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5. Photo Booth



Click Photo Booth icon in Dock.

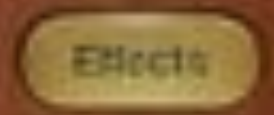
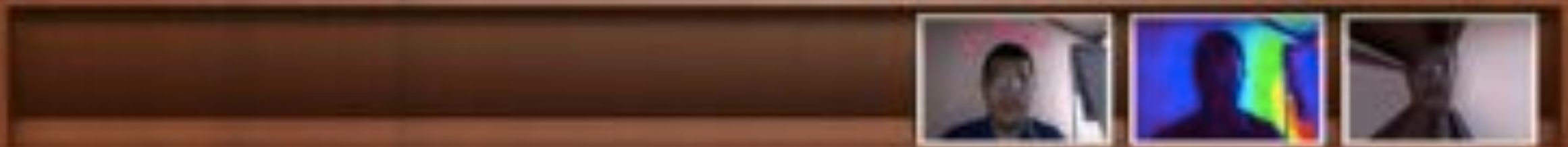


Effects

Click the red button to take a picture. Use the slider on the left to switch between photos and videos.



Click Effects.



Play around with the different effects and take a few more pictures.



Quit Photo Booth (you will need to move your cursor to the very top of the screen to see the Photo Booth menu, alternatively, use the Command-Q keyboard shortcut.)

6. Quicktime Screen Recording



Click LaunchPad and launch QuickTime.



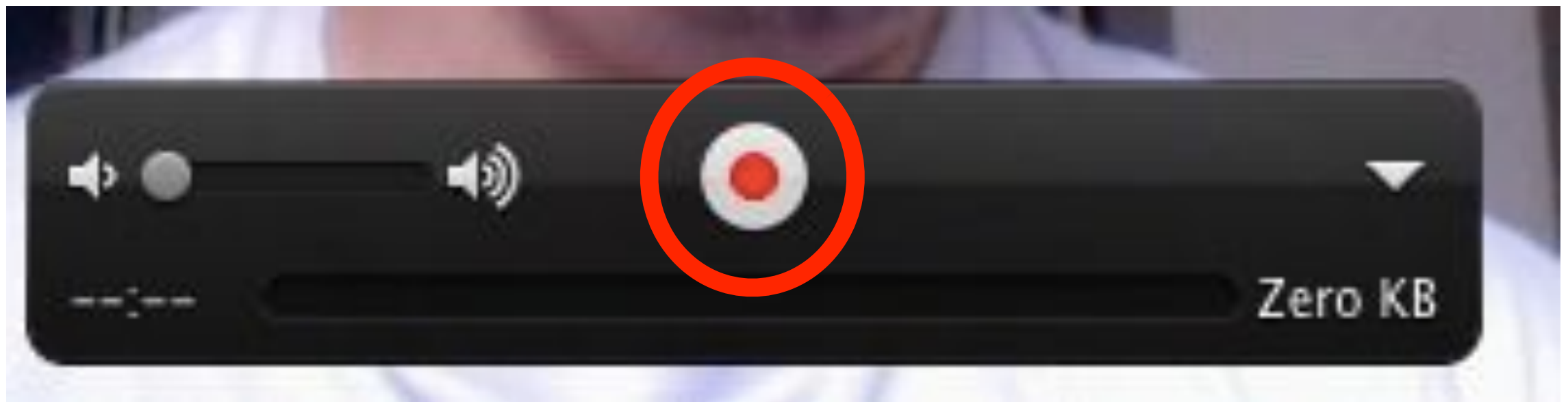
Choose New Movie Recording from the File menu.



Click on the small disclosure triangle in the player.



Make sure that the Built-in Microphone is selected. You can choose Medium quality to conserve disk space.



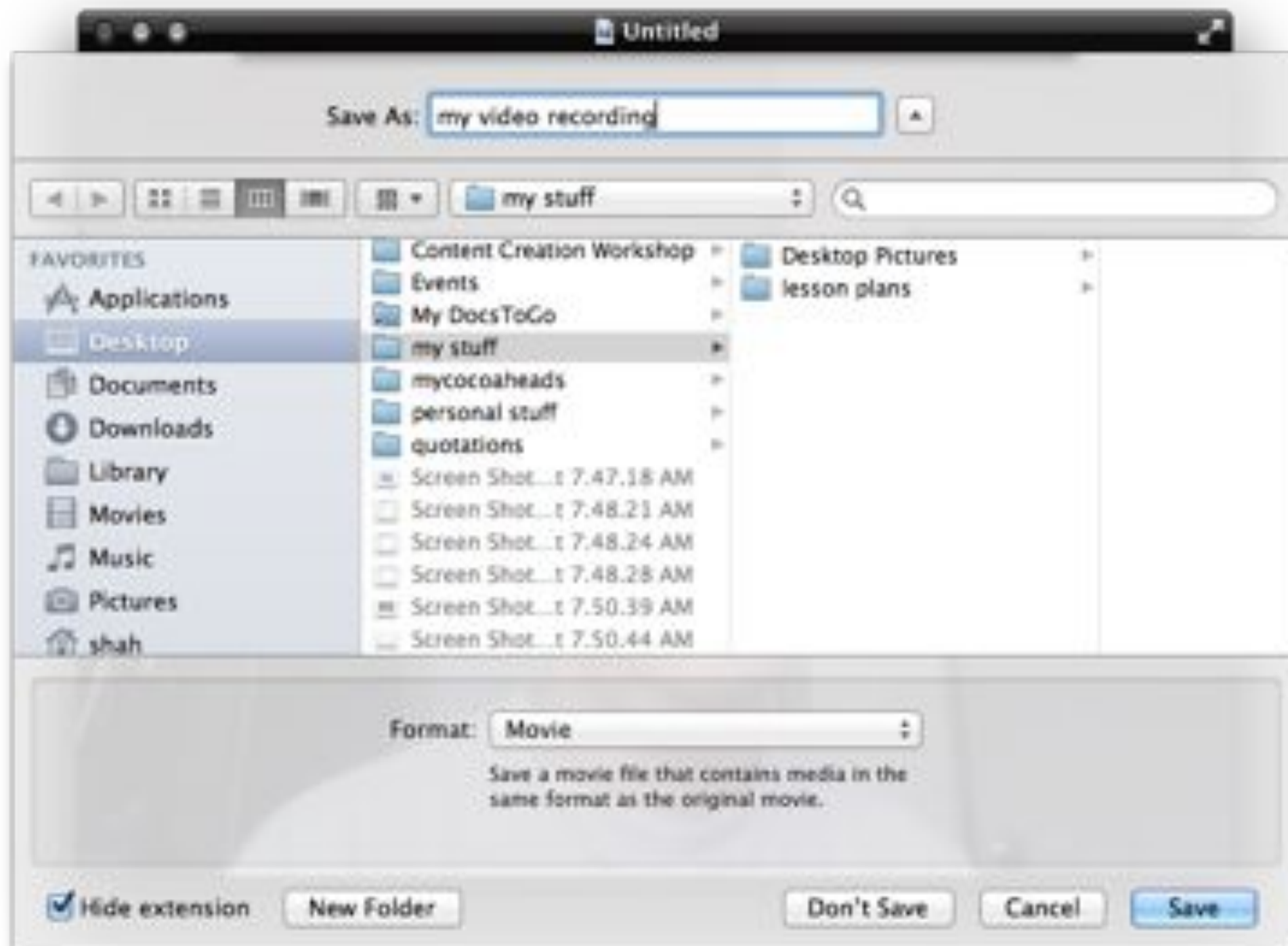
Click the Record button.



Record 10 seconds of video. Click the Stop button.



