Click Send to send an invitation to another teacher



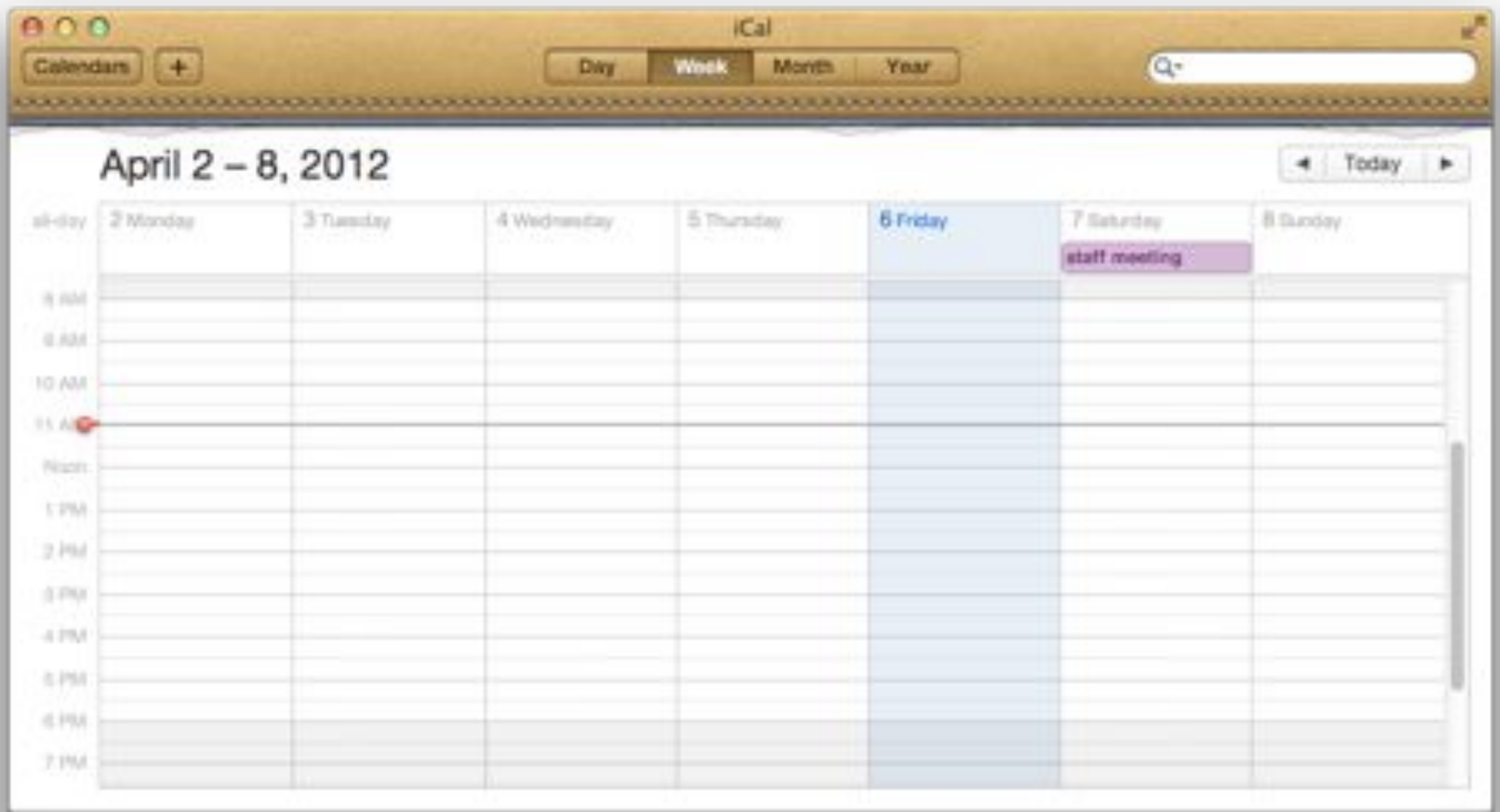
A badge appears on the second teacher's iCal



