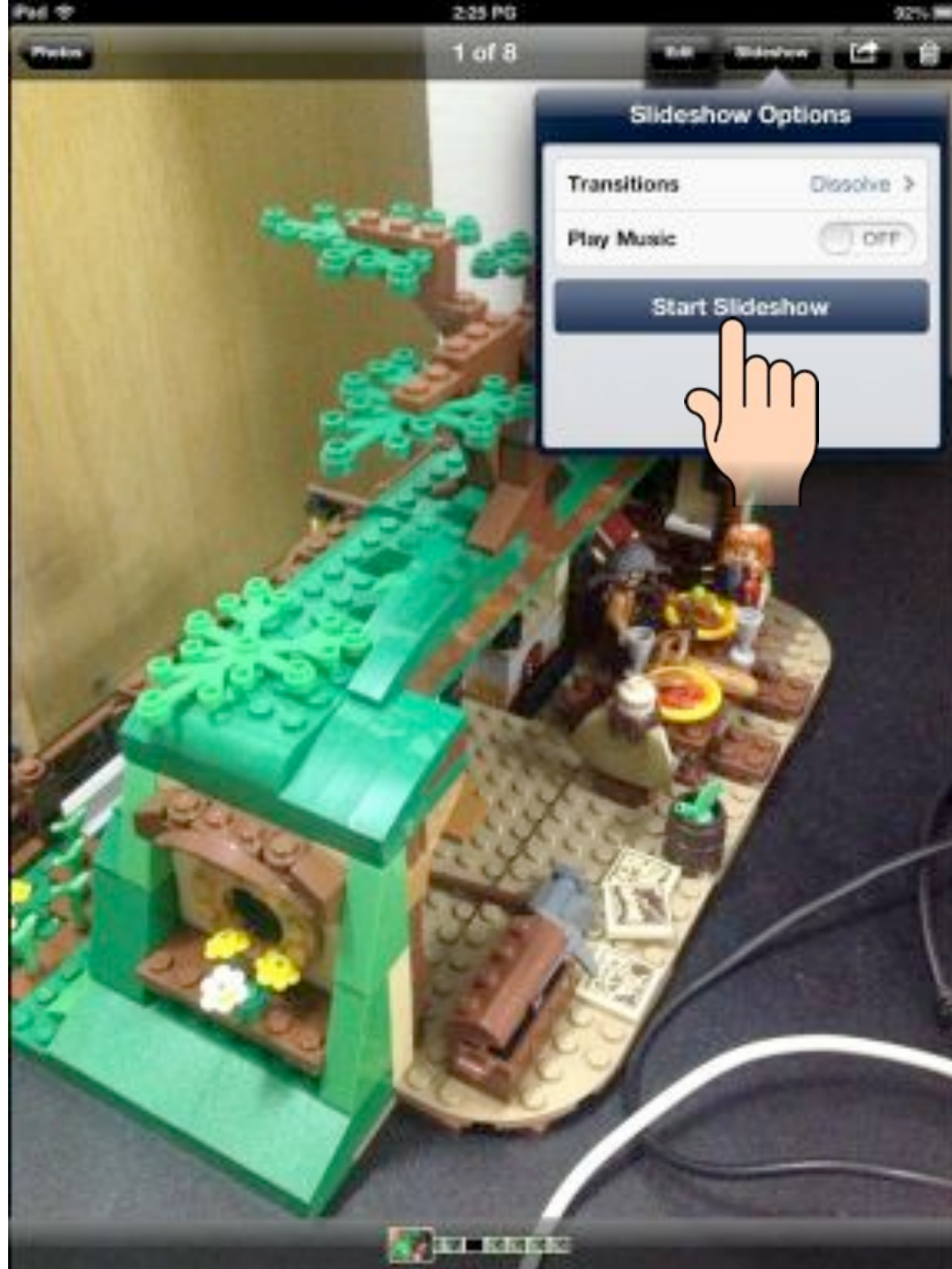
You can rotate, enhance, remove red-eye and crop the picture.



Tap Cancel.



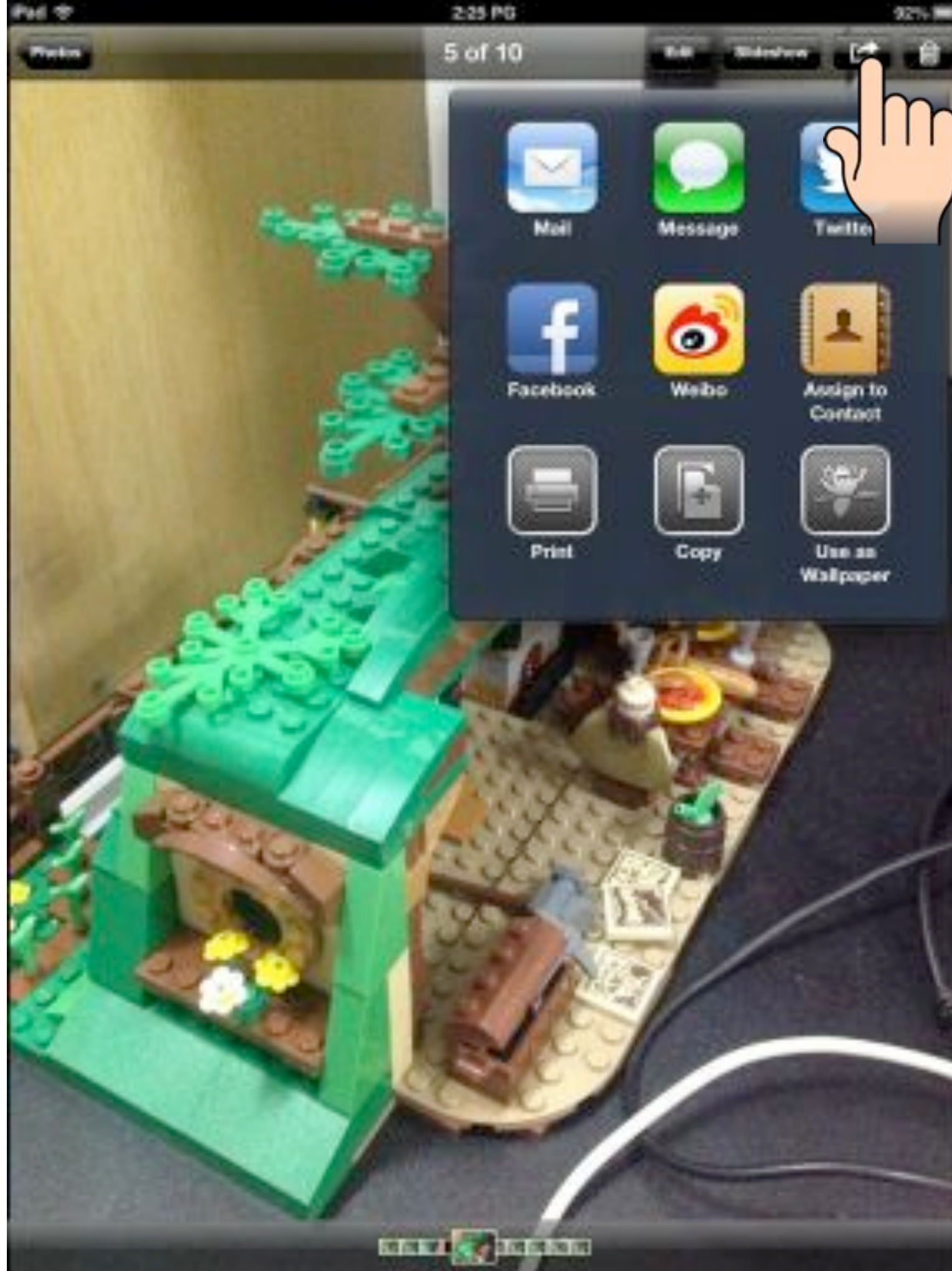
Tap Slideshow to change slideshow settings.



Tap Start Slideshow to begin.



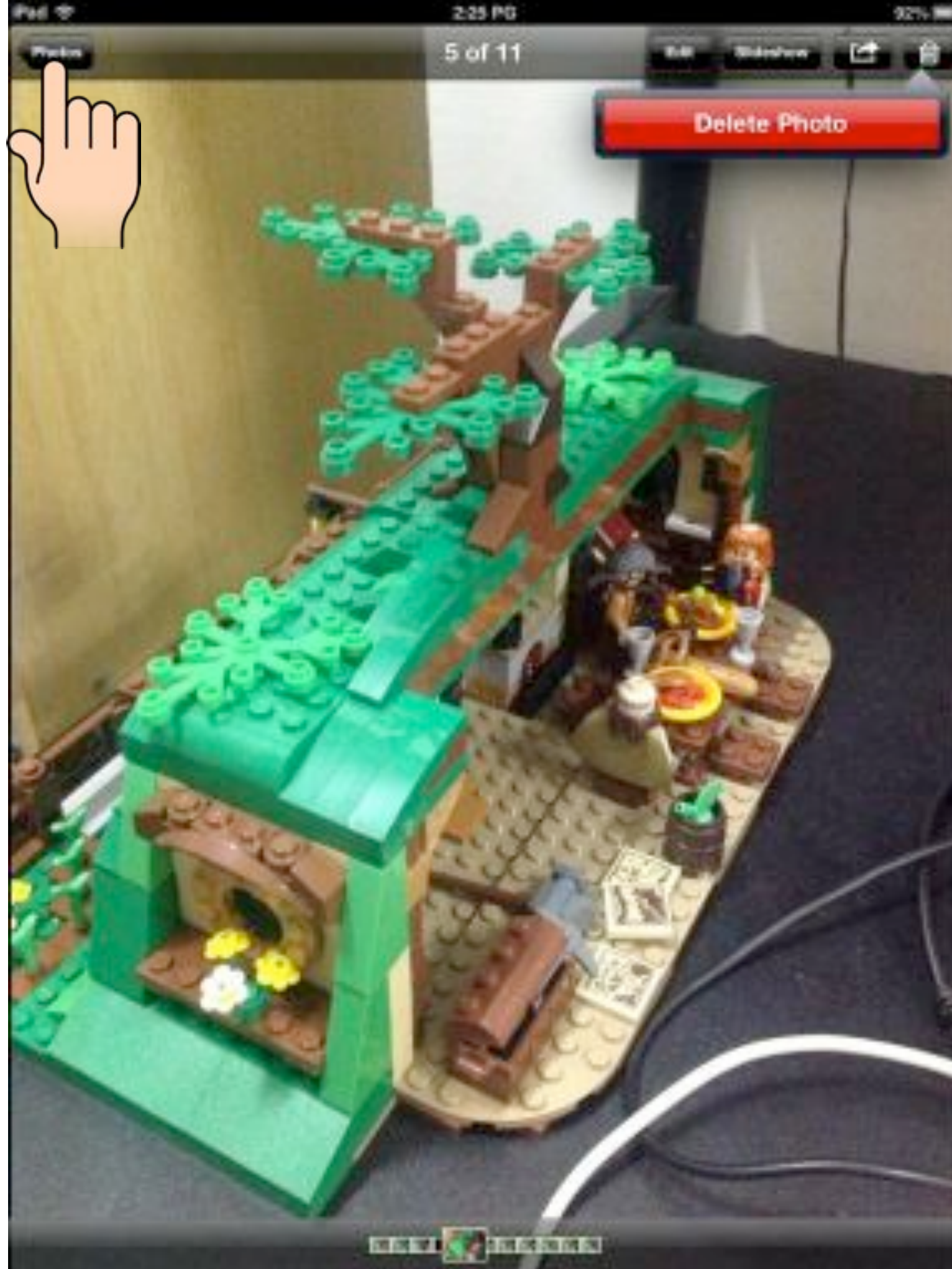
Tap anywhere on the screen to display the 'menu bar'.



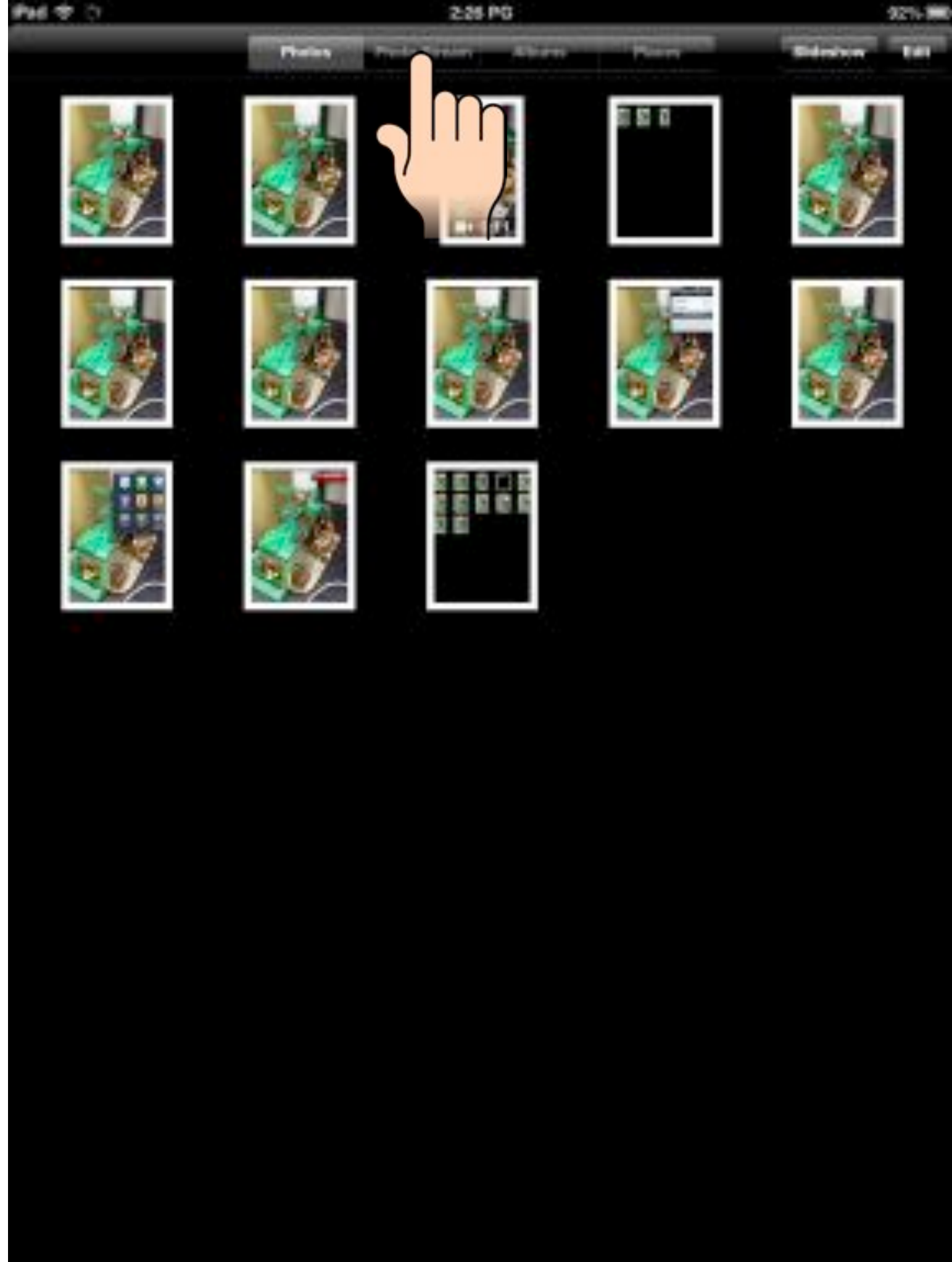
Tap the share button to share your pictures. There are many ways to share.

Tap Photo Stream.

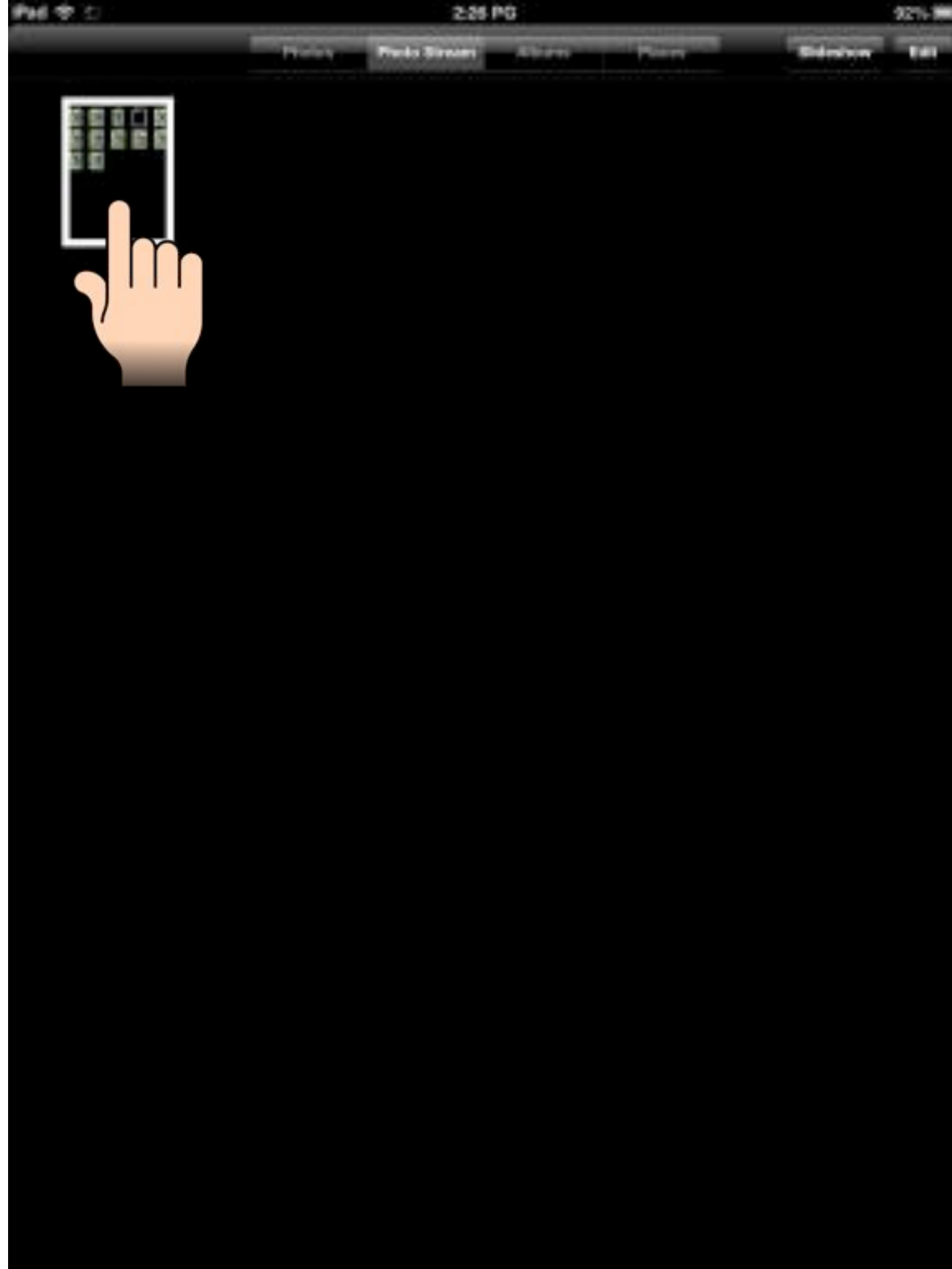
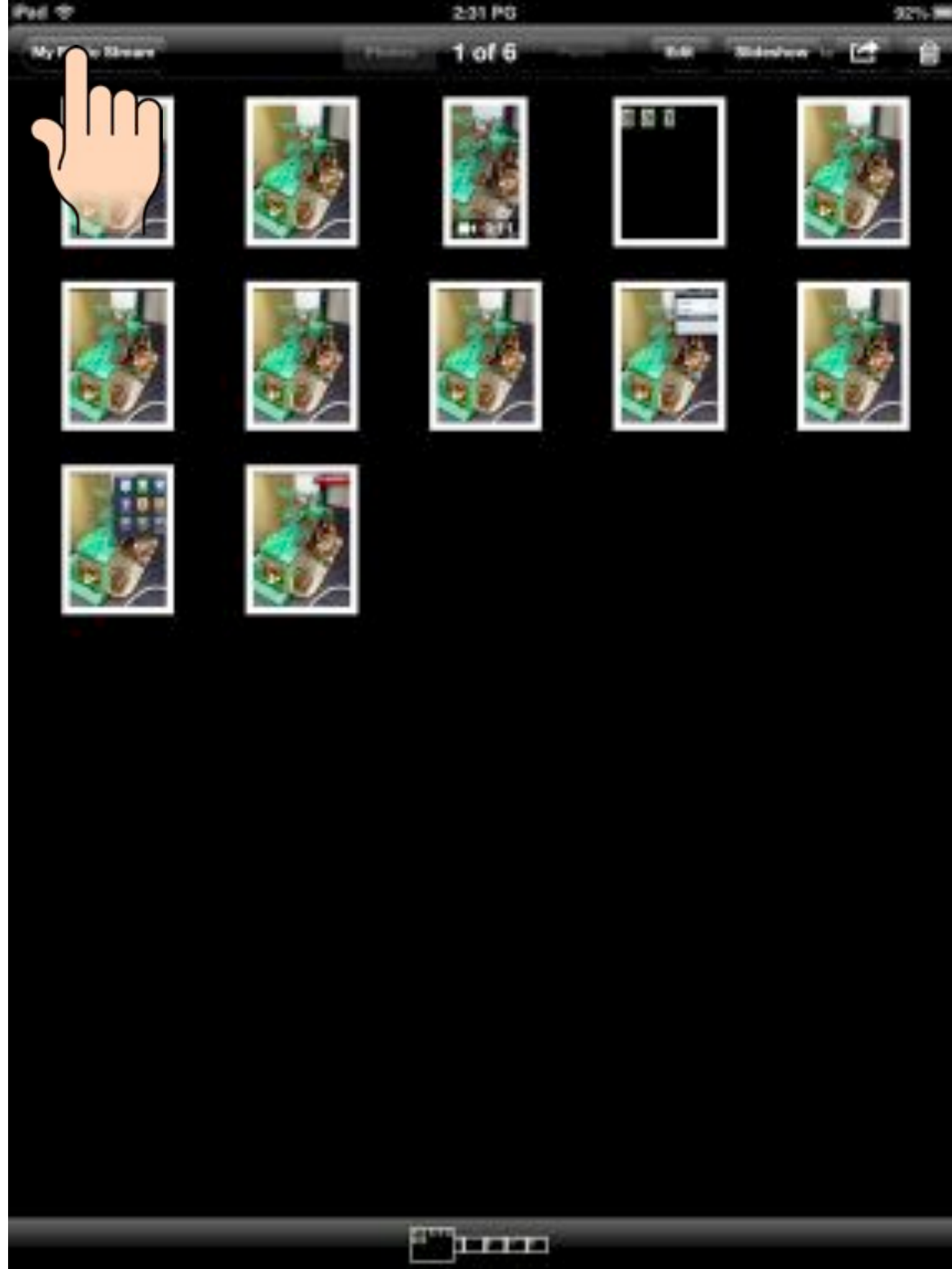
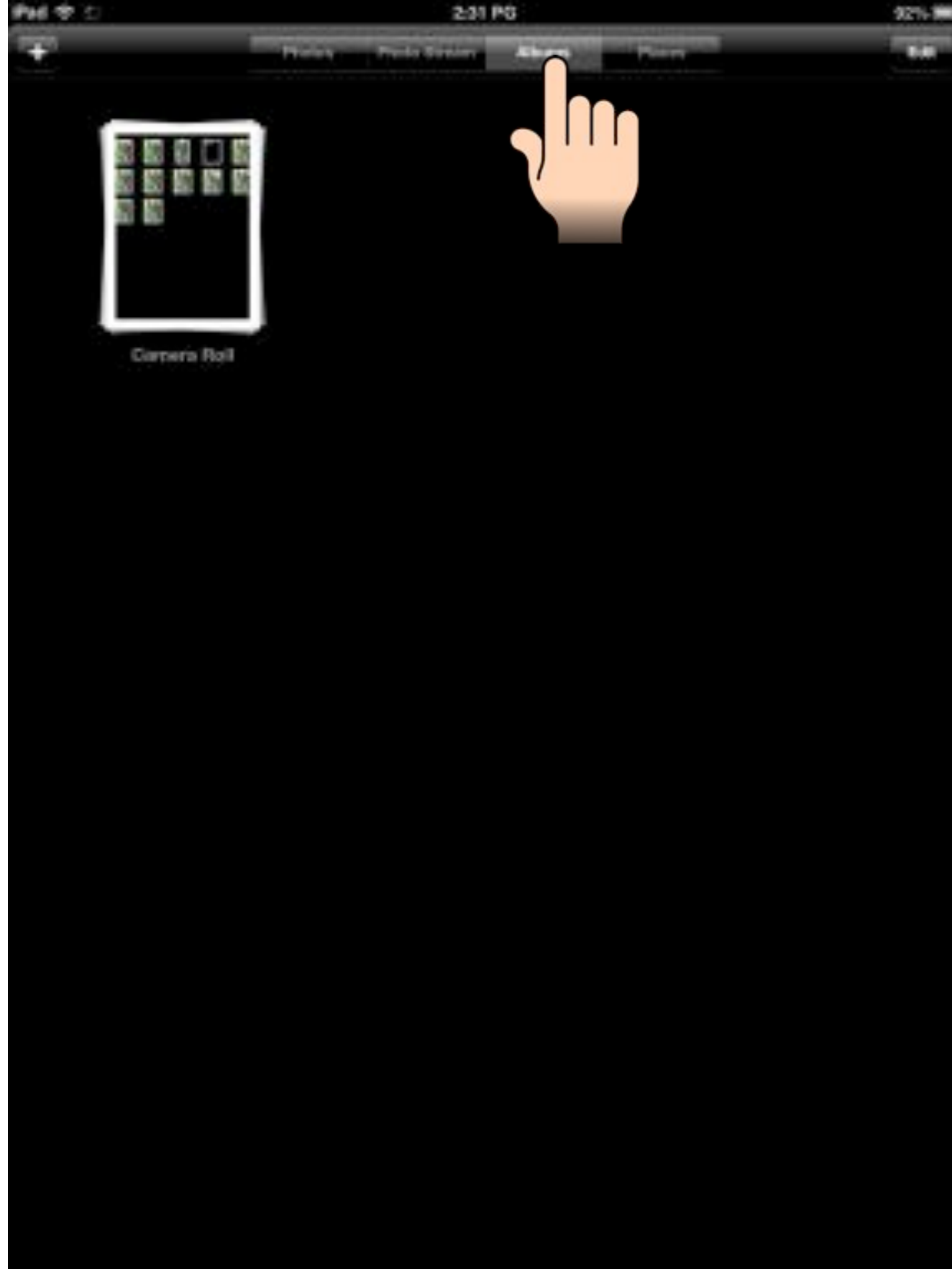


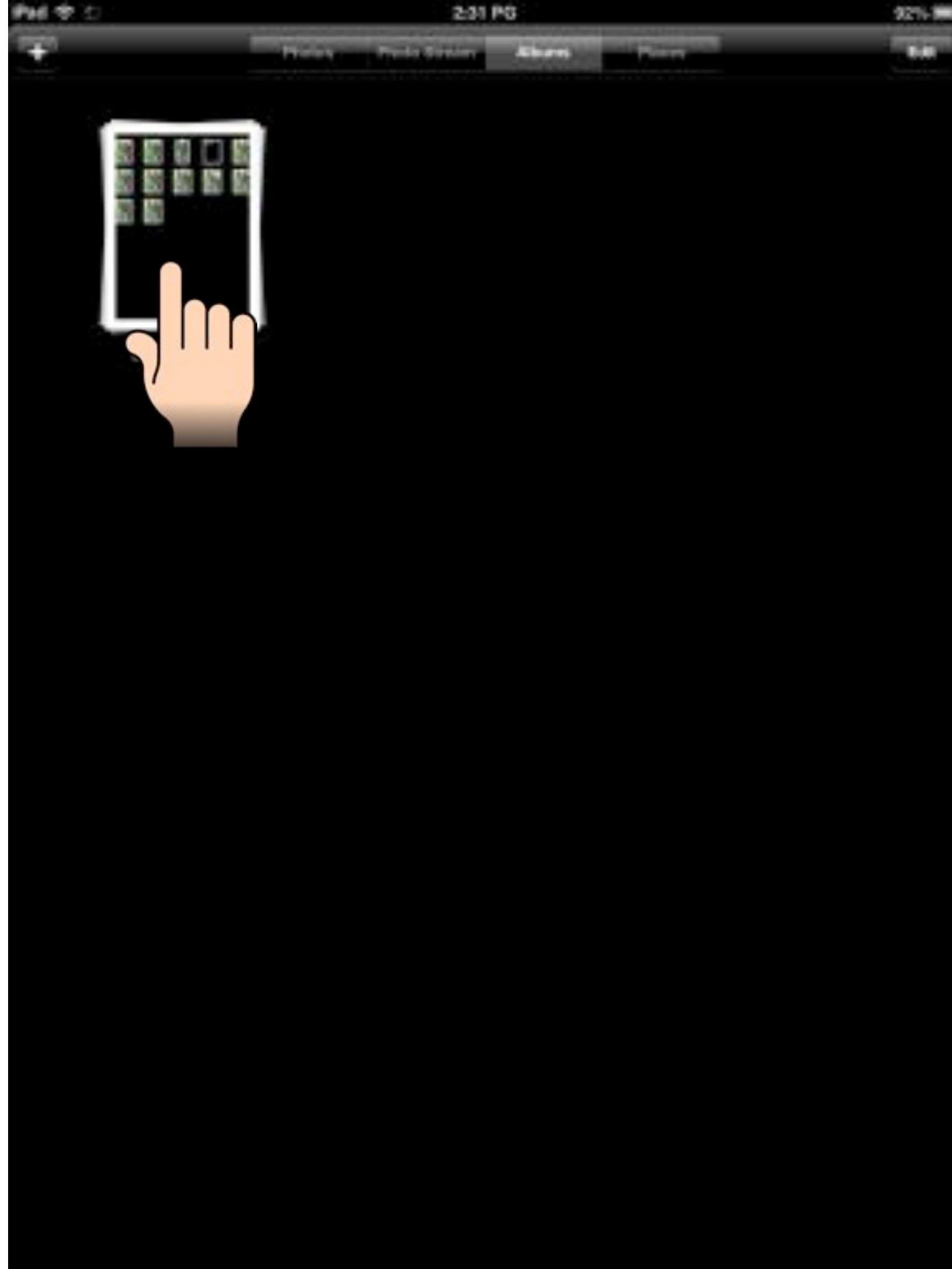
Photo Stream shows all the photos that have been uploaded to your iCloud account. Touch the picture collection.



