Subject: Visual Art

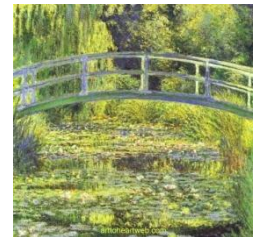