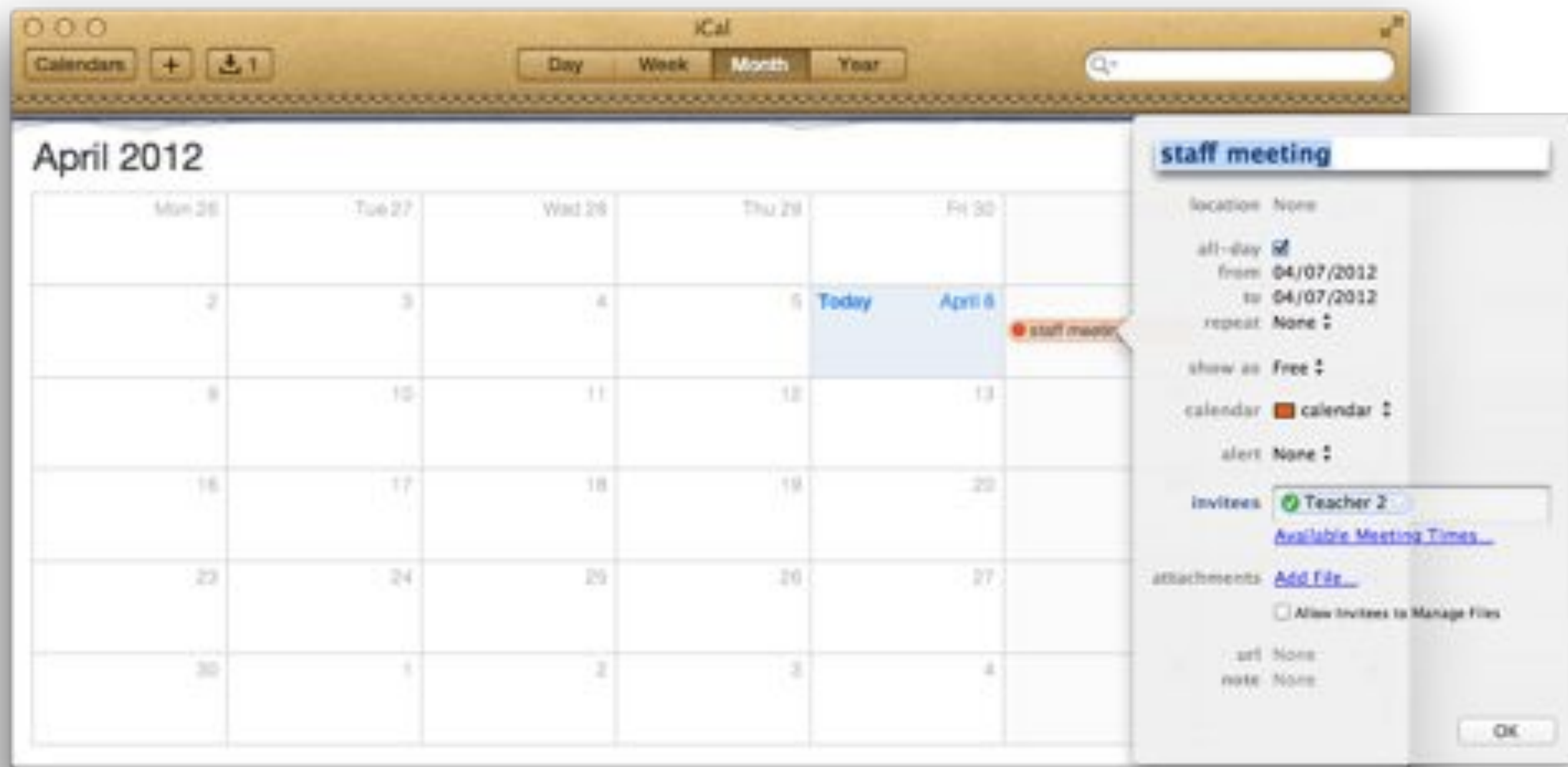
When iCal is launched you can see 1 in your in tray

Messages Beta brings iMessage to Mac and lets you send unlimited messages to iPhone, iPad, iPod touch, or Mac right from your Mac.

Send unlimited messages, photos, videos, documents, and contacts – even send messages to a group of people. If you have more than one Mac or iOS device, iMessage keeps the conversation going across all of them. iMessages are securely encrypted so your messages stay safe and private.