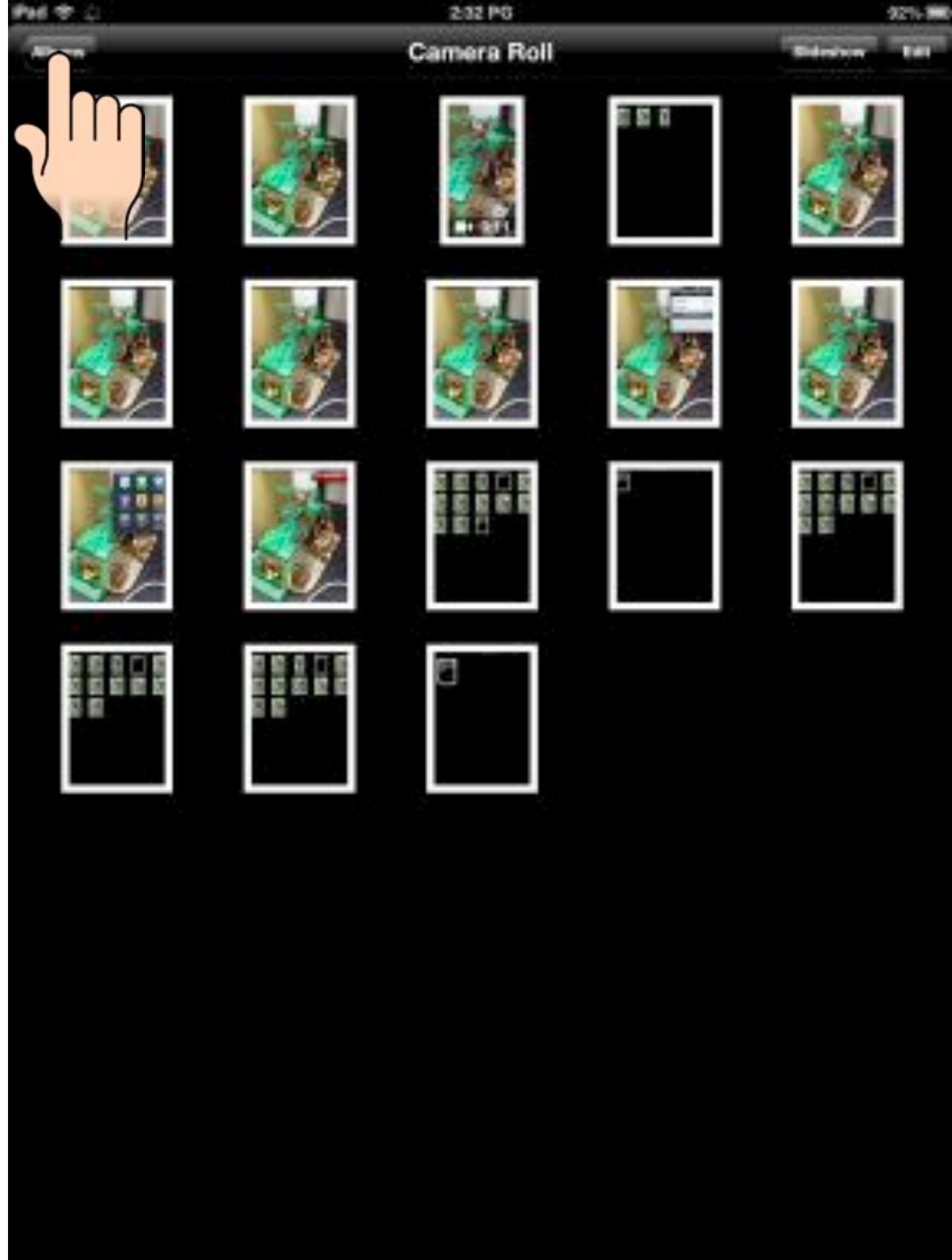
All the pictures in your Photo Stream are displayed. Tap Photo Stream.

Tap Places. A map will show you the location where your pictures were taken.

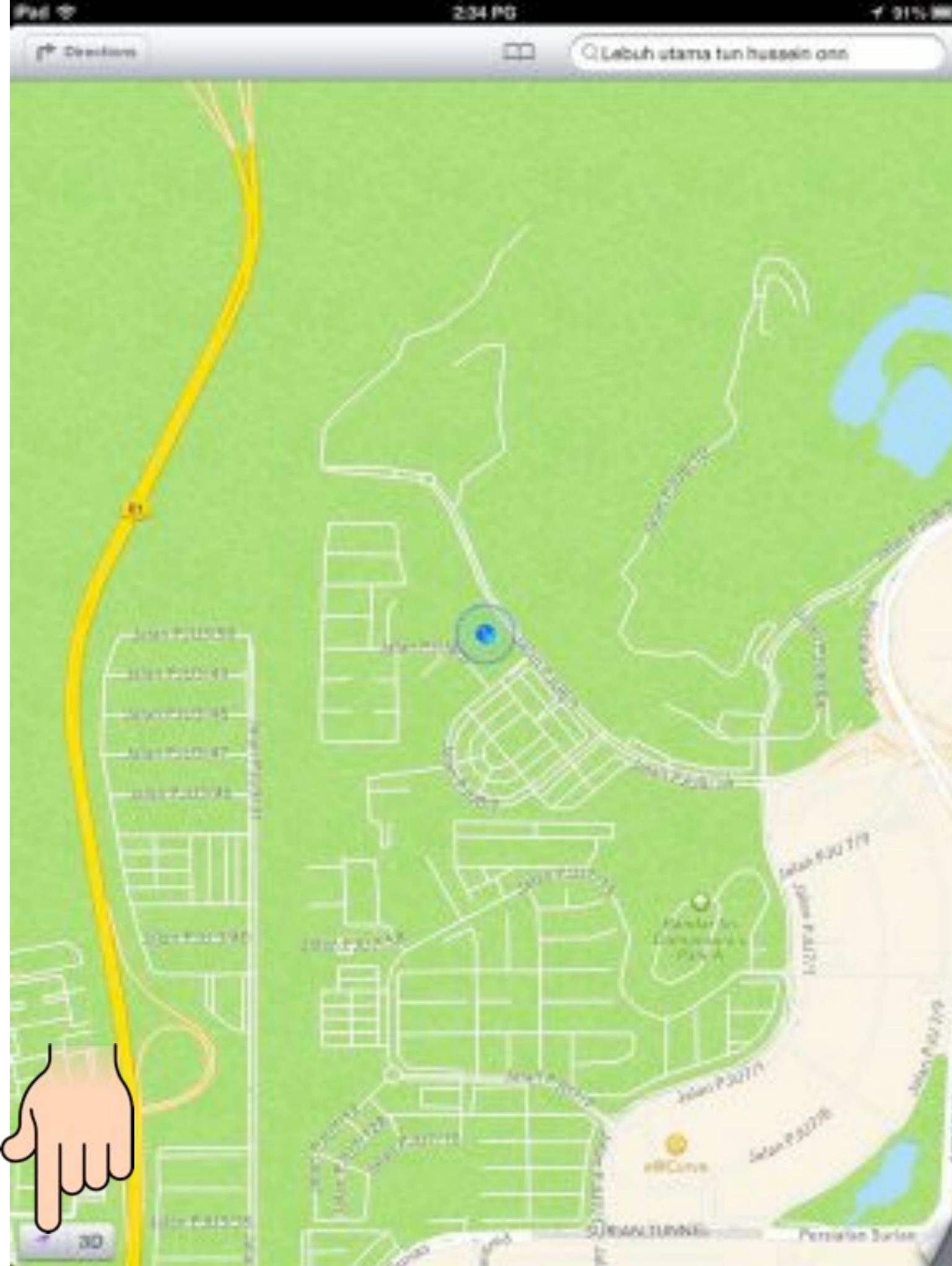


Press the Home button to return to the starting screen.

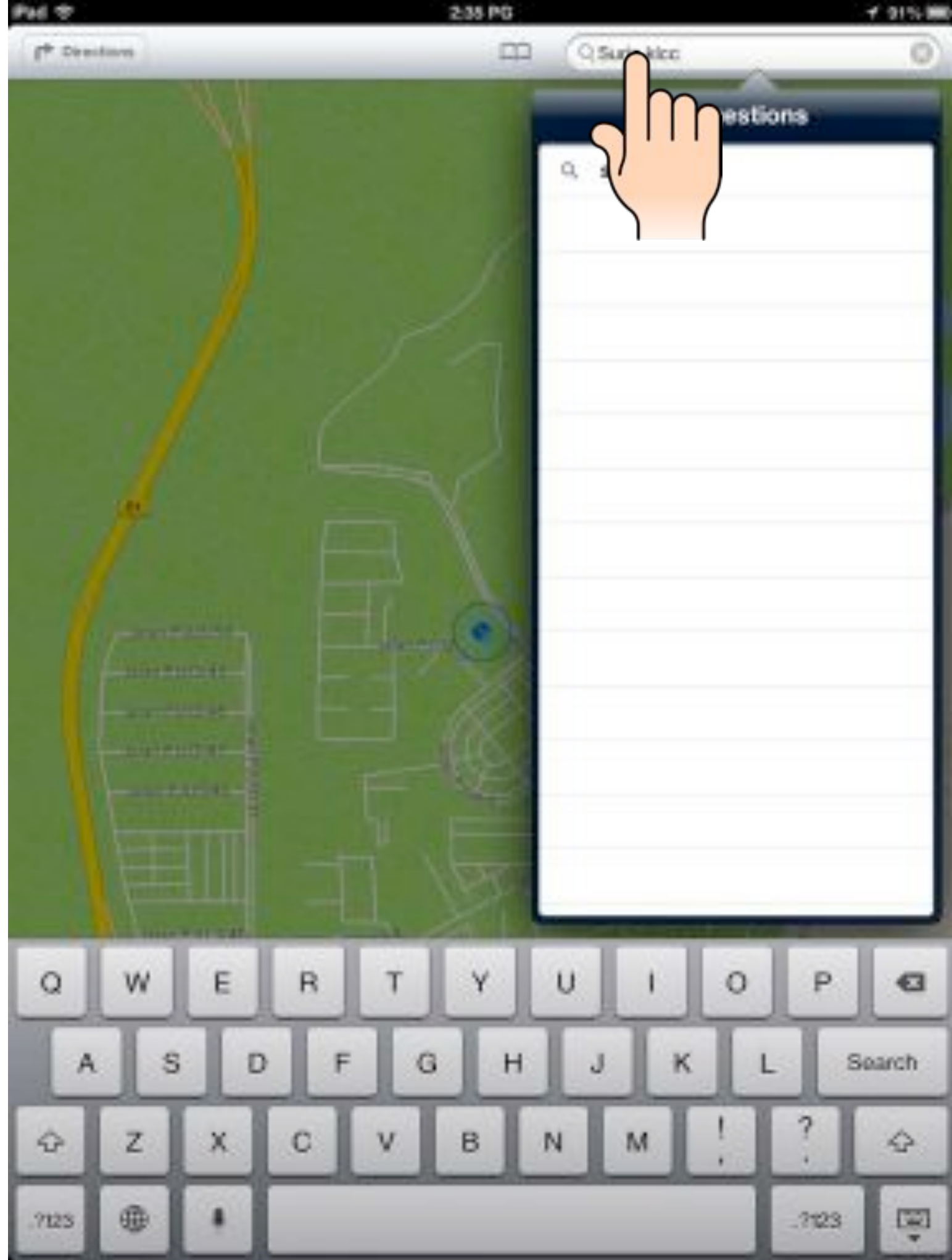
7.5 Maps



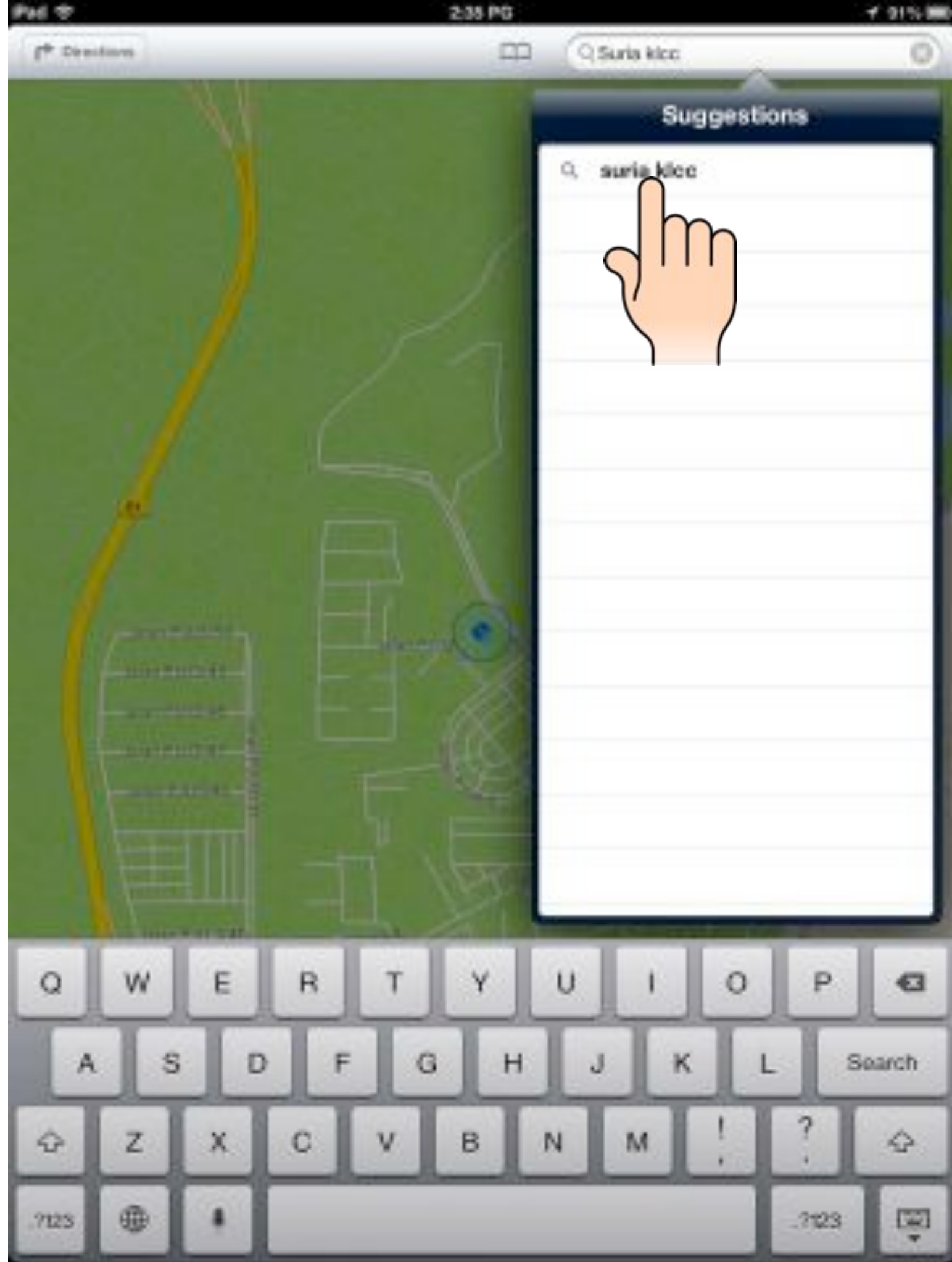
Tap Maps.



Tap here to determine your location.



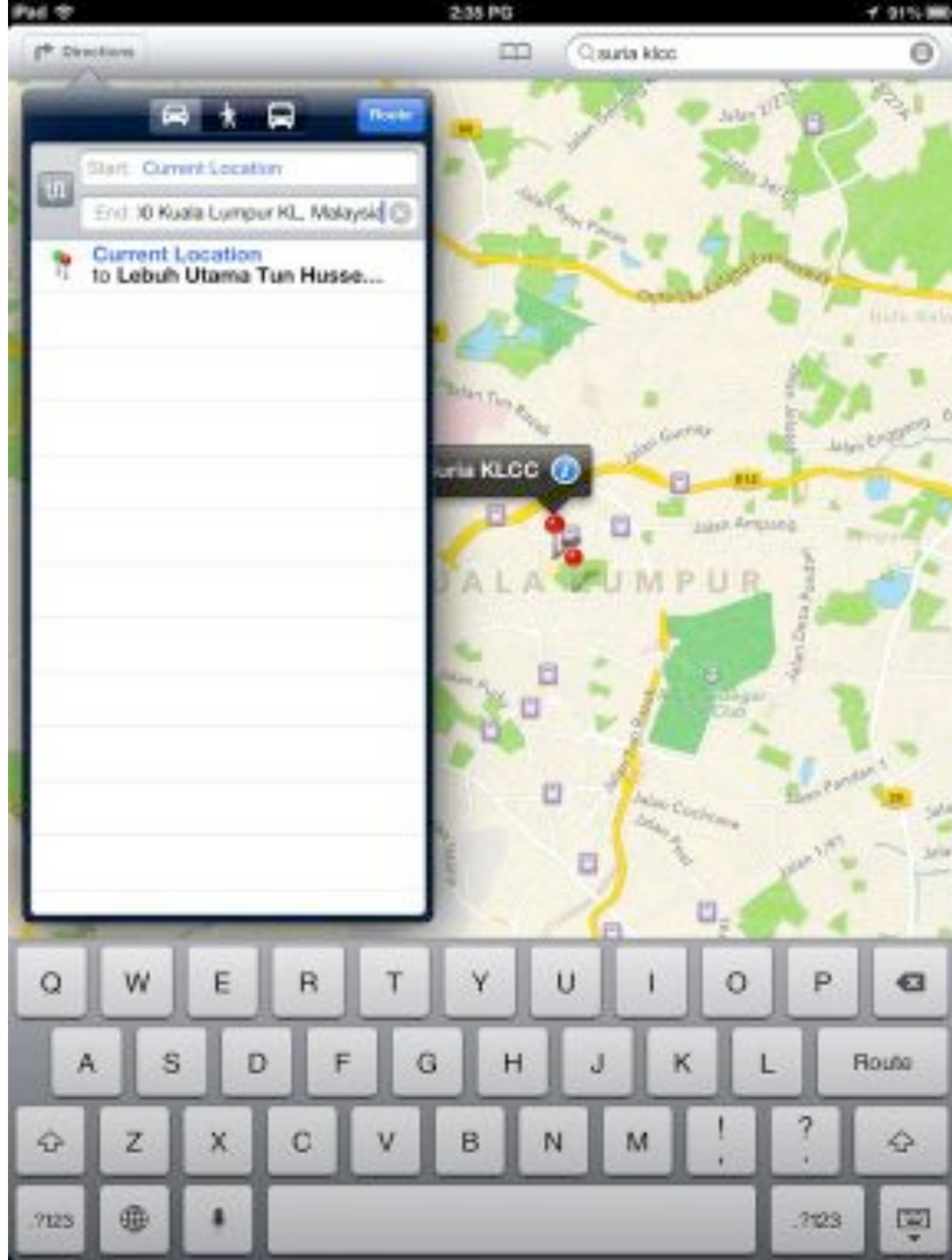
Tap here to search for a location. For example, type 'suria klcc'.



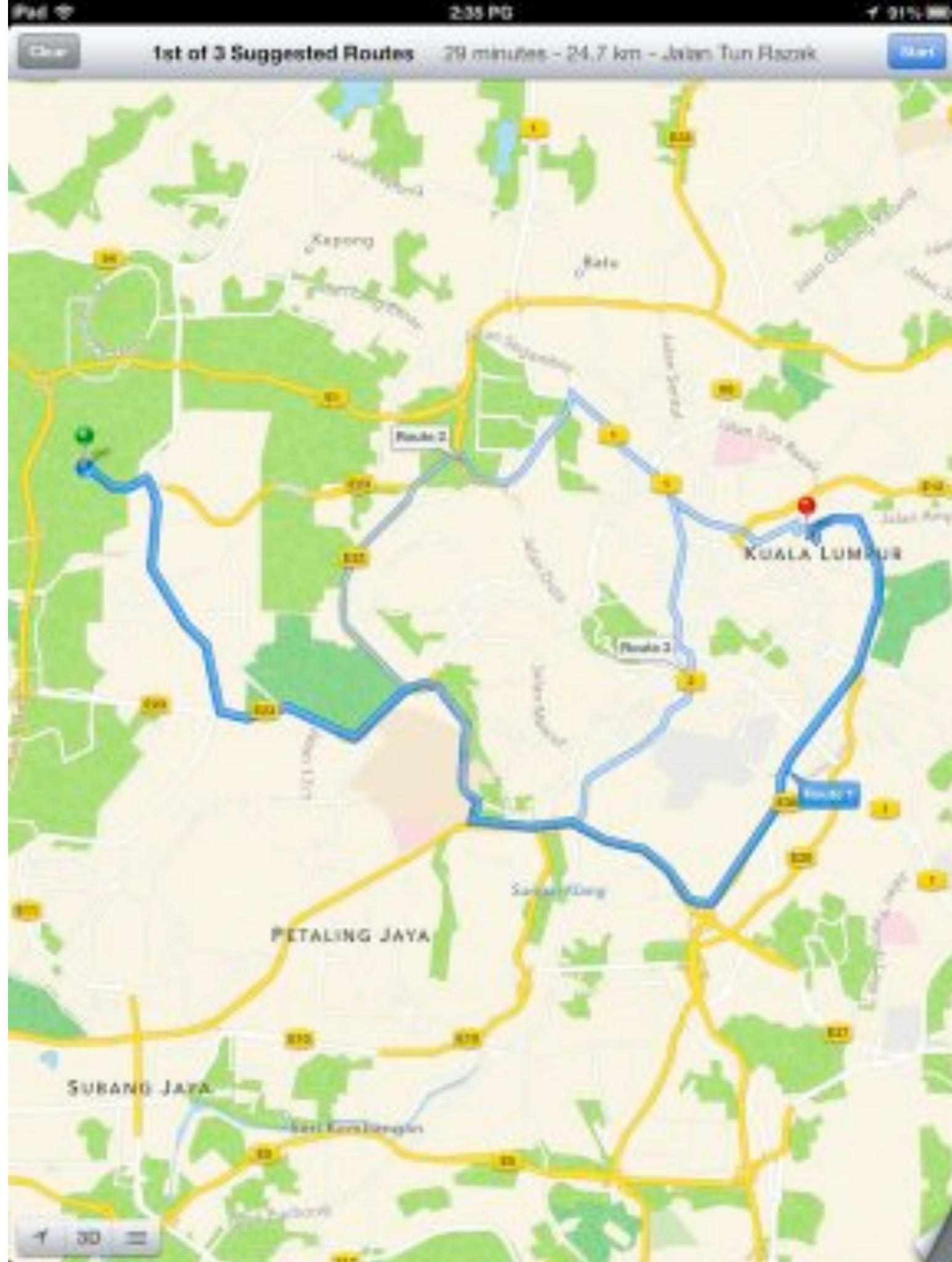
Tap the suggestion.



Suria KLCC is displayed. Tap Directions.



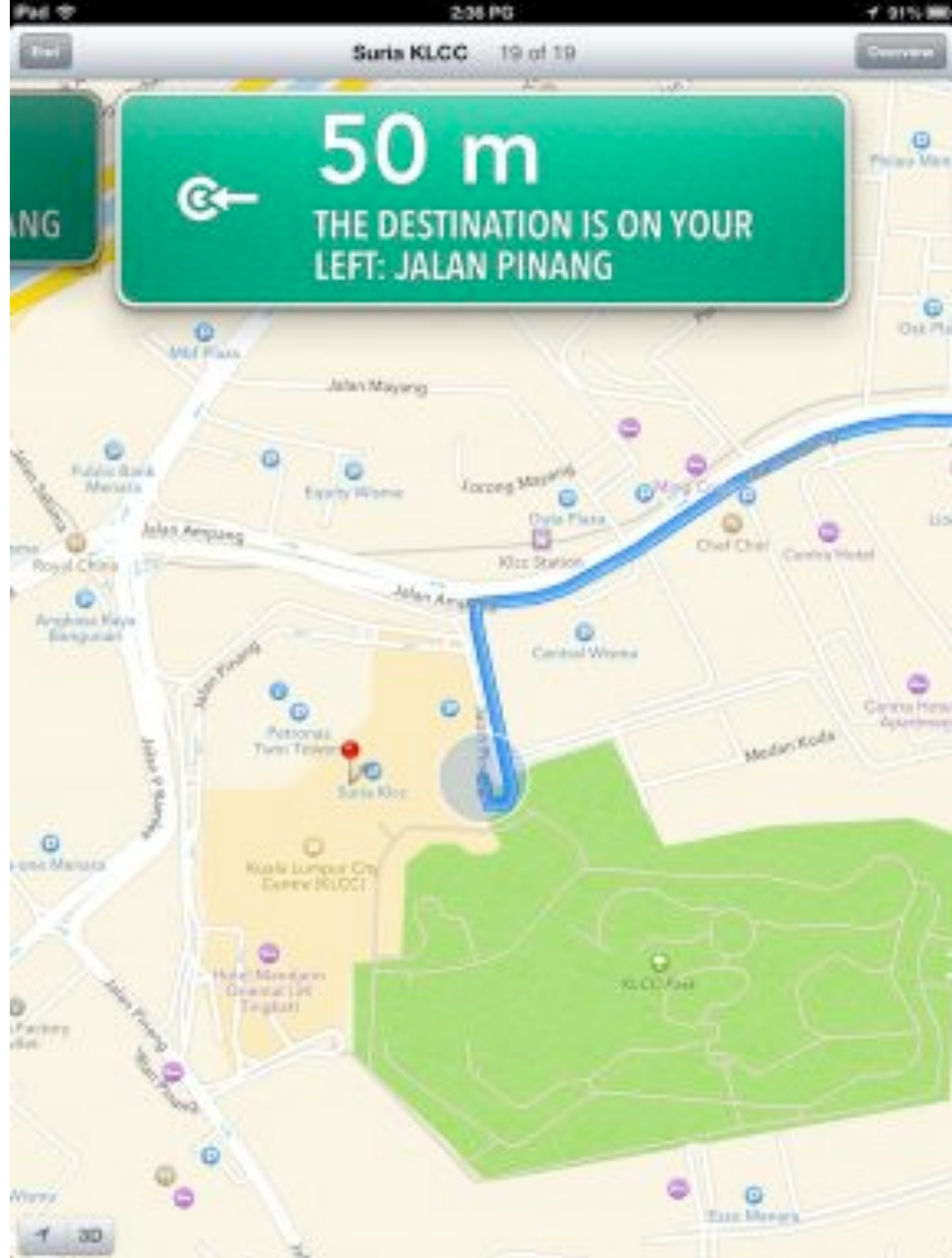
Tap Route.



