

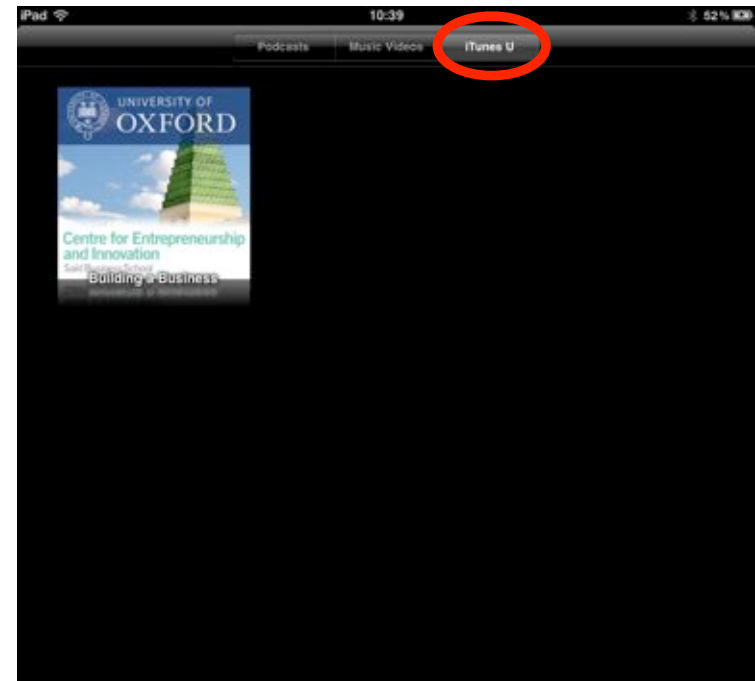
# Introduction to iPad

Tap the Videos icon on the iPad.



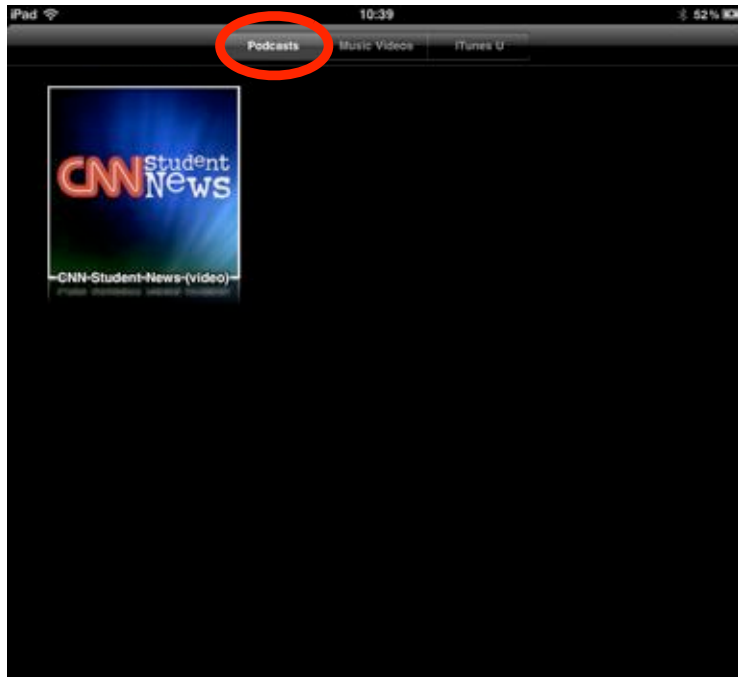
Tap iTunes U to see iTunes U content. To watch the video, tap it.

Tap on Podcasts to see your Podcasts.

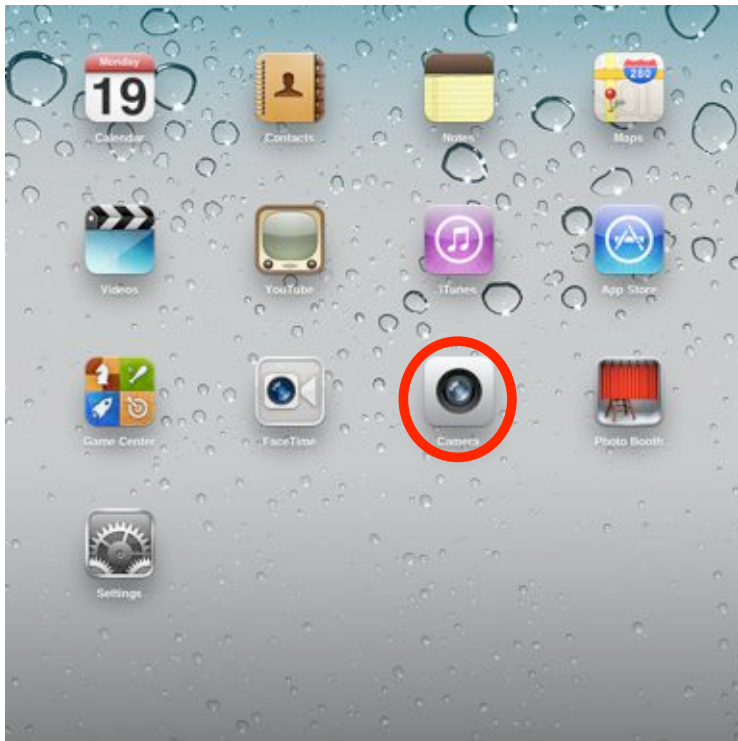


Tap the play button to play the selected video.



Camera

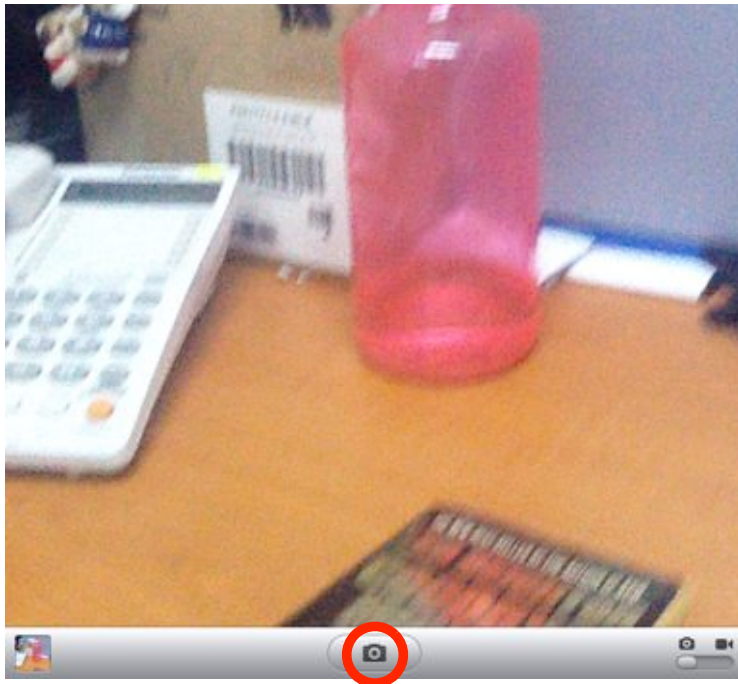
The video plays. When you are done, press the iPad button to return to the home screen.

Tap the top button to switch between front and back cameras.

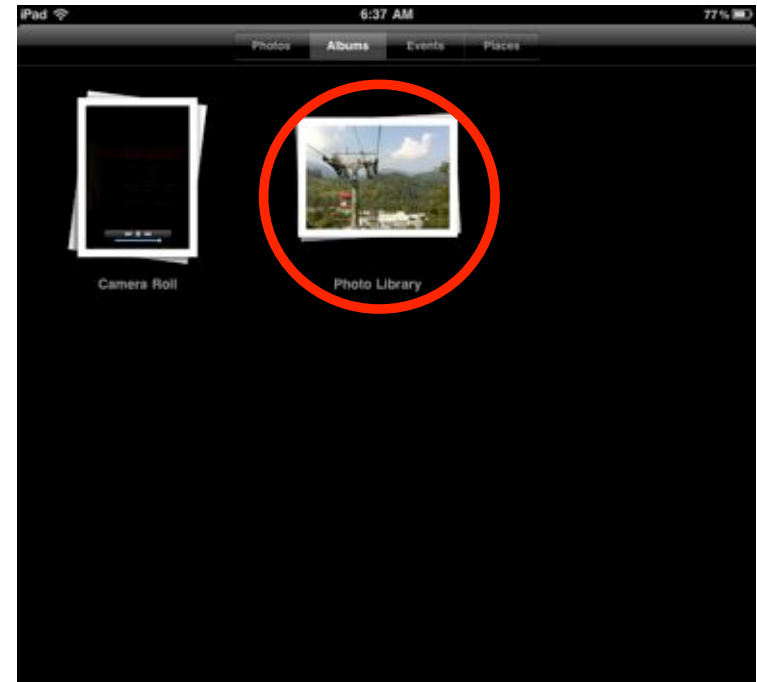


# Photos

Tap the bottom button to take a still picture. Press the iPad button to return to the home screen.

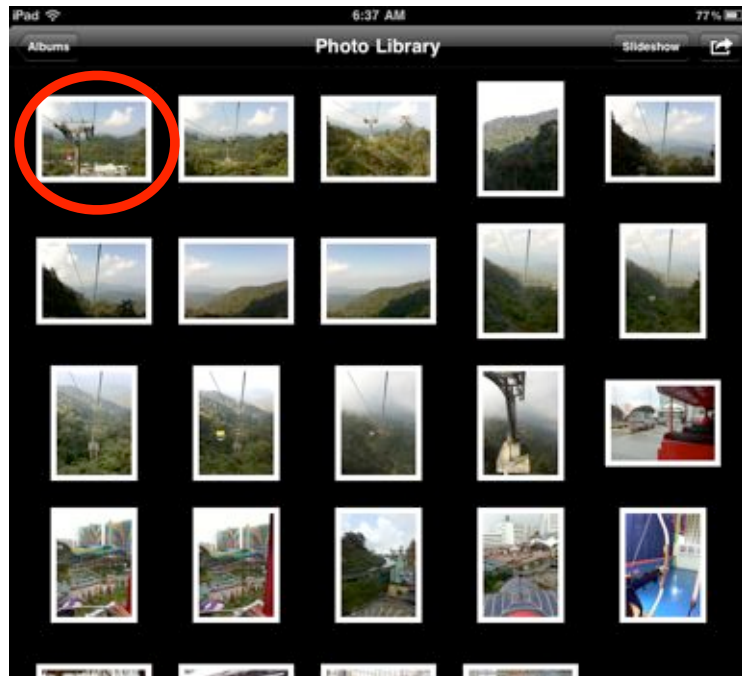


Tap the Photos icon on the iPad.

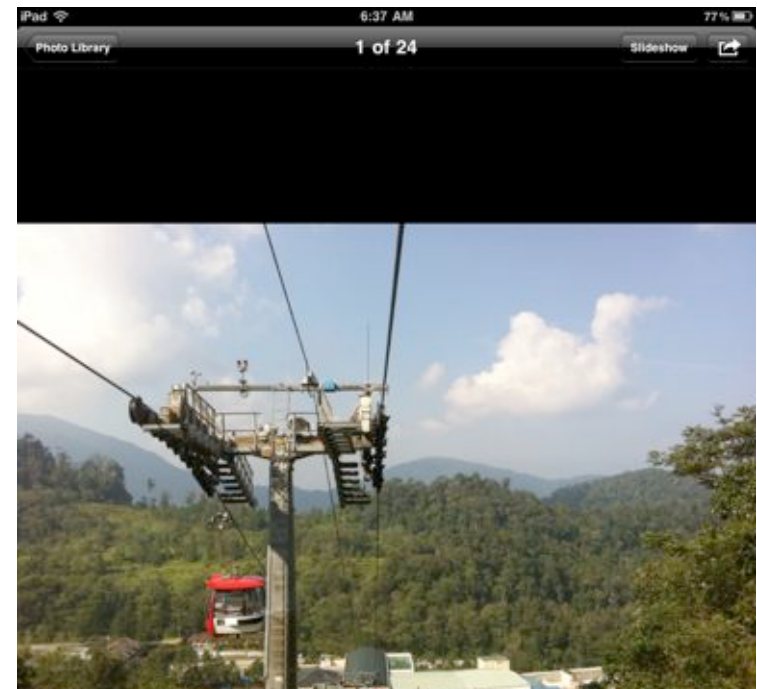


Tap Photo Library.