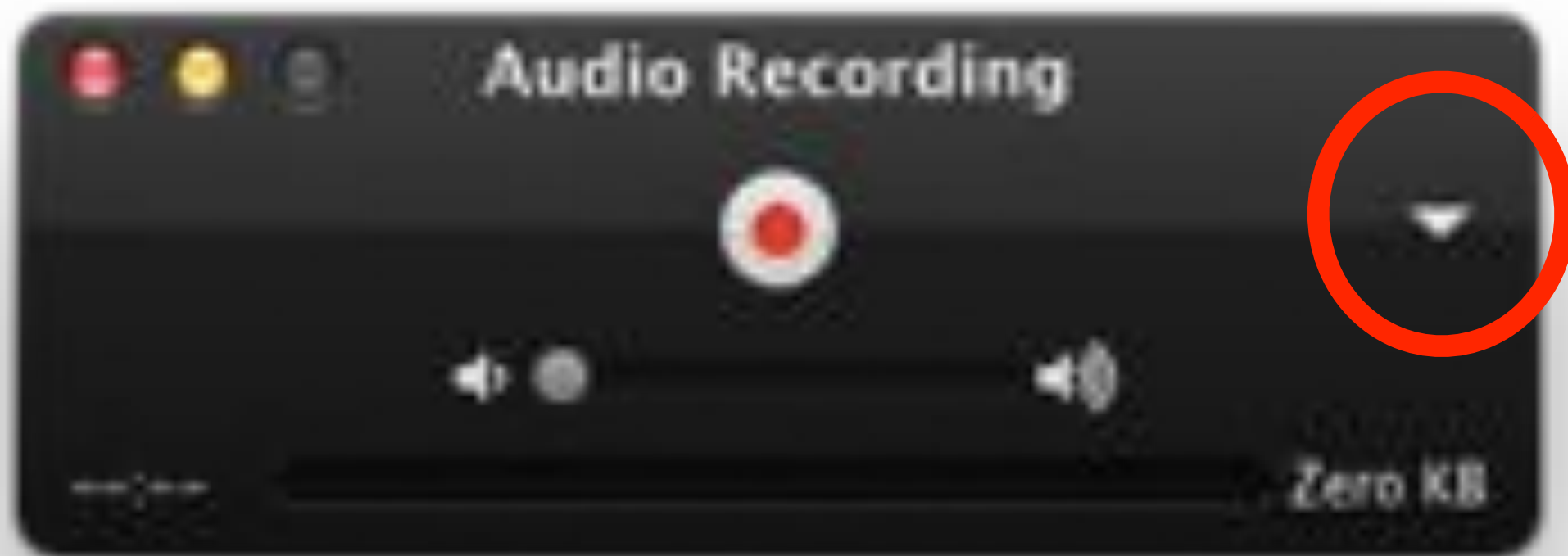
Click the Play button to play the movie you just recorded. Click the red button on the upper left corner.



Save the movie to your My Stuff folder.



Choose New Audio Recording from the File menu.



Click on the disclosure triangle.



Make sure the Built-in Microphone is selected. You can choose High Quality to conserve disk space.



Click the Record button to start recording. Record audio for 10 seconds. Click the Stop button to stop.



Play back the recording. Click the Red button in the upper left hand corner.



Save this recording to your my stuff folder.



Choose New Screen Recording from the File menu.



Click the disclosure triangle.



Make sure that Built-in Microphone is set and Show Mouse Clicks in Recording is set. You can set the Quality to Medium to conserve disk space.

Click to record the full screen. Drag to record part of the screen.

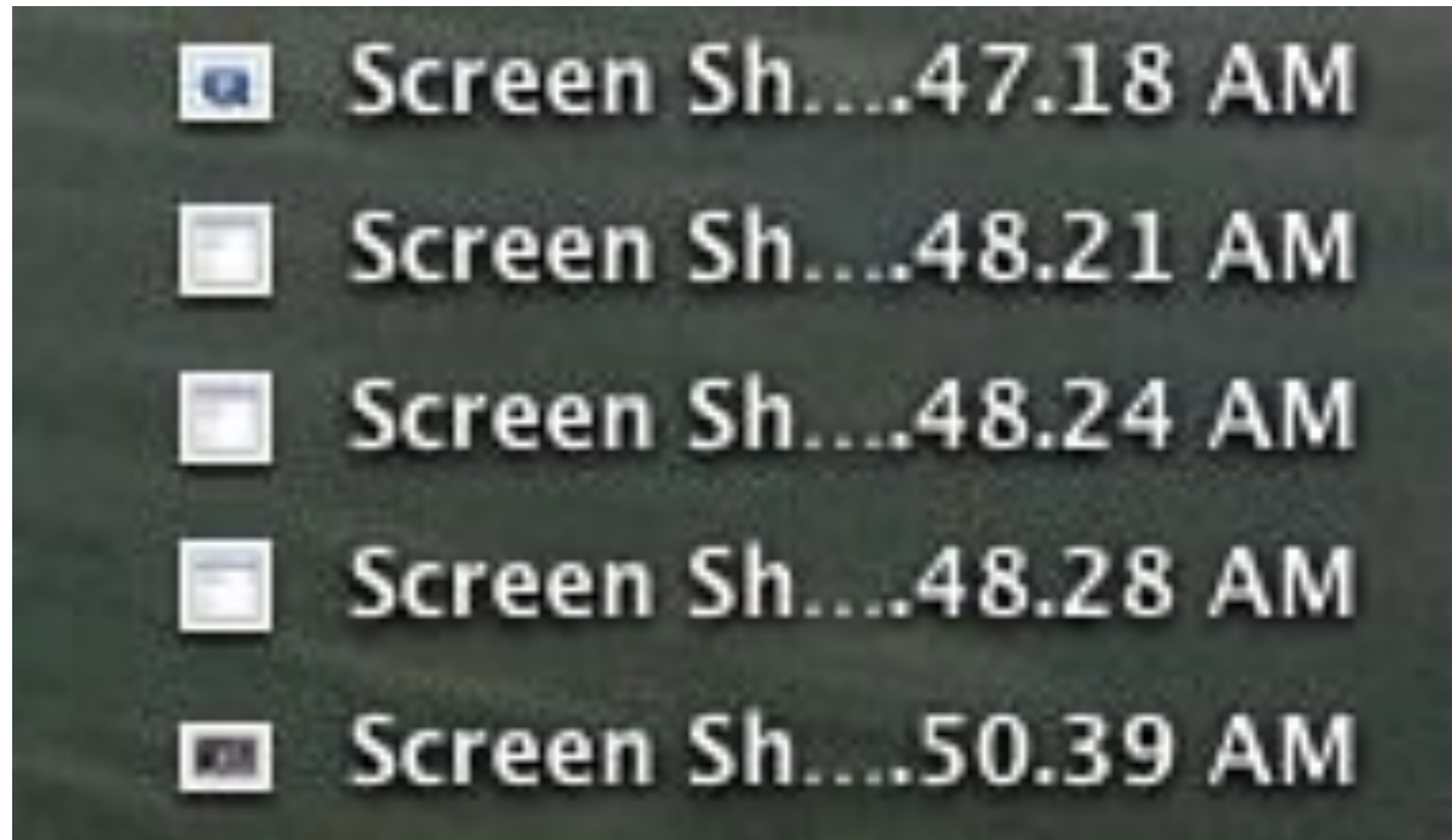
Click to start recording the screen. Drag to just record part of the screen. Click the Stop button when done.



Click Play to play the recorded video. Click the red button on the upper left hand corner.



Save the recorded video to the my stuff folder.



If you want to capture screenshots, use the Command-Shift-3 and Command-Shift-4 key combinations. Screenshots will be saved to the Desktop.

7. iPhoto



Click the iPhoto icon in the Dock.



Click Yes.



Look up Photo Locations

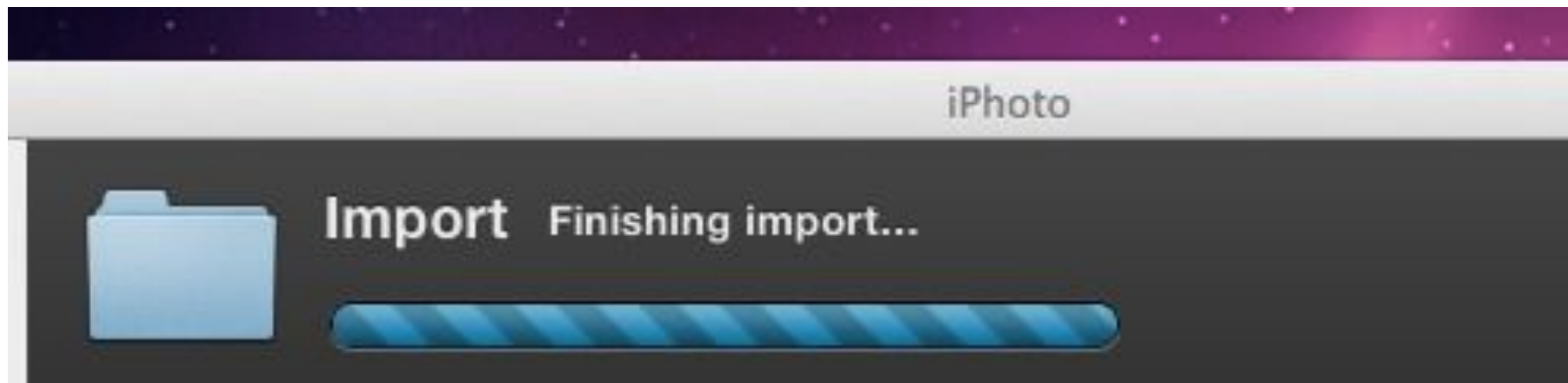
Click Close.