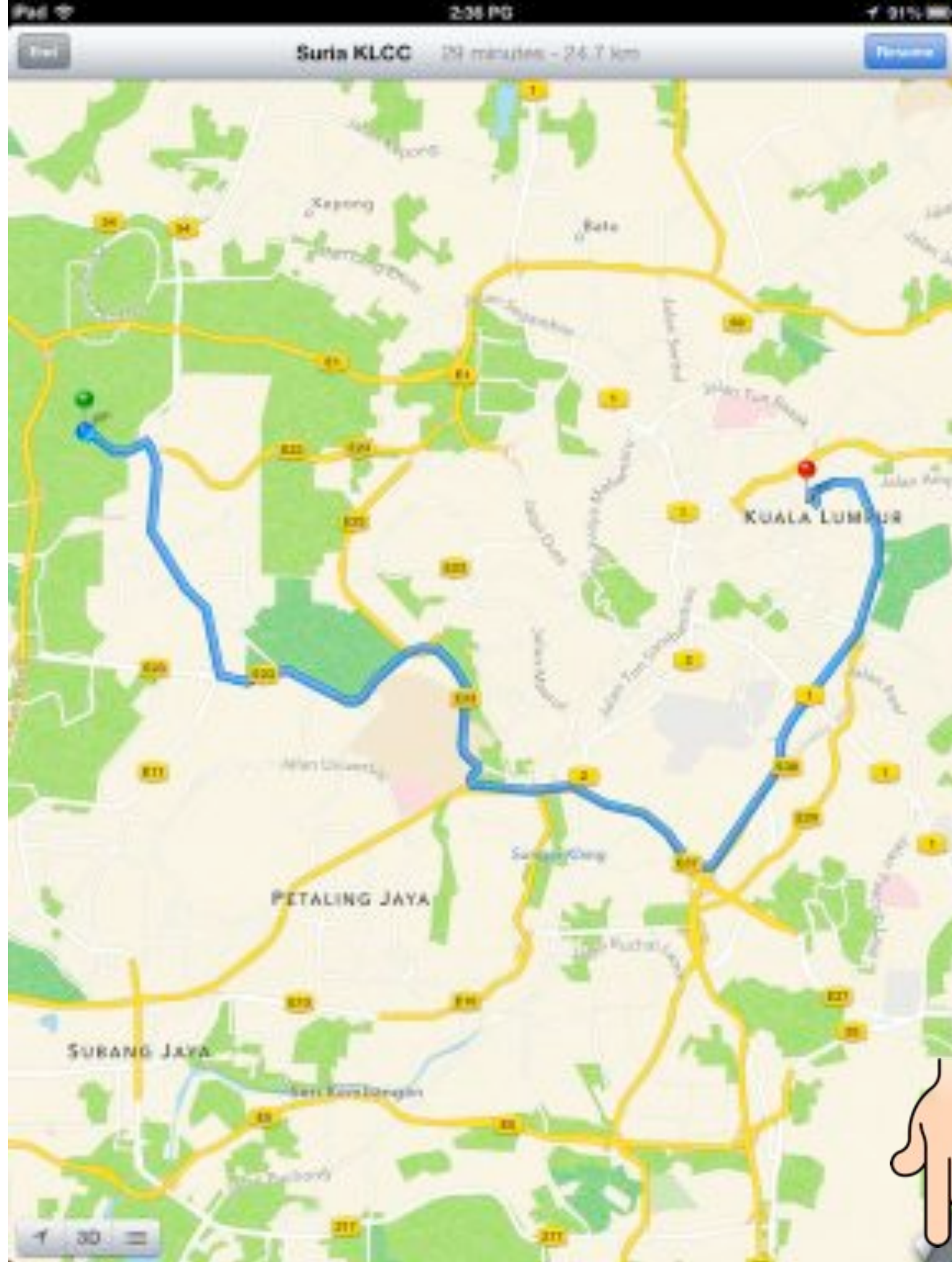
Tap Start.



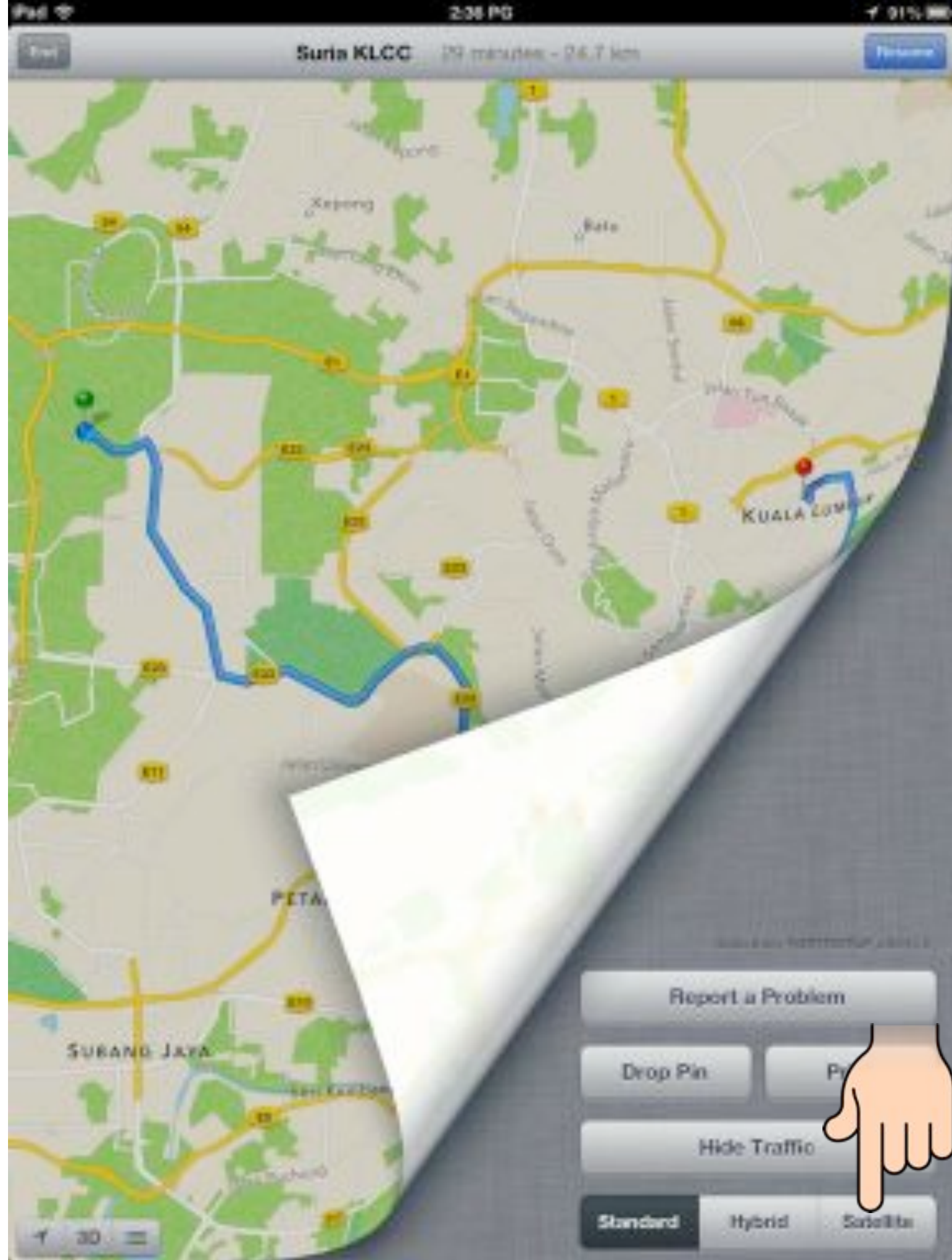
Instructions will be displayed on the screen. Tap the next instruction to see it.



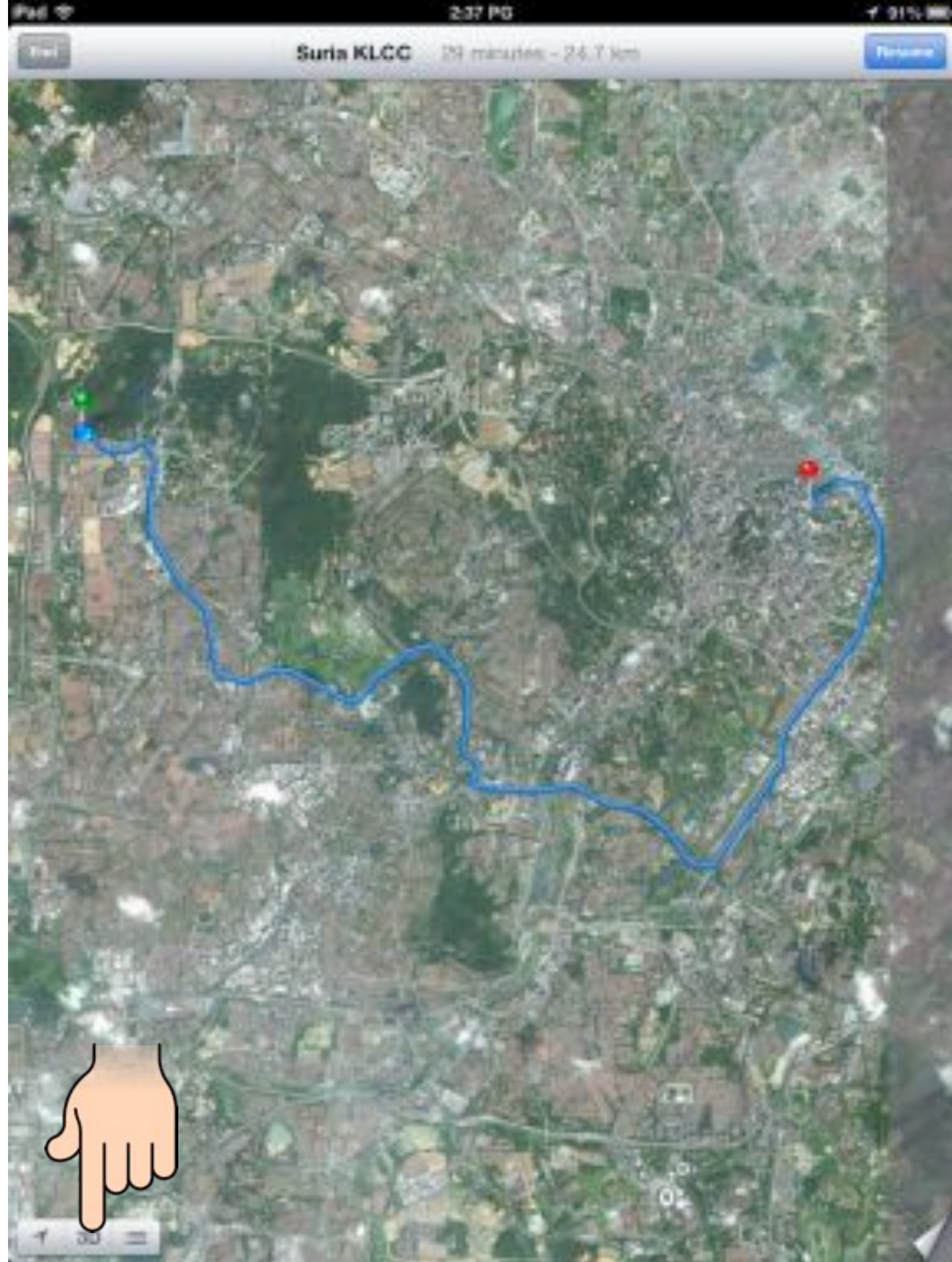
Tap End when you have reached your destination.



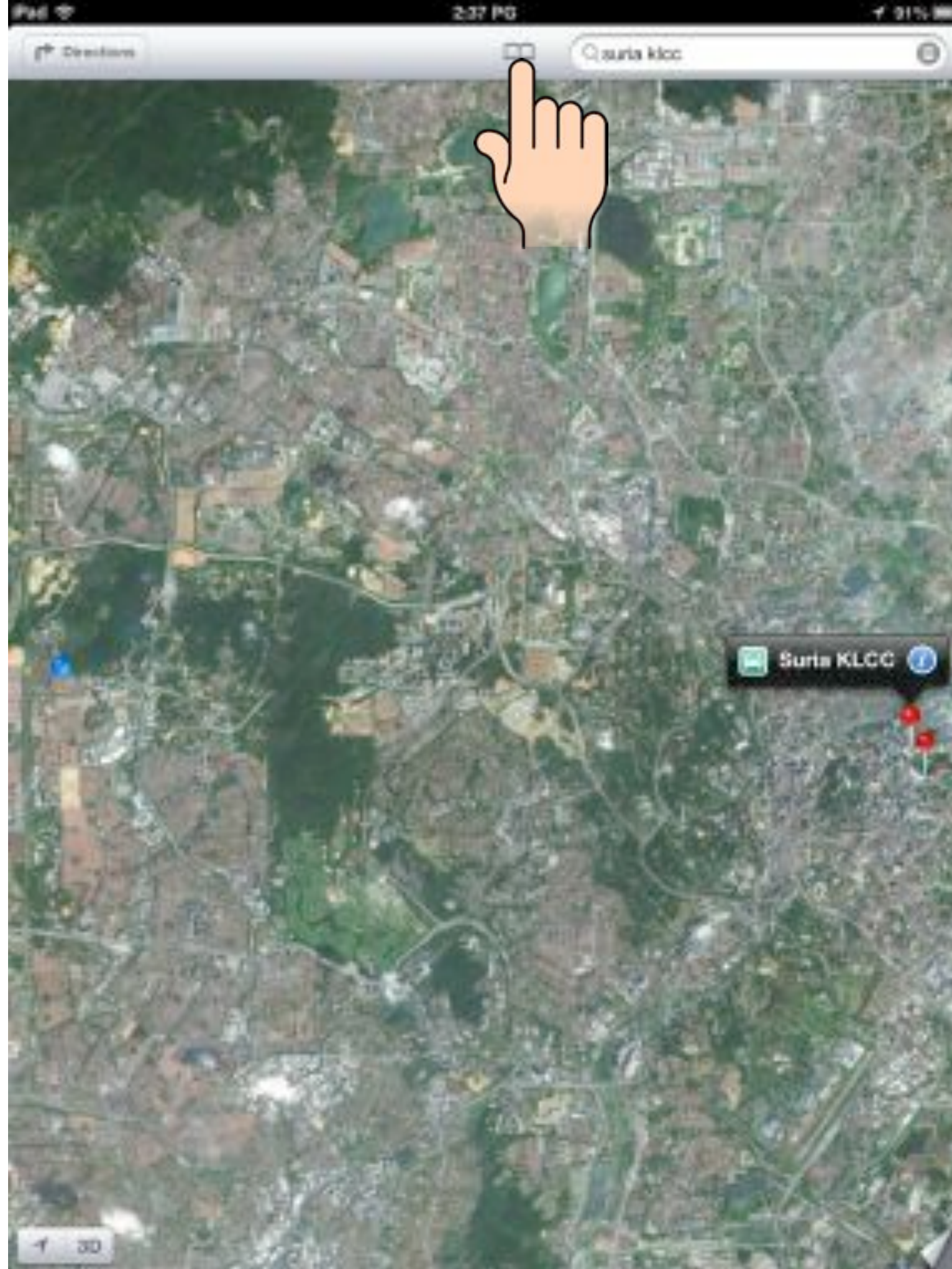
Tap the bottom right corner of the screen.



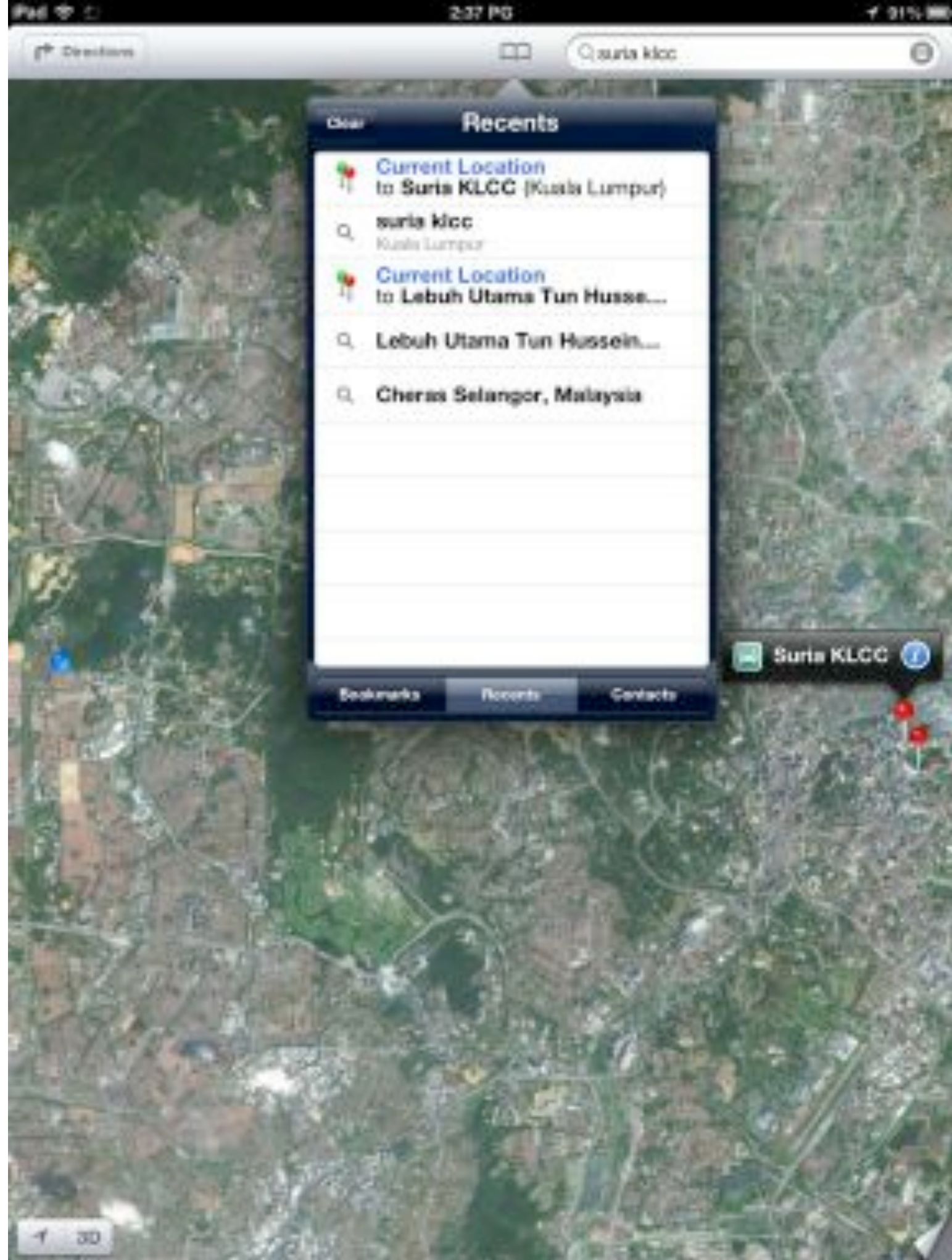
Tap Satellite to display satellite view.



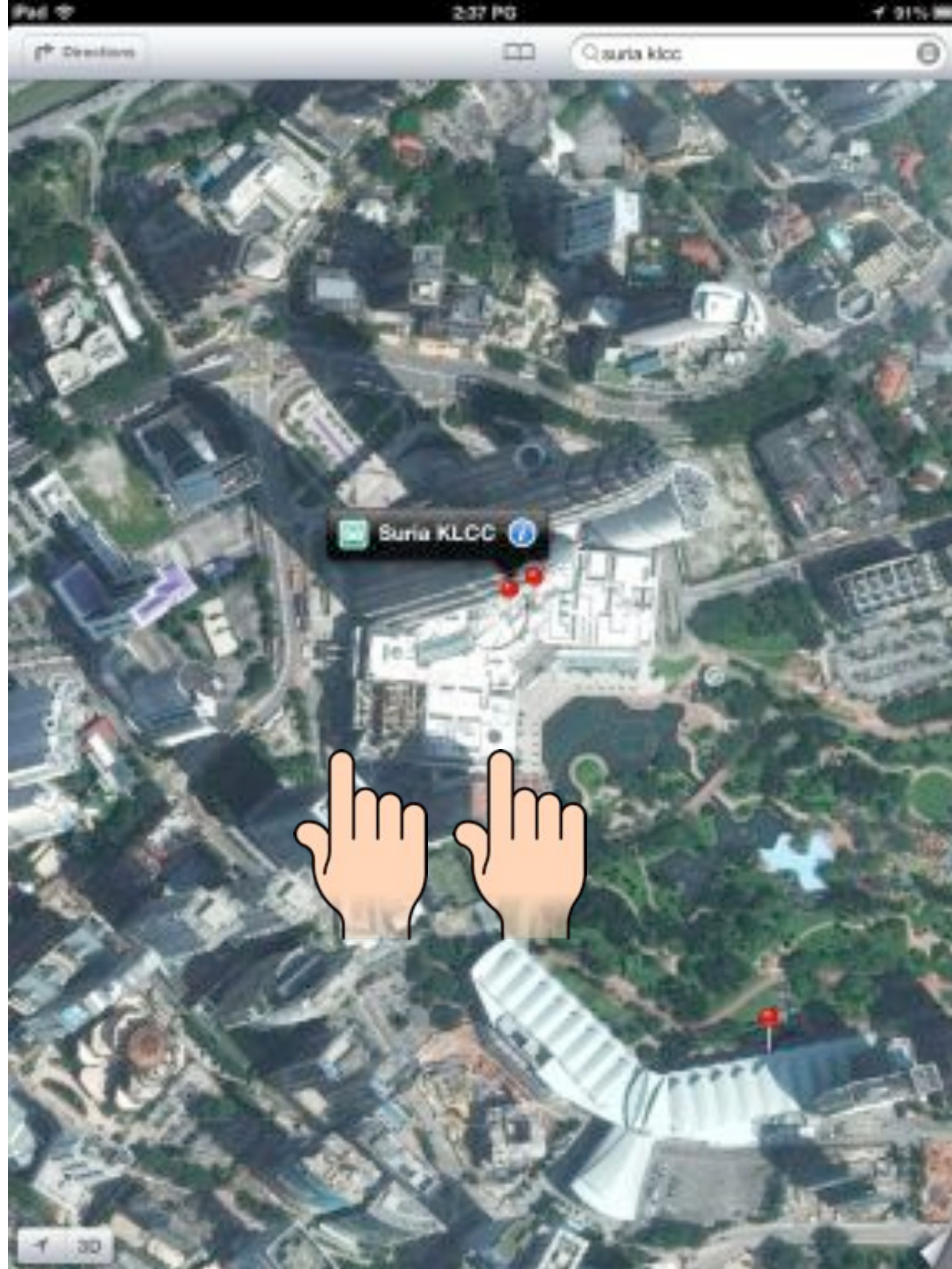
Tap 3D to display 3D view.



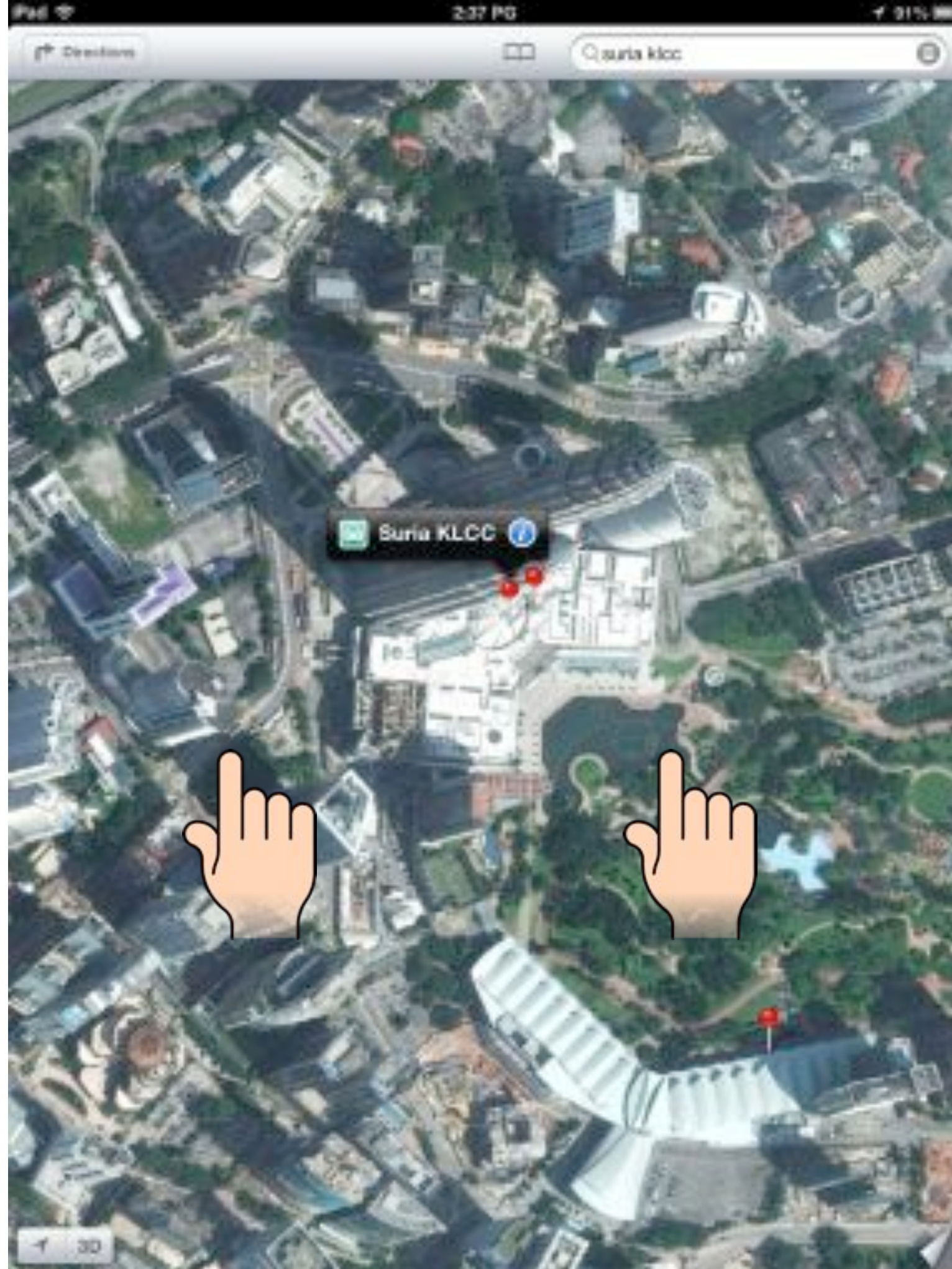
Tap this control to display Bookmarks.