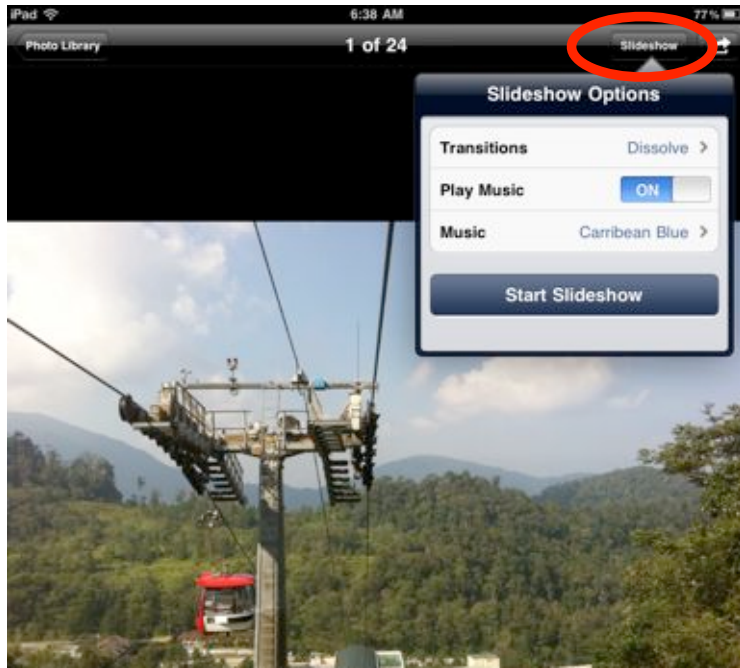




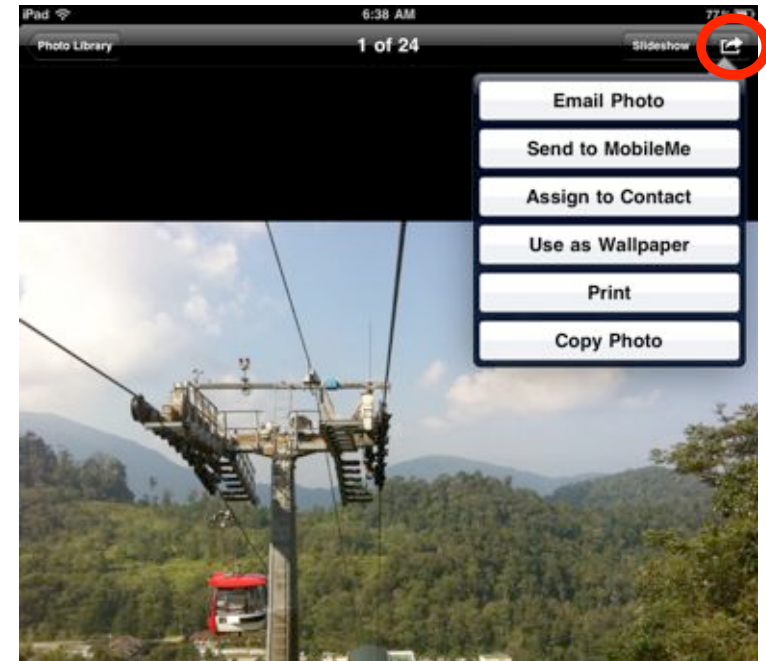
Tap any Photo to see it.

Tap slideshow to play a slideshow of photos.

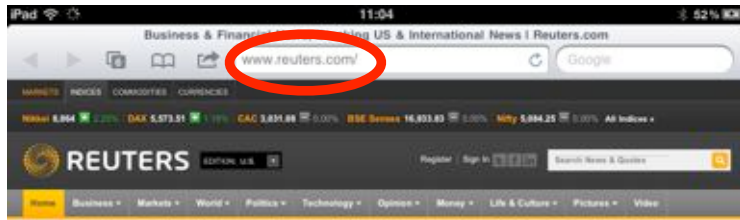


Tap the action icon. See the additional things you can do. Press the iPad button to return to the home screen.

# Safari



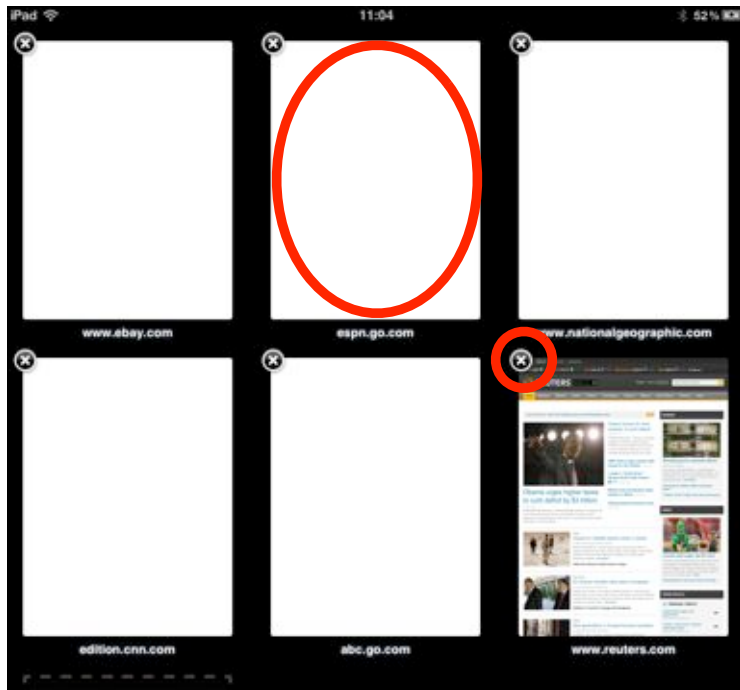
Tap the Safari icon on the iPad.



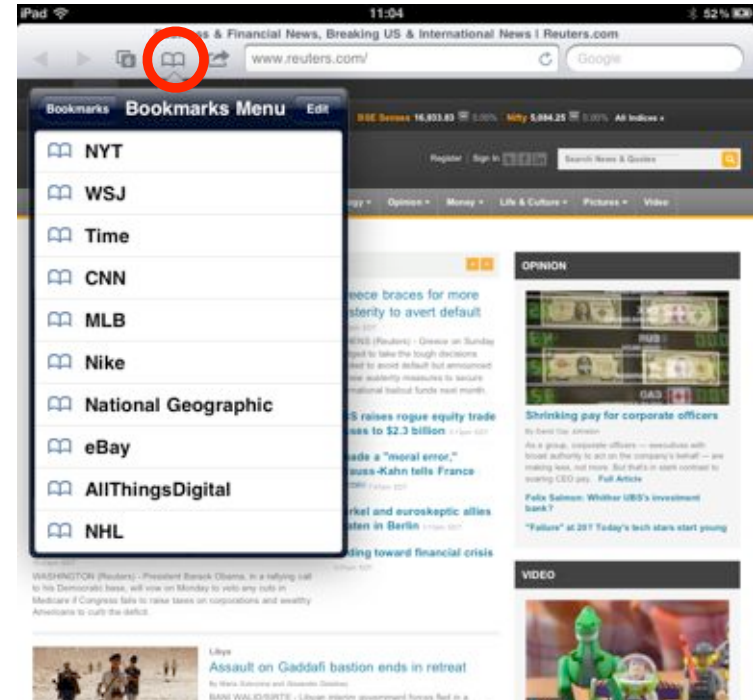
Type a URL in the URL field to go to the specified website.



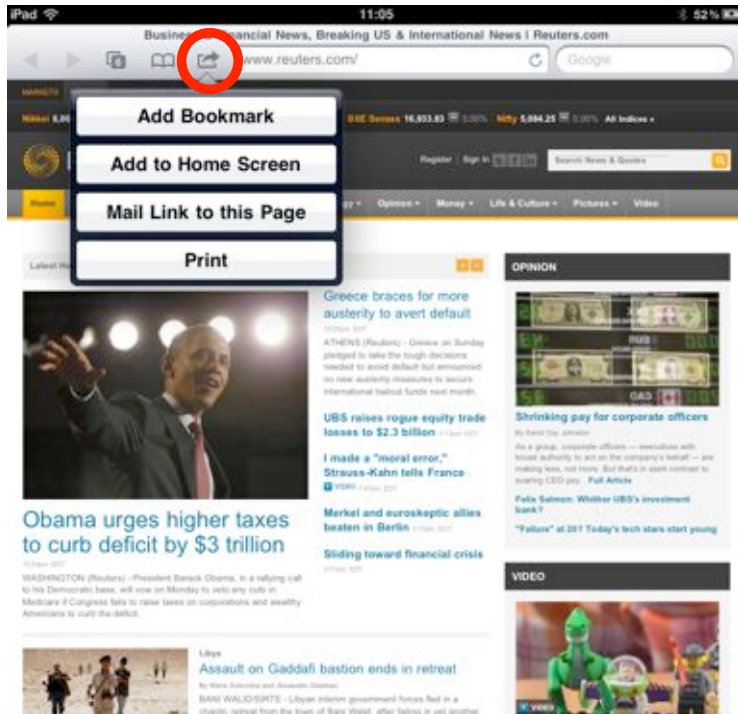
Tap the window button to create a new web browser window.



Tap a window to go to it. Tap the close button to close a window.



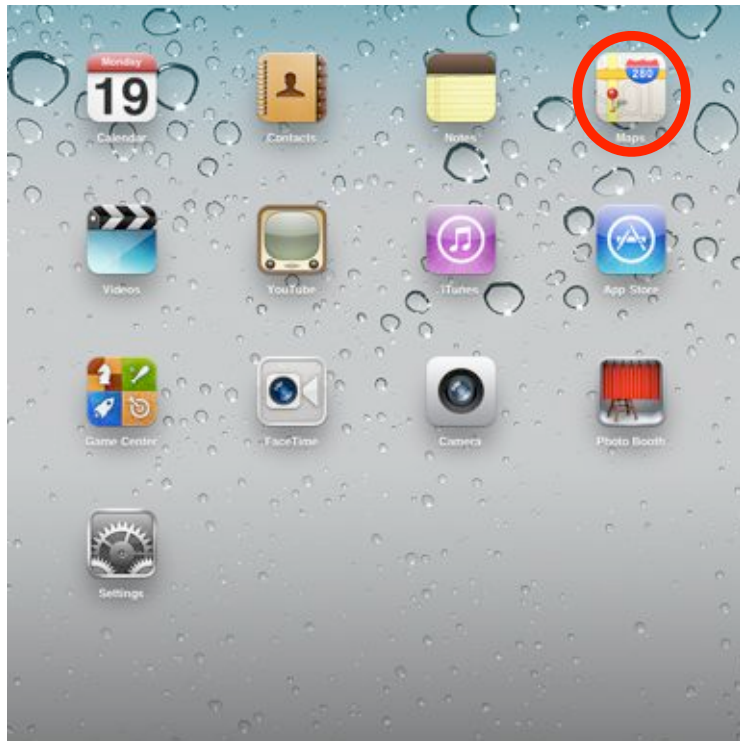
You can go to a Bookmark or Edit a Bookmark using the Bookmark menu.



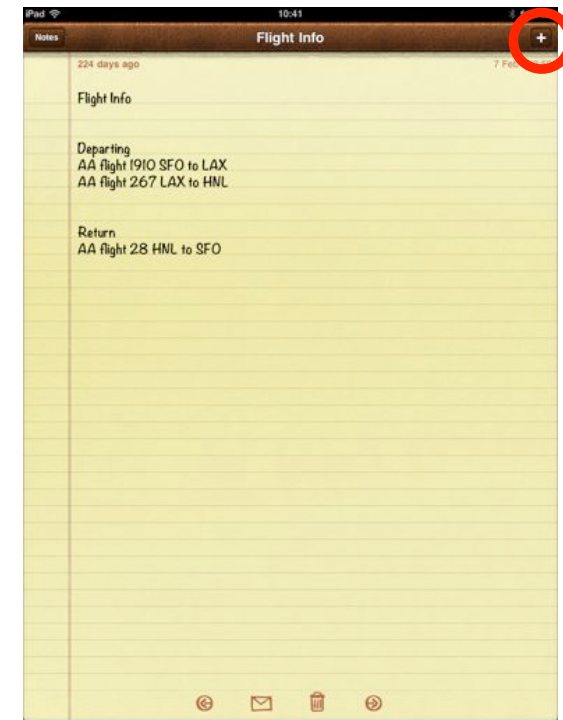
# Notes

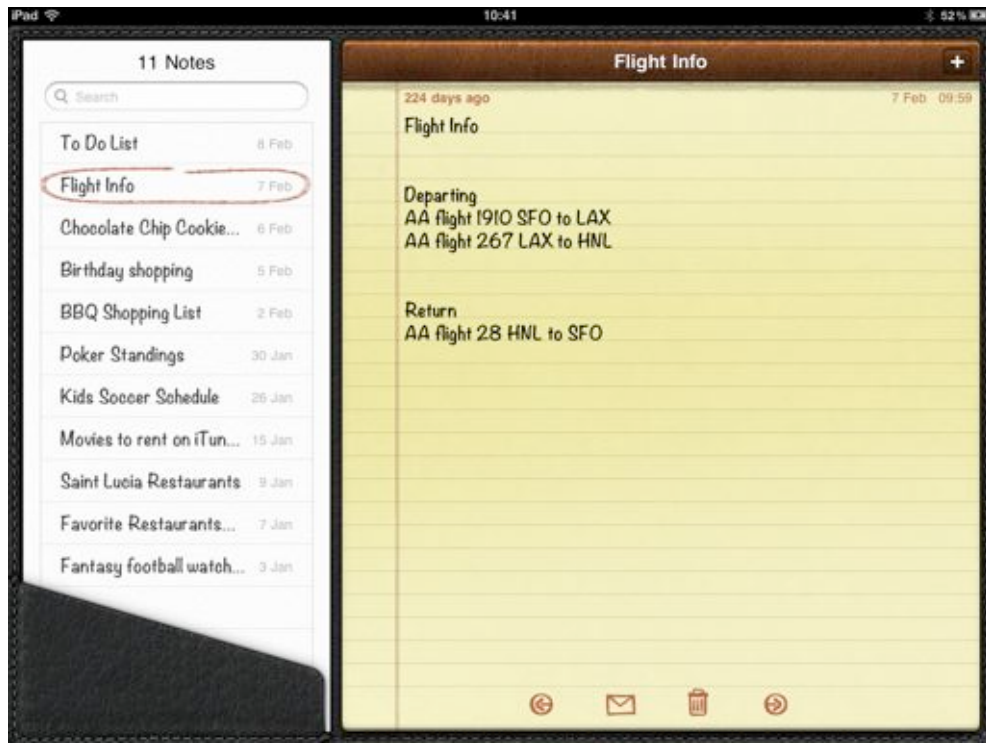




Tap the Notes icon on the iPad.



Click + to make a new note.



