



QUEENSLAND FIRE & RESCUE AUTHORITY SMOKE ALARMS SAVE LIVES

Most deaths and injuries from fires occur in the family home.

If a fire occurs in your home, your chances of survival are doubled if you have a smoke alarm. (Standards Approved and properly maintained)

Early warning of the presence of fire increases your chance of survival.

Install the smoke alarm between the sleeping areas and the lounge room and kitchen.

Higher risk groups, children, heavy sleepers, the elderly, hearing impaired, disabled etc, should have a smoke alarm in their bedroom.

IN THE EVENT OF FIRE RING 000 ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

1. Cut out the shape of the money box.
2. Fold the sides and the ends of the Fire Unit down from the roof.
3. Fold in the tabs marked A, B, C & D.
4. Fold tab A into slot A, then tab B into slot B & so on to D. Glue flaps for a stronger join.