Tap Clock.



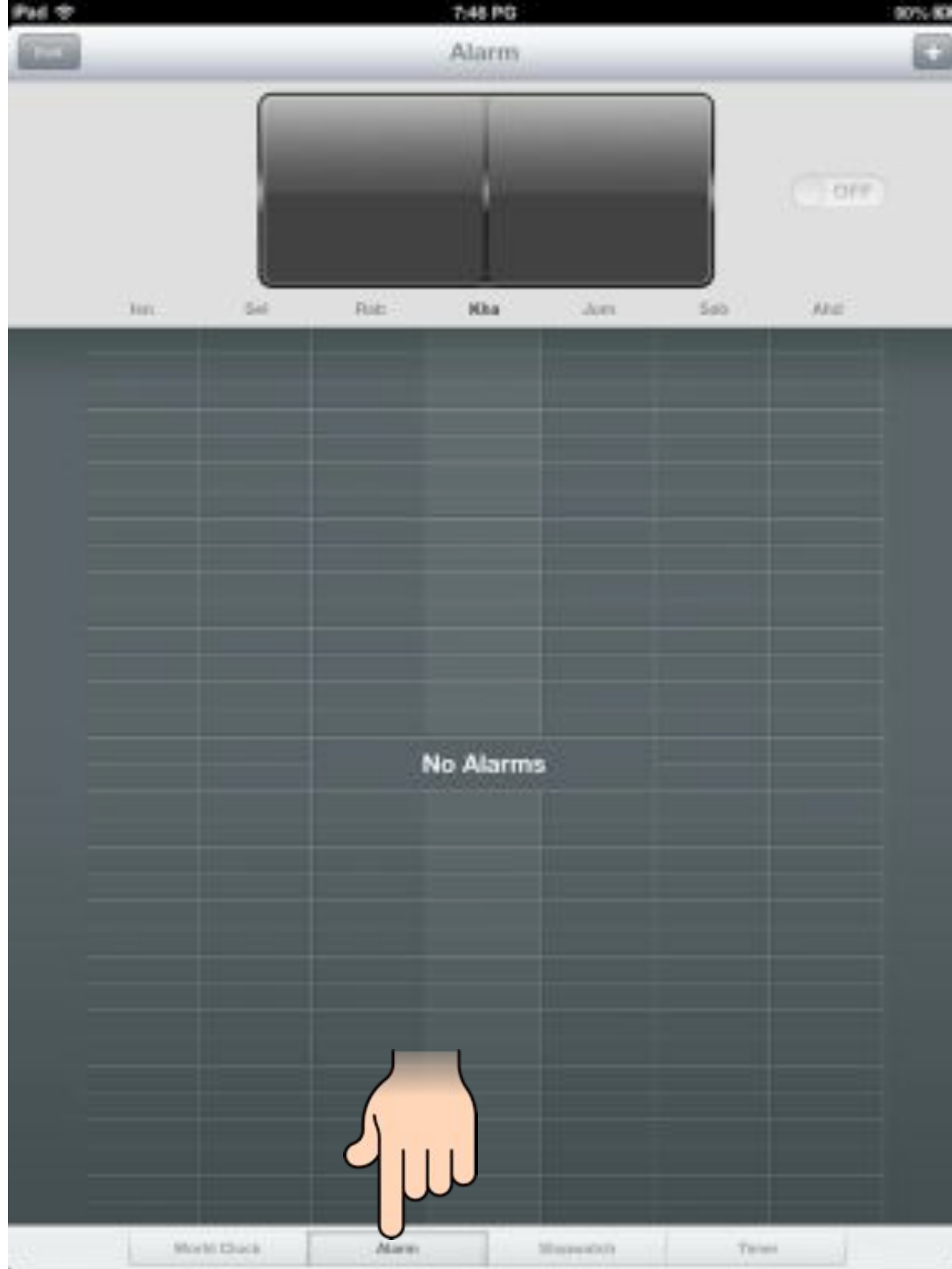
Tap Add.



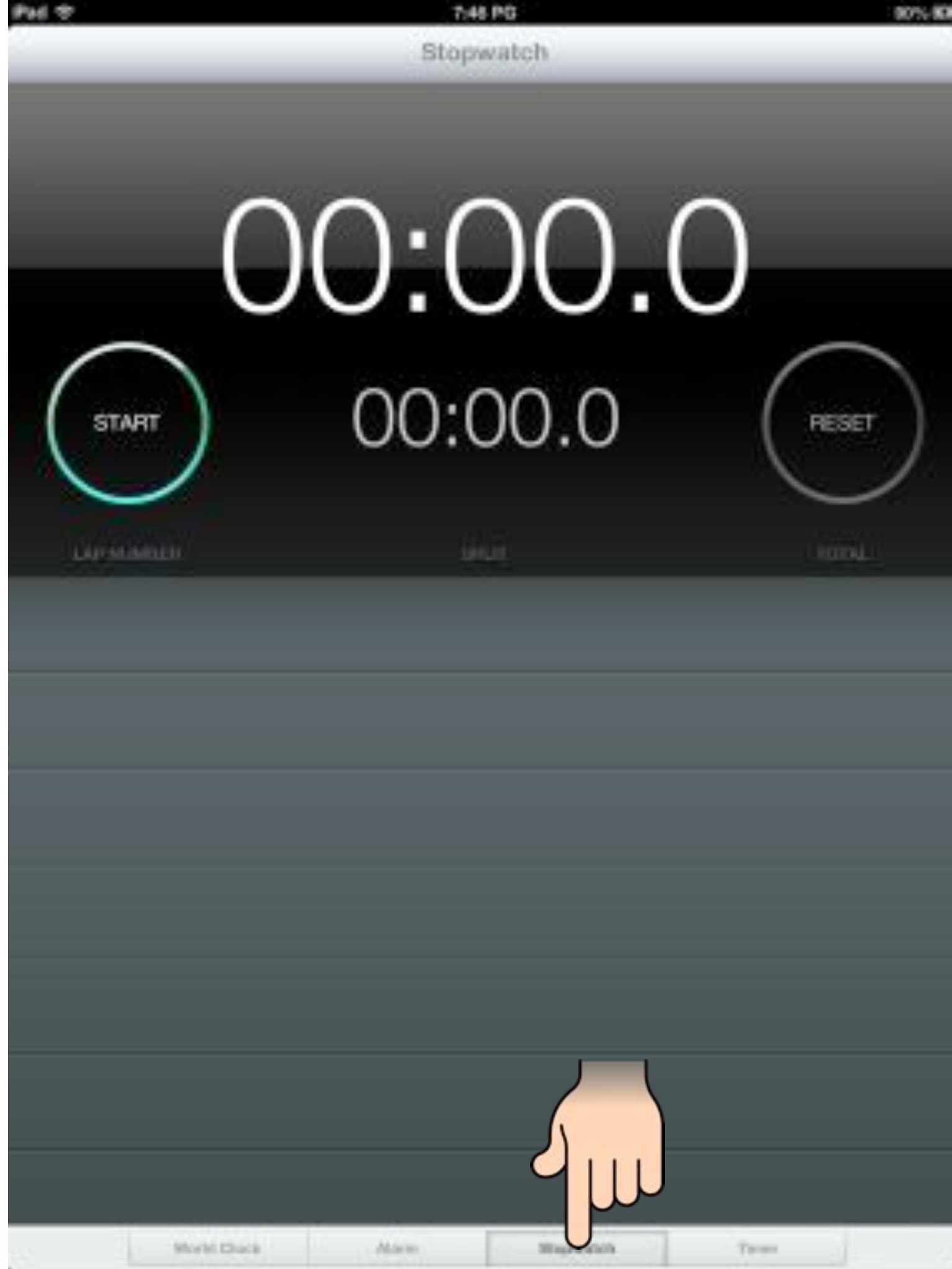
Choose a city you would like to add.



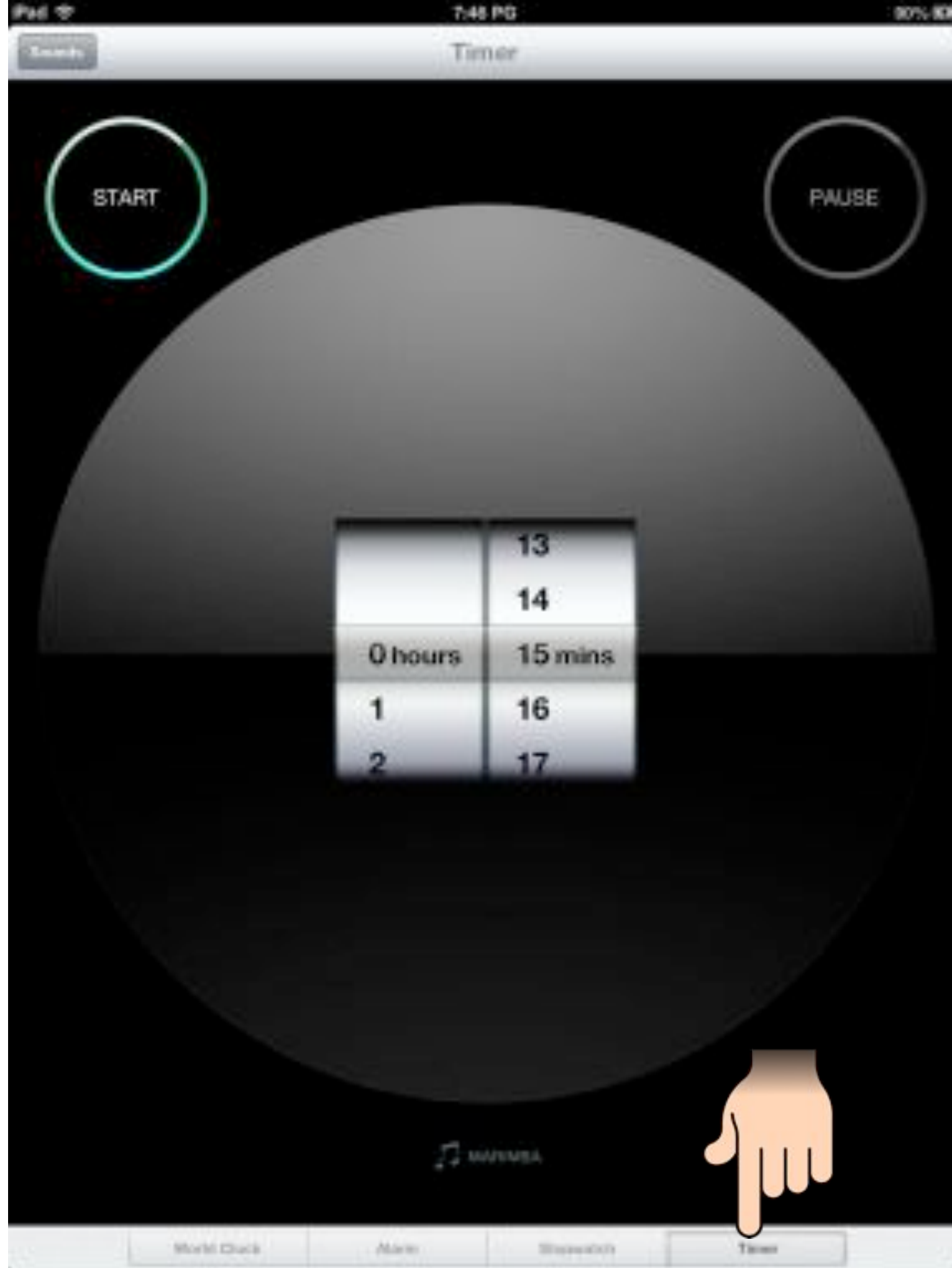
The clock for that city is displayed.

Tap this button to take a picture. Try other special effects.

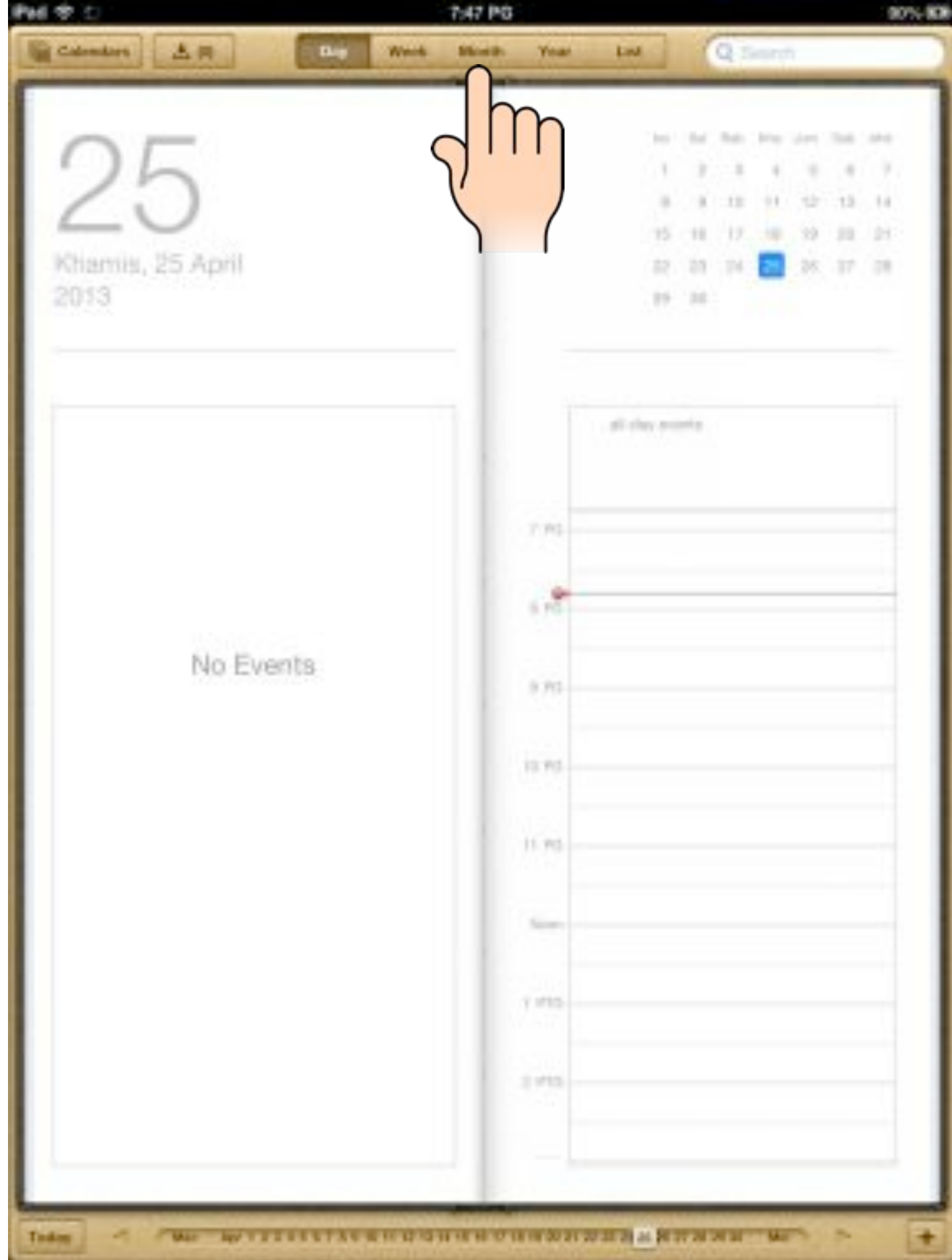


Press the Home button to return to the starting screen.

Fill in the details of the event. Tap Done when complete.

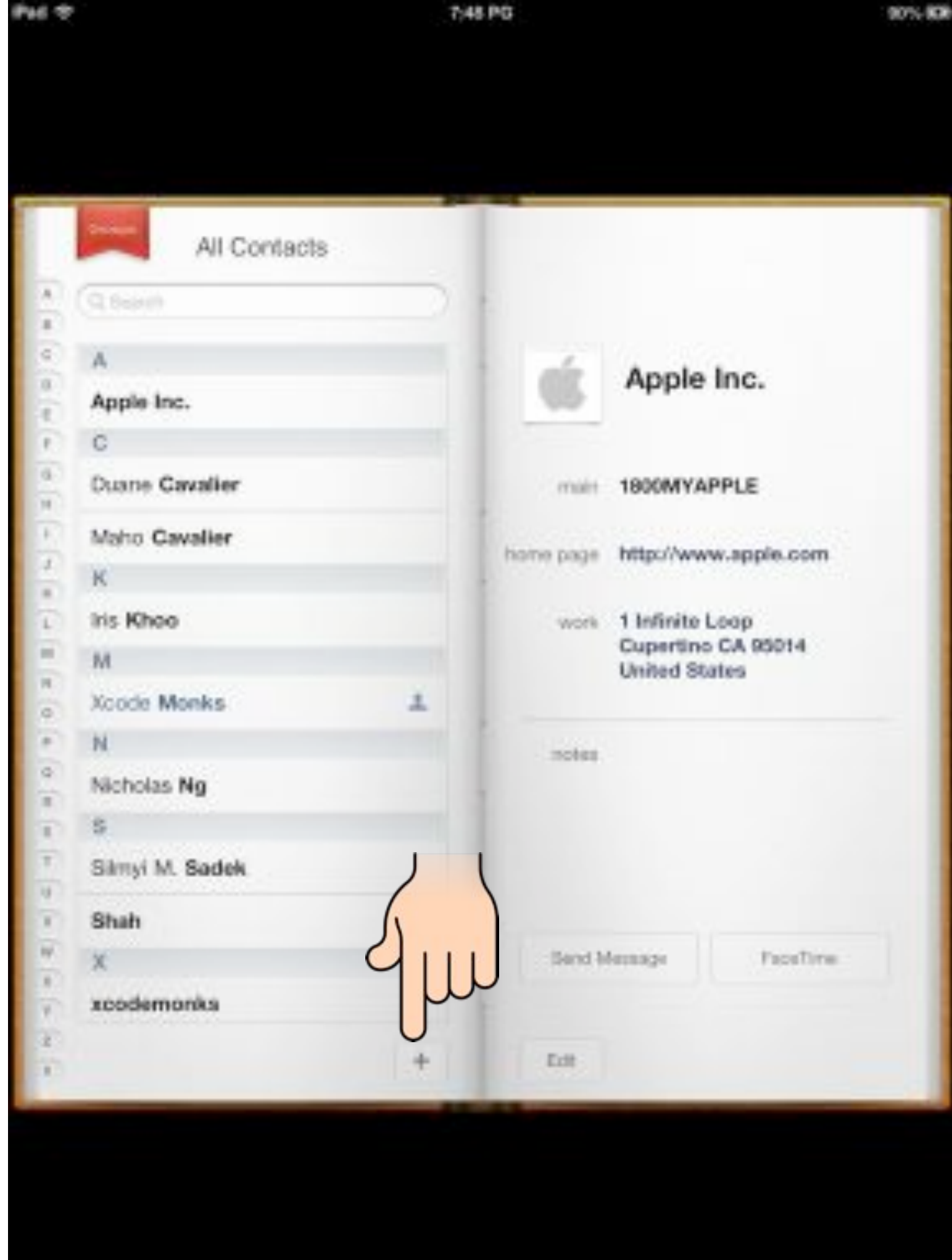


Press the Home button to return to the starting screen.

Tap in the required information and tap Done.

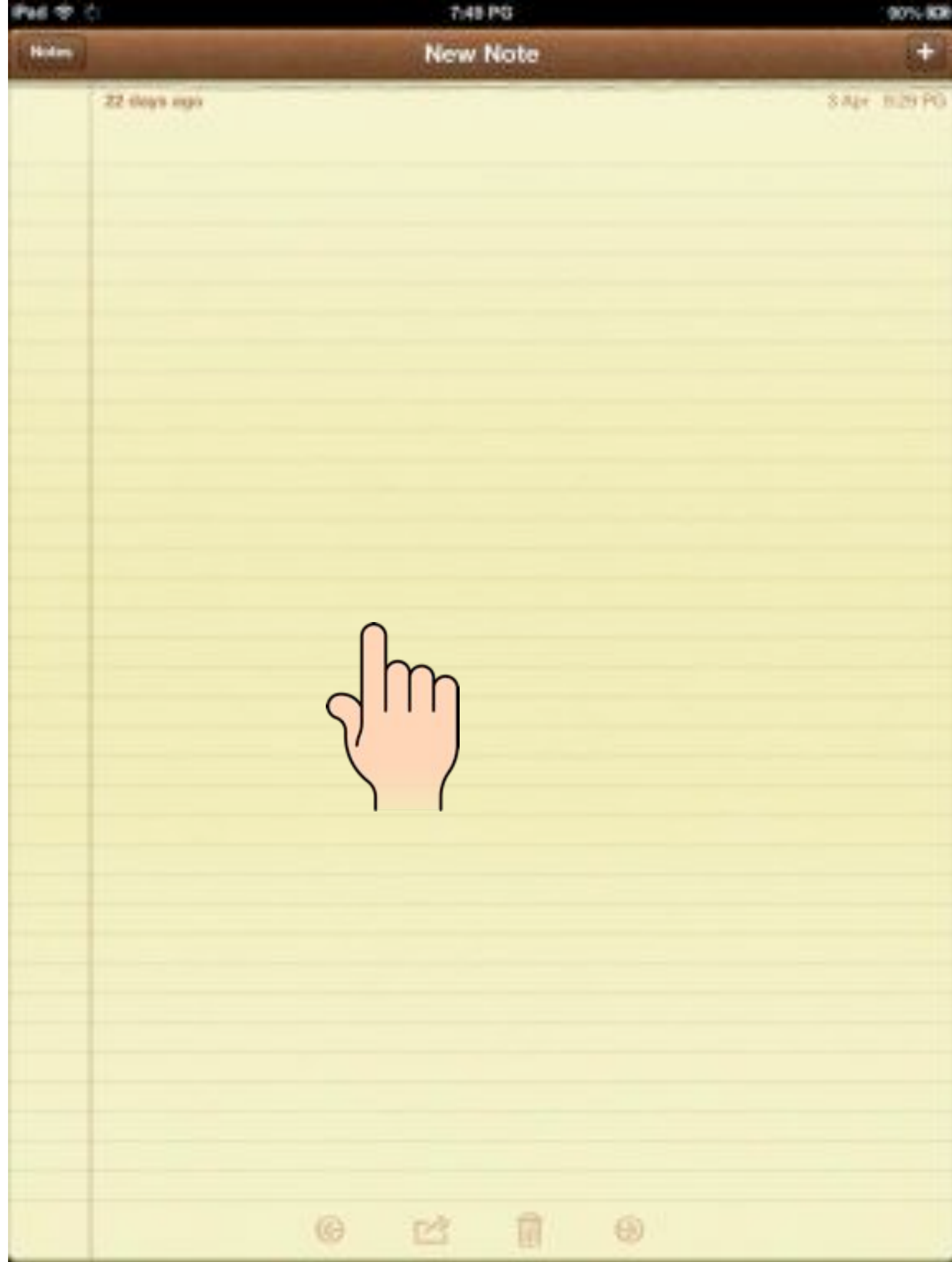


Press the Home button to return to the starting screen.

7.10 Notes



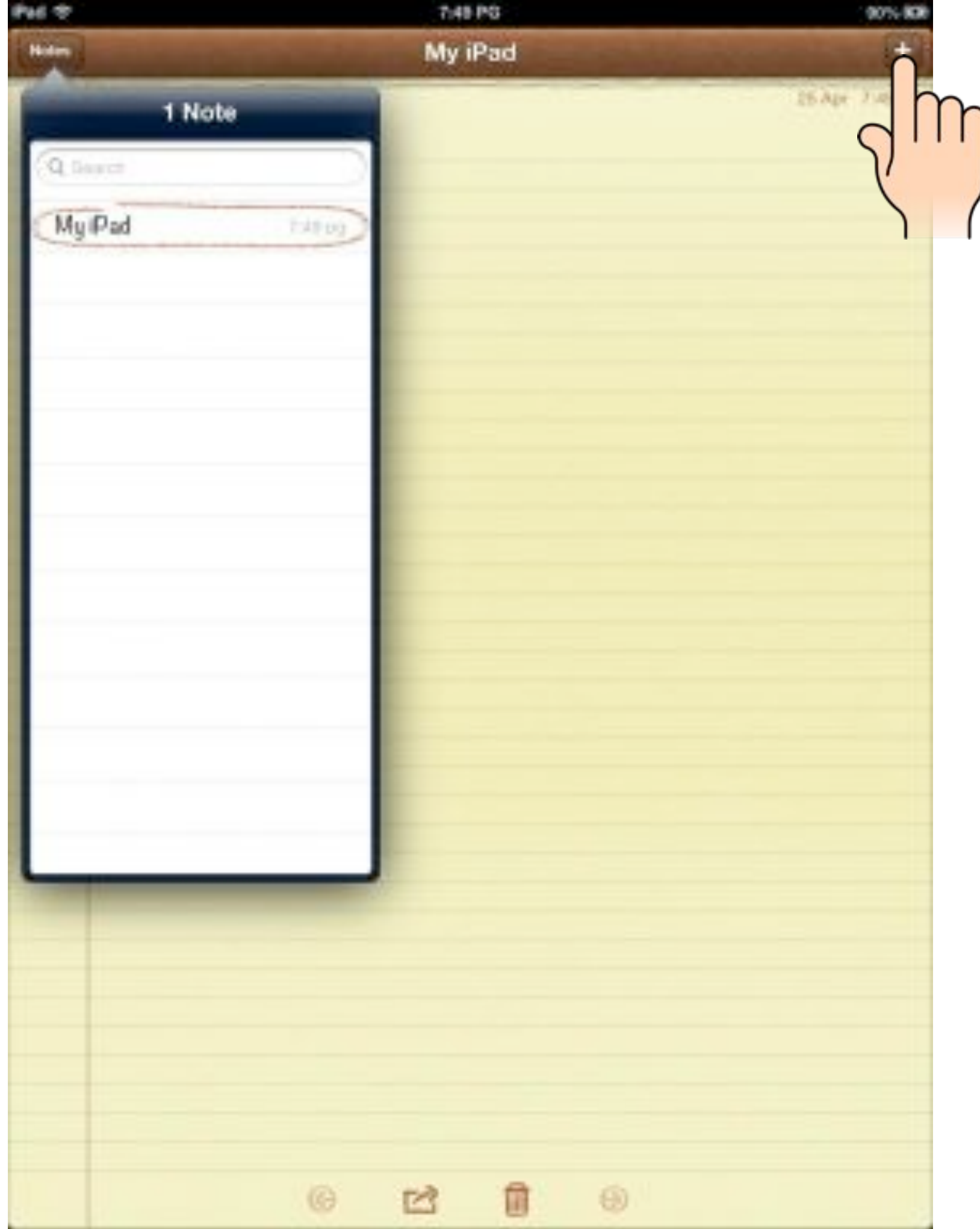
Tap Notes.



Tap the note.



