Time Frame	Components (Responsibility/Grouping)	Assessment
20 min.	Warm-up: Students will have five minutes to review grammar notebooks before taking a fifteen item grammar quiz. (Bloom's: Knowledge and Application)	Formal Assessment: 15 item quiz.
20 min.	Introduction: As a final assessment for <i>Ethan Frome</i> , students will create a new ending for the novel. Distribute and discuss the rubric. Remind students of some of the opinions expressed in yesterday's discussion.	Informal Assessment: determine student understanding of the assignment by evaluating responses. *Project to be formally assessed with a rubric.
30 min.	Student Activity: "Dr. Phil's Fish Bowl: The Bermuda Triangle of Love" "Dr. Phil" will mediate between members of the panel as they discuss reasons for their actions and express grievances towards other panel members in an attempt to resolve their issues. "Dr. Phil" will allow "the audience" to pose questions and facilitate the development of a solution. (Bloom's: Knowledge, Comprehension, Application, Analysis, Evaluation, Synthesis)	Formal Assessment: Project assessed according to rubric.

Time Frame	Components (Responsibility/Grouping)	Assessment
10 min.	Debriefing: Survey the class to attain feedback on the proposed solutions. Was anything left out? Are the solutions realistic in light of the characters' personalities? (Bloom's: Synthesis)	Informal assessment: Assess students as they participate in discussion and answer questions.
10 min.	Closure: Students clean-up and return to seats. Remind students that Writer's Workshop will begin tomorrow.