Open the my stuff folder you created earlier.



Drag Desktop Pictures into the iPhoto window to import them.



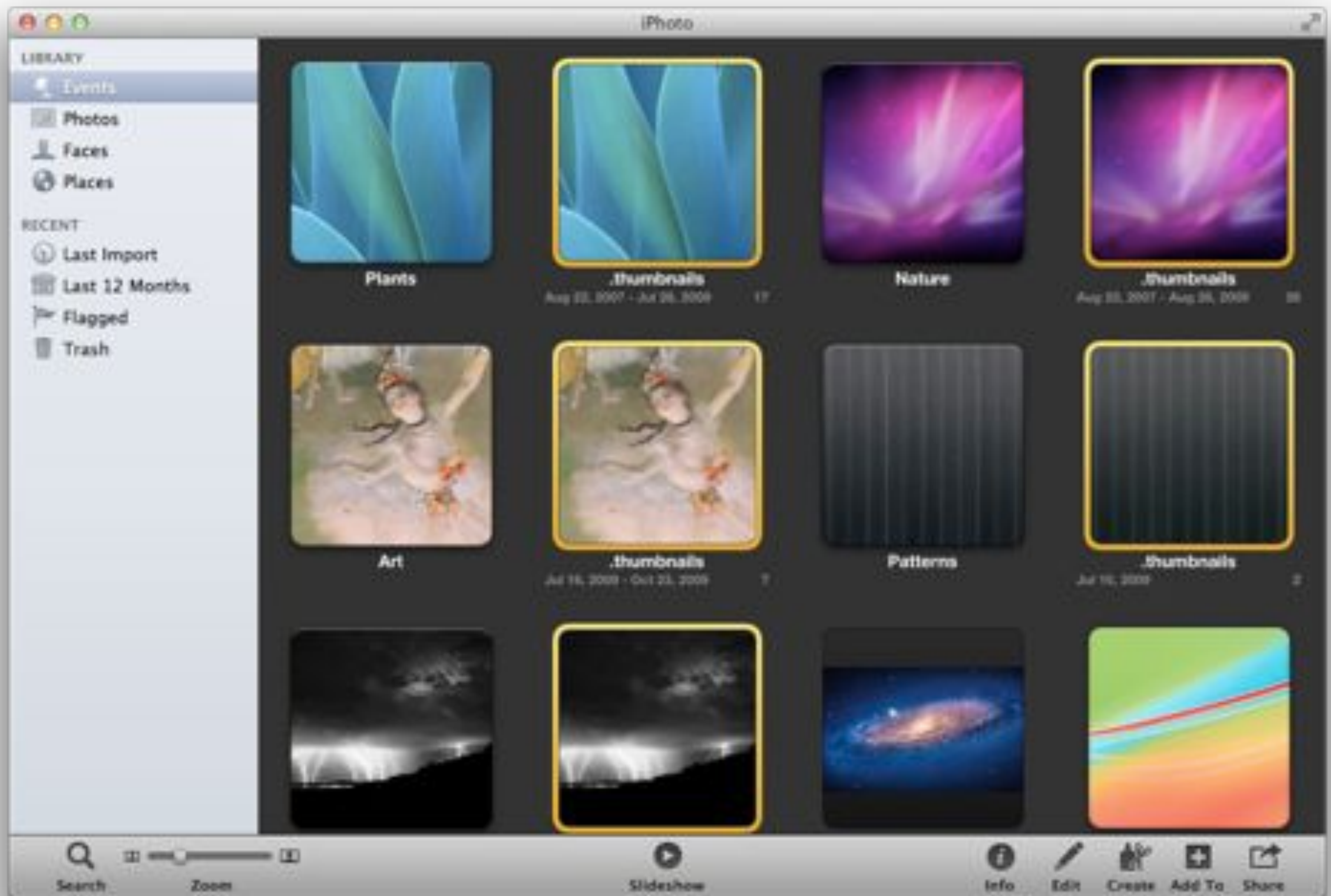
Wait until the import finishes.



Click Events after all the pictures have been imported.



Select all the .thumbnails folders (Use Command-click to select).



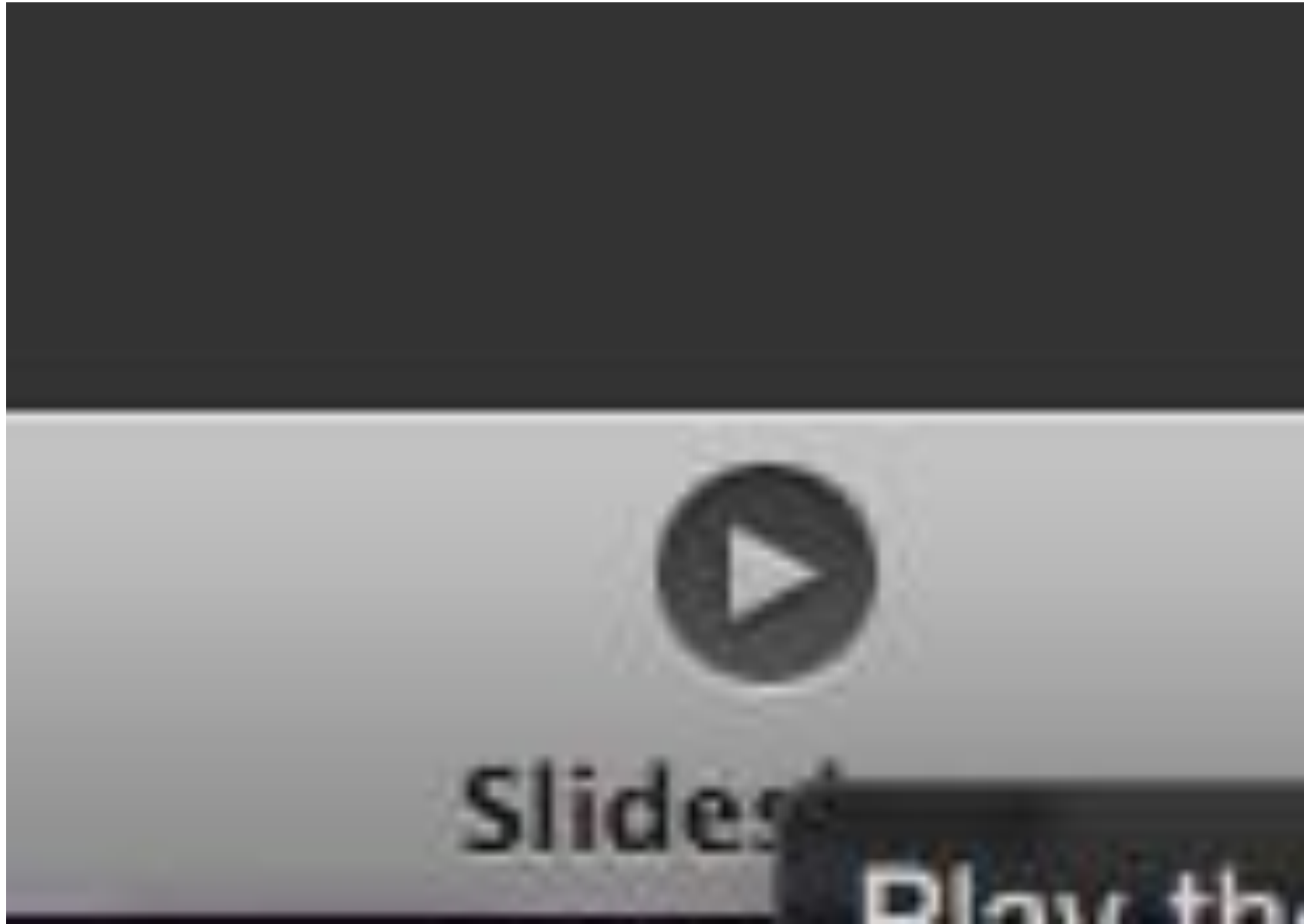
press Command-Delete to remove all the selected folders.



Drag one folder on top of another.



Click Merge to merge them into a single event.