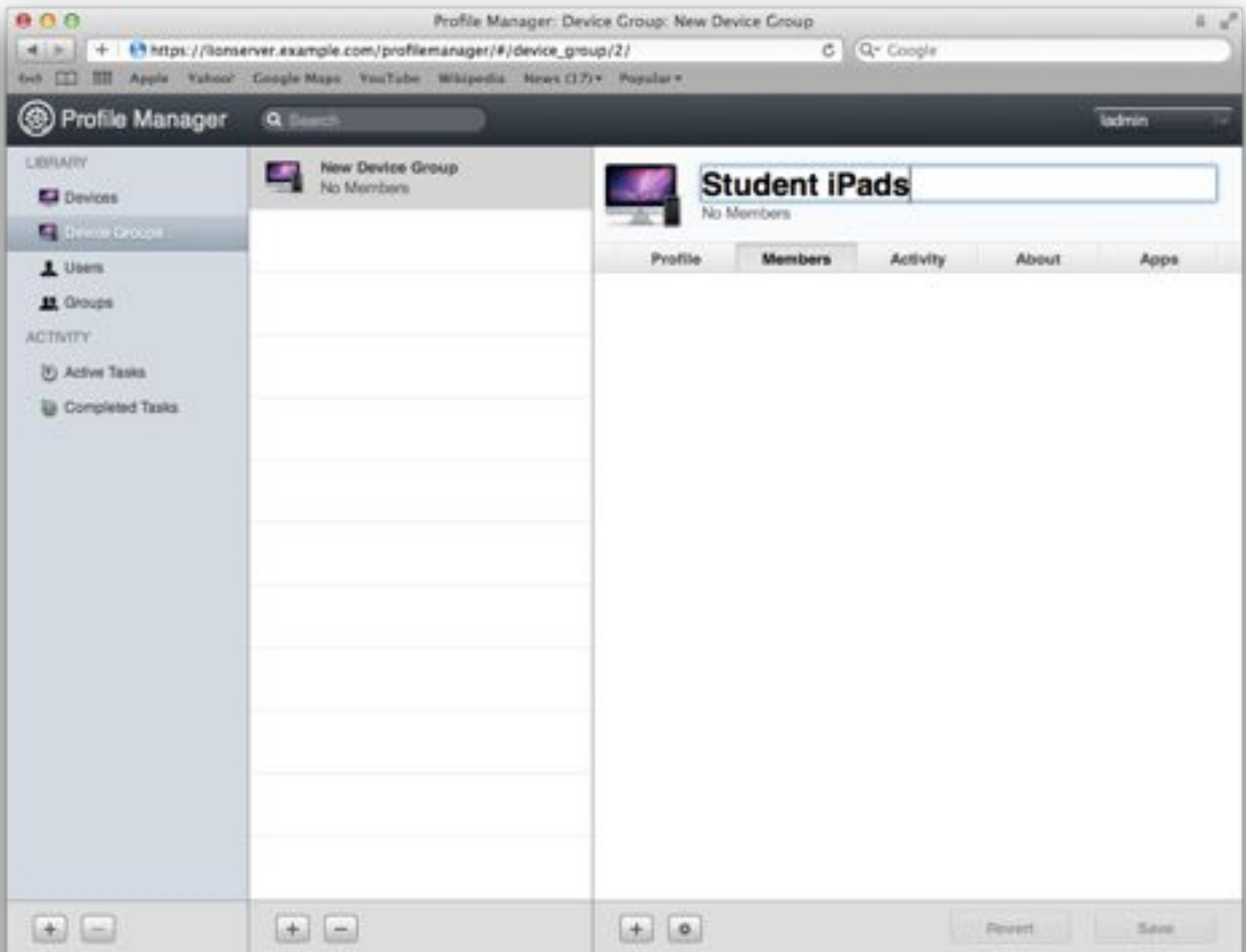
Installing Apps



Install iTunes on the server. Make sure it's configured with an iTunes Store account and authorize it using Authorize This Computer from the Store menu. Connect an iPad to it, and make sure the backup for this iPad is on the server, and encrypted.



Open Safari on the server and go to <http://lionserver.pretendco.com/profilemanager>. Click on Device Groups



