

- **1989**
The World Wide Web begins as a CERN (European Organization for Nuclear Research) project called ENQUIRE, initiated by British scientist Tim Berners-Lee.
- **1989**
AOL launches its Instant Messenger chat service and begins welcomign users with the iconic greating "You've got mail!"
- **1990**
Archie, the first tool to search the internet is developed by McGill University student Alan Emtage.
- **1991**
The line-mode browser launces. it is the first readily accessible browser for the World Wide Web.
- **1993**
The NCSA releases Mosaic 1.0, the first web browser to become popular with the gener public.
- **1994**
Yahoo! is created by Stanford University grauate students.
- **1995**
Microsoft releases Windows 95 and the first version of Internet Explorer.
- **1996**
HotMail launches as one of the world's first Webmail service,
- **1997**
Google.com registers as a domain.
- **2001**
Jimmy Wales launches Wikipedi.
- **1998**
Oxford Dictionary adds "span" and "digerati."
- **2002**
A TV streaming media device.
- **2003**
WordPress blog publishing system created
- **2004**
Mozilla releases Firefox 1.0
- **2004**
Zuckerberg launches thefacebook.com
- **2005**
YouTube is founded on Feb. 14.
- **2005**
The first personalized dashboard publishing platform.
- **2006**
Twitter launches.
- **2006**
A home video game console by Nintendo.
- **2007**
Lets you effortlessly share anything.

Apple releases its first iPhone.
- 2007
A defined hosting environment for web-based applications.
- 2008
Apple launches its App Stores with 552 applications.
- 2008
A freeware web browser by Google.
- 2009
The first mobile augmented reality browser.
- 2010
A iOS based line of tablet computers
- 2011
An intelligent personal assistant and knowledge navigator.
- 2012
Cloud computing allows software to be operated using internet-enabled devices.
- 2012
Web-based approach to semantic markup which seeks to re-use existing HTML/XHTML tags to convey metadata.
- 2013
An app that lets users create documents on any compatible device
- 2013
An app that can be accessed while working on the Office applications such as Word, Excel, and Powerpoint.
- 2015
The main international standards organization for the World Wide Web.
