The ECU AIG Add-On Licensure Program is comprised of a Four Course Sequence taught at the Graduate Level. A new cohort begins every summer and is taught ONLINE with the exception of ONE WEEK of face-to-face interaction each summer at our AIG Camp.

### **SPED 6104 INTRODUCTION TO GIFTED EDUCATION**

An introduction to the education of gifted students emphasizing definitions, characteristics, theories of intelligence, and methods of identification.

### **SPED 6401 METHODS & MATERIALS IN GIFTED EDUCATION**

An in-depth investigation of the materials, programs, and theories of educating the gifted.

FALL SEMESTER

### **SPED 6402 DIFFERENTIATED CURRICULUM FOR THE GIFTED**

An in-depth study of assessment and the development of differentiated curriculum for gifted students.

SPRING SEMESTER

### **SPED 6403 PRACTICUM IN GIFTED EDUCATION**

Actual classroom teaching experience with gifted children. Students will be responsible for planning and implementing instructional programs.