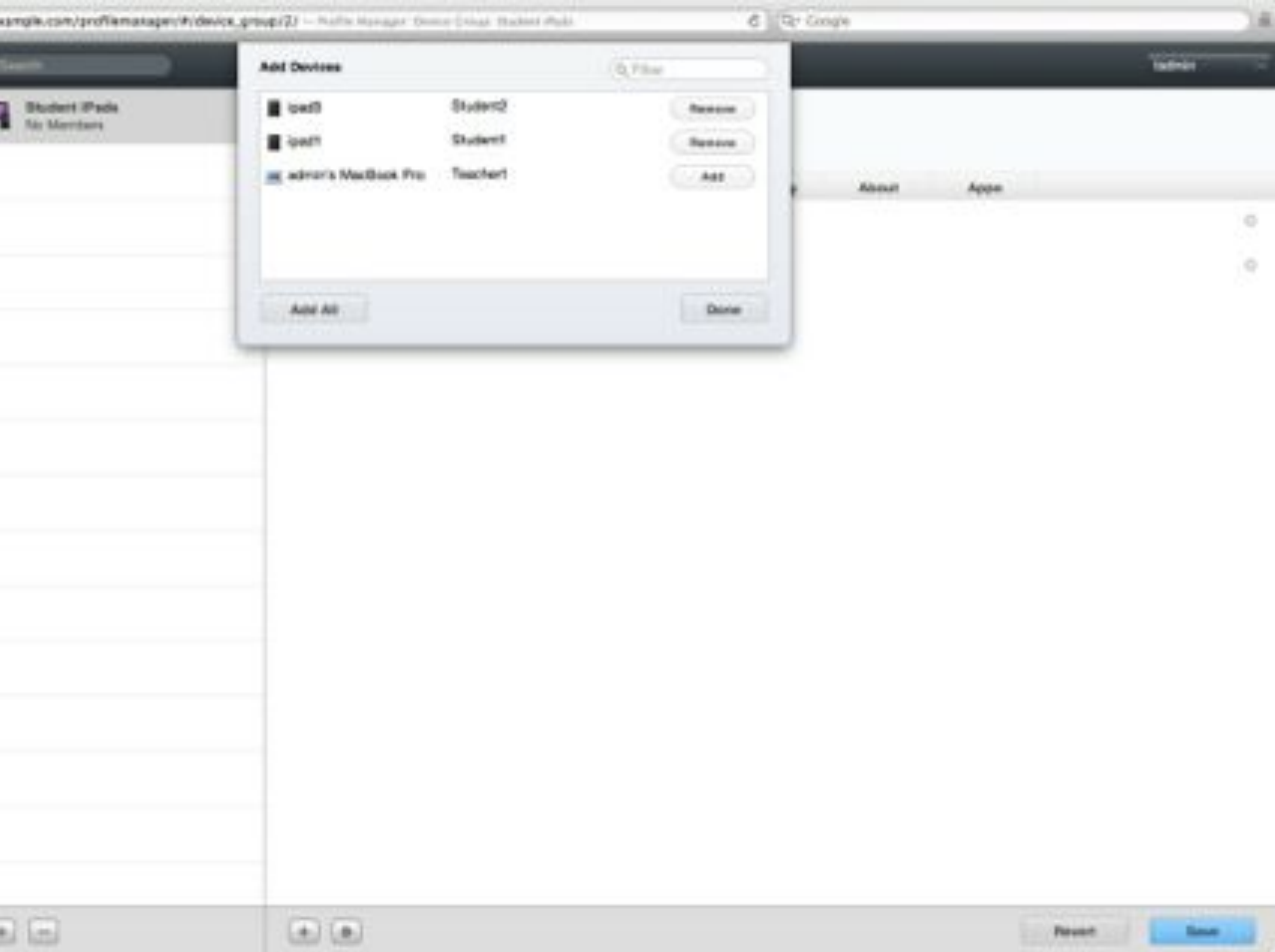
Create a new device group called Student iPads