With the merged event selected (it will have a yellow border), click Slideshow.

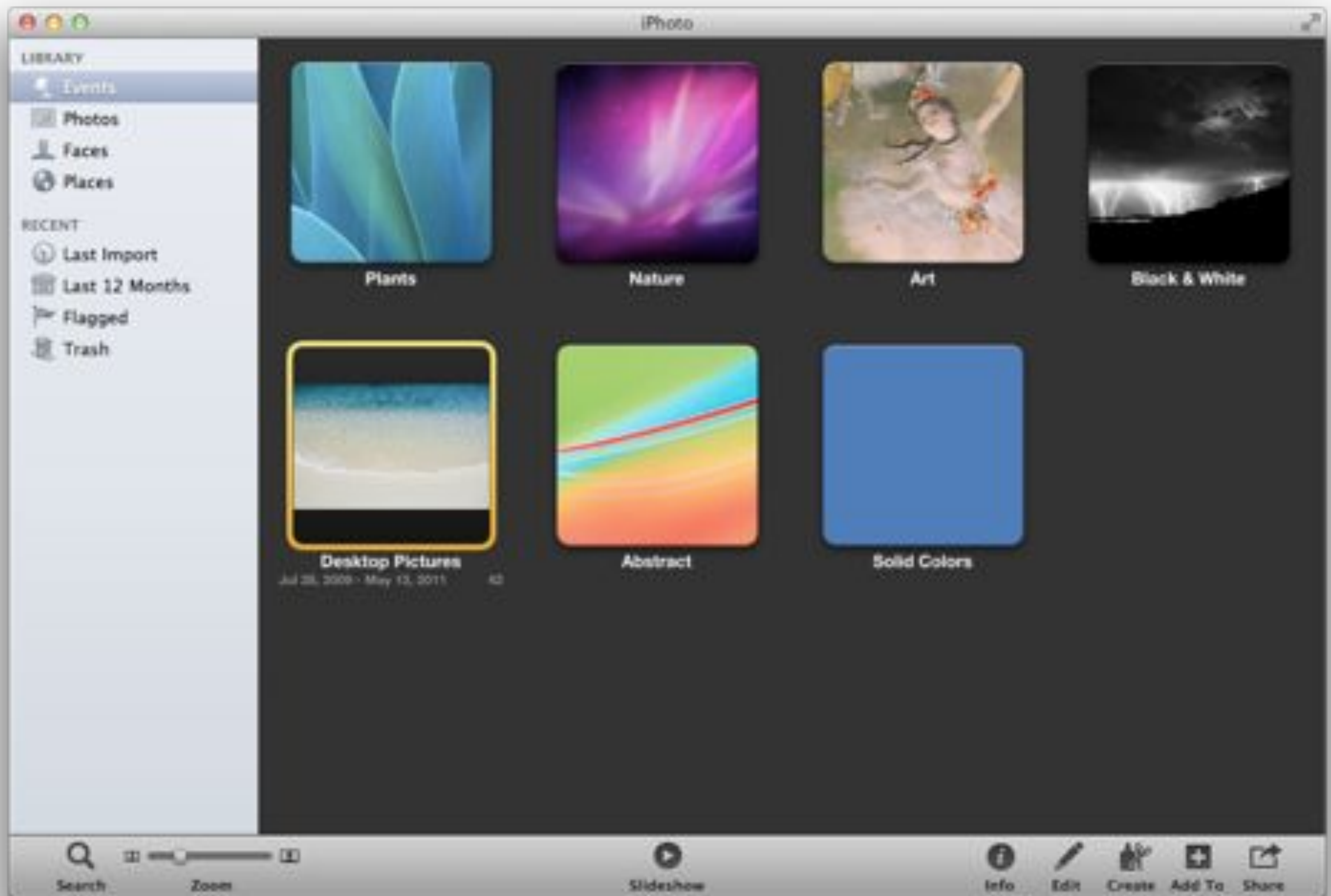


Choose a slideshow theme and click Play.