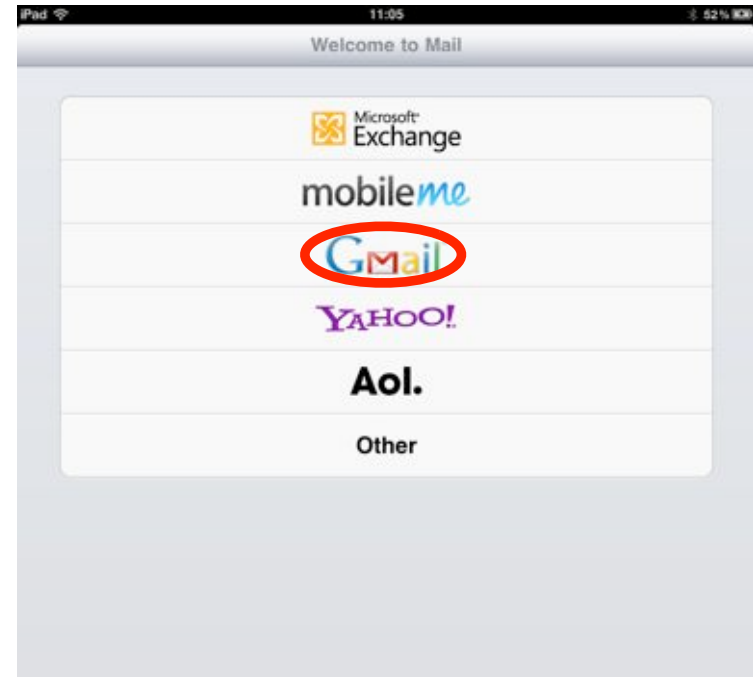
Mail

Rotate the iPad to landscape mode. You will be able to see all the notes that you have made. Press the iPad button to return to the home screen.

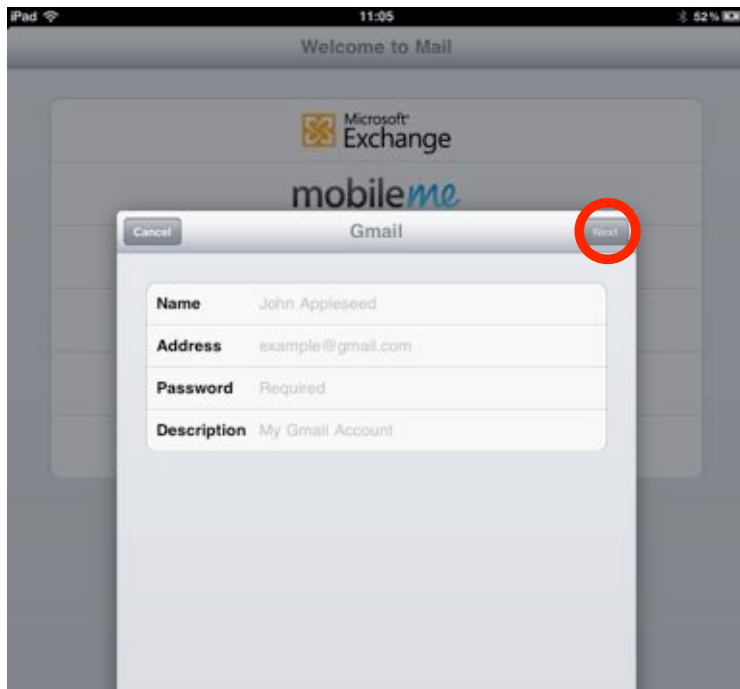




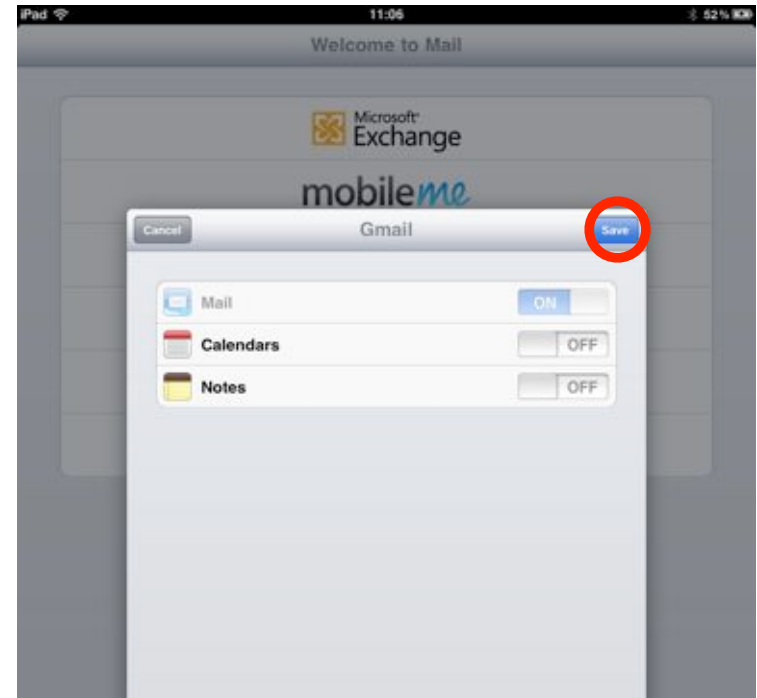
Tap the Mail icon on the iPad.



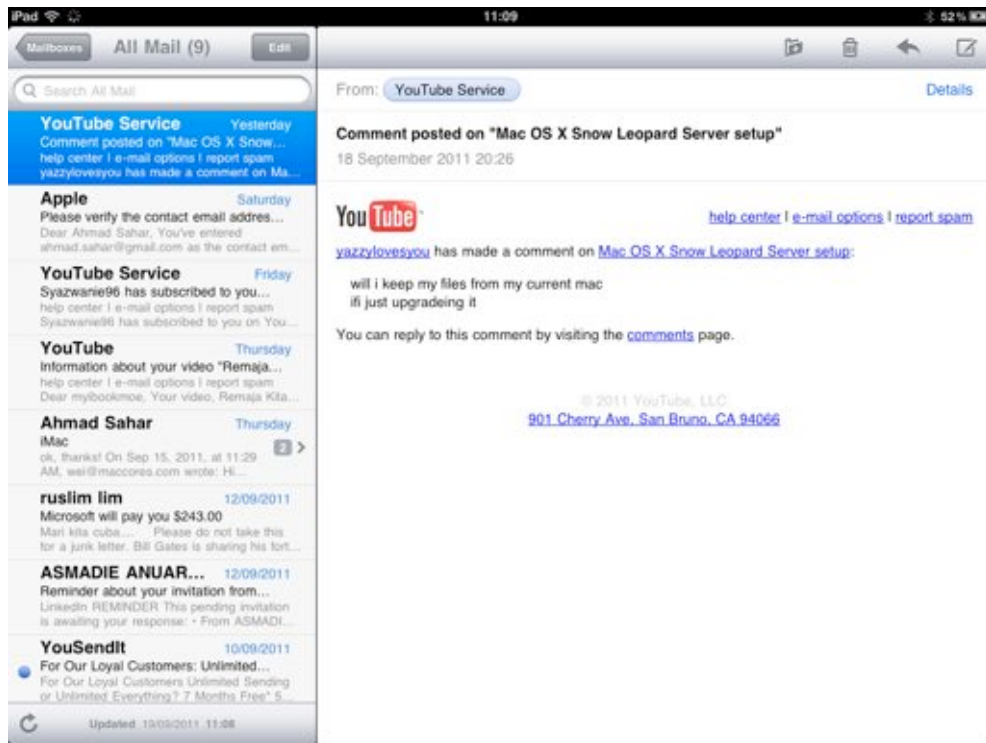
Tap Gmail if you have a Gmail account.



Enter your information in the fields given and click Next.

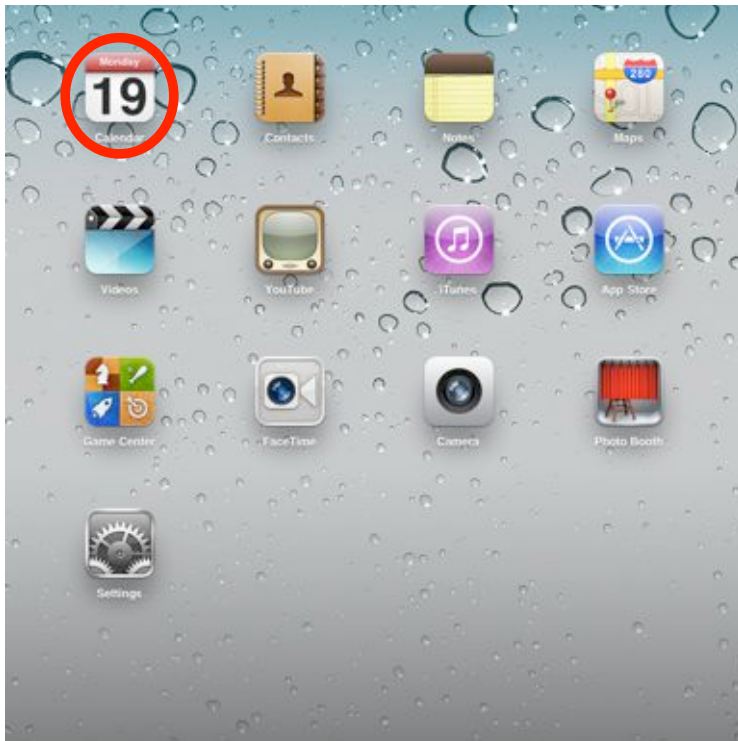


You can sync your Calendars and Notes with Gmail if you wish. Click Save.

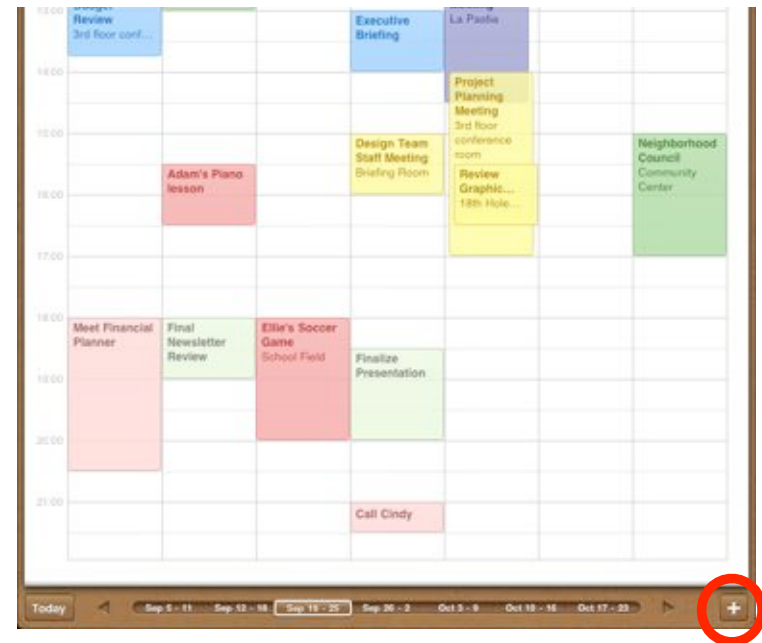


# Calendar

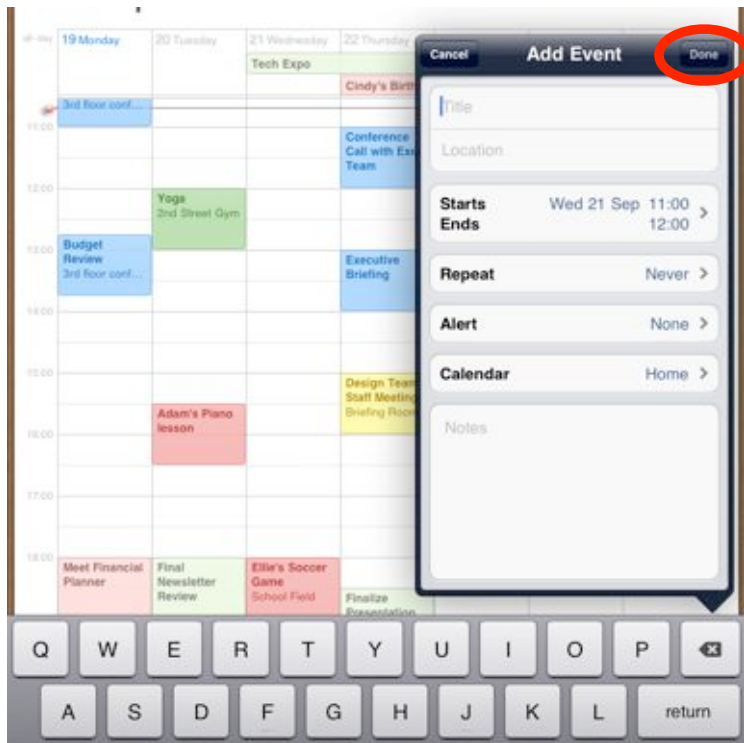
You can view your email in landscape mode by rotating the iPad. Press the iPad button to return to the home screen.



Tap the Calendar icon on the iPad.