Click Members



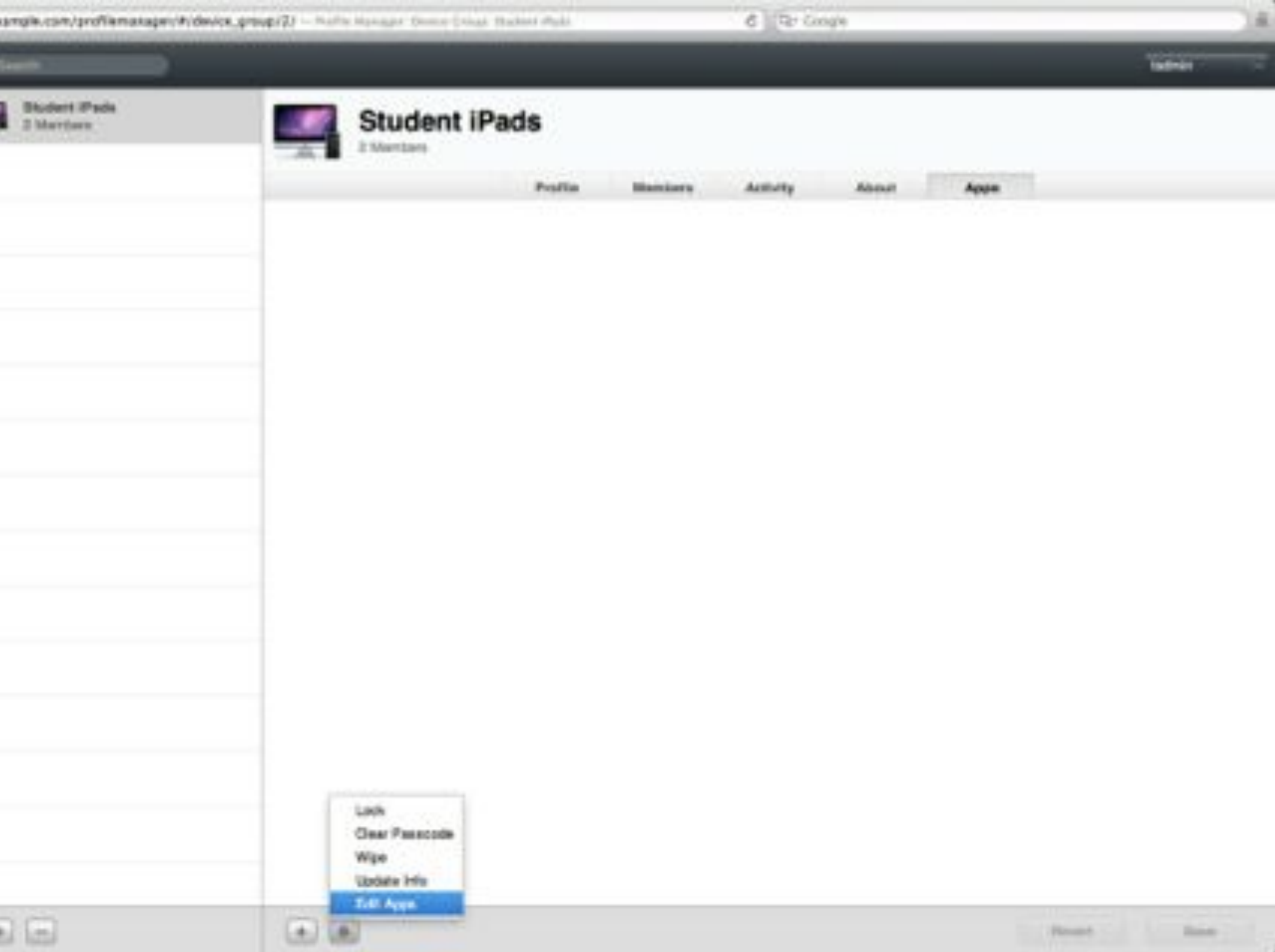
Click Add Devices



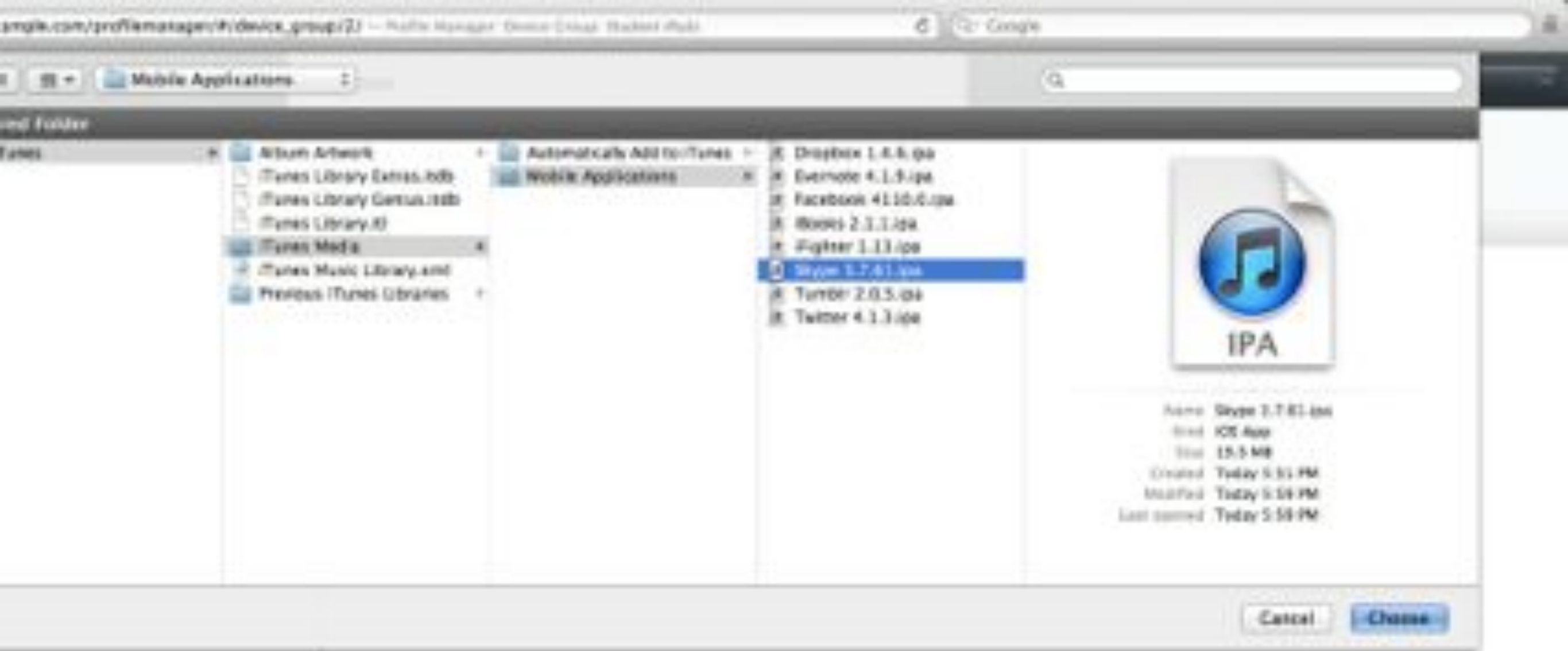
You should see all the iPads you enrolled. Add them and click Done