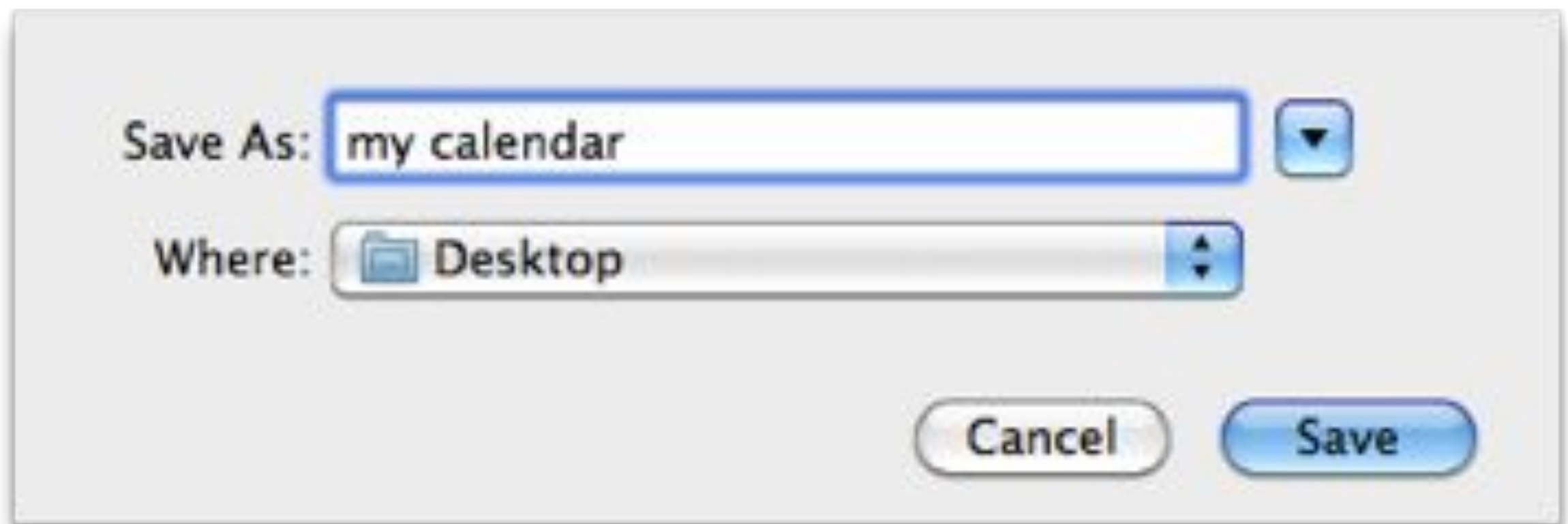

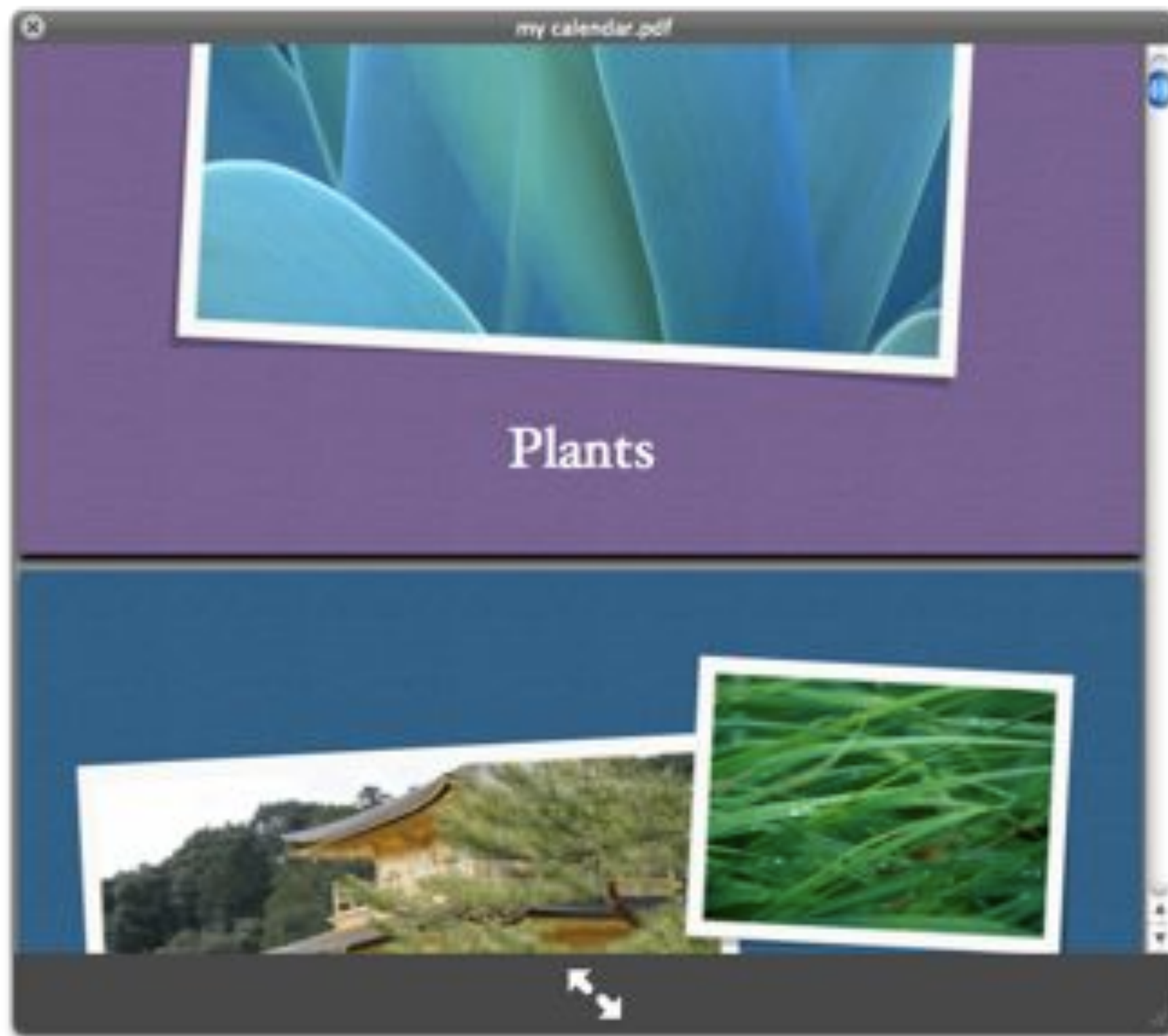

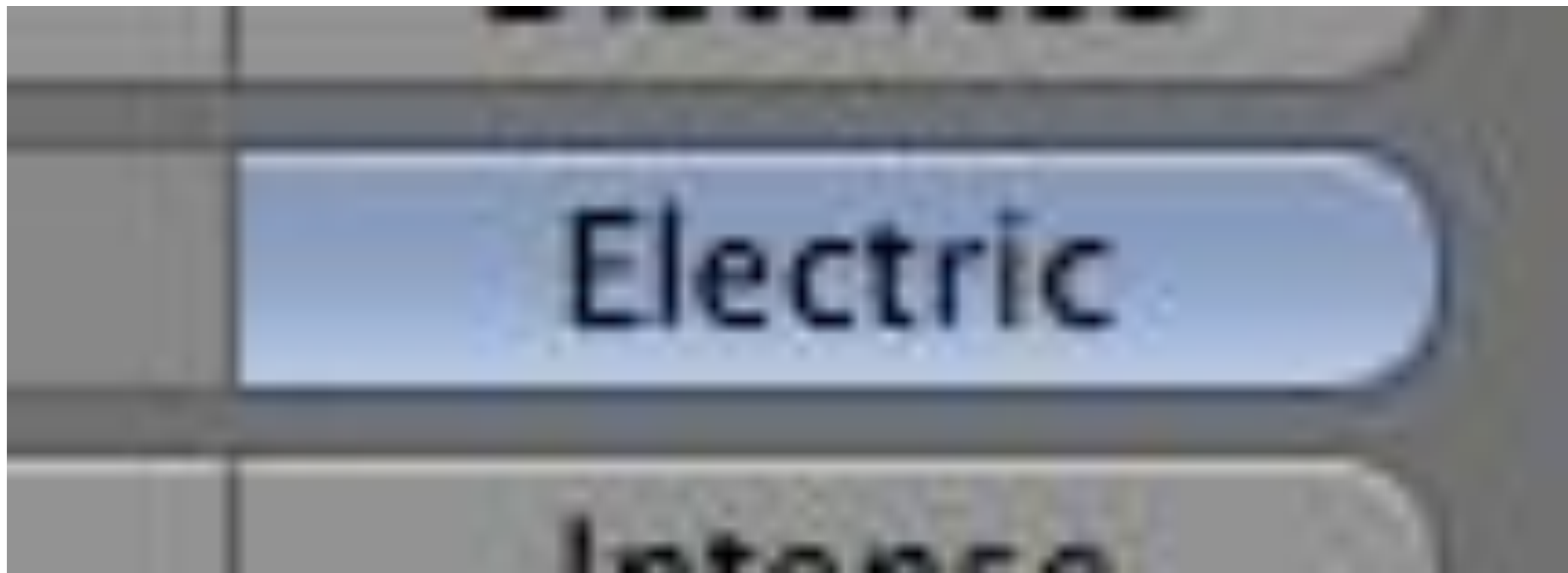
Click Create.



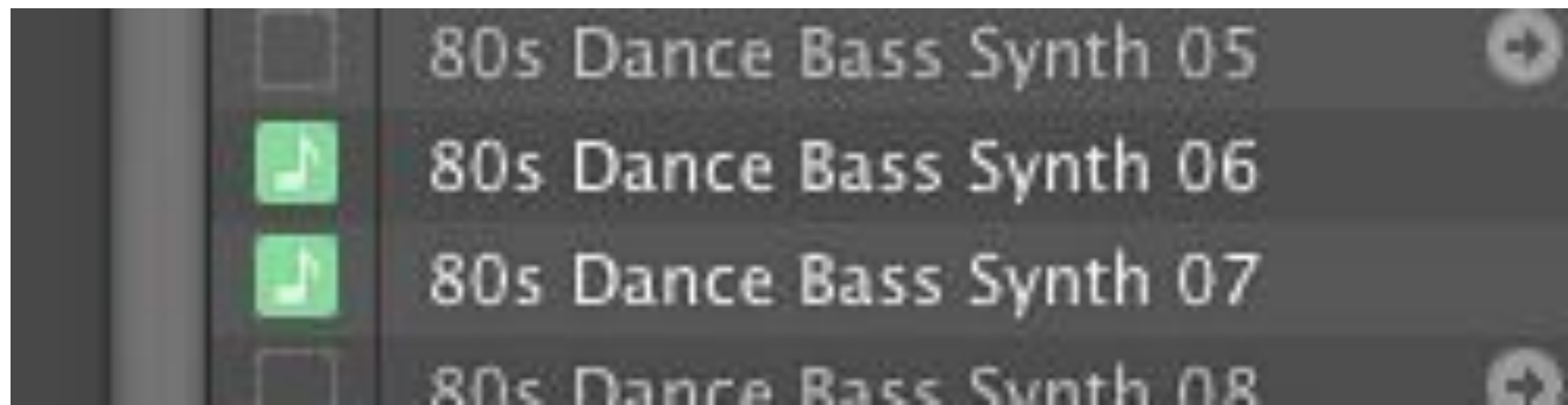
The main GarageBand window is displayed.



Click the metronome at the bottom of the viewing area so won't here a tock-tock sound while you play back the music.



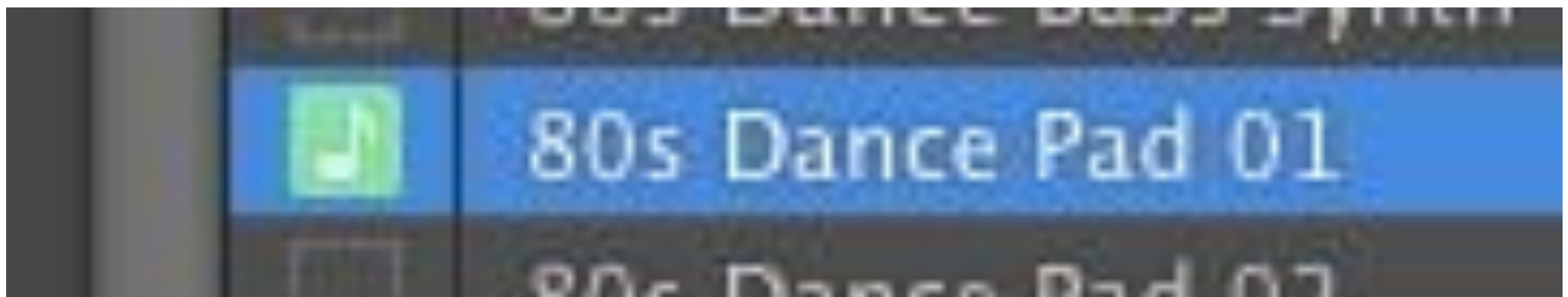
Click Electric, loops will be displayed.