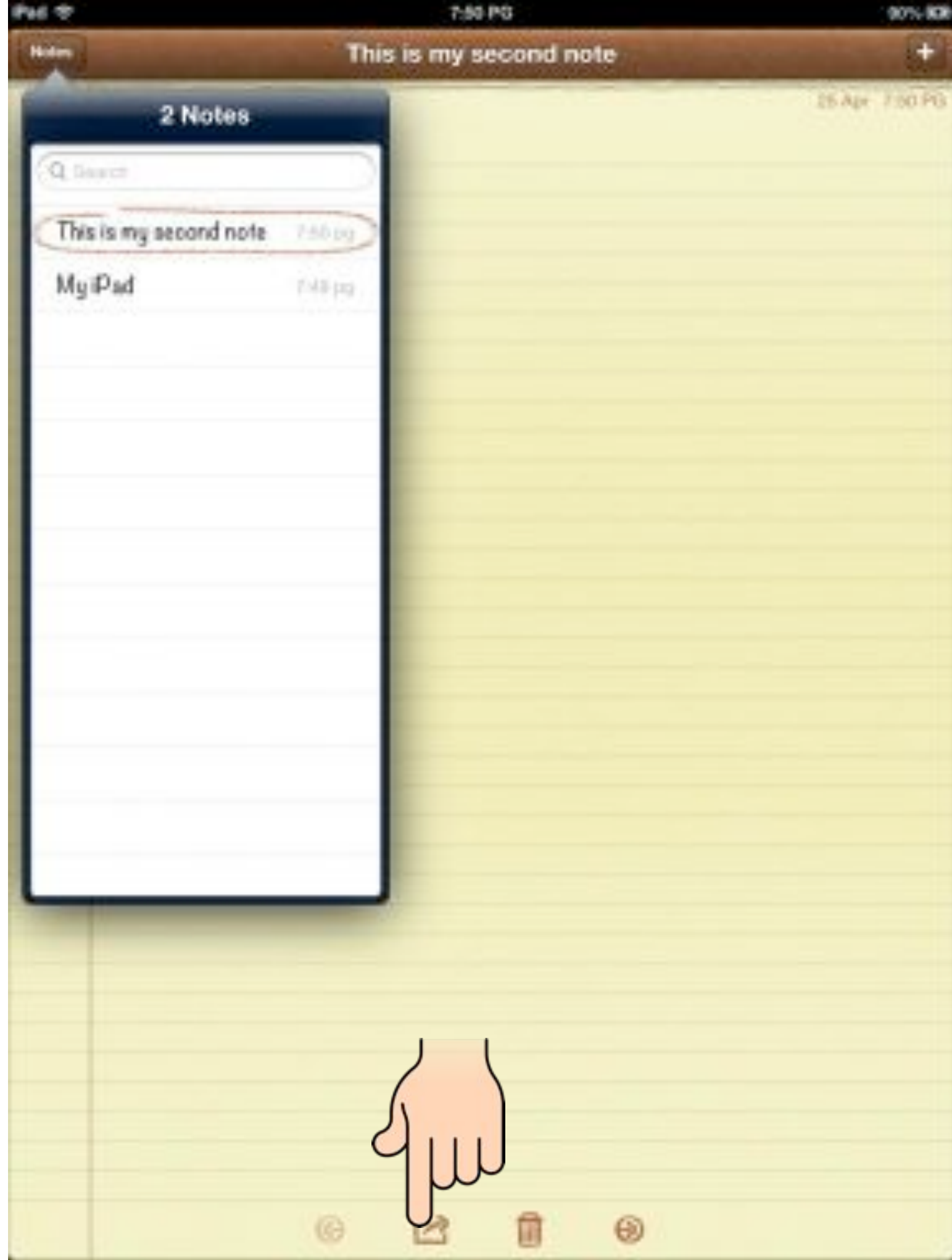
The keyboard appears. Type in a sentence. Tap Notes.



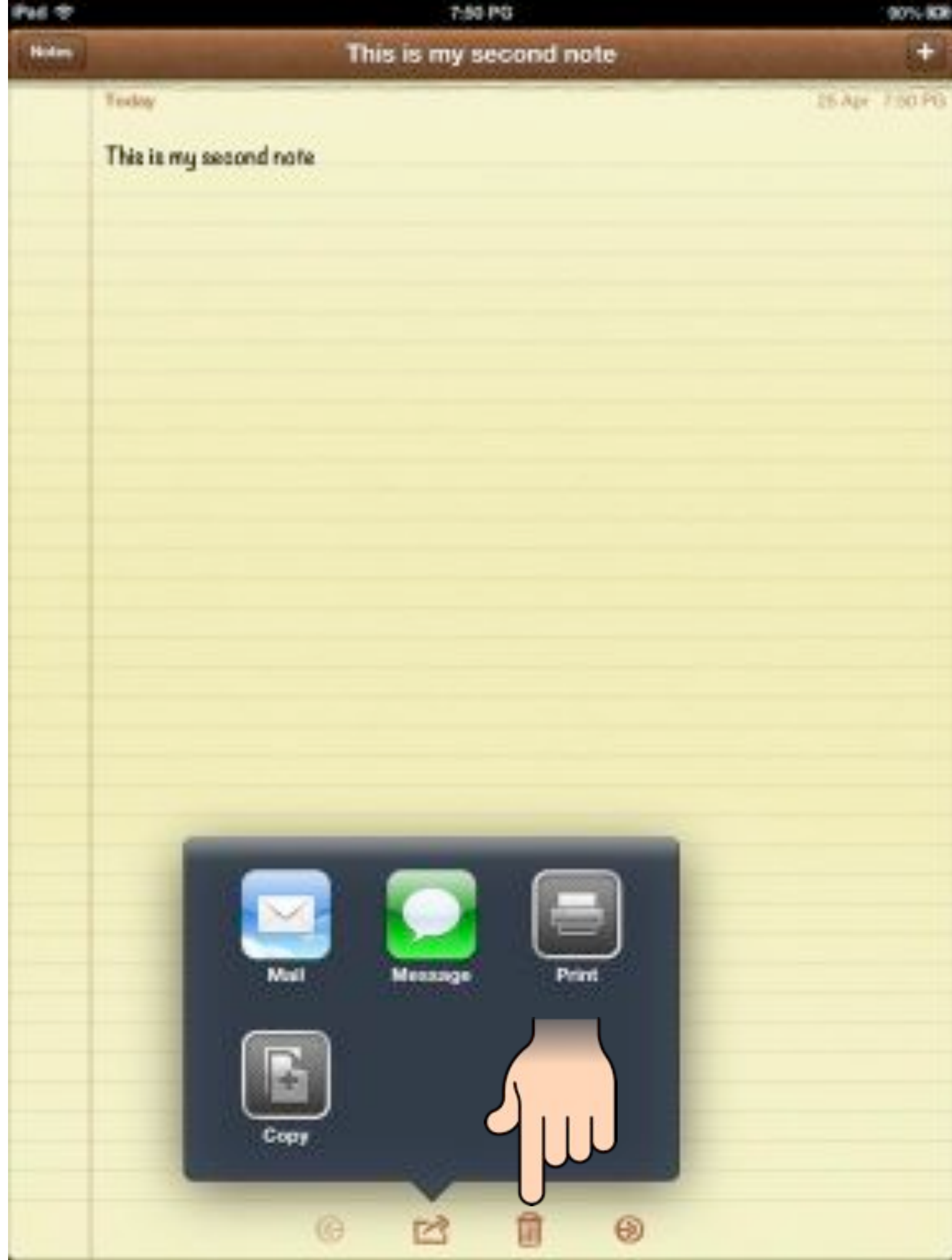
List of notes is displayed. Tap the + button.



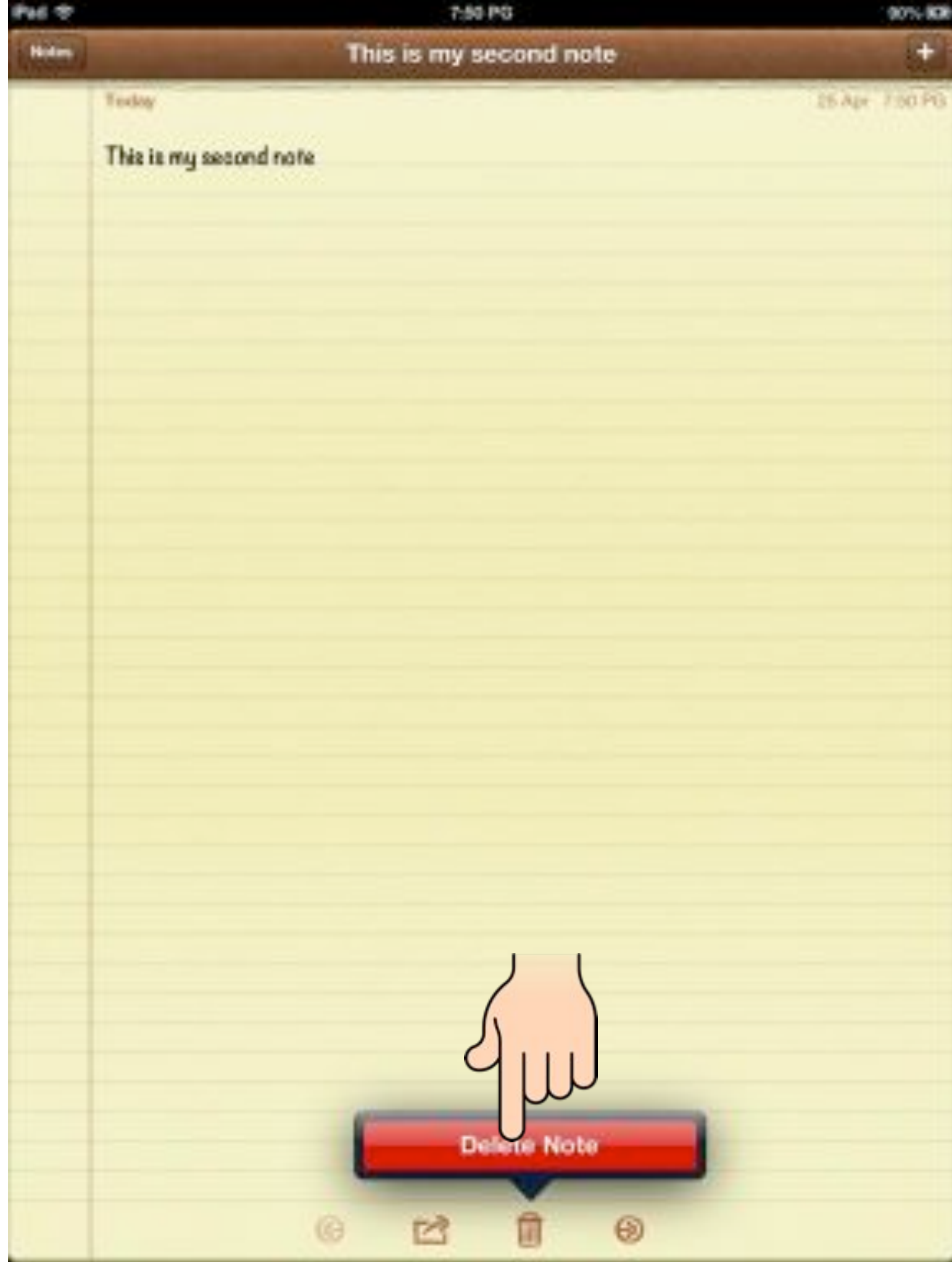
A new blank note is created. Type in a few words. Tap notes again.



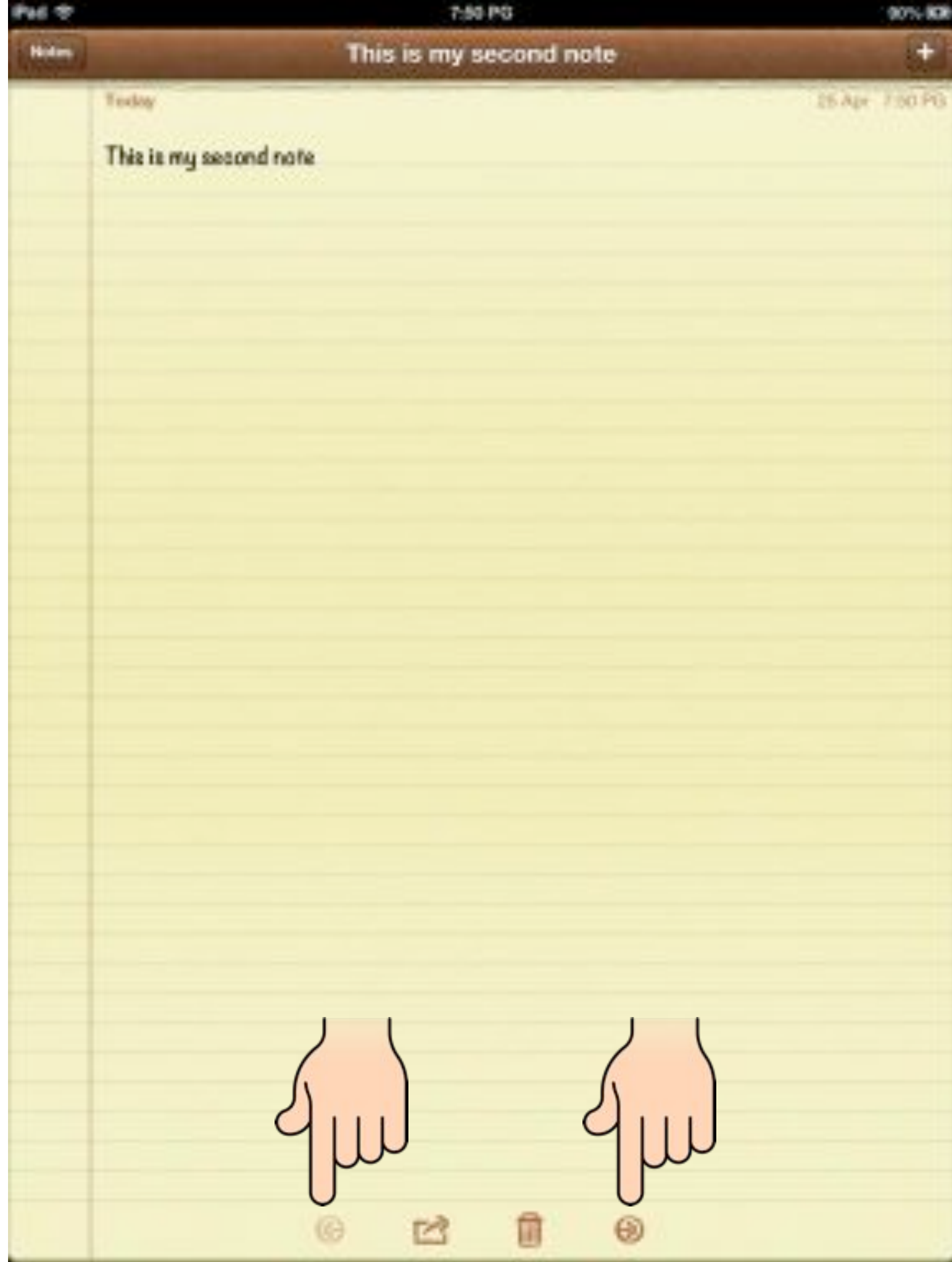
You'll see the second note in the list of notes. All notes are saved automatically. Tap the sharing button.

These buttons take you to the previous and next notes.

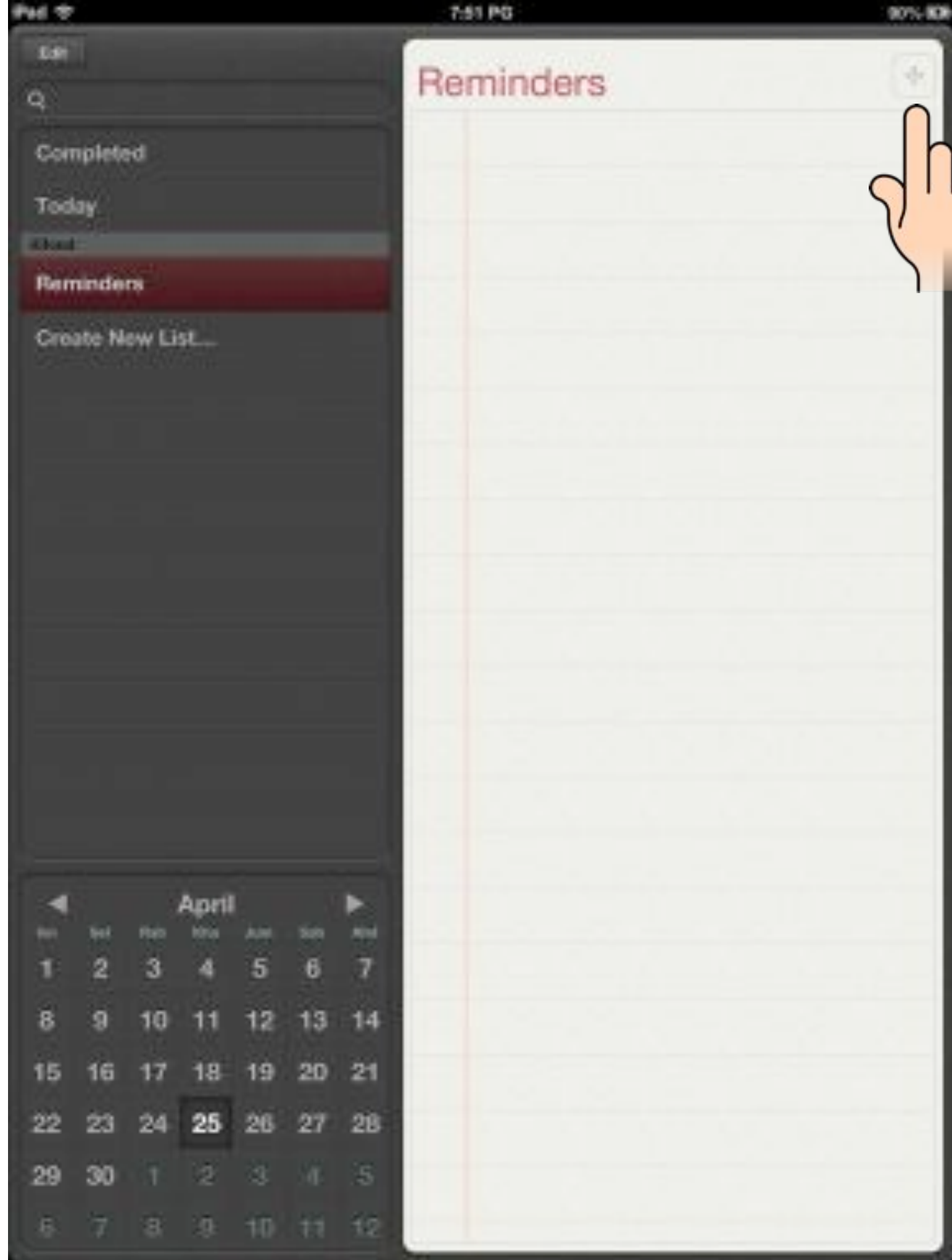


Press the Home button to return to the starting screen.

Tap Reminders.



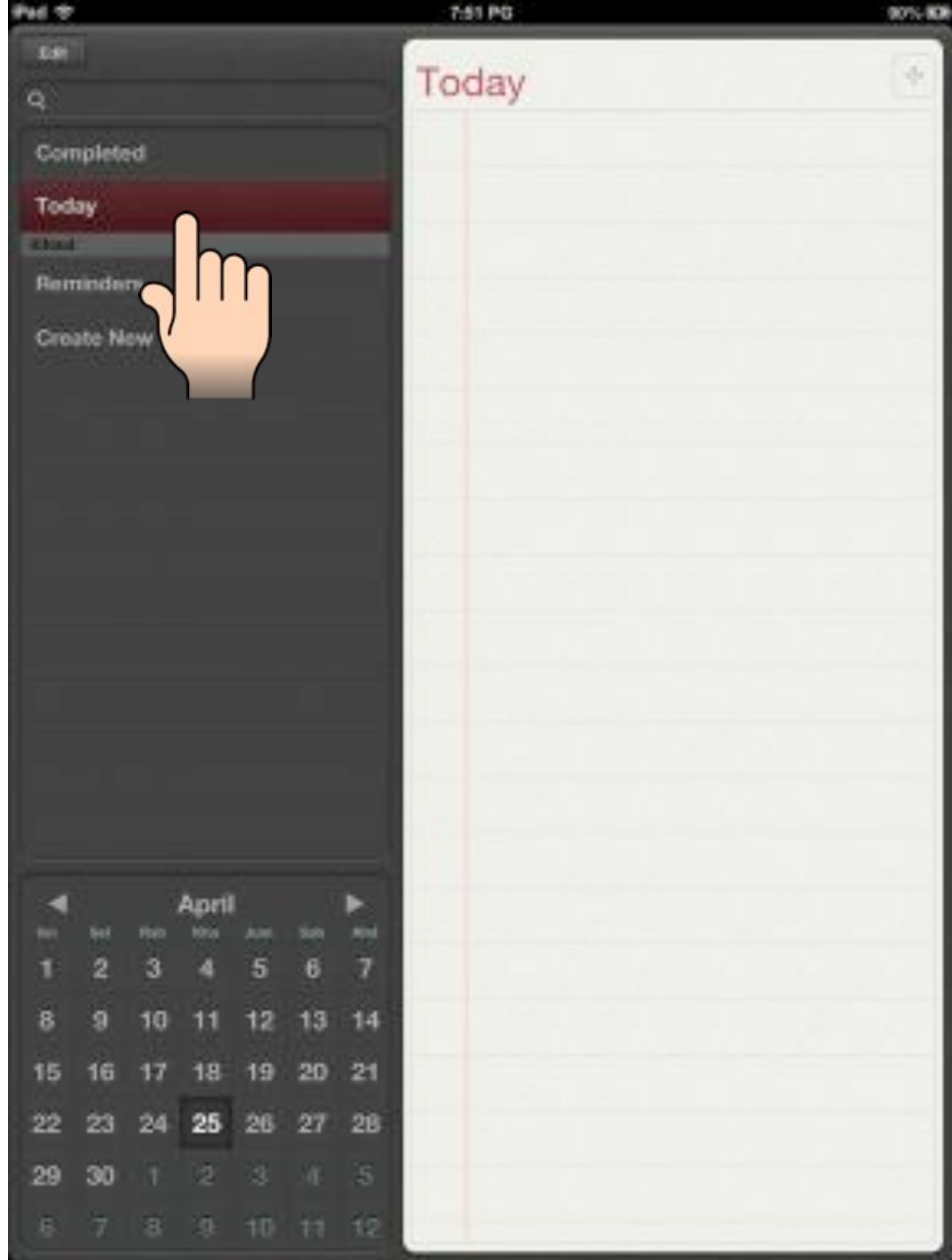
Tap the + button.



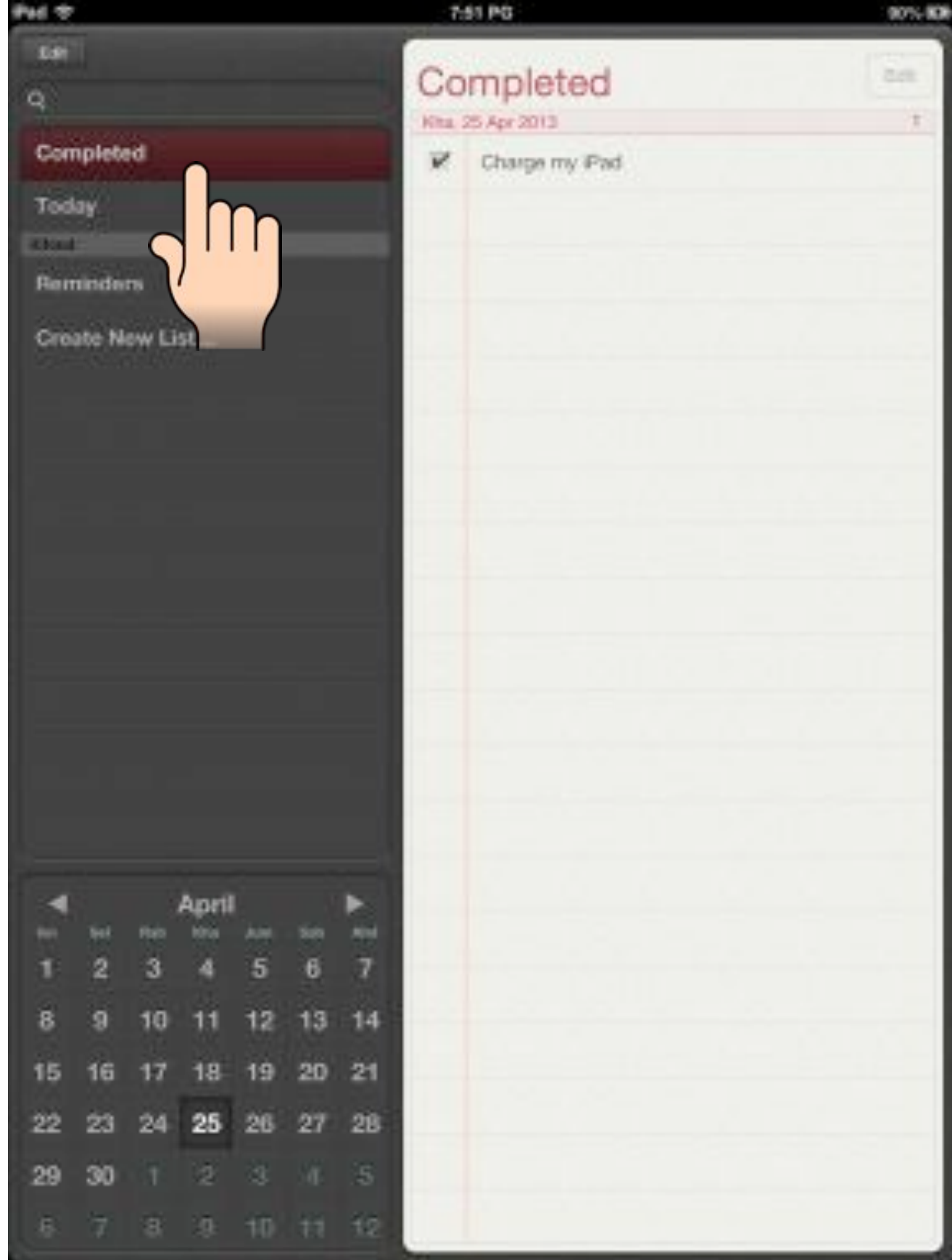
A new reminder is created. Type in some text for that reminder.

The completed button shows all completed tasks.

Tap Safari.



