Kahoot!

- ✓ Competitive – perfect for AIG students
- ✓ Quick – 5 to 120 seconds per quiz question

Quiz

- Competitive (points earned; correct answer given)
- Results can be exported for data analysis
 - Students create quizzes to show learned knowledge

Survey

- Not competitive (no points earned; no correct answer given)
- Results can be exported for data analysis
 - Students gather information through research

Discussion

- Just like the Survey option, but with only one question

Google Drive

- ✓ Motivator – write more, collaborate more, learn more
- ✓ Mobility – access from here, there, and everywhere that has internet
- ✓ Communication – virtual parent/teacher conference
- ✓ Portfolio – store data, notes, work samples, and resumes

Google Forms

- Assessments
 - Multiple choice, checkboxes, short answer text boxes
- Surveys
 - Graphs based on students' favorite part of a field trip, needs at school, sports performance
 - Presentations based on students' ideas about school, local, global issues

Google Docs

- Write letters, create resumes, complete assignments
 - School improvement projects, grocery lists/party supplies (fractions, money), water cycle illustration, senior graduation project

Live Chat

- Collaboration Tool
 - Instantaneous peer review
 - Work together at home or in school

- ✓ Creativity – plethora of options
- ✓ Mobility – easy access with internet
- ✓ Presentation – more engaging to audience