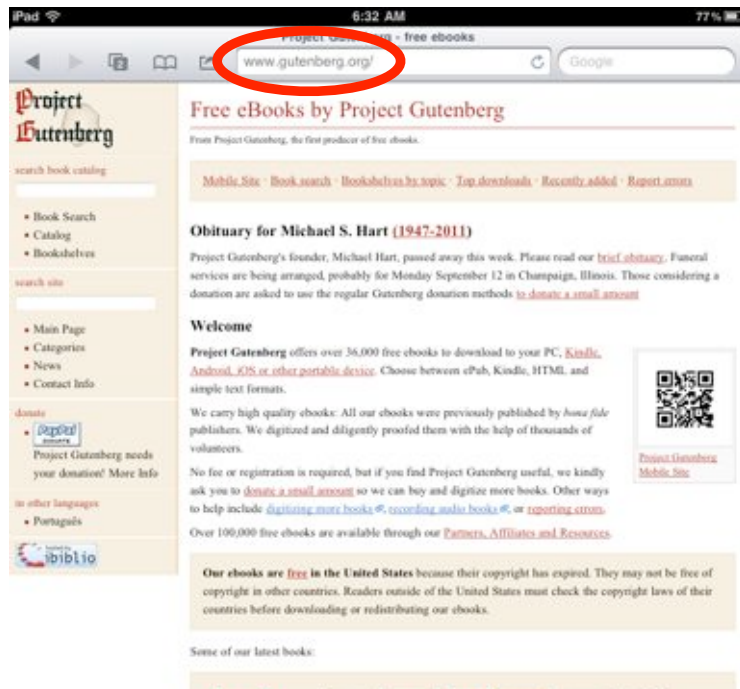


Calendar is displayed. Tap the + button.

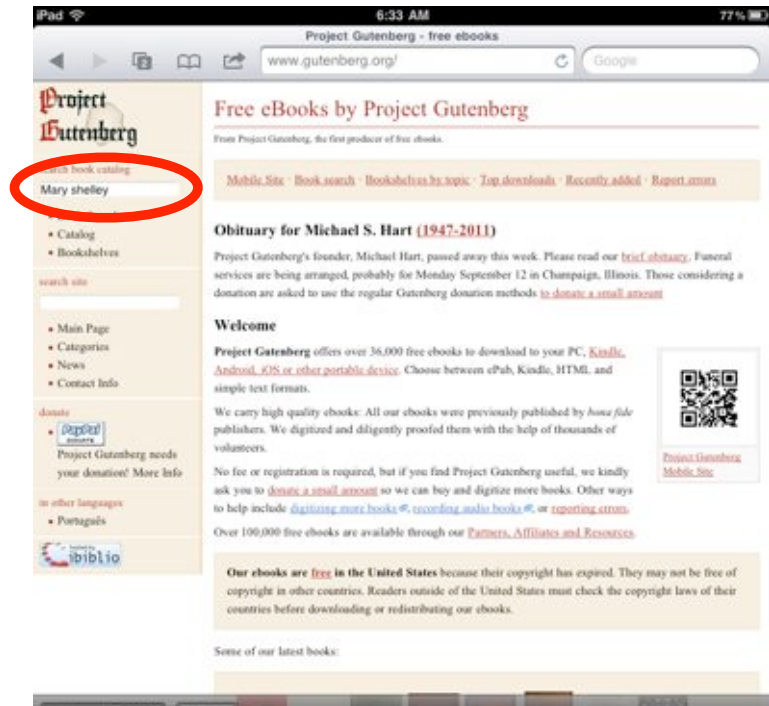


iBooks

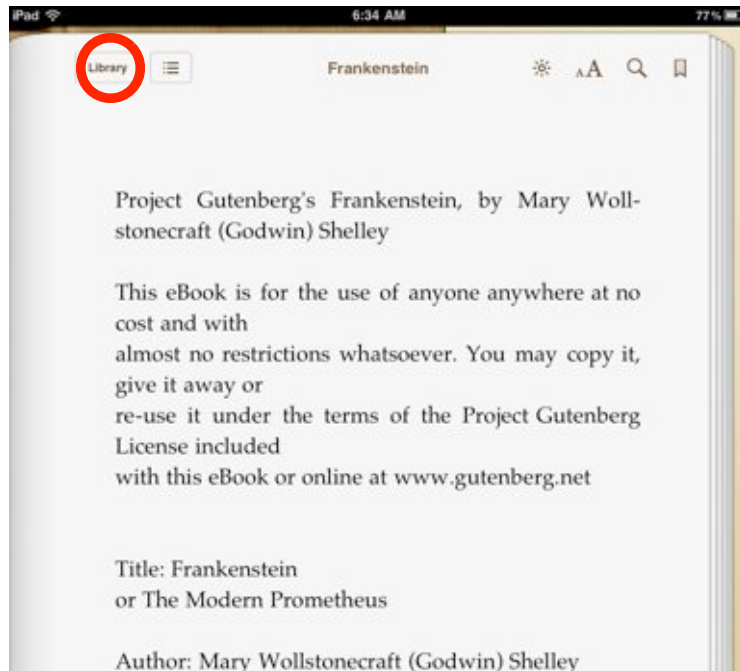




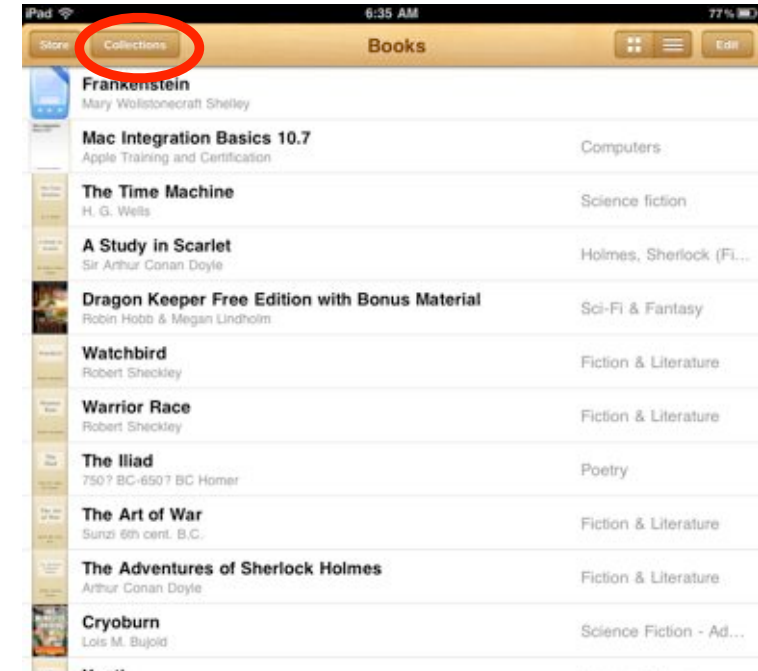
Tap the A button to change font size, type and to turn Sepia on or off.



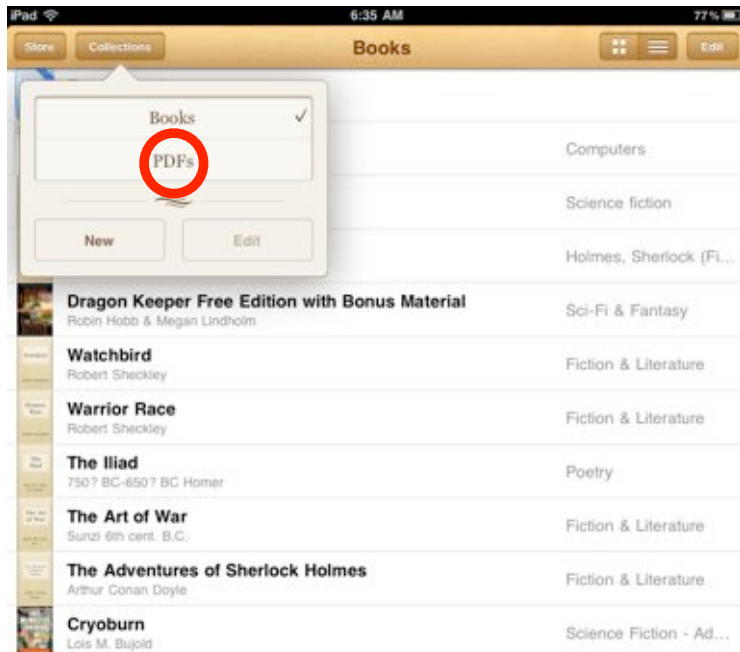
Tap the magnifying glass to search.



Tap Library.

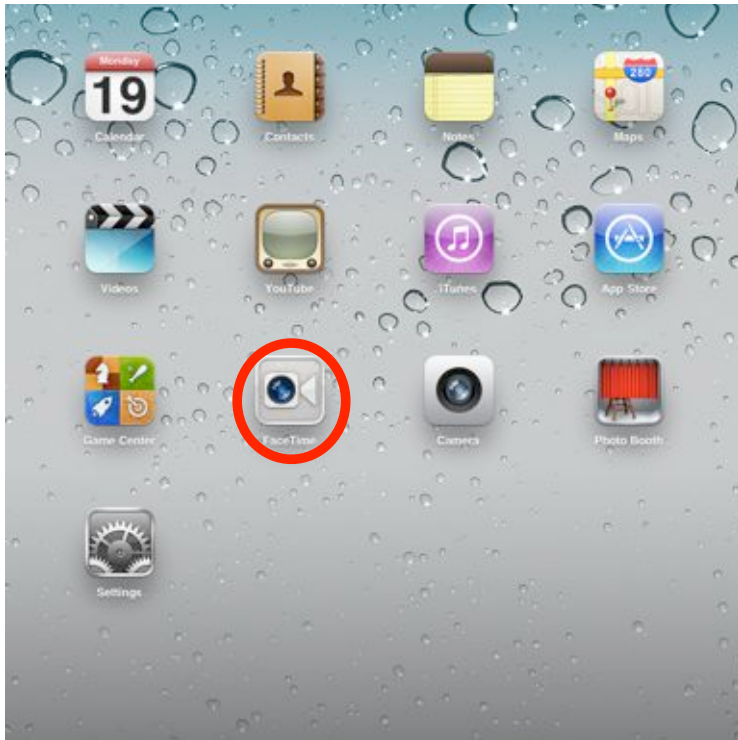


This shows all the books in the Library. Tap Collections.

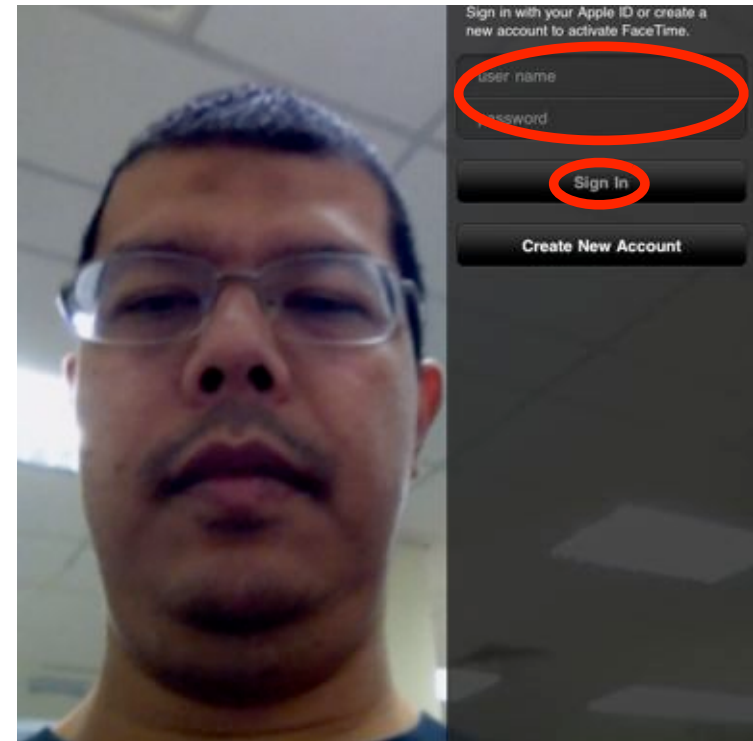


# FaceTime

You will be able to use the existing AppleID which you created earlier to sign in.

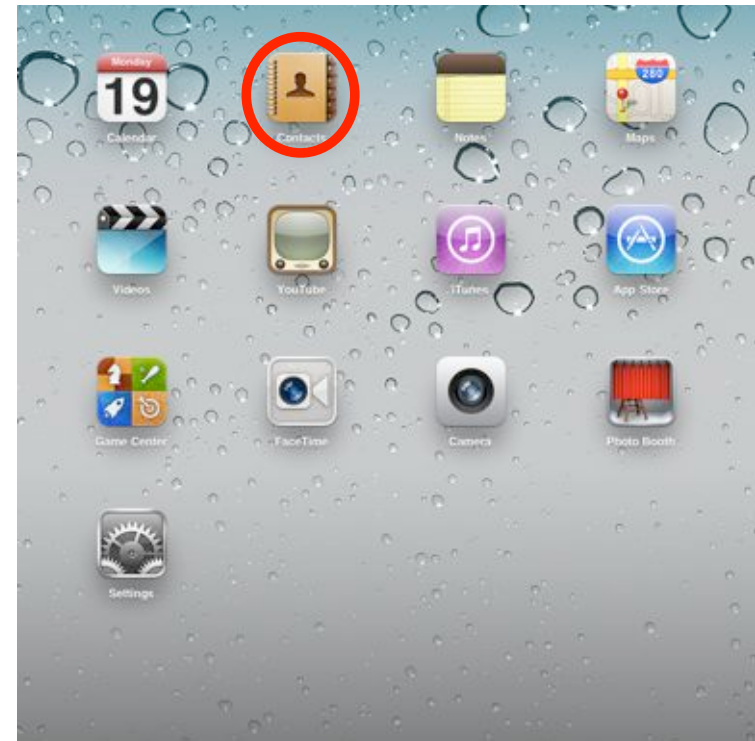


Your email will be used to contact you.