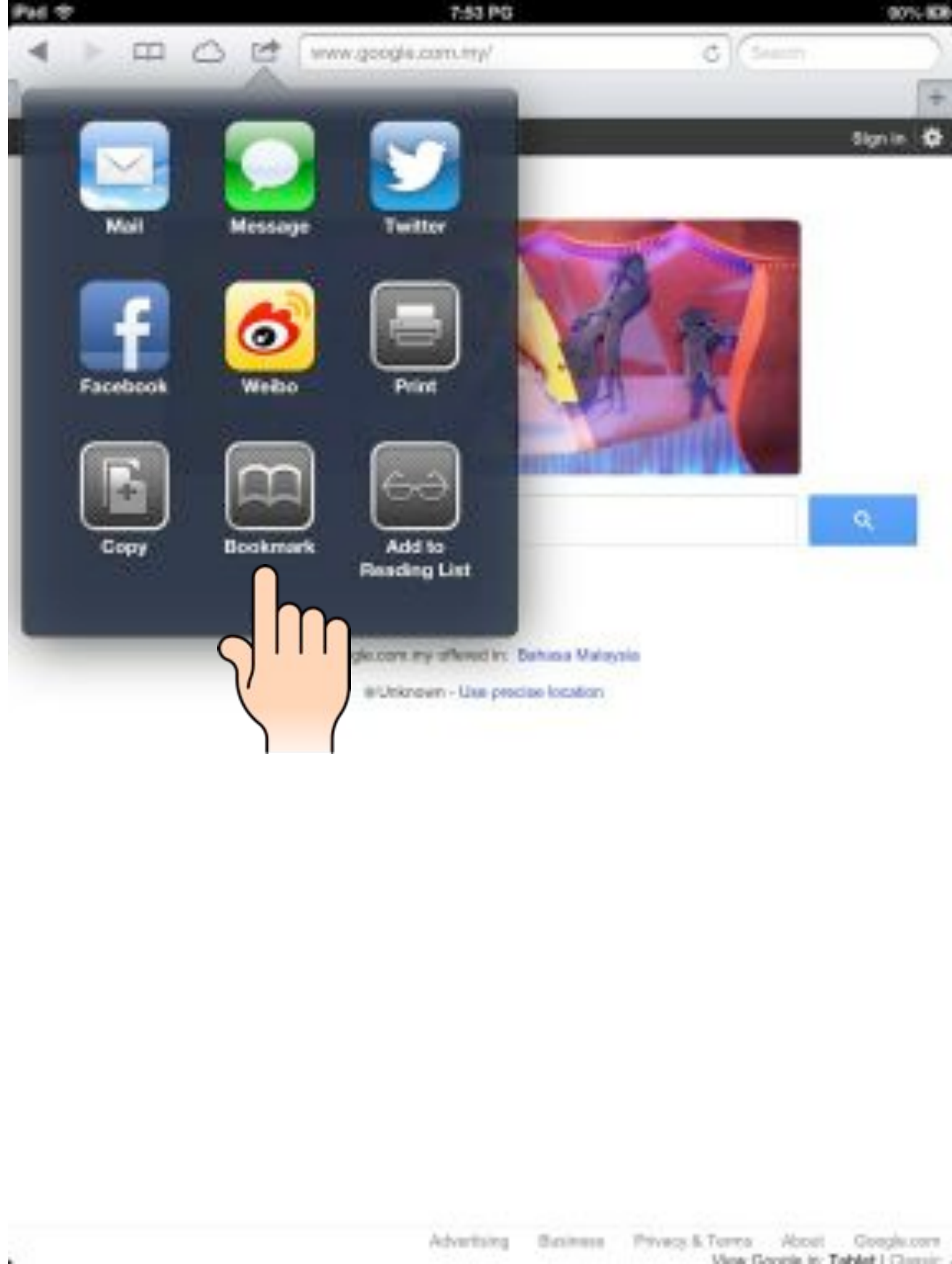
A web page is displayed. Tap the Bookmarks button.



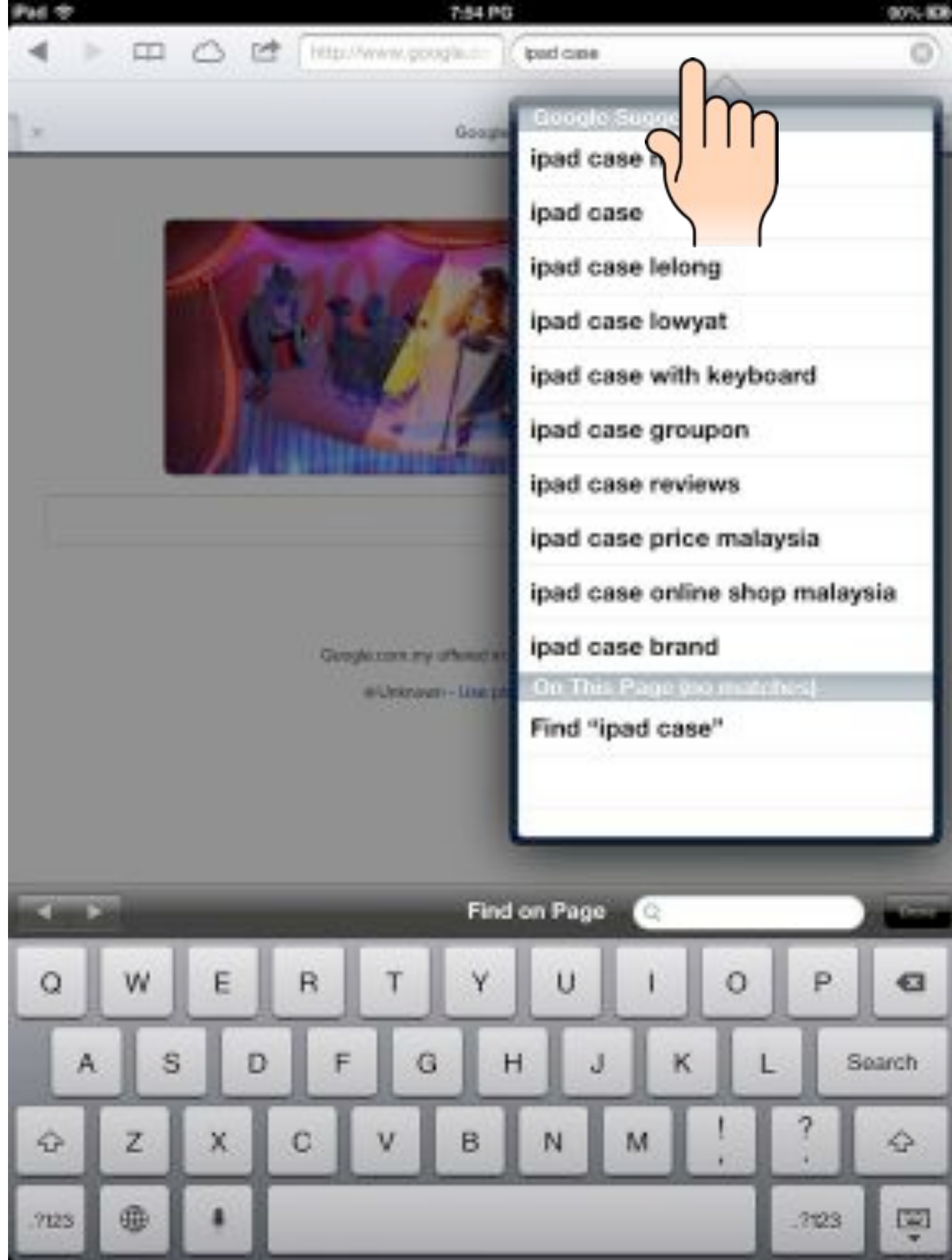
A list of bookmarks appears. Tap Google.



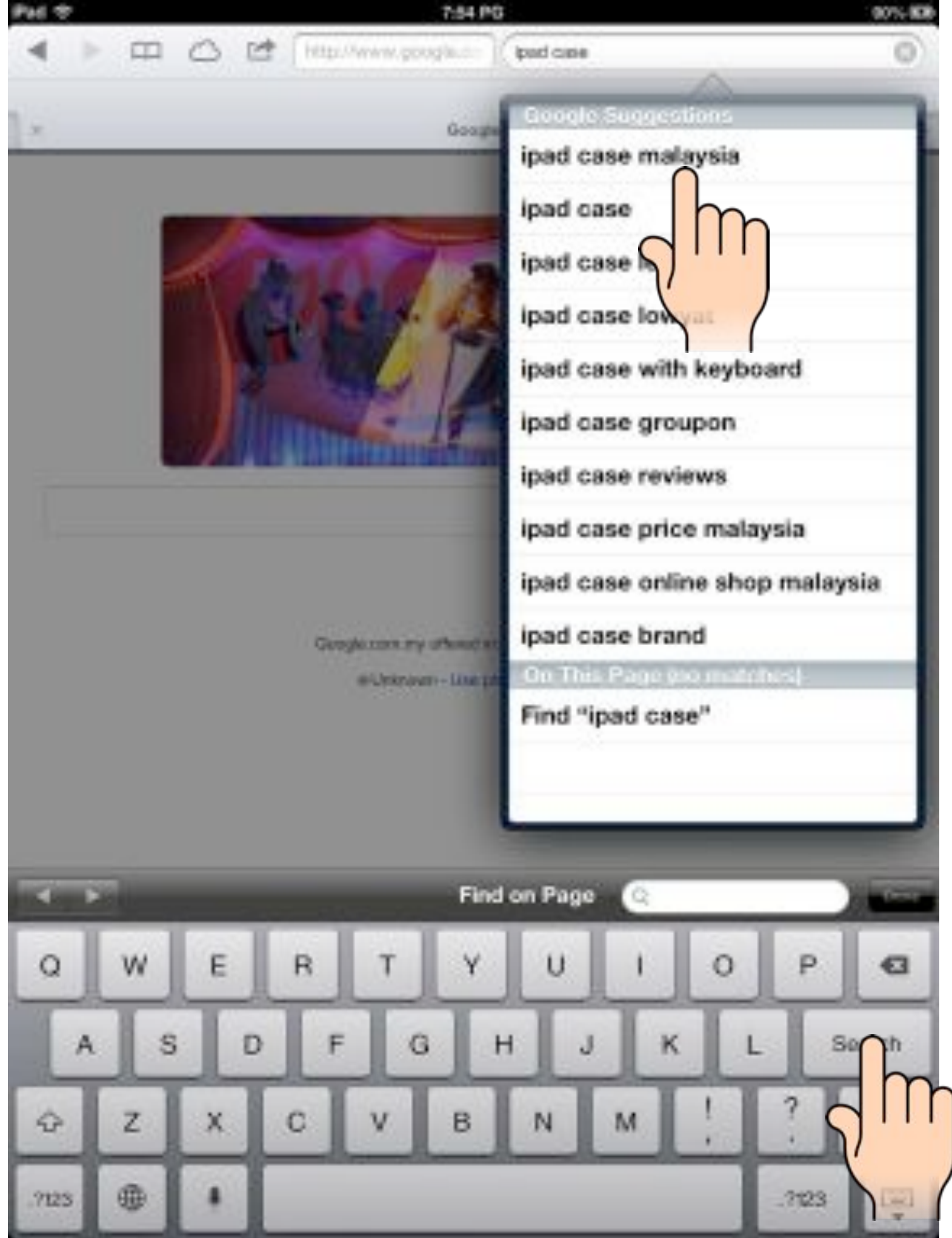
The Google web page is displayed. Touch the Sharing button.



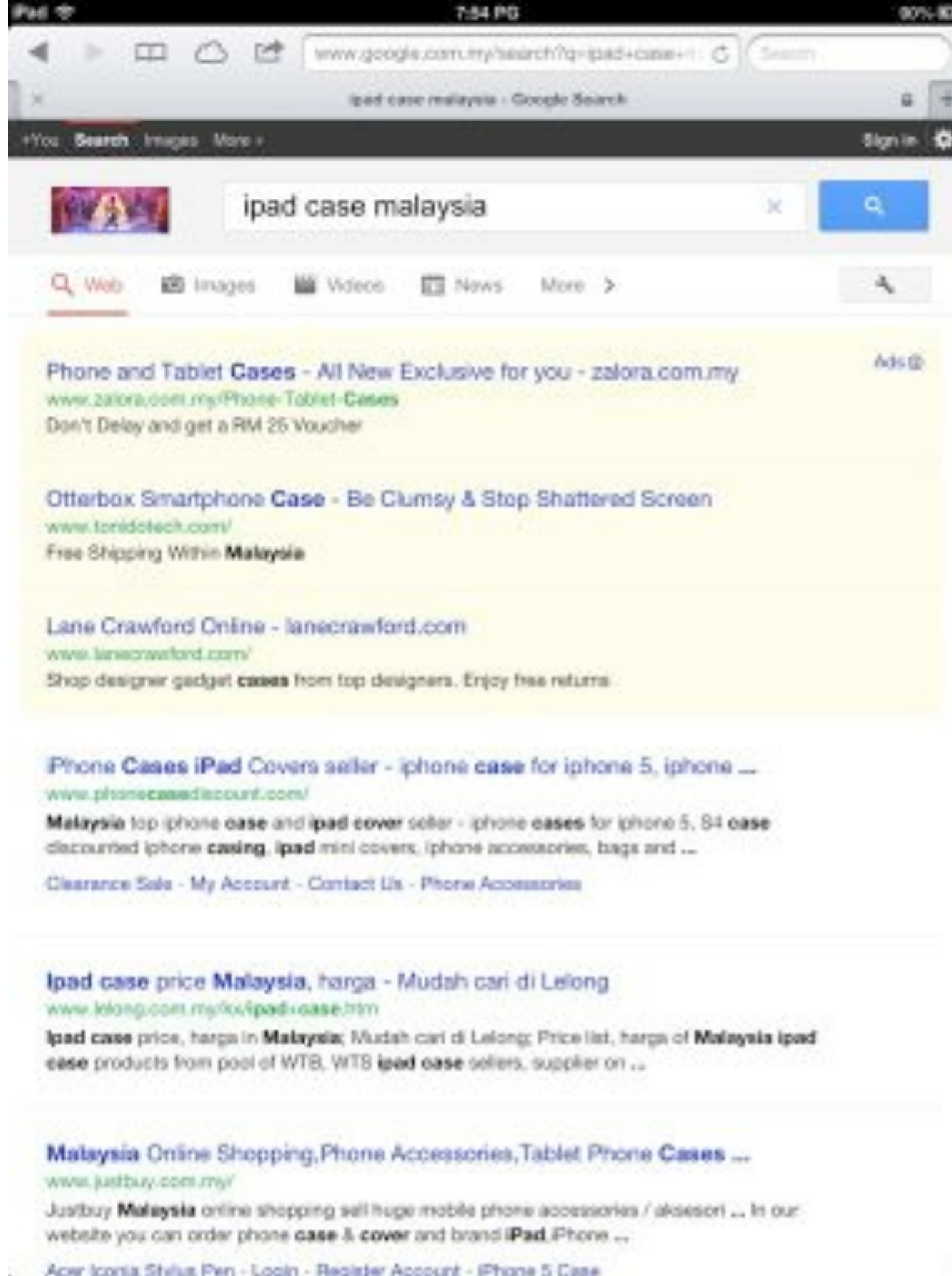
There are many ways to share a web page. You can also save the page to Bookmarks here.



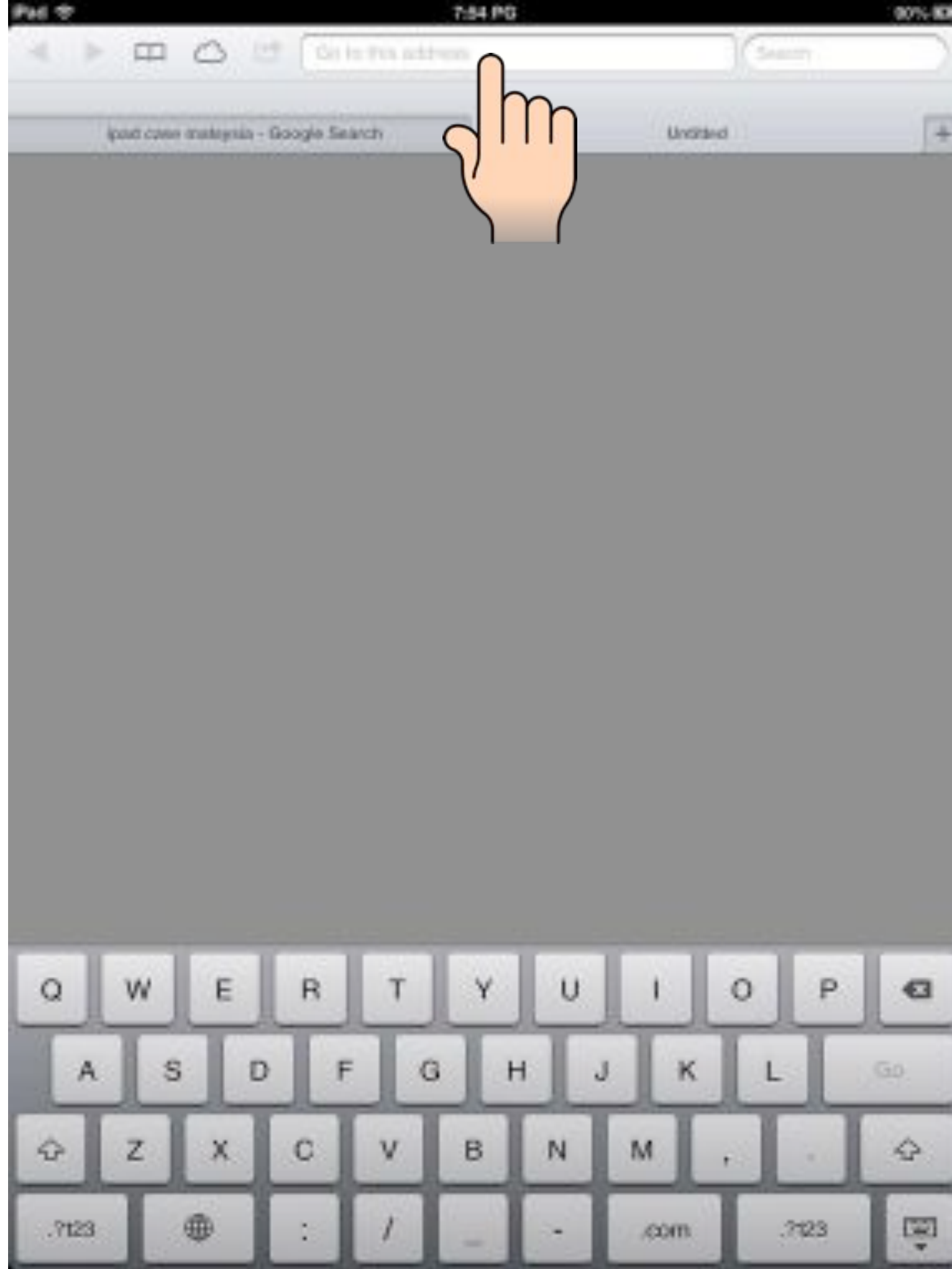
This field is used for Search. Type in what you are looking for.



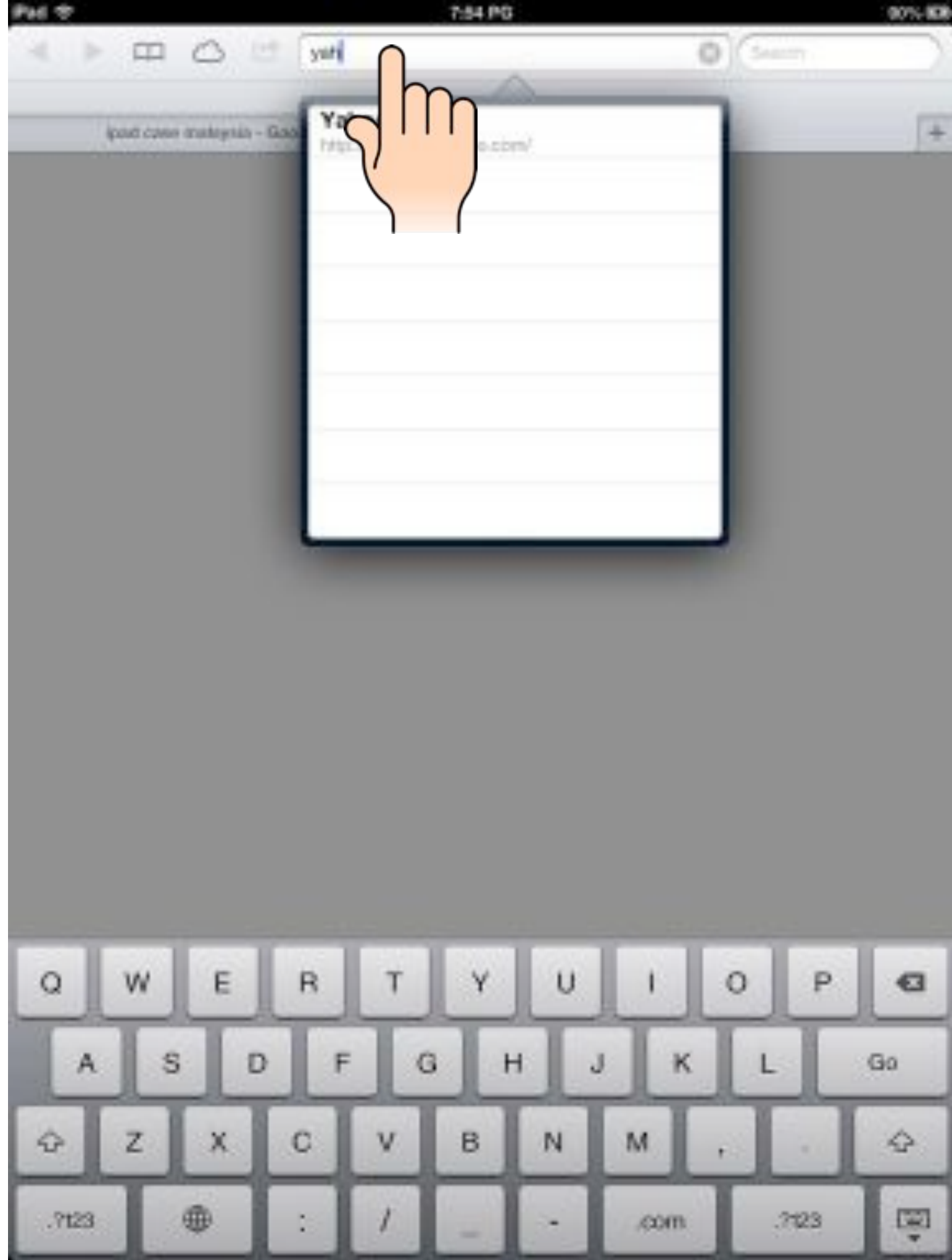
You can tap a search suggestion, or tap Search.



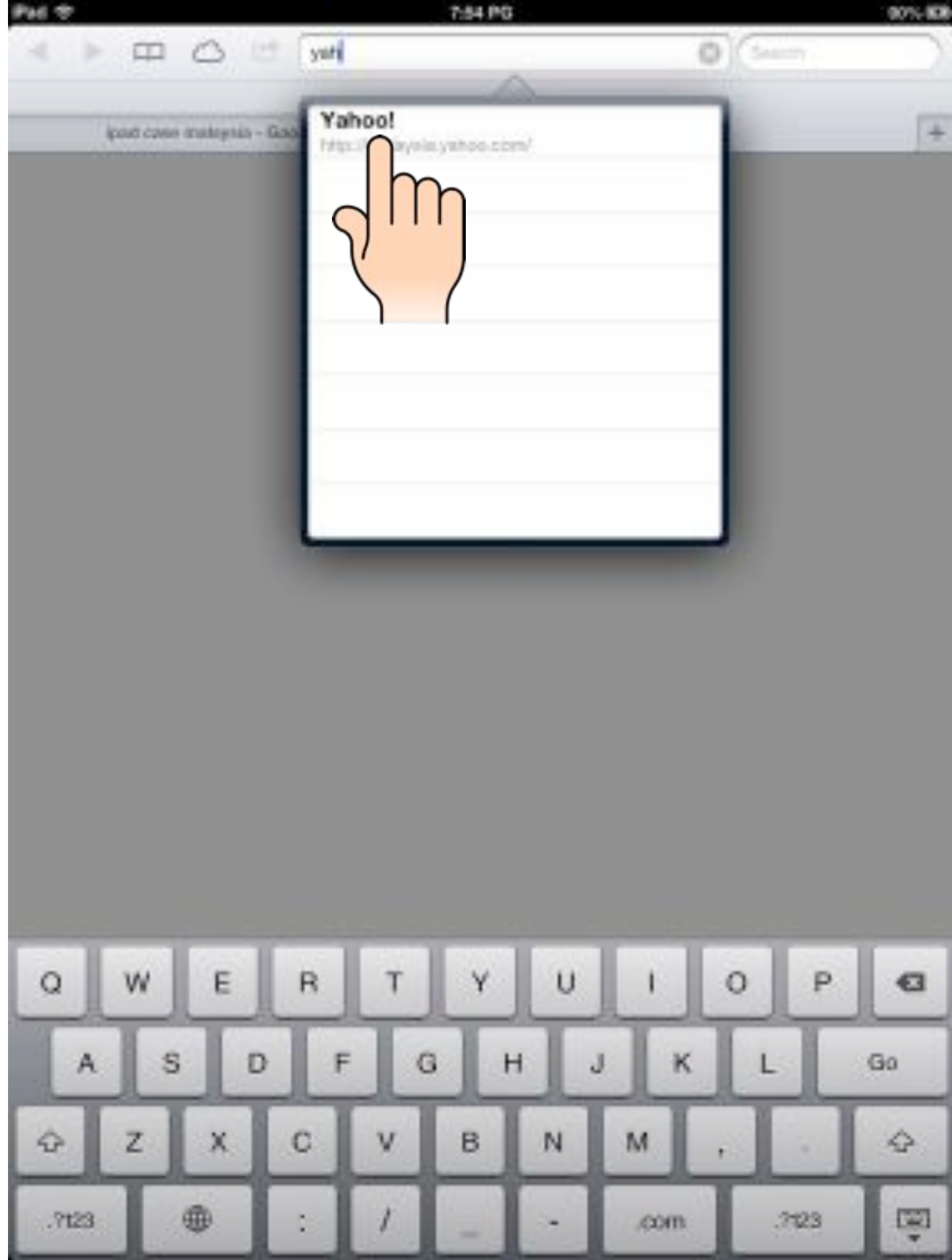
Results of the search are displayed. Tap +.

Tap Yahoo!.

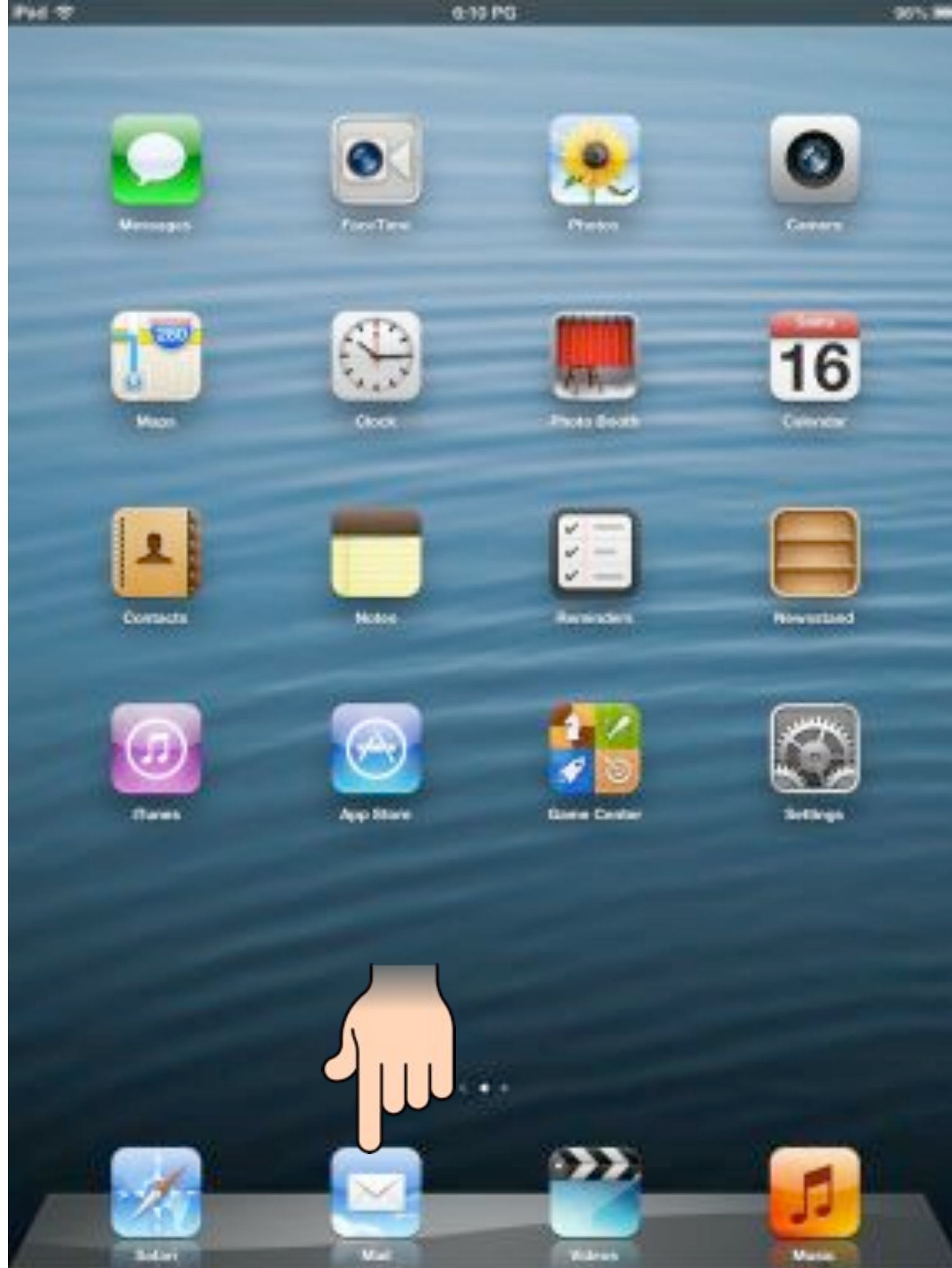


The Yahoo page is displayed.