Find 80s Dance Bass Synth 06 and 07 in the list.



Drag them to GarageBand to make a new track, 07 first then 06. Make sure you drag 06 to the same track as 07.



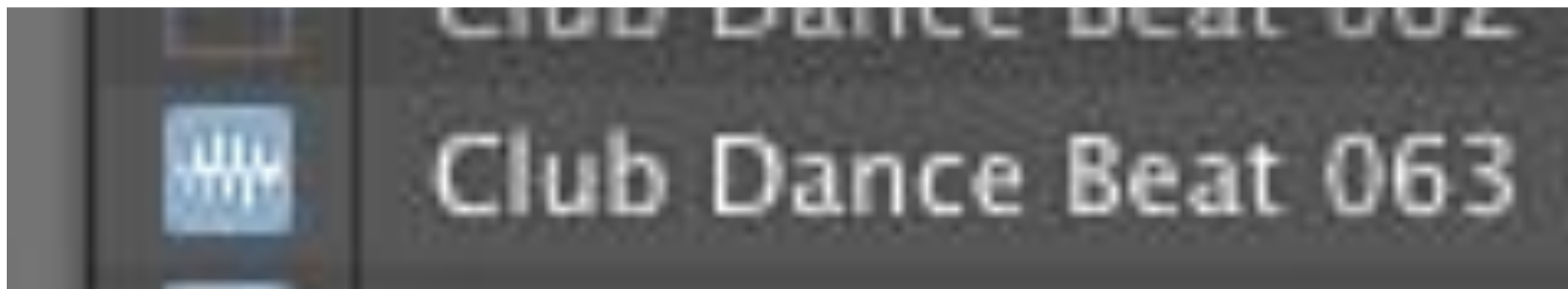
Find 80s Dance Pad 1.



Drag that to a new track in GarageBand as shown.



Click top right corner of Dance Bass Synth 06 and drag to the right until it is at the same point as Dance Pad 01.



Find Club Dance Beat 063.



Drag it to a third track. You can rewind and play it.



Choose Export Song to Disk... from the Share menu.



Click Export and save it to the Desktop. You now have a song you can copy to your phone as a ringtone.



Choose Quit from the GarageBand menu.



Click Save.

9. iMovie



Click the iMovie icon in Dock.



Click Close.



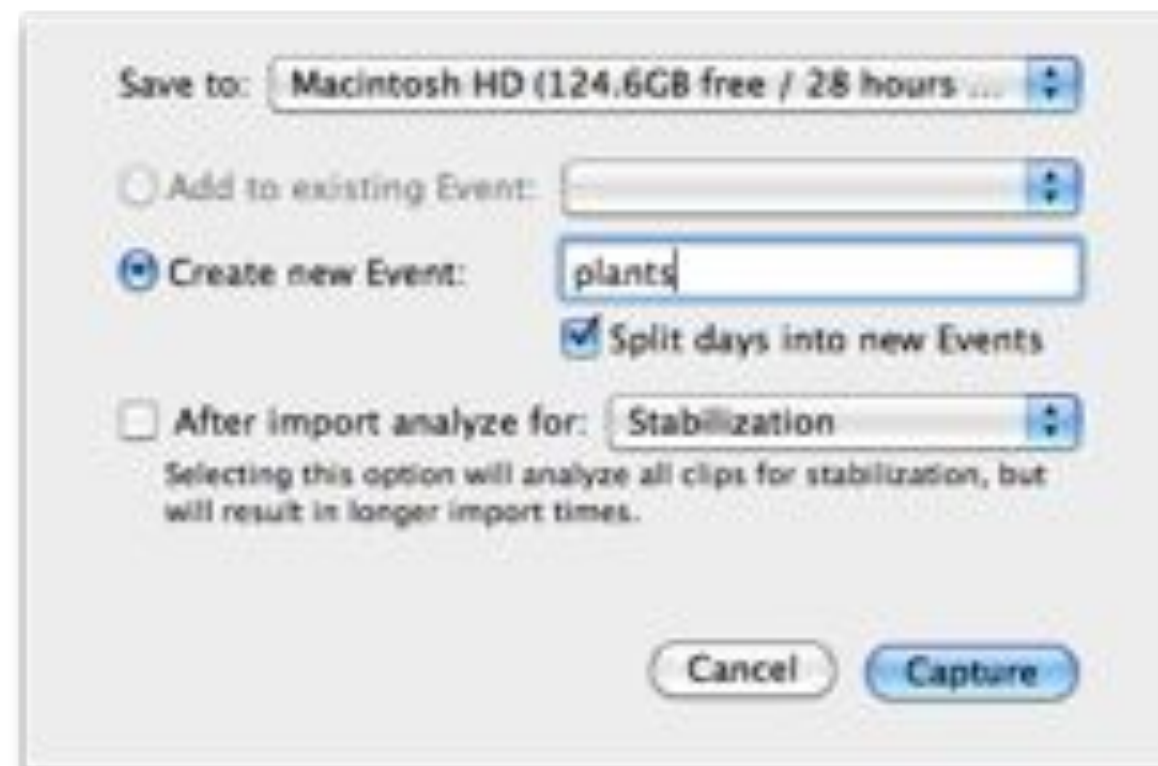
The main iMovie window is displayed.



Click on Camera icon.



You will see your face, click Capture...



Choose Create new Event and click Capture. You can change the event name if you wish.



Say “Hi, my name is (name) and i’d like to talk about plants”. Click Done.



The video has been captured, press the space bar to play it.
Select the whole clip or just the part you want.
Drag the selected part to the project area.

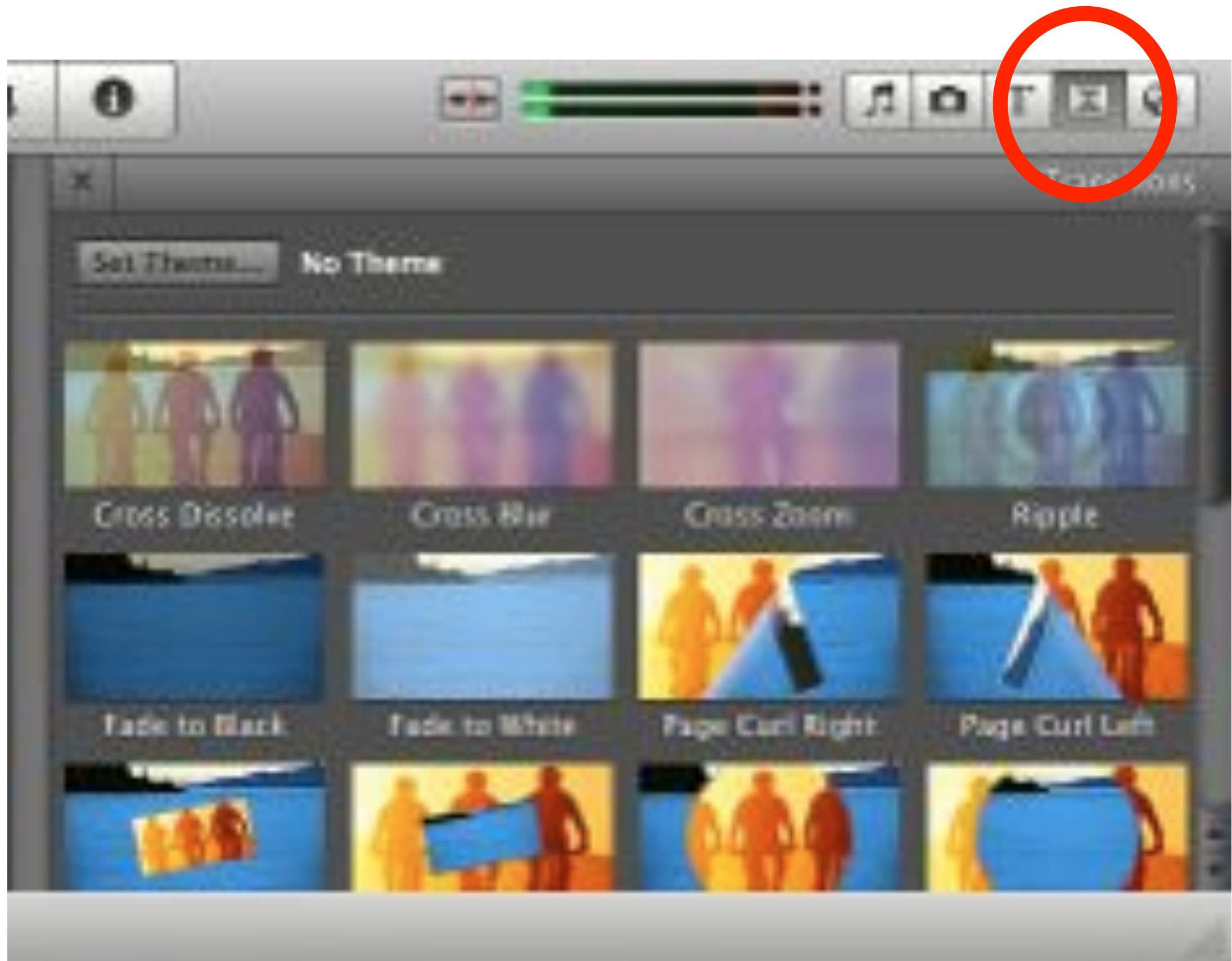

Click Photos tab.