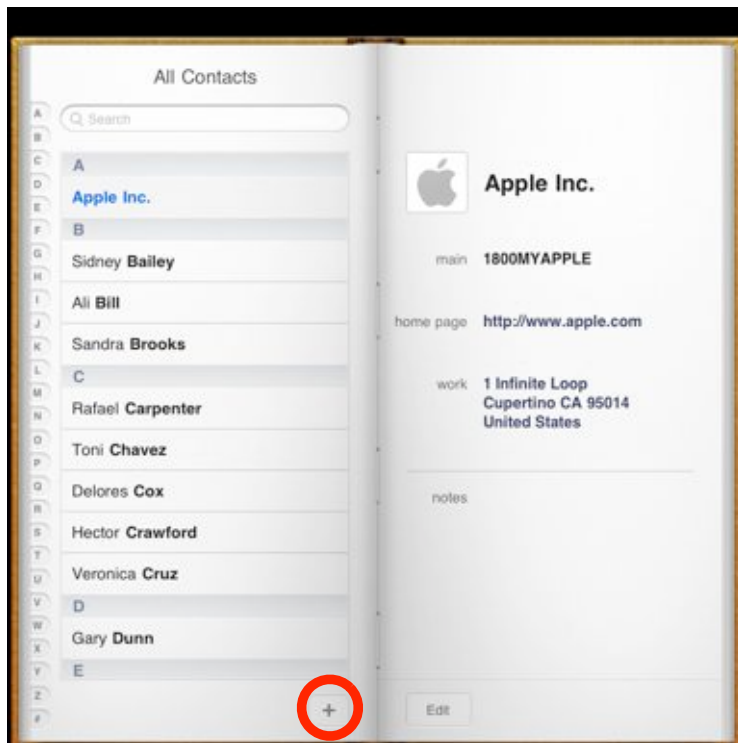


You can add additional contacts using the + button. Press the iPad button to return to the home screen.

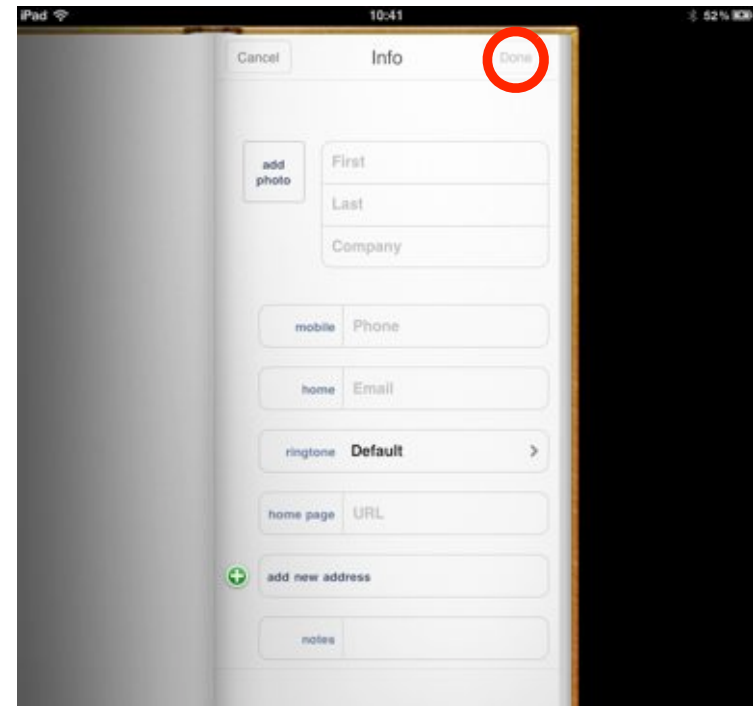

Tap the Contacts icon on the iPad.



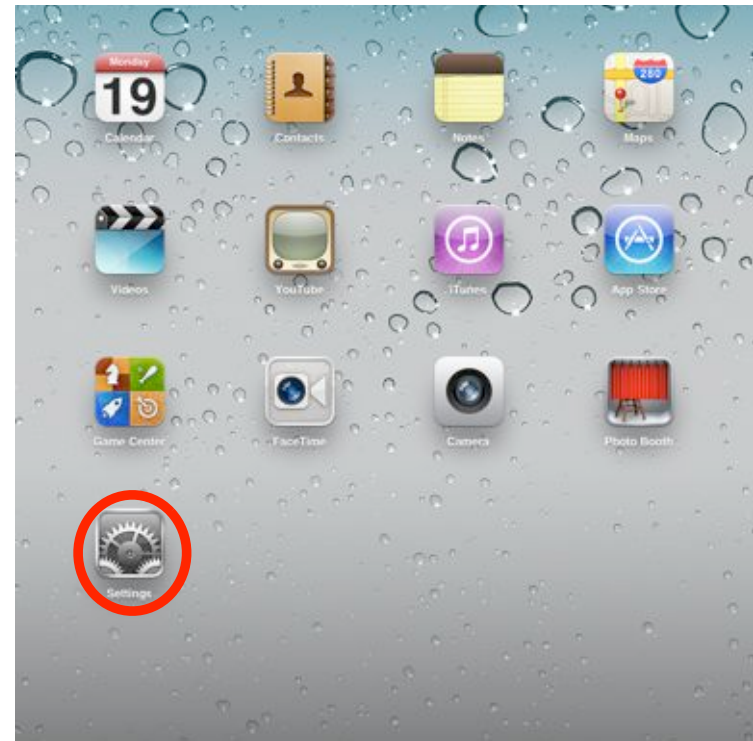
Tap the + button to add a new entry.



Tap done when you have finished. Press the iPad button to return to the home screen.

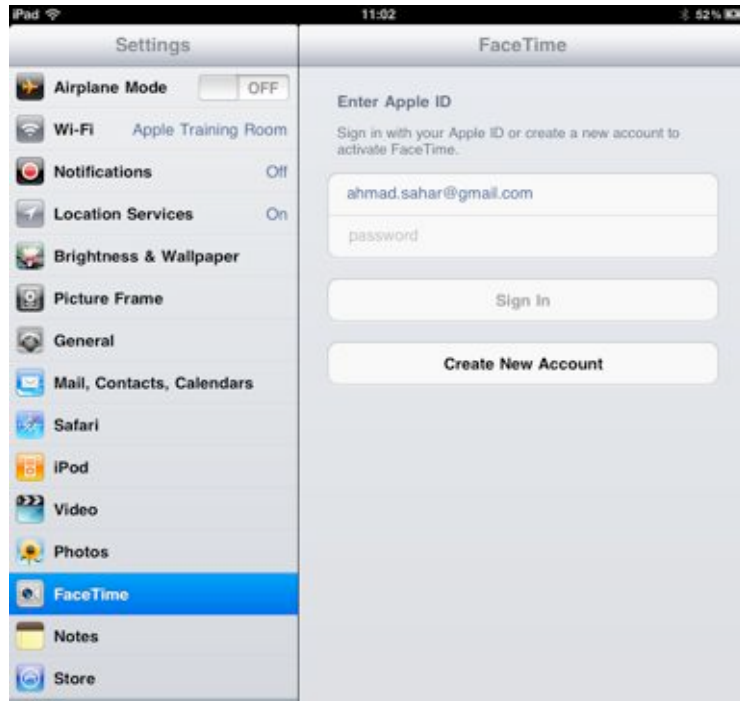

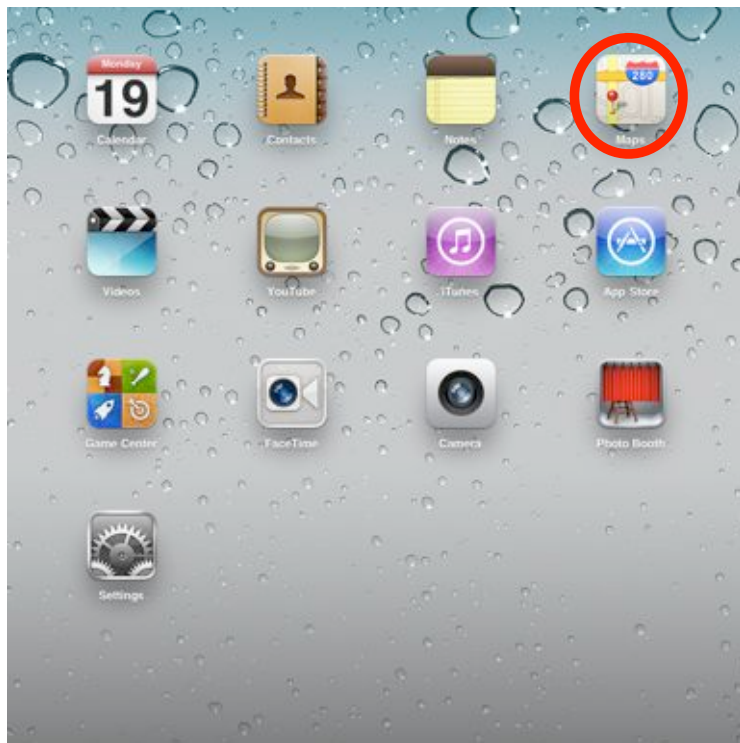

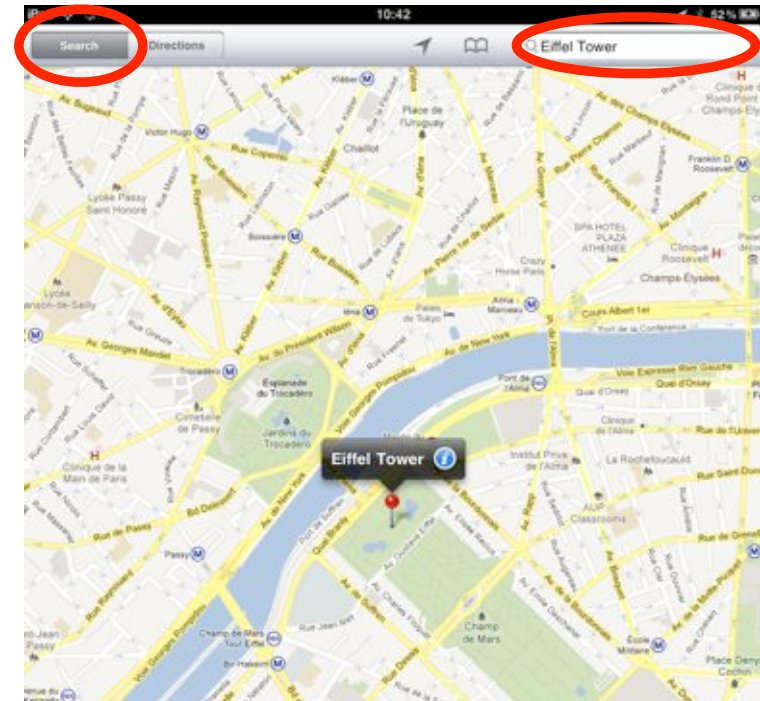


# Maps

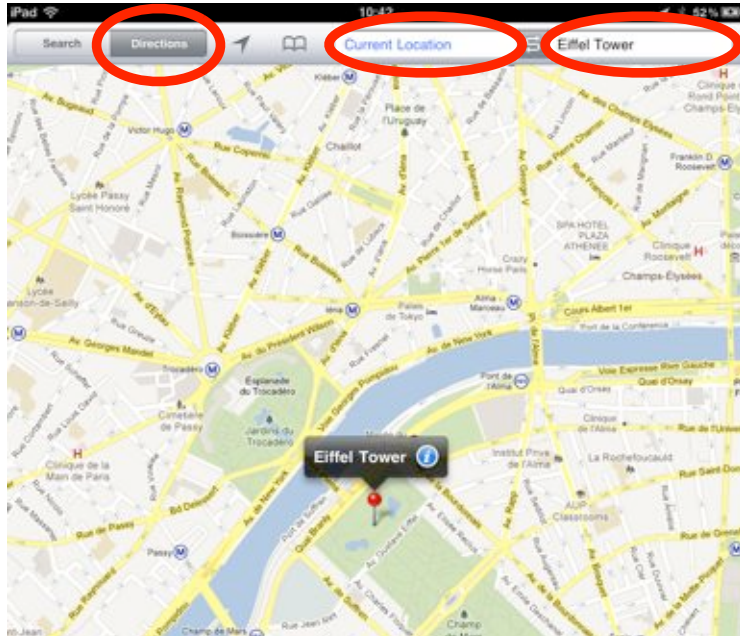
You'll be able to change all the settings here. Press the iPad button to return to the home screen.

Tap Search. Enter a search term to look for a particular location.