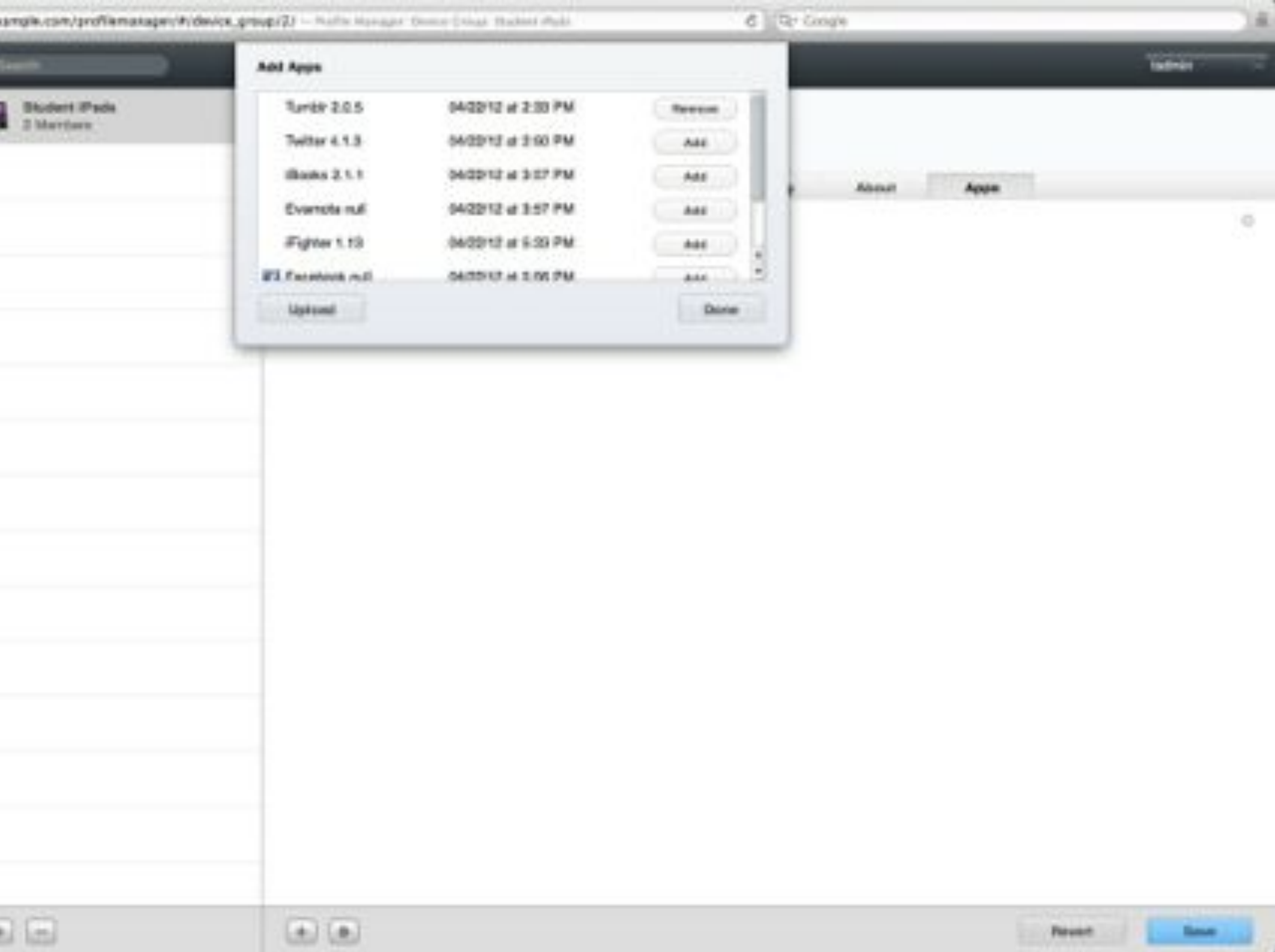
Click the blue Save button



Click Apps and choose Edit Apps



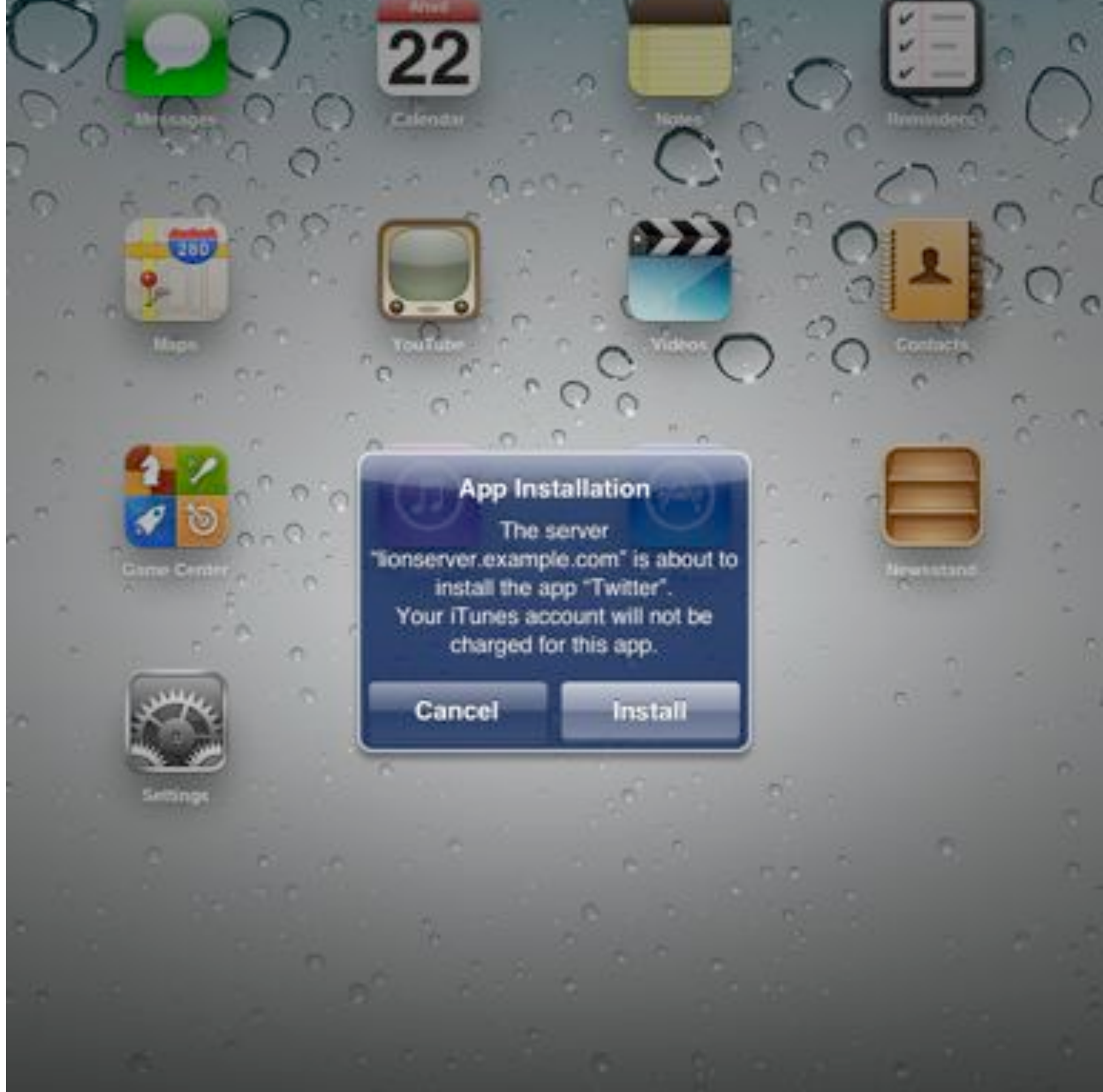
Navigate to your home directory, and go to Music/iTunes Music/Mobile Applications/ to see all iOS Apps.
Click one and click Choose