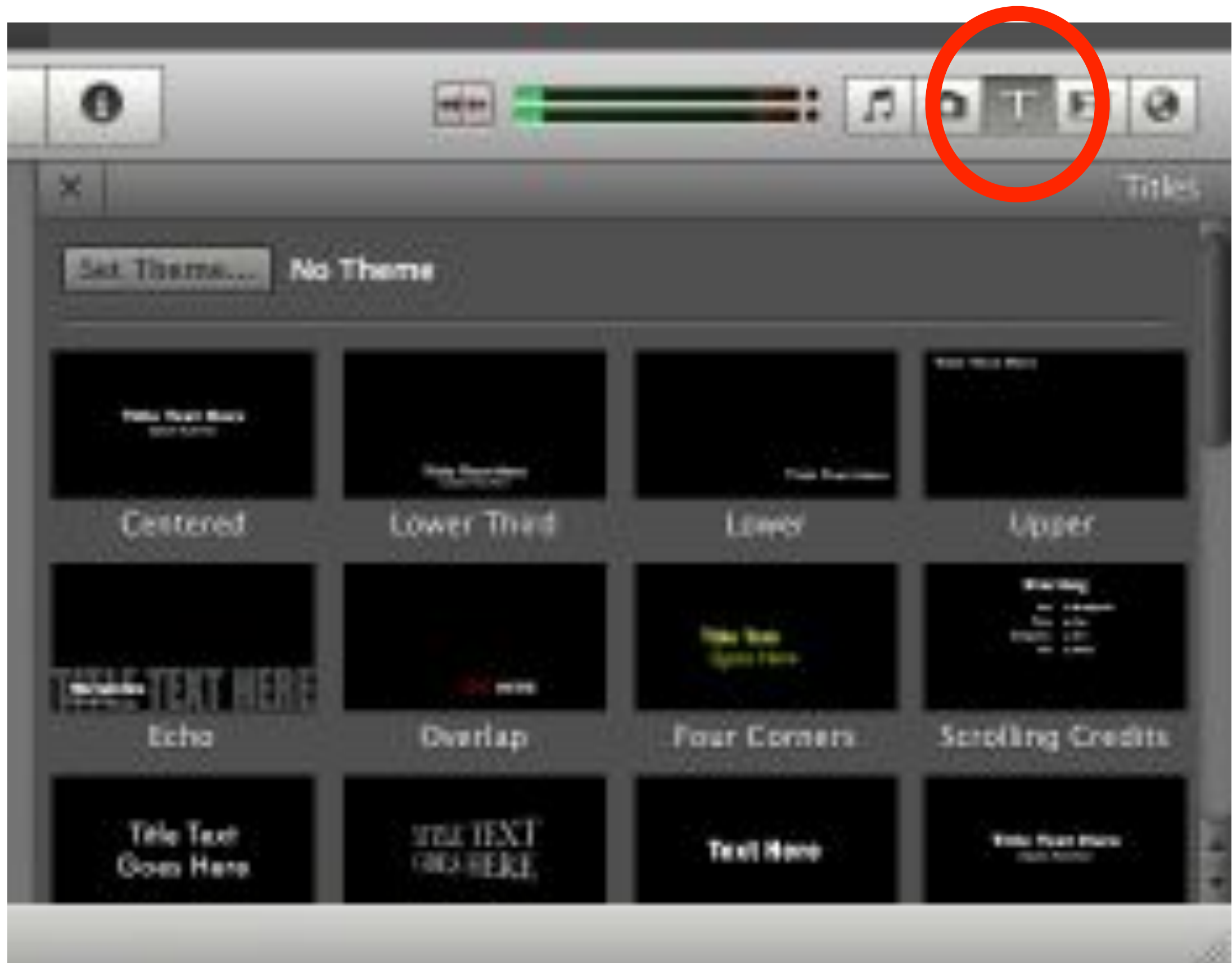
Drag at least 3 photos to project area.

Drag transitions between each clip.



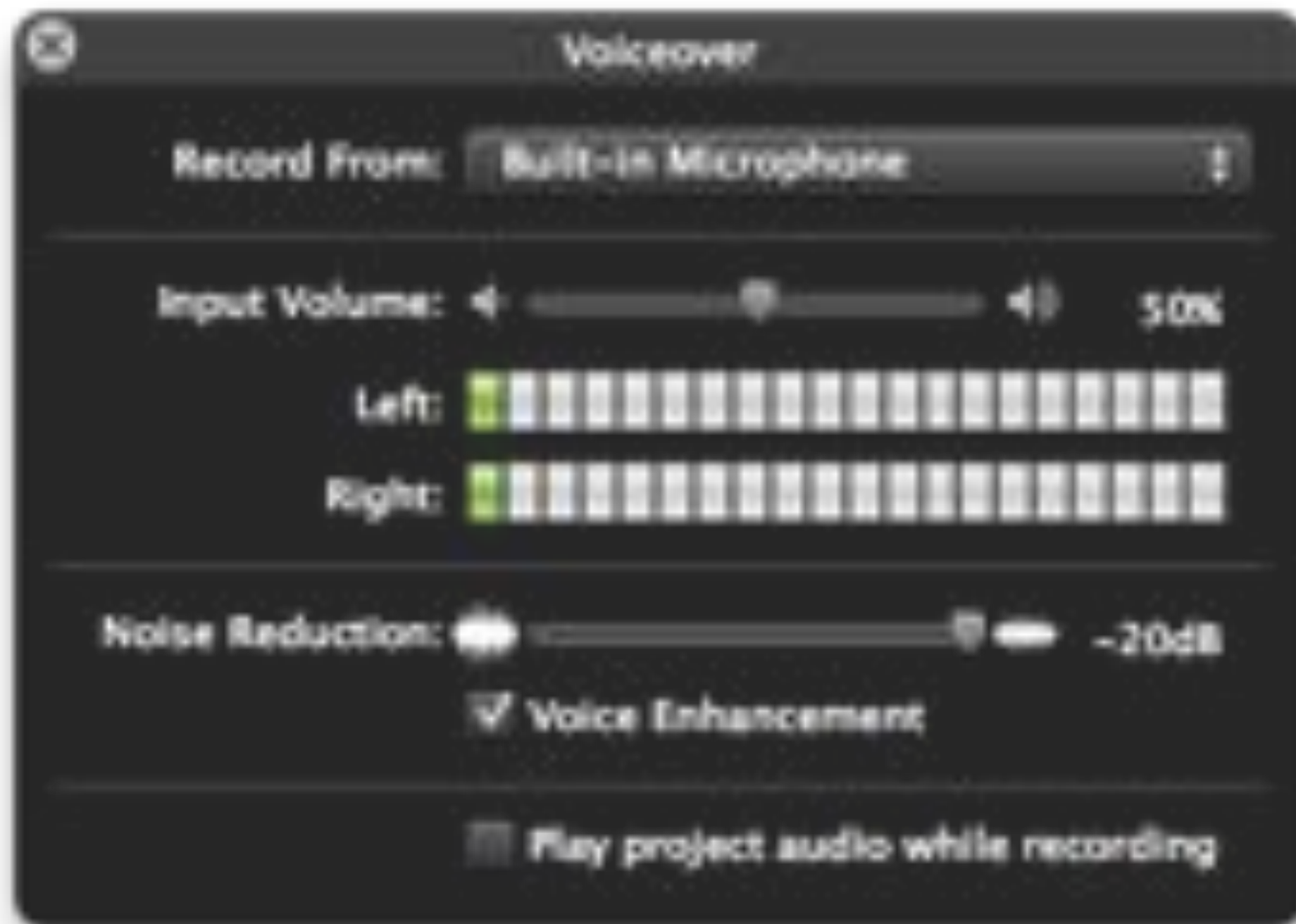
Click Titles.