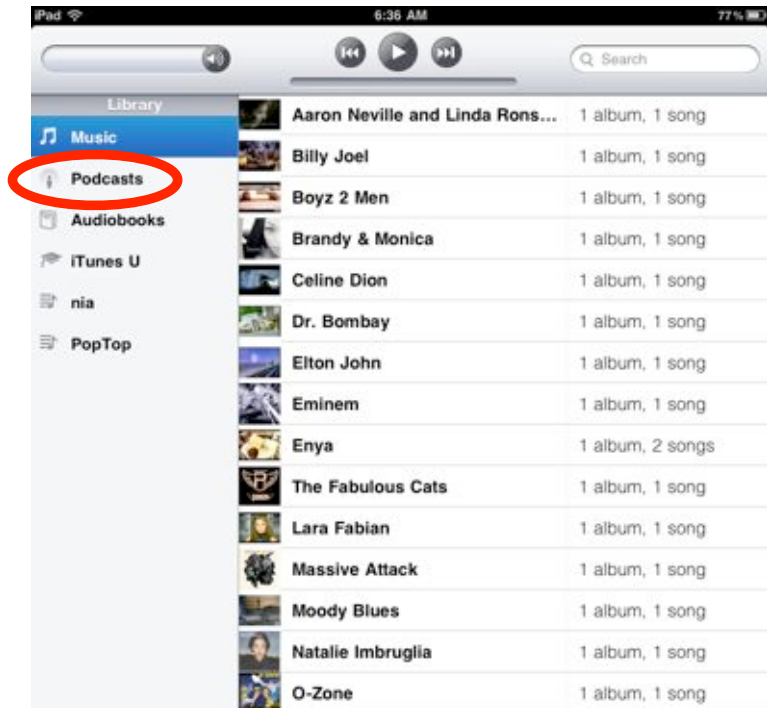

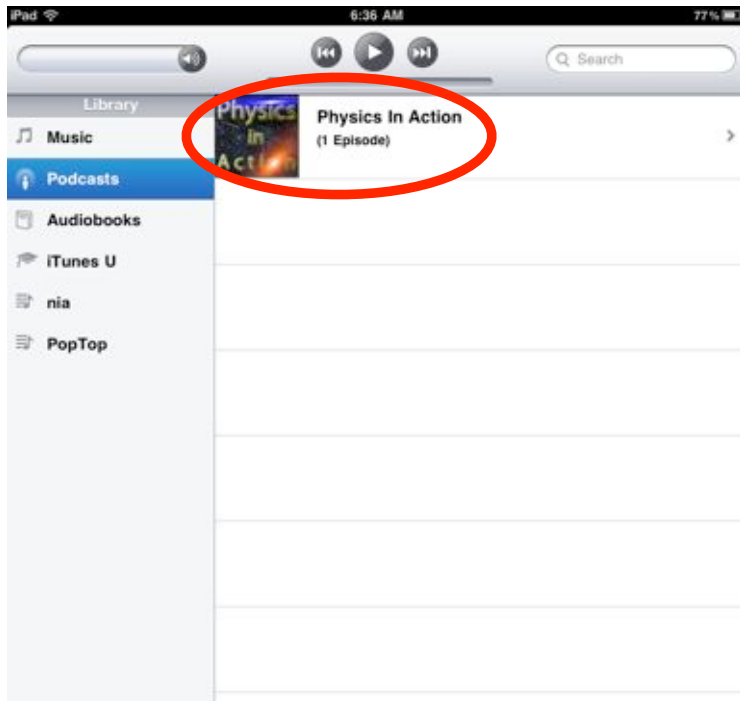
Tap Directions. Enter the start and ending locations to get directions. Press the iPad button to return to the home screen.



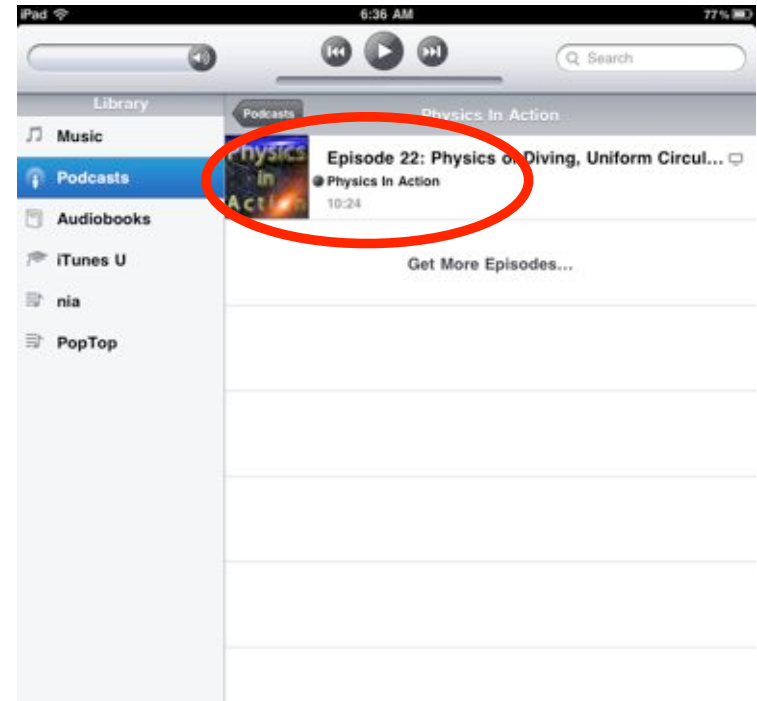

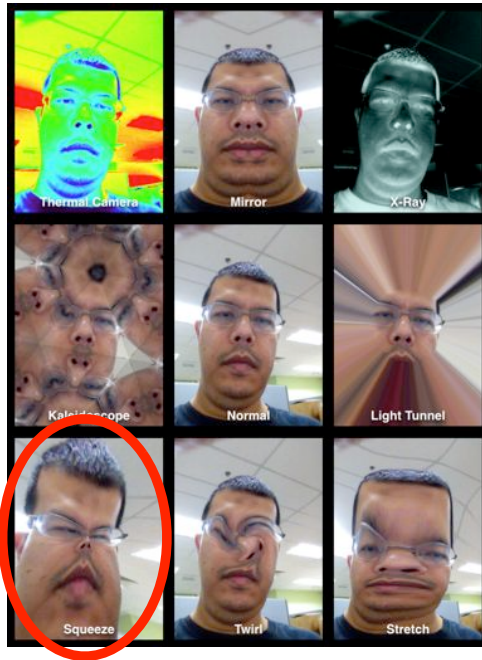


# Photo Booth

Click Apps. Tick Sync Apps. This will sync all the applications you downloaded on iTunes to your iPad.



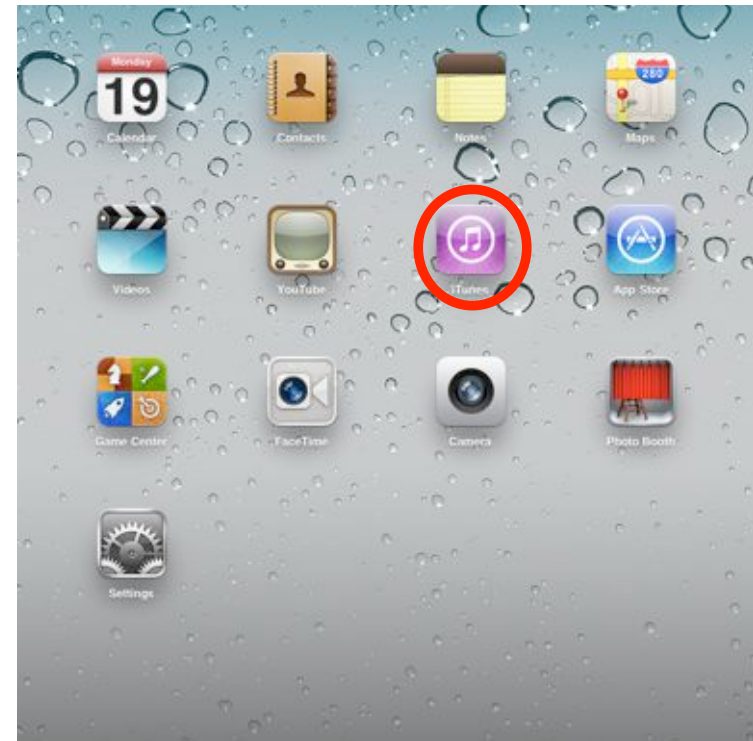
Click Podcasts. Tick Sync Podcasts. This will sync all the podcasts you downloaded on iTunes to your iPad.



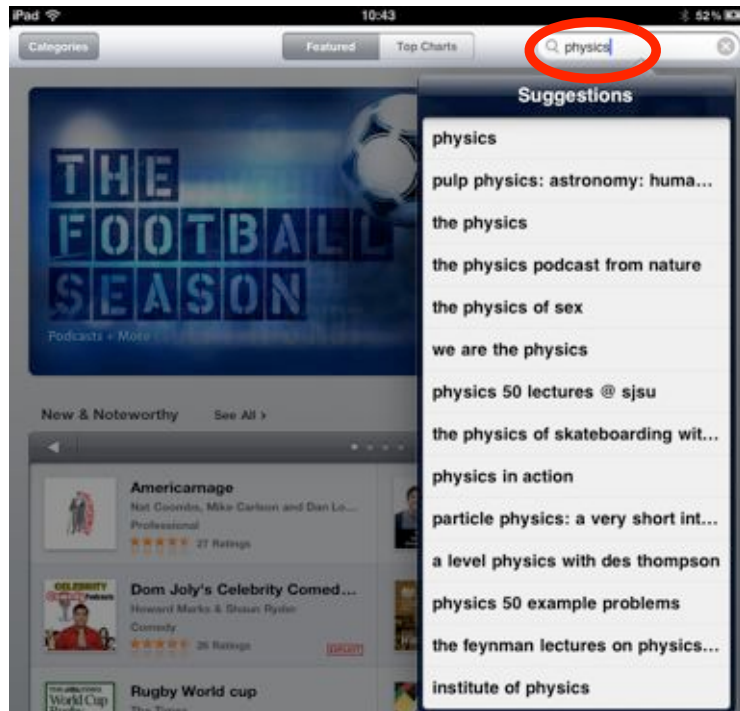

Click iTunes U. Tick Sync iTunes U. This will sync all the podcasts you downloaded on iTunes to your iPad.

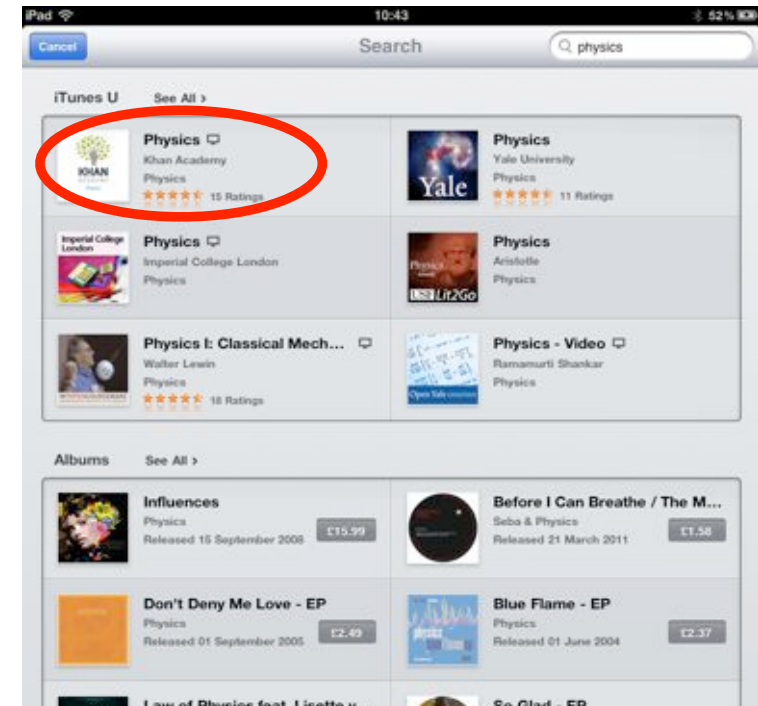

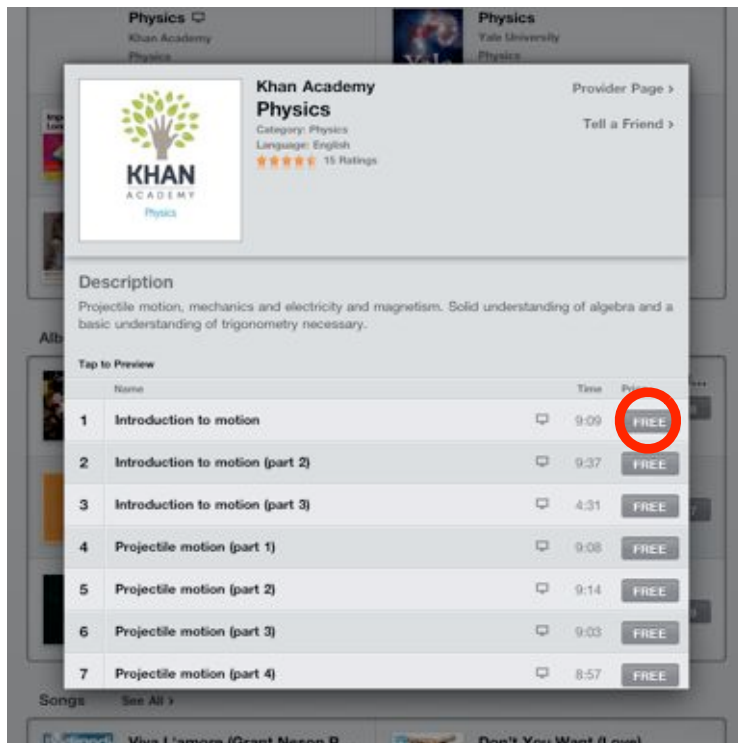
Tap the iTunes icon on the iPad.



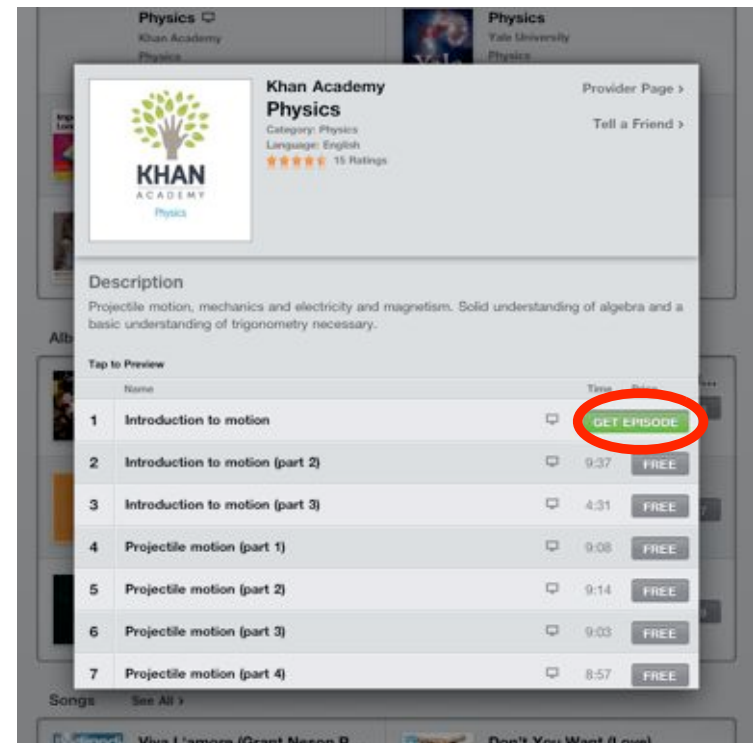
Type in a search term, such as physics in the search field.