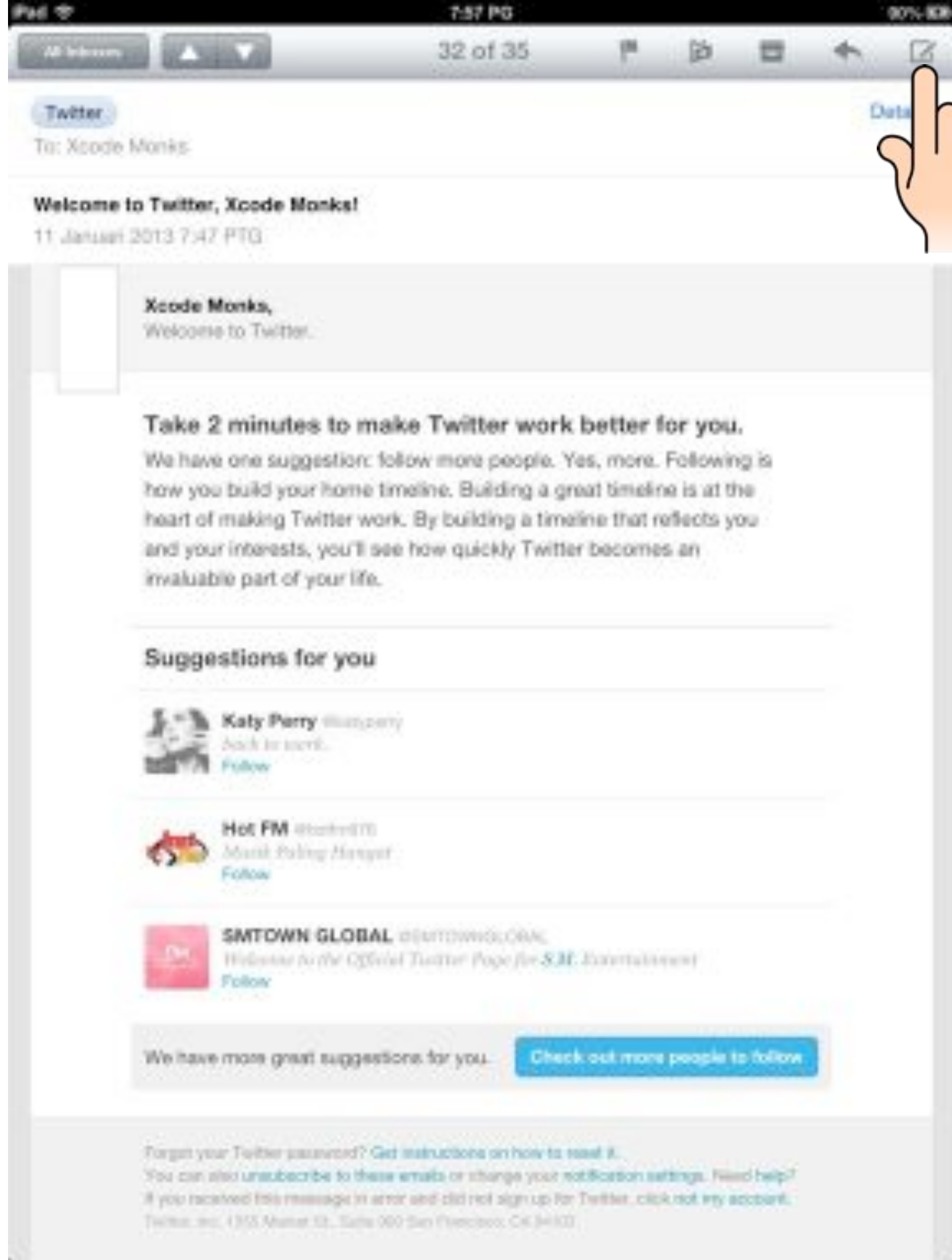


Press the Home button to return to the starting screen.

7.13 Mail



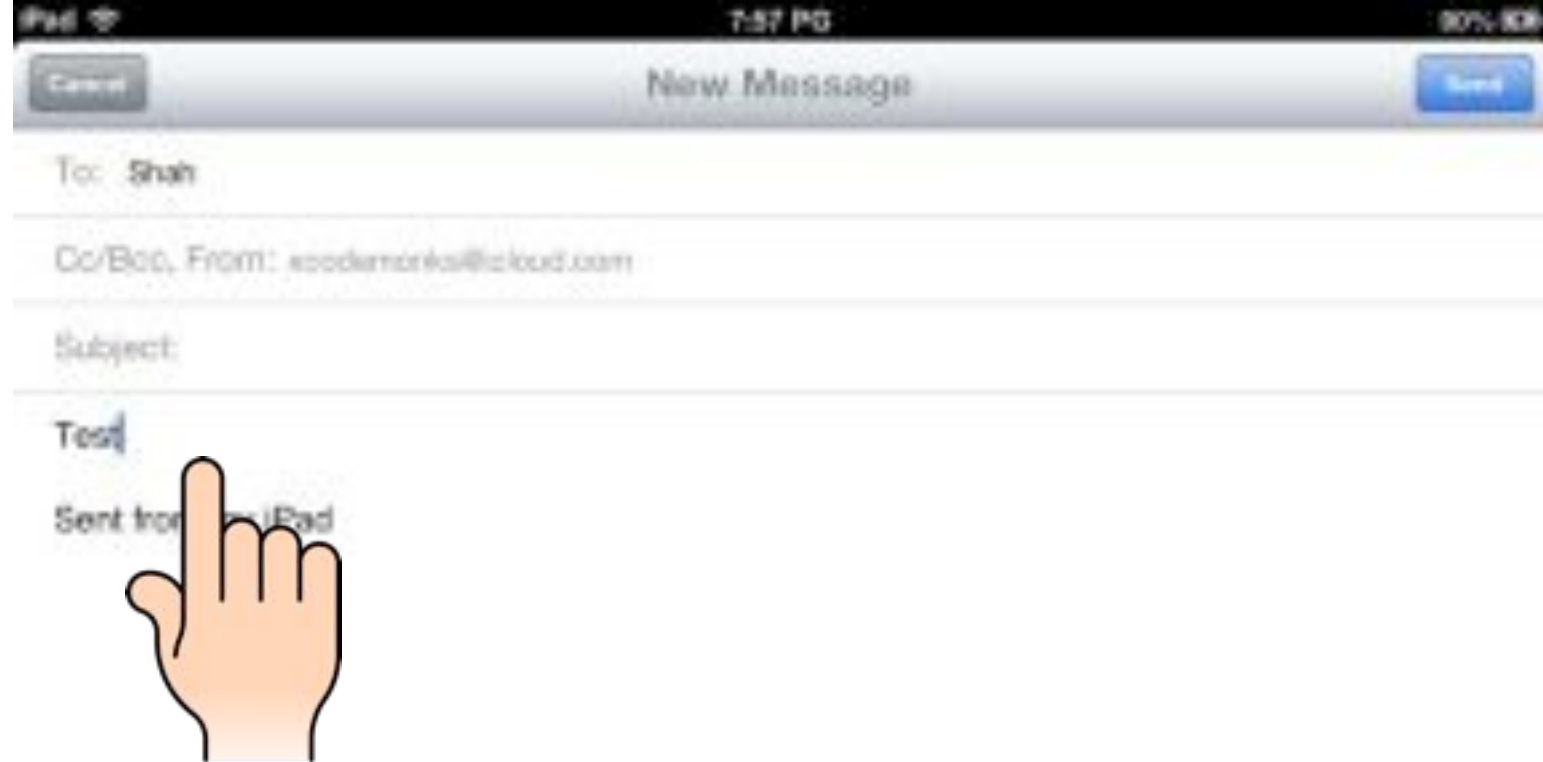
Tap Mail.



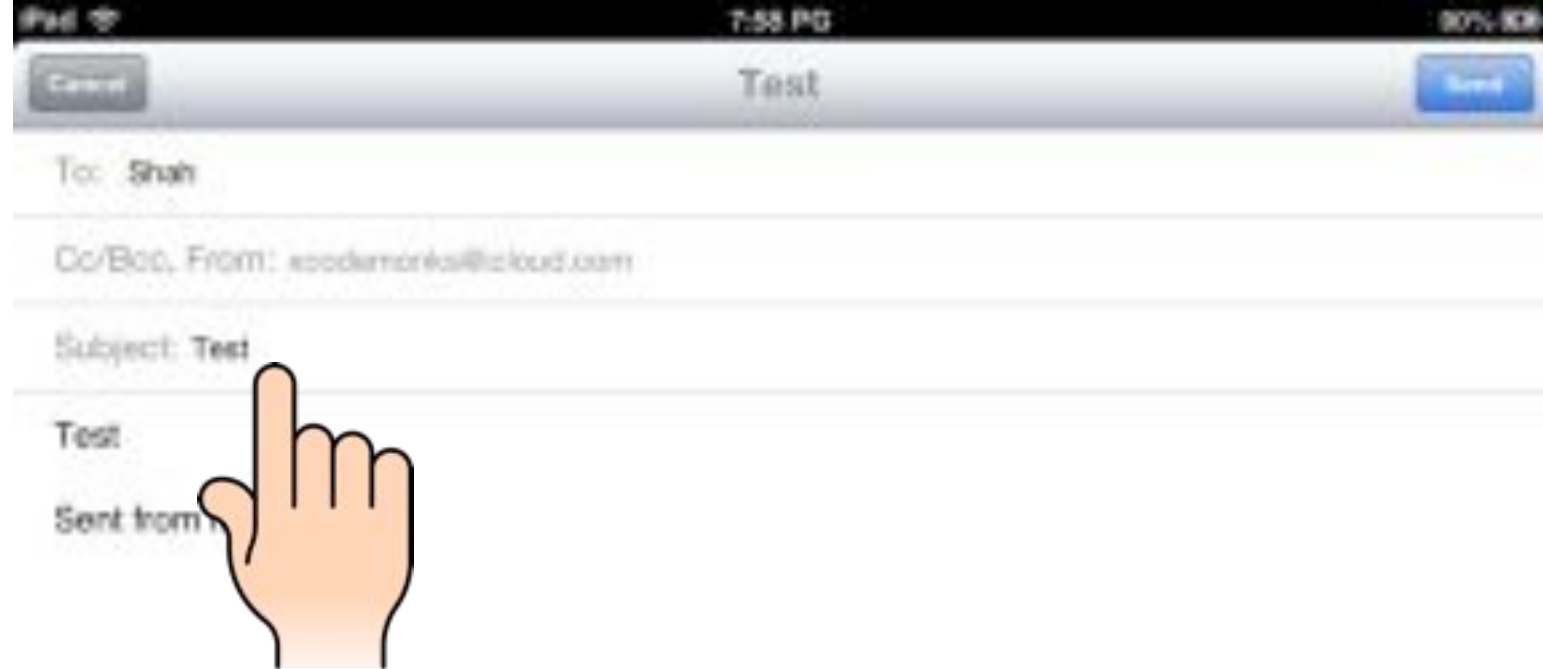
Your emails are displayed. Tap the control to create a new email message.

Tap the body of the email and type in some words.



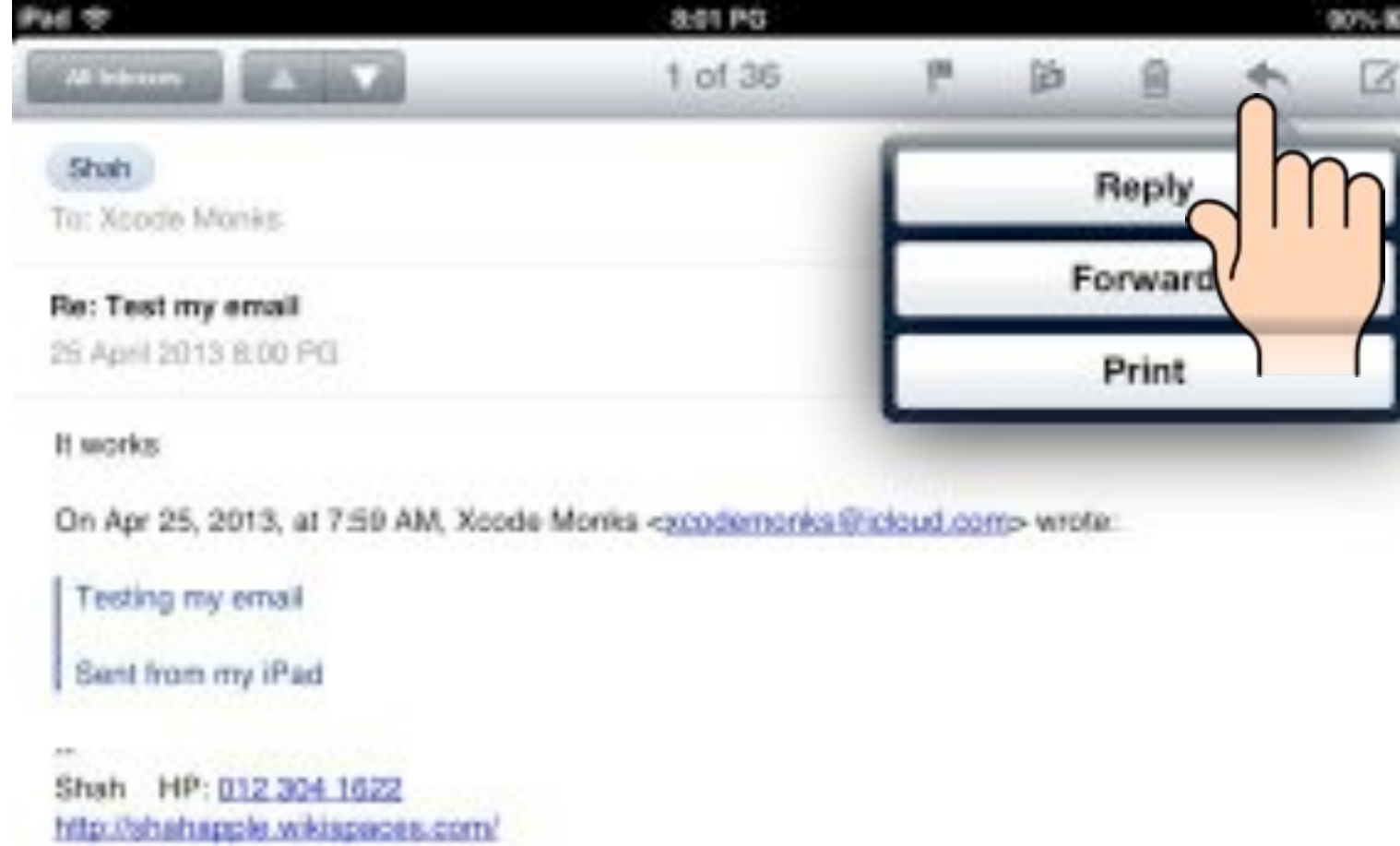
Tap the subject field and type in some words.



When you're happy with your email, tap Send.



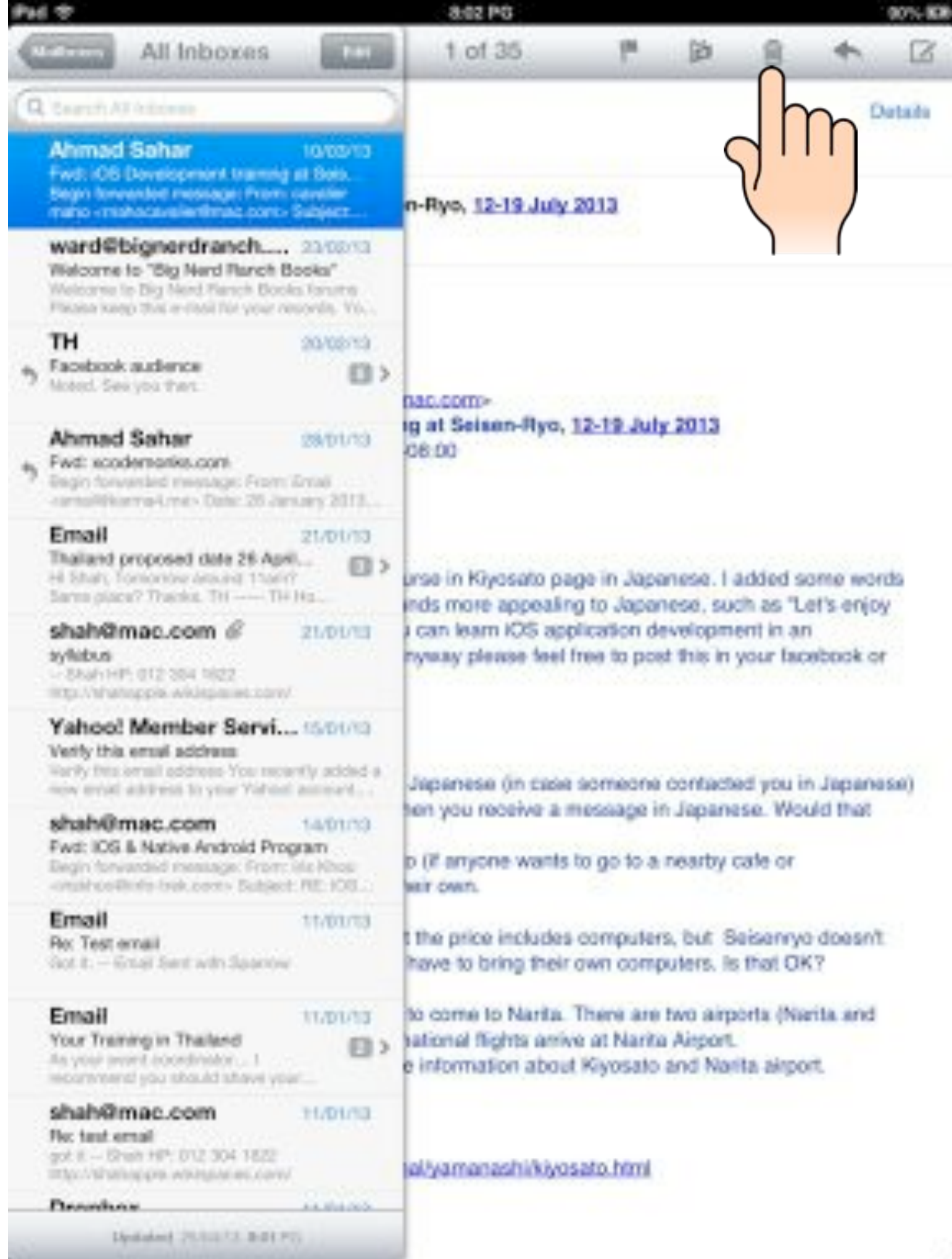
When the recipient replies, you'll see it on screen.



To reply, tap the Reply control.



Tap All inboxes to see all the mail you have received.



Tap the Trash Can to delete mails you don't want any more.



Press the Home button to return to the starting screen.

7.14 Settings



Tap Settings.



When on a plane, turn on Airplane Mode.



After you have landed, you can turn it off.



Tap Wi-Fi.



Choose the network you want.



Type in the password to the network if required.



Tap Bluetooth.



If you don't have any Bluetooth peripherals, you can switch Bluetooth off. iPad only uses Bluetooth to connect with peripherals, not for File Sharing or Contacts.



Tap General.



Tap Software Update.



New updates will be seen here. If your device is up to date, then the message 'Your software is up to date' will be displayed.



Tap General to return.



Tap Auto Lock. This is the time elapsed before the iPad locks itself.



Choose a lock time that you prefer.



Tap General.



Tap Passcode Lock.



Tap Turn Passcode On. Now when your iPad is locked, you'll need to enter a passcode to unlock it.



Type in your desired Passcode.



Type it in again to verify.



Tap General.



Tap Sounds. Volume and ringtone is set here.



Move this slider to increase or decrease the volume.



Tap Brightness and Wallpaper.



Brightness is controlled by moving this slider.



Tap Wallpaper.



Tap Wallpaper.



Choose a picture that you like and tap Back.



Tap Use Both.



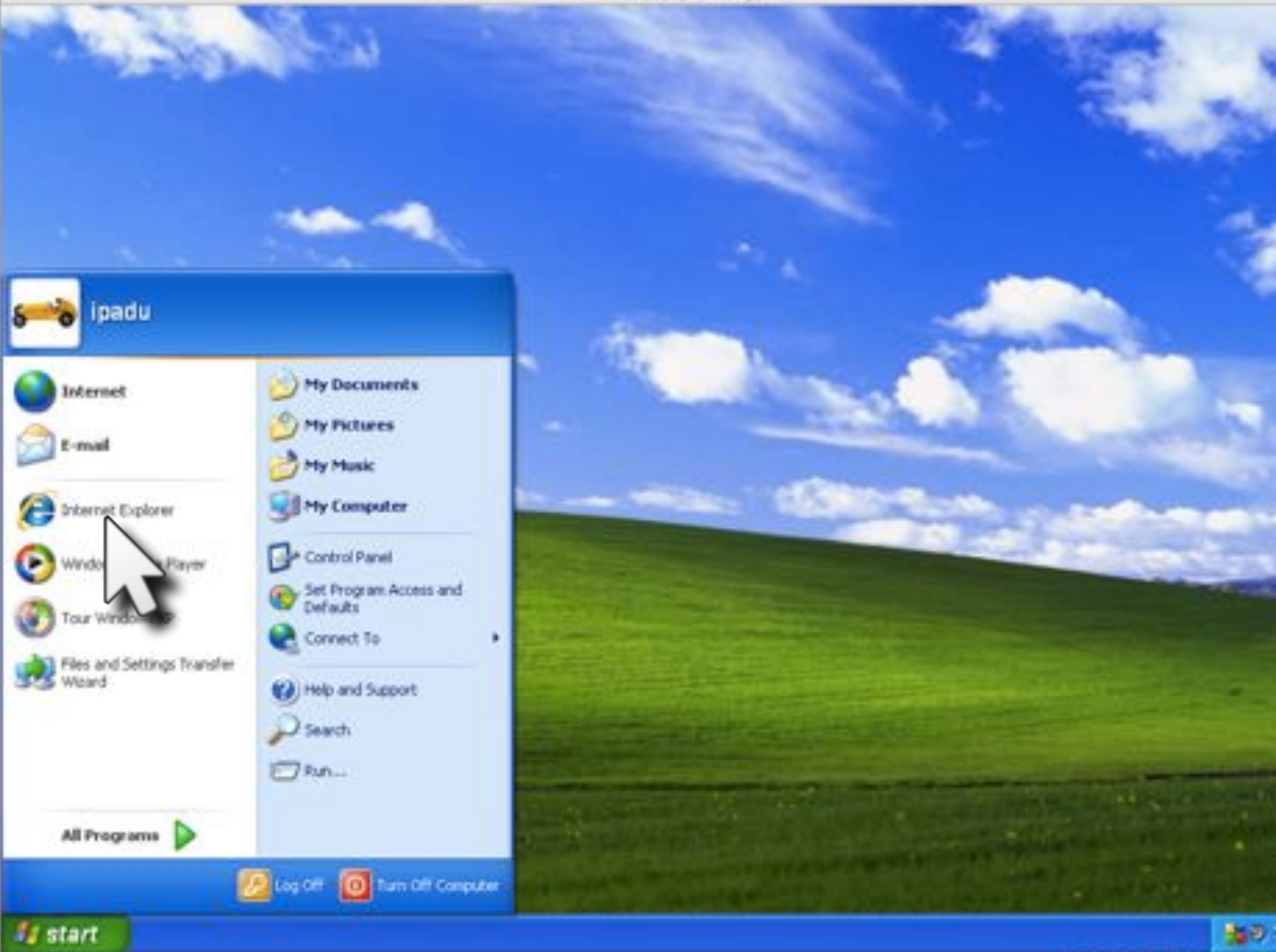
Press the Home button to return to the starting screen.

8.1 Downloading iTunes (PC)



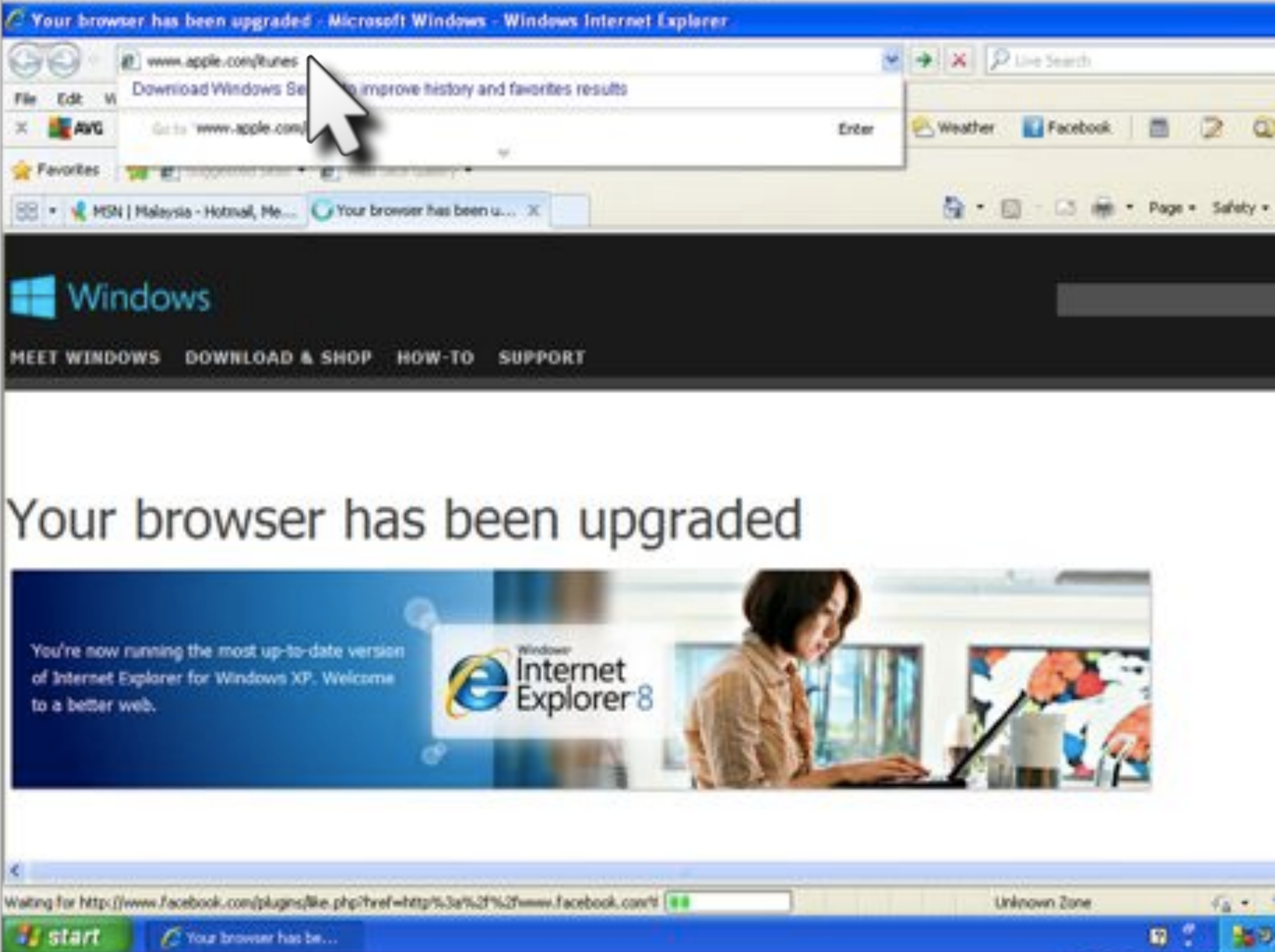
Click Start.