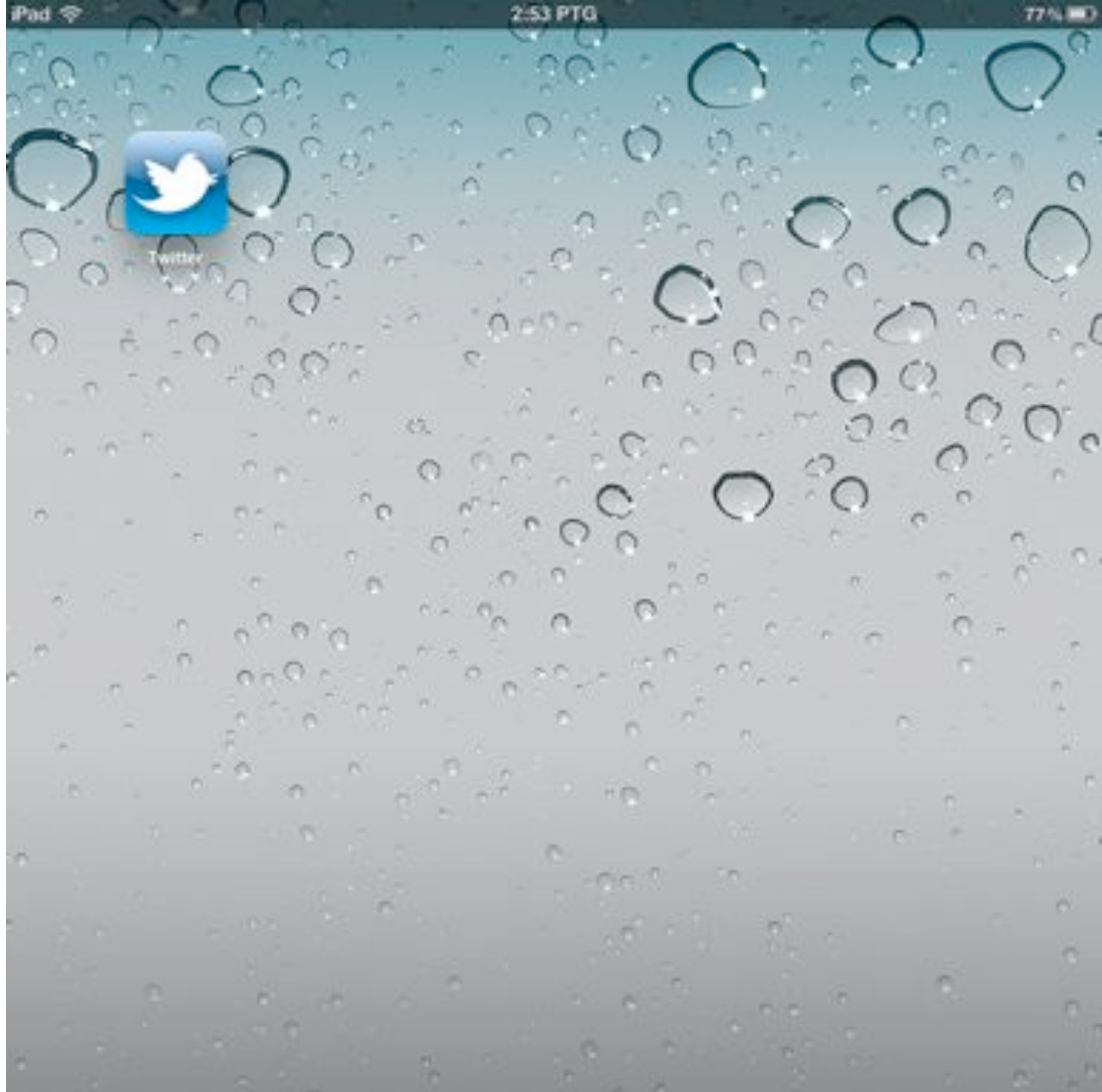
The app will appear in a window. Click Add and click Done