Physics-related content will appear. Tap the Khan Academy icon.

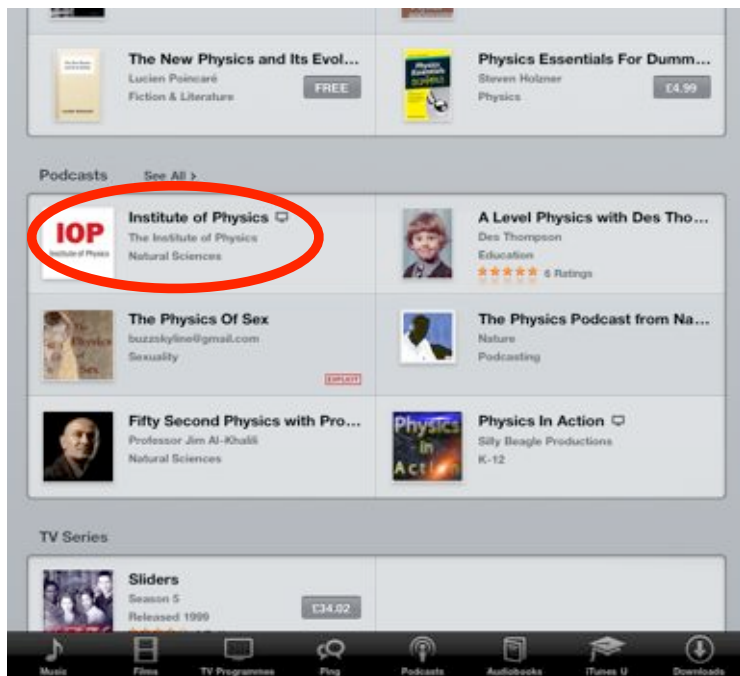


Tap the Free icon.

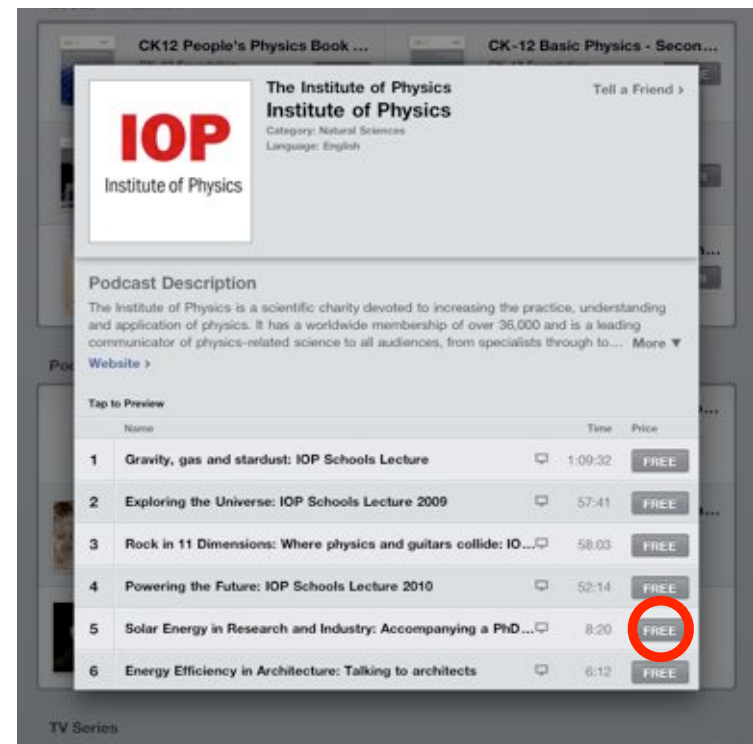


Tap Get Episode to download straight to the iPad. Tap outside the Khan Academy window to see the search results again.



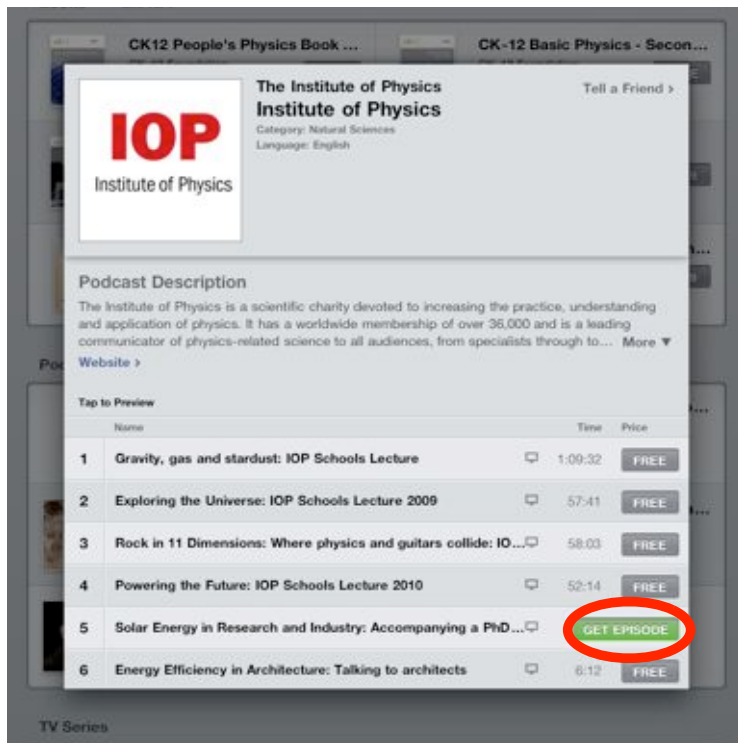


Scroll down to Podcasts. Tap a Podcast.

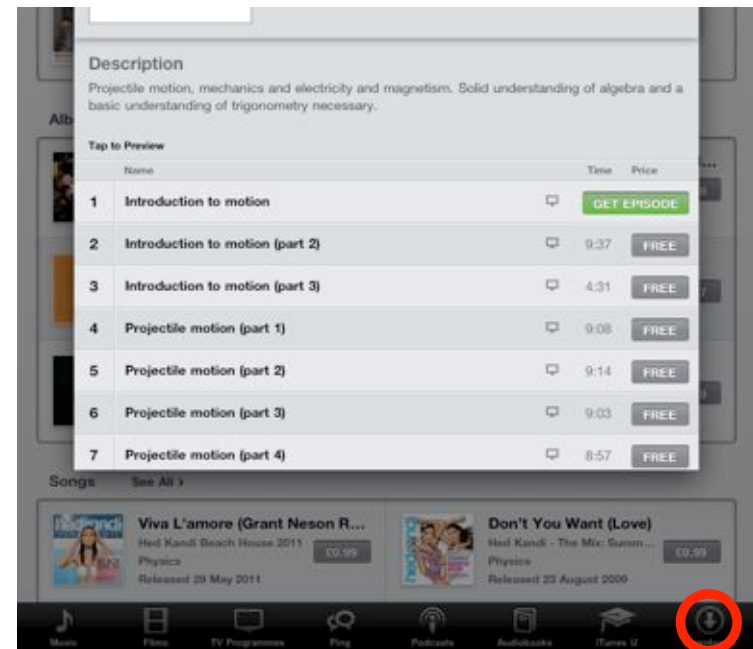


Tap the Free button.

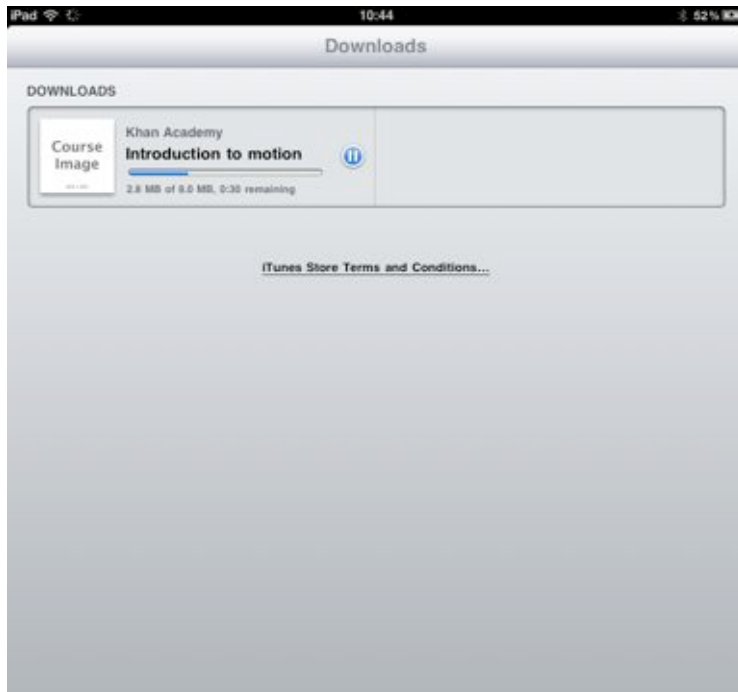

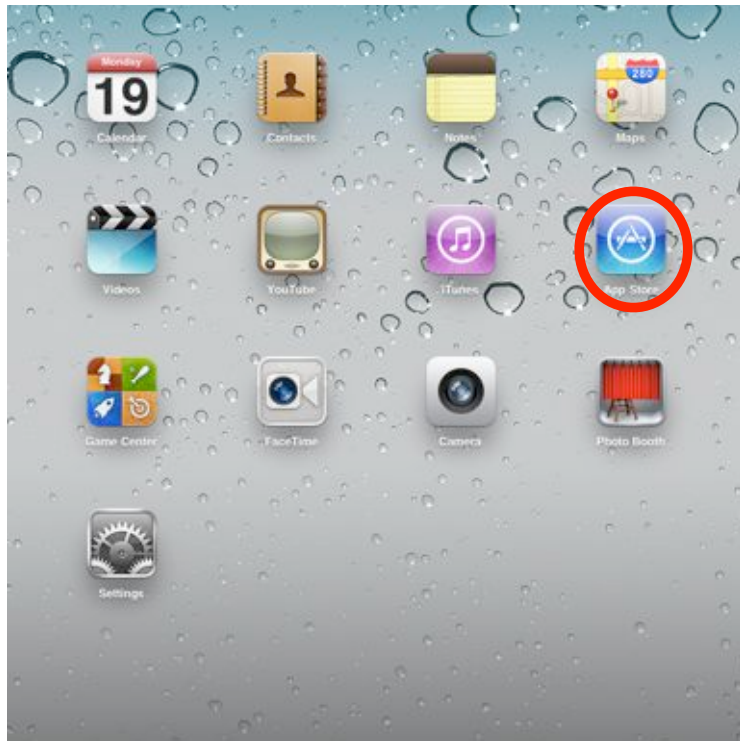

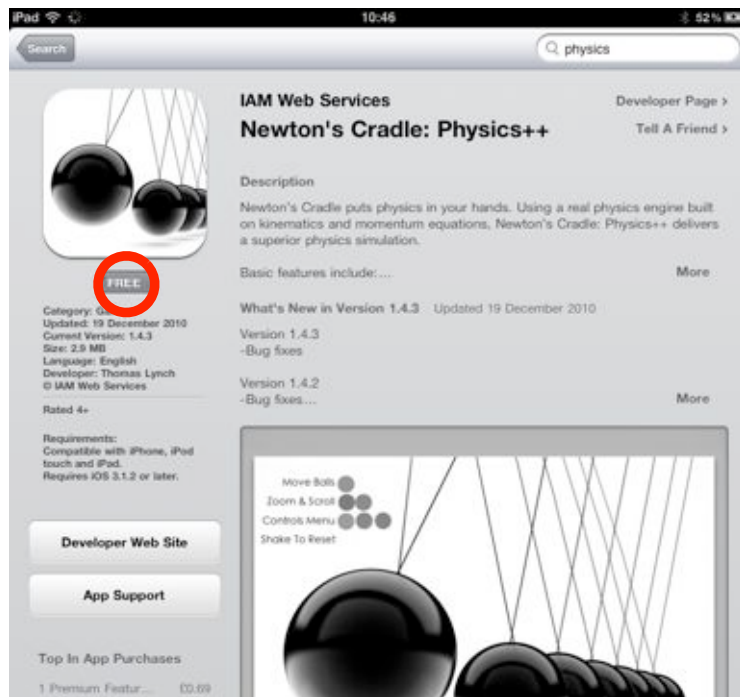
You'll see the episode downloading. Press the iPad button to return to the home screen.