Click the URL field.

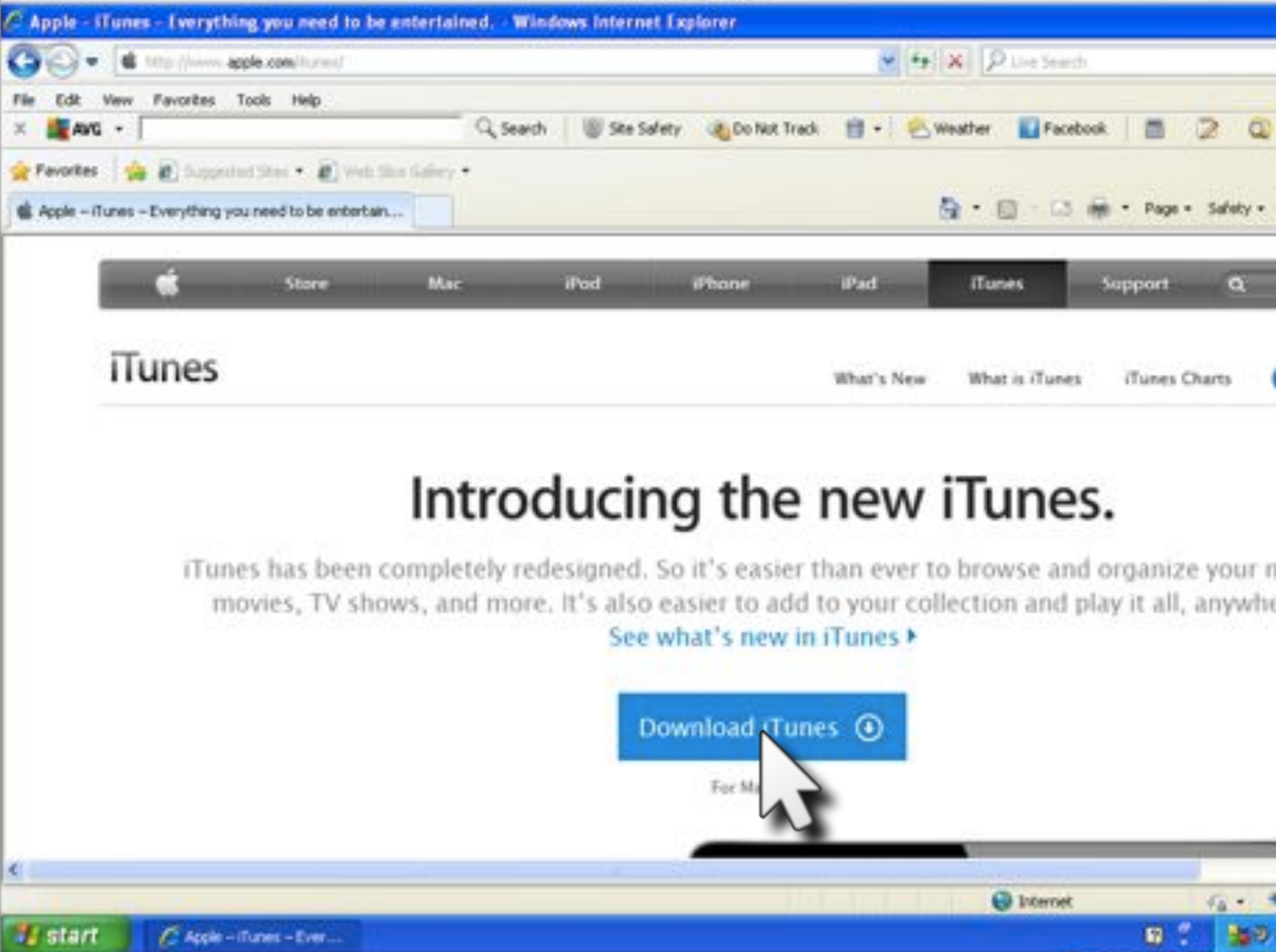

Click the Red button to quit Internet Explorer.

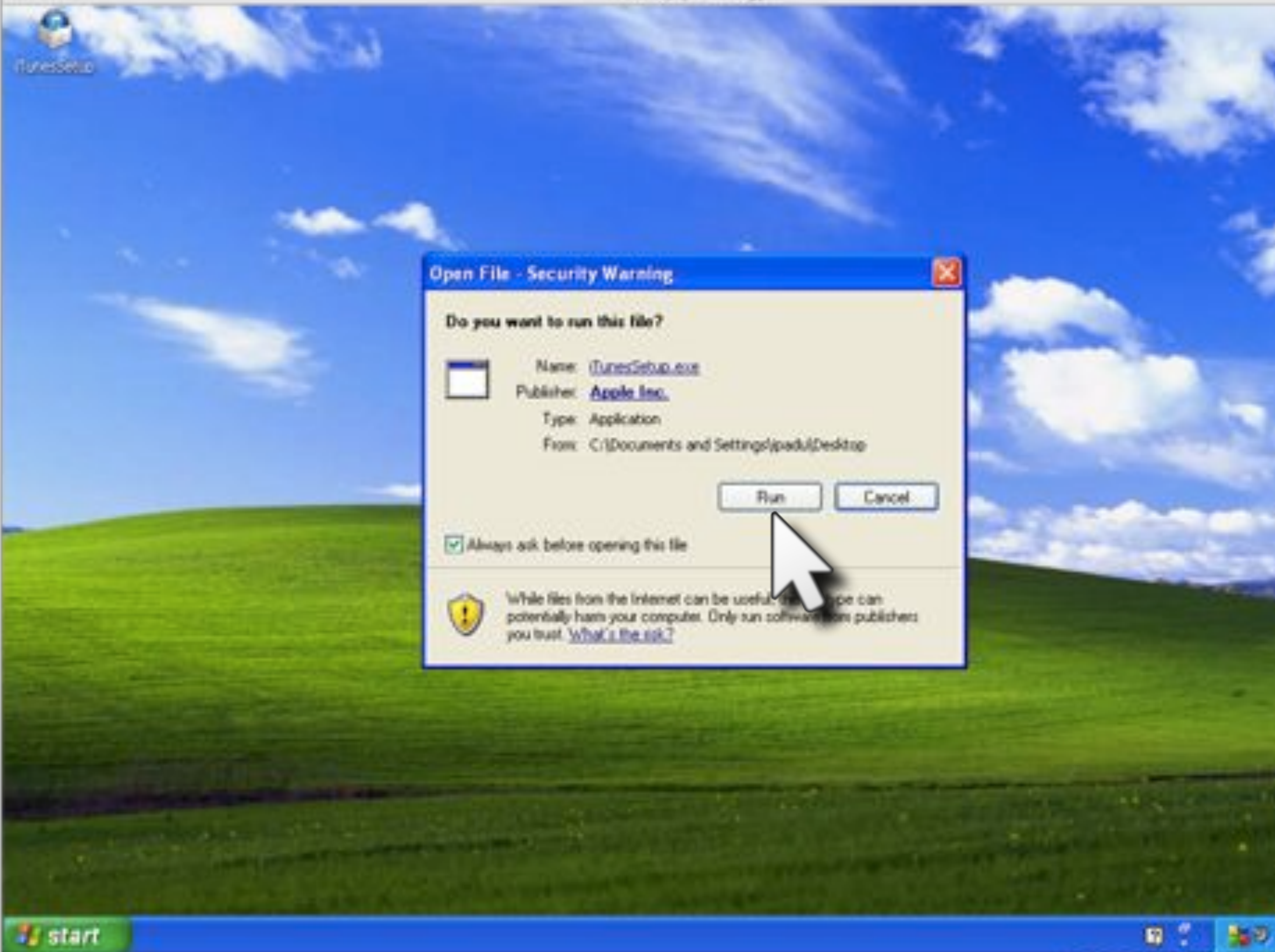


You will see the iTunes installer on the Desktop.

Connect the iPad to the computer using the USB cable provided.



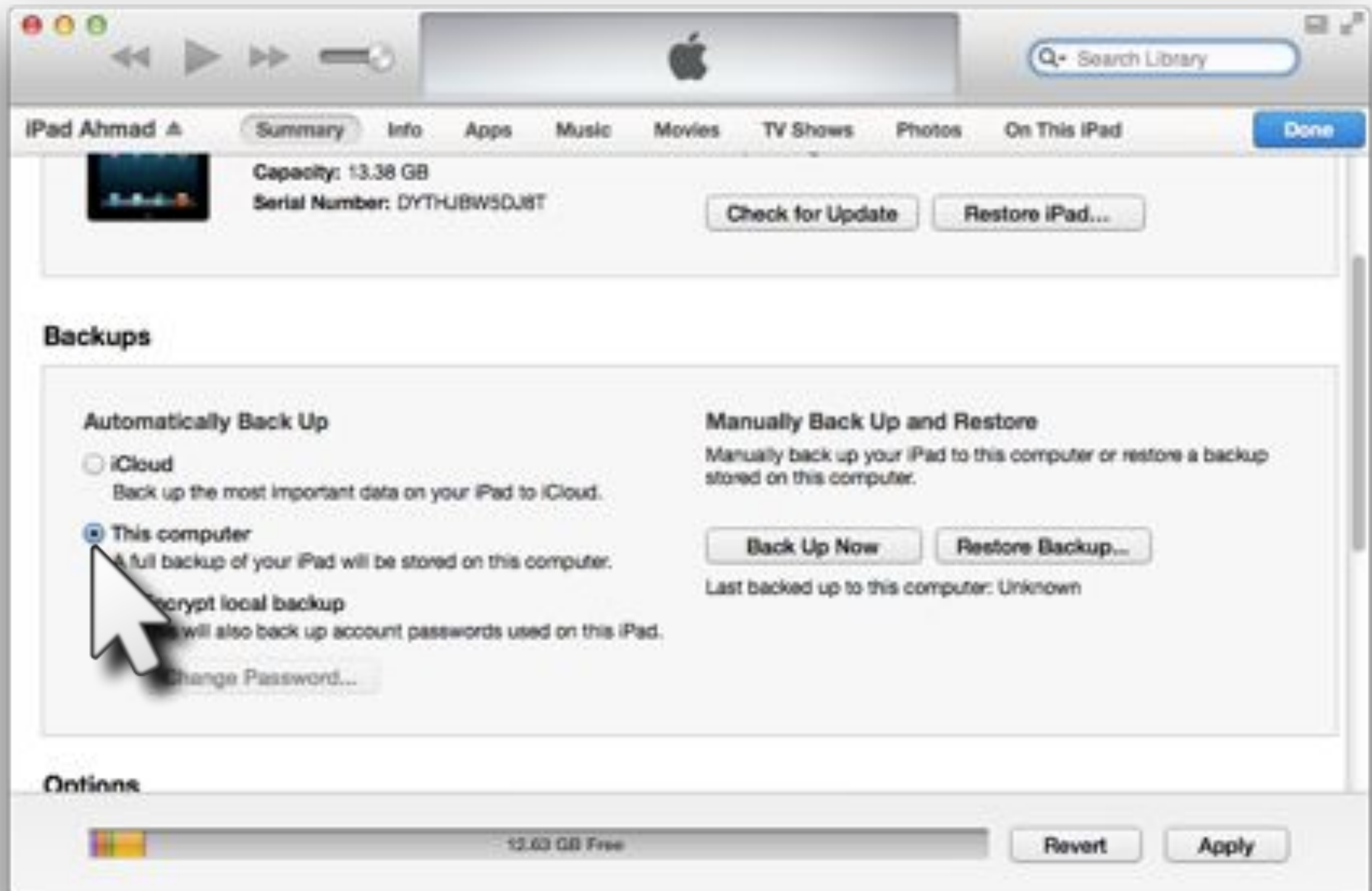
iTunes displays the following message. Click Set up as new iPad.



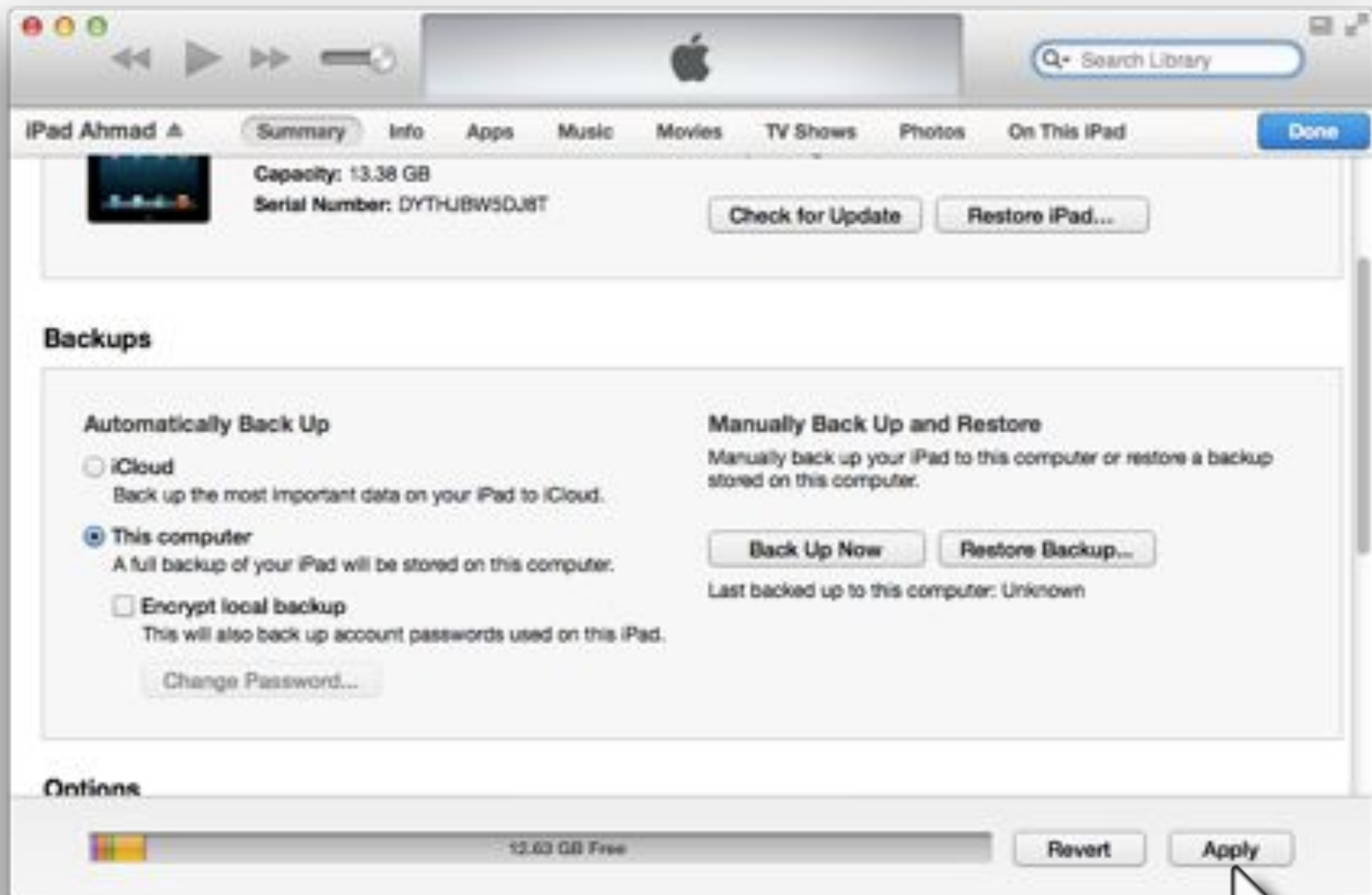
Click Continue.



Click Get Started.



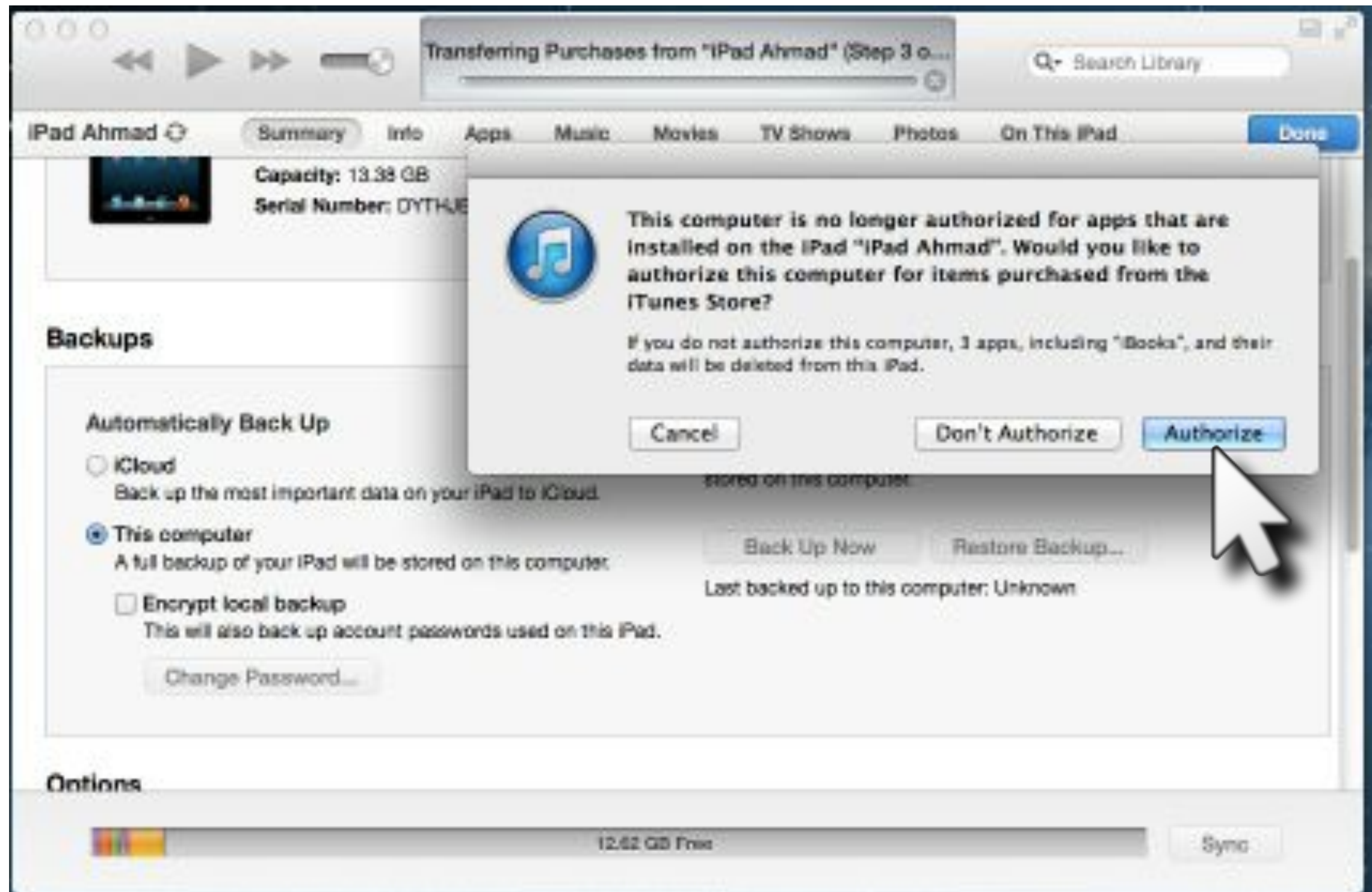
Click This computer.



Click Apply.



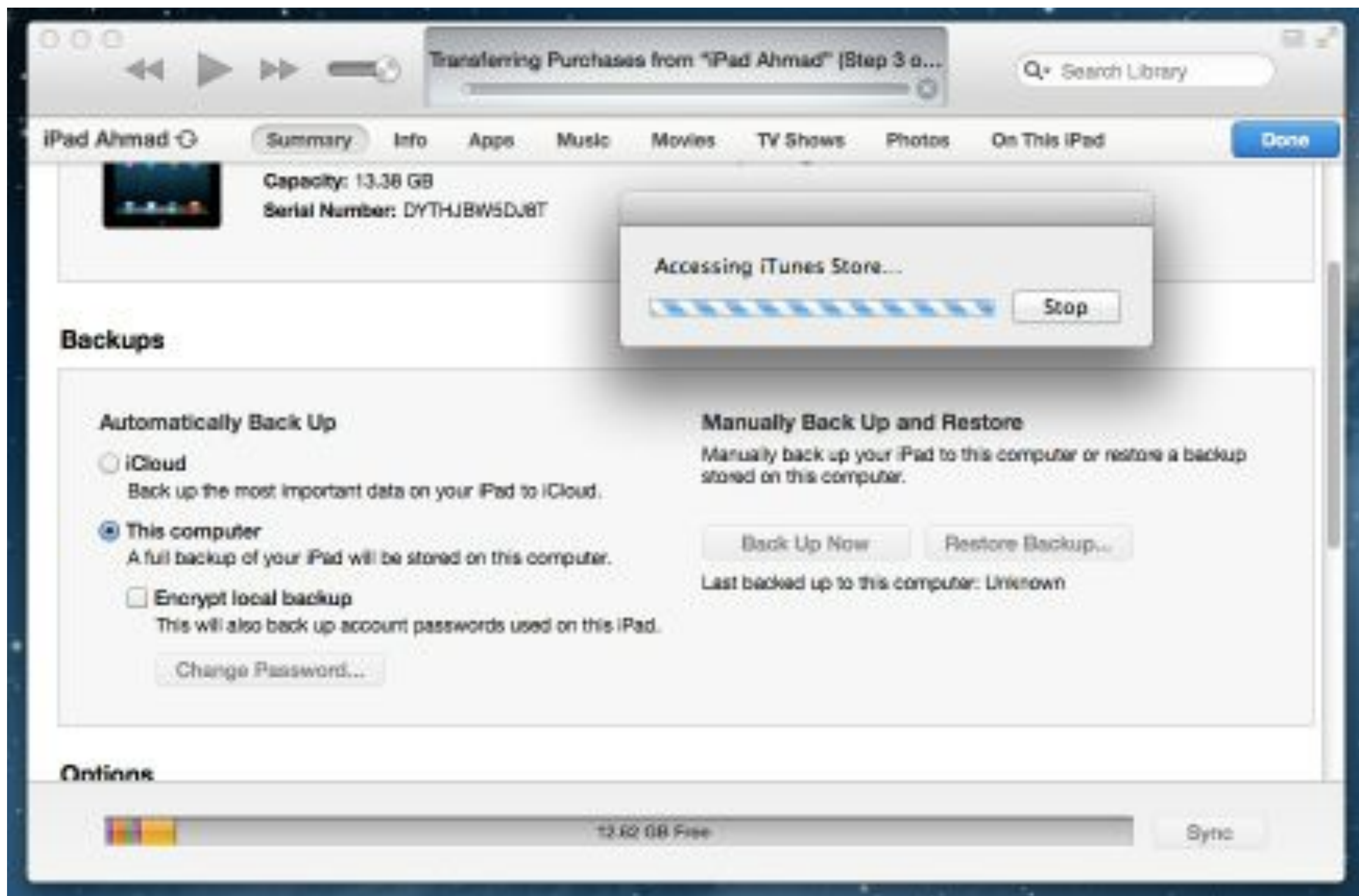
Click Sync.



If you see this message, click Authorize.



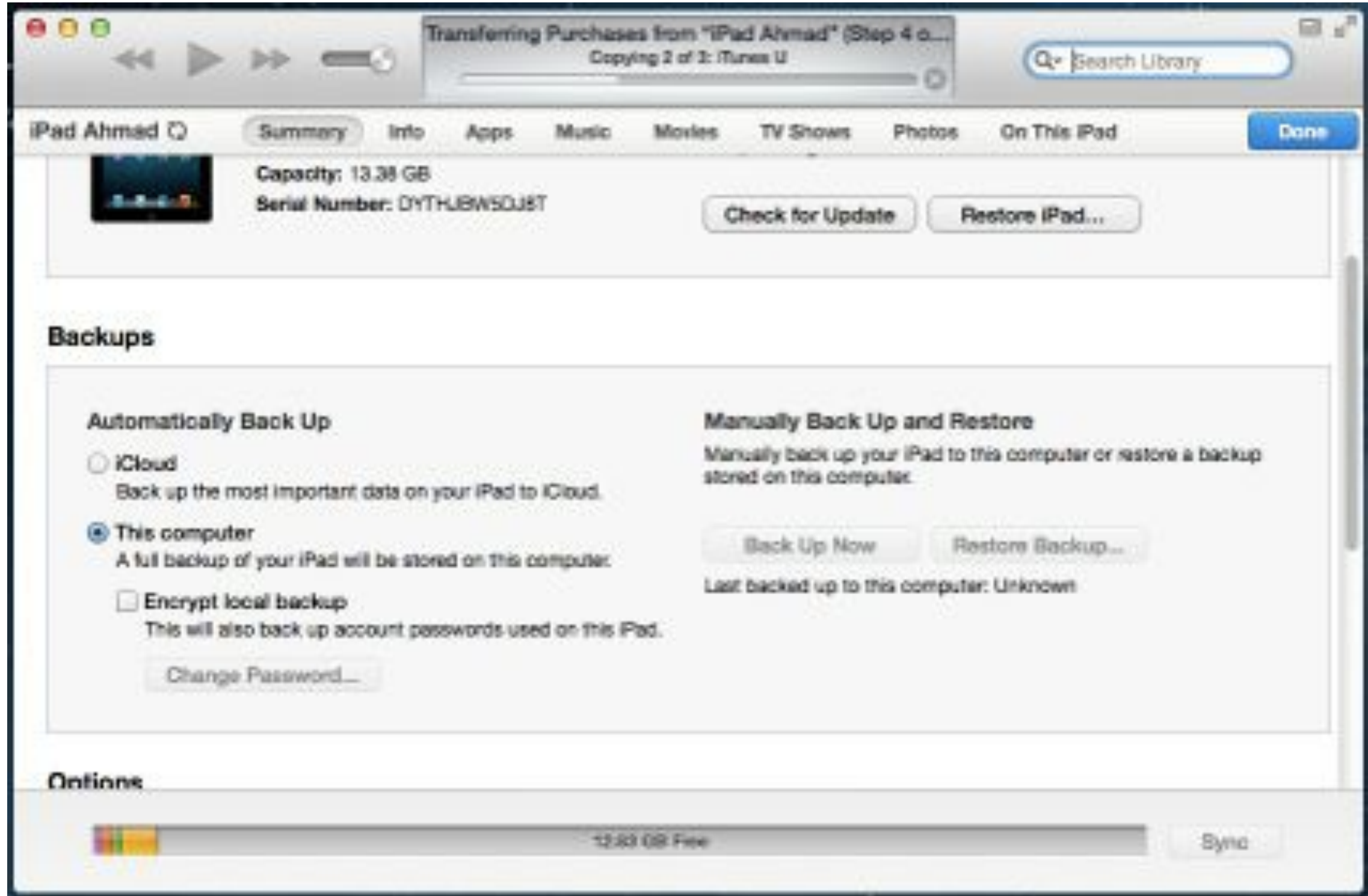
Enter your Apple ID username and password, and click Authorize.