Click again to stop, it appears as purple box.



Click Music, Click GarageBand.



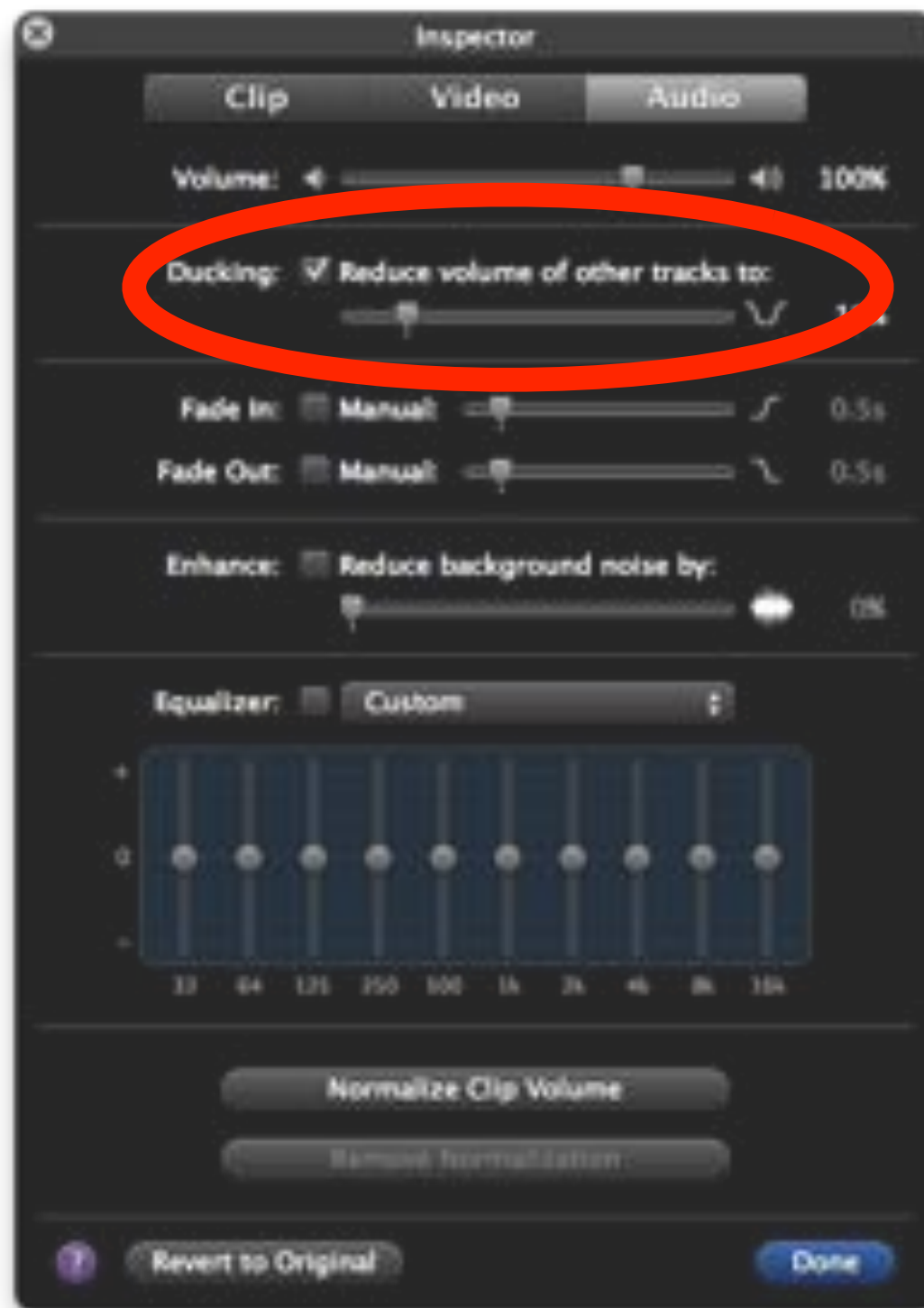
Drag the song you made earlier to the project. It appears as green block.



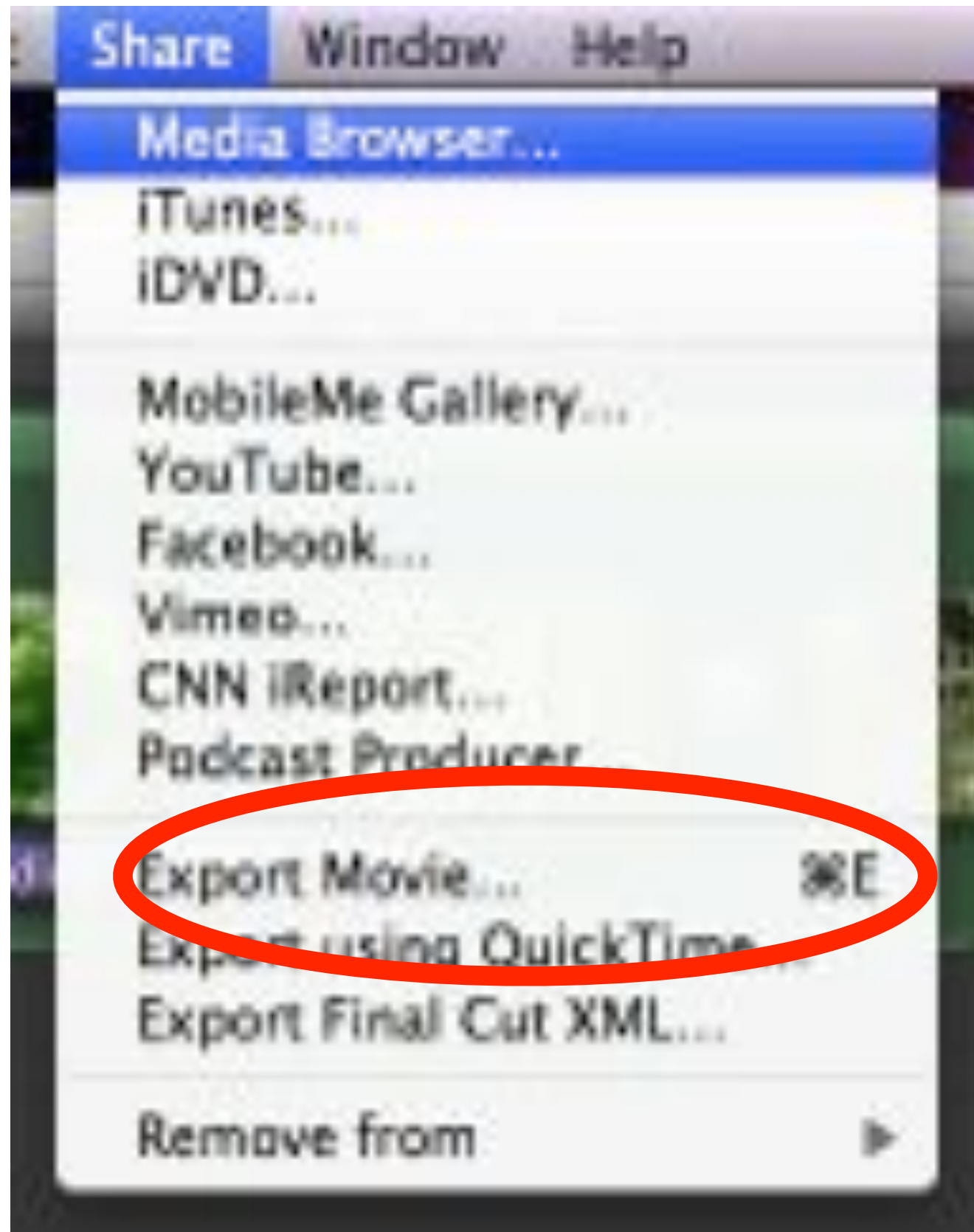
Your voice in the first clip will be much softer than the music. Click the clip to fix this.



Click on the i button.



Choose the Audio tab and tick Ducking.



Choose Export Movie... from the Share menu and save your movie to the my stuff folder.



Quit iMovie when done.