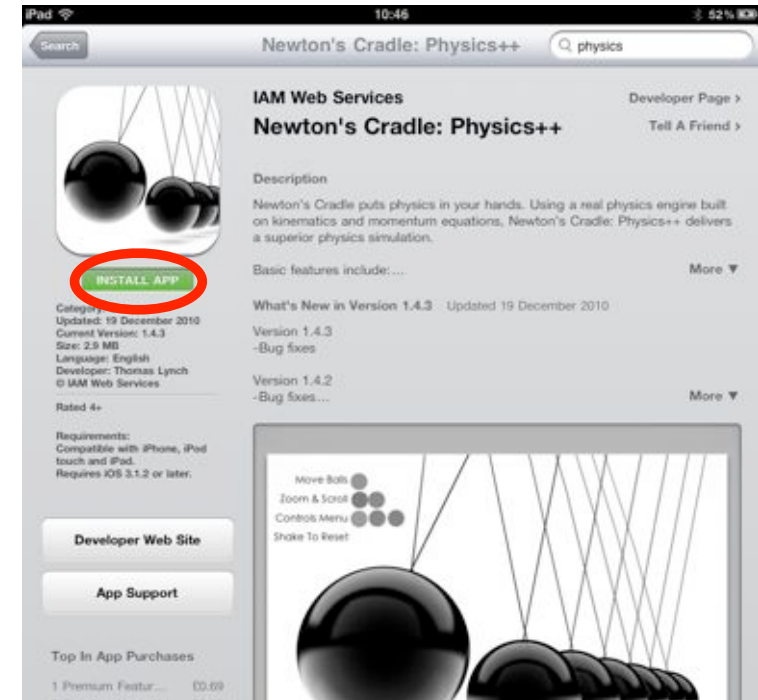
Tap the App Store icon on the iPad.



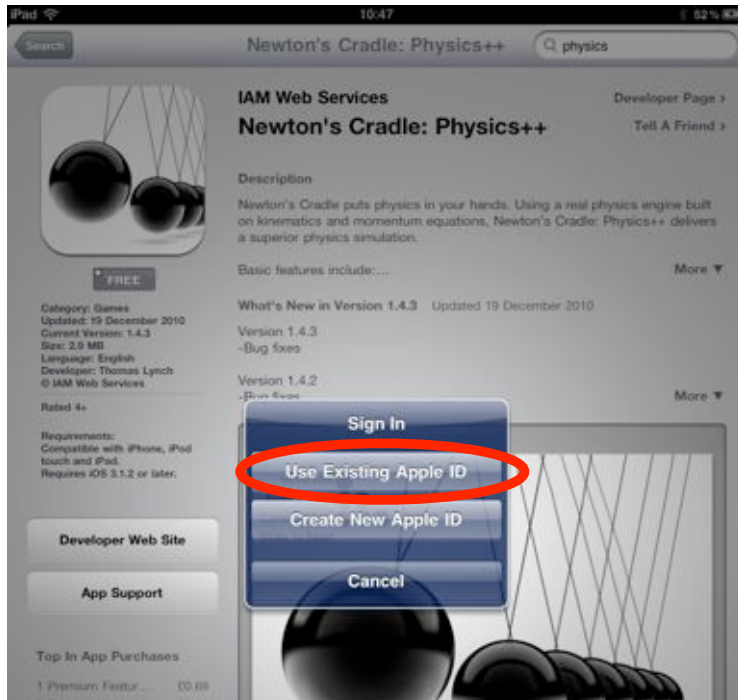
Type a search term such as physics in the Search field.

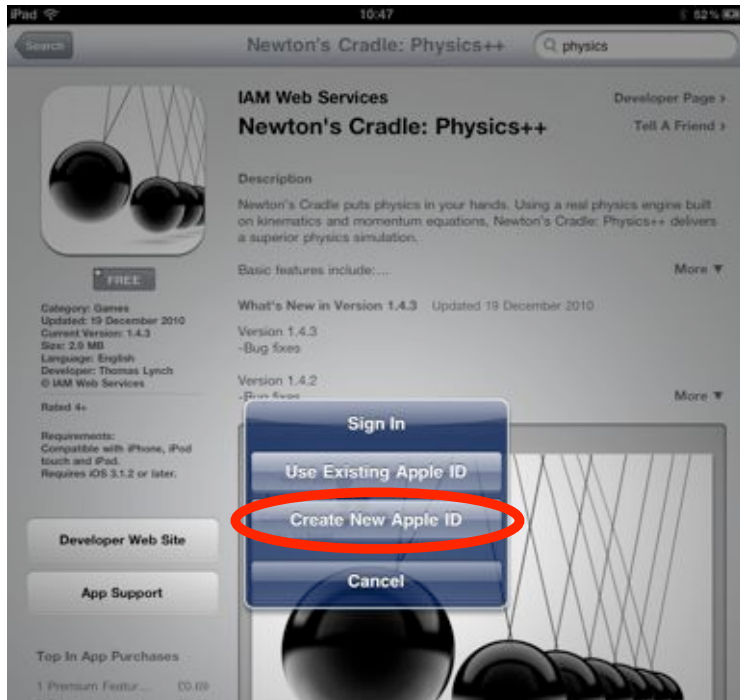

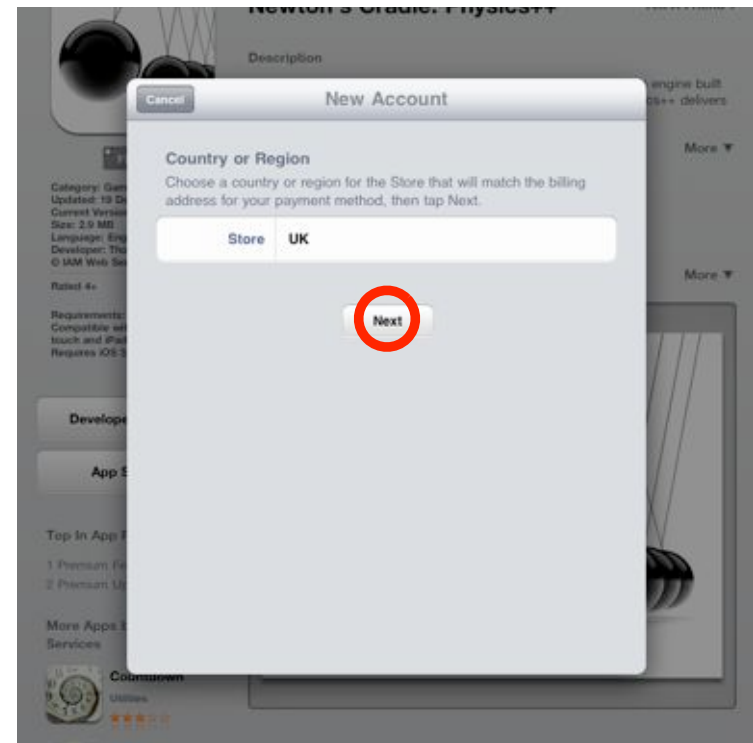


## Creating a new Apple ID

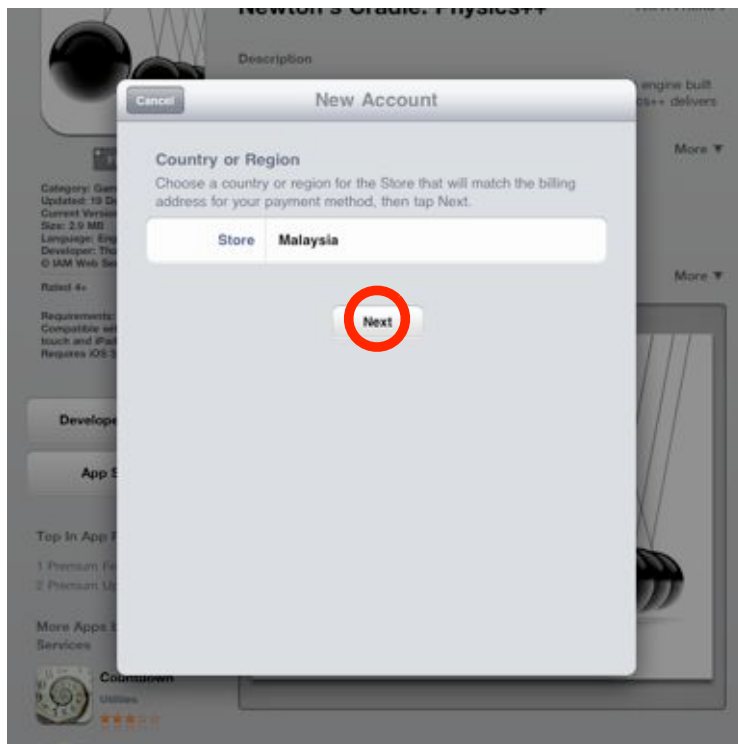
If you see this screen tap “Use Existing Apple ID” and enter your AppleID username and password. After the application has downloaded you can press the iPad button to return to the home screen.

If you tapped Create a New Apple ID in the previous screen, you will see this screen. If the Store is not Malaysia, tap it and change it to Malaysia.

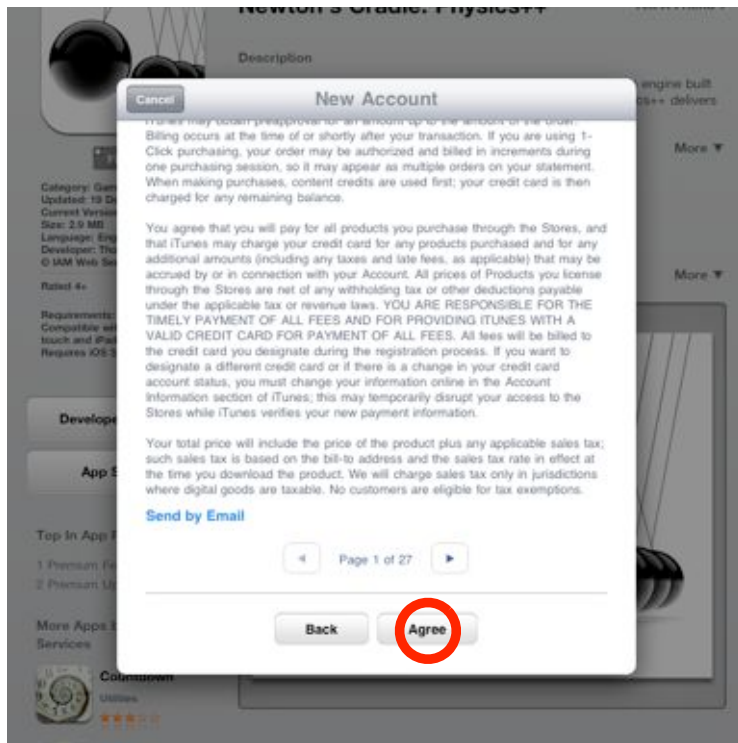

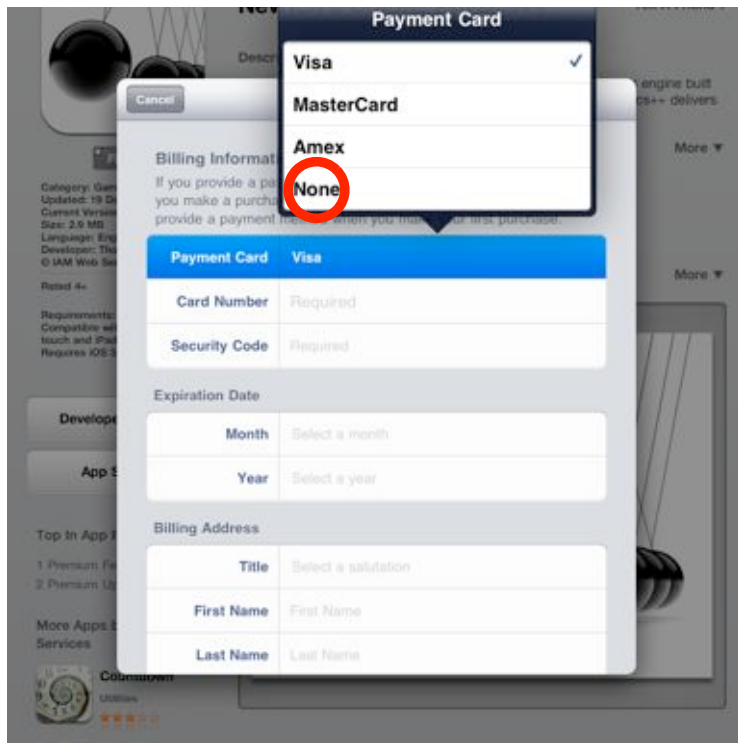

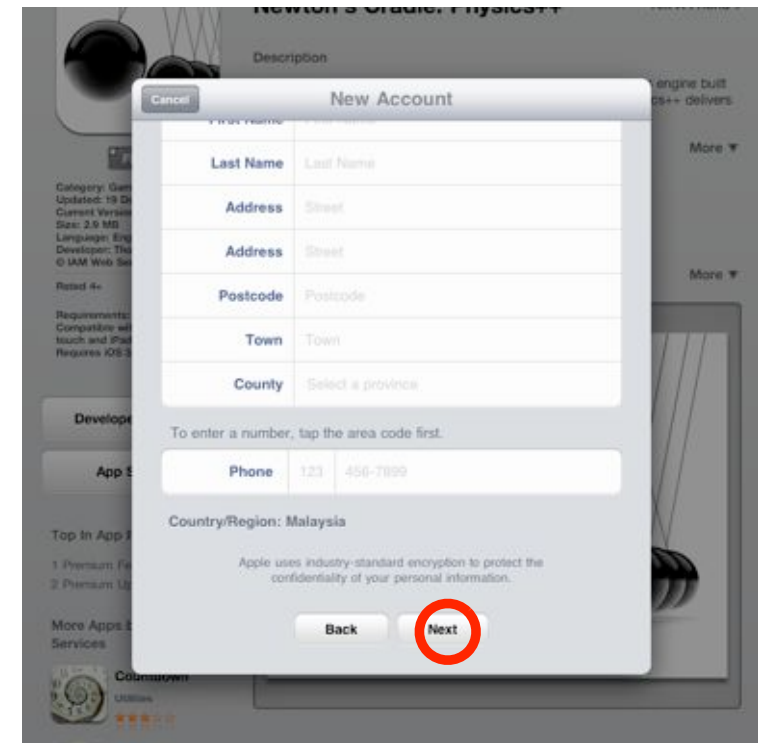
